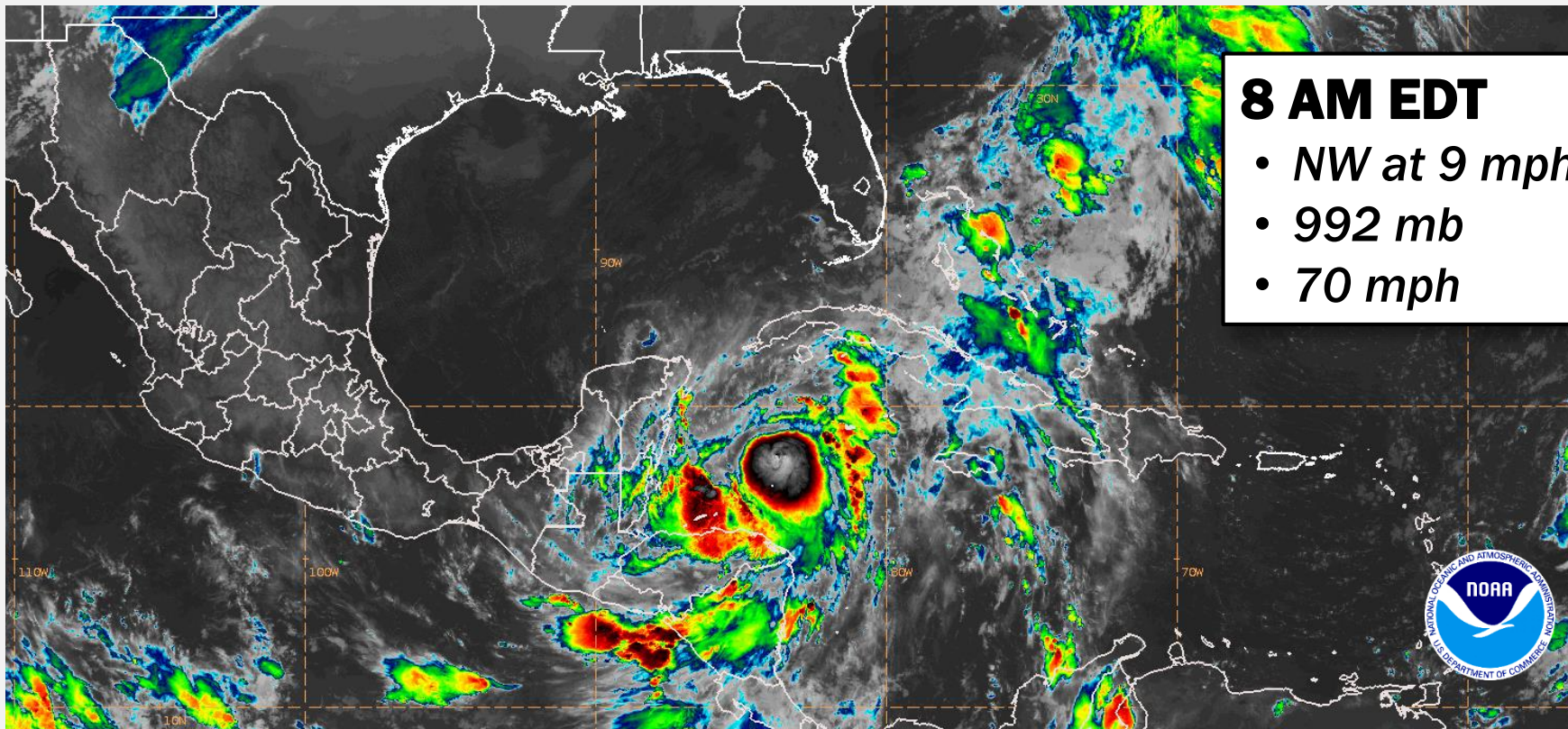
Tropical Activity:

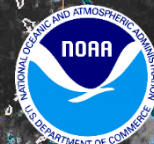

SATELLITE LOOP



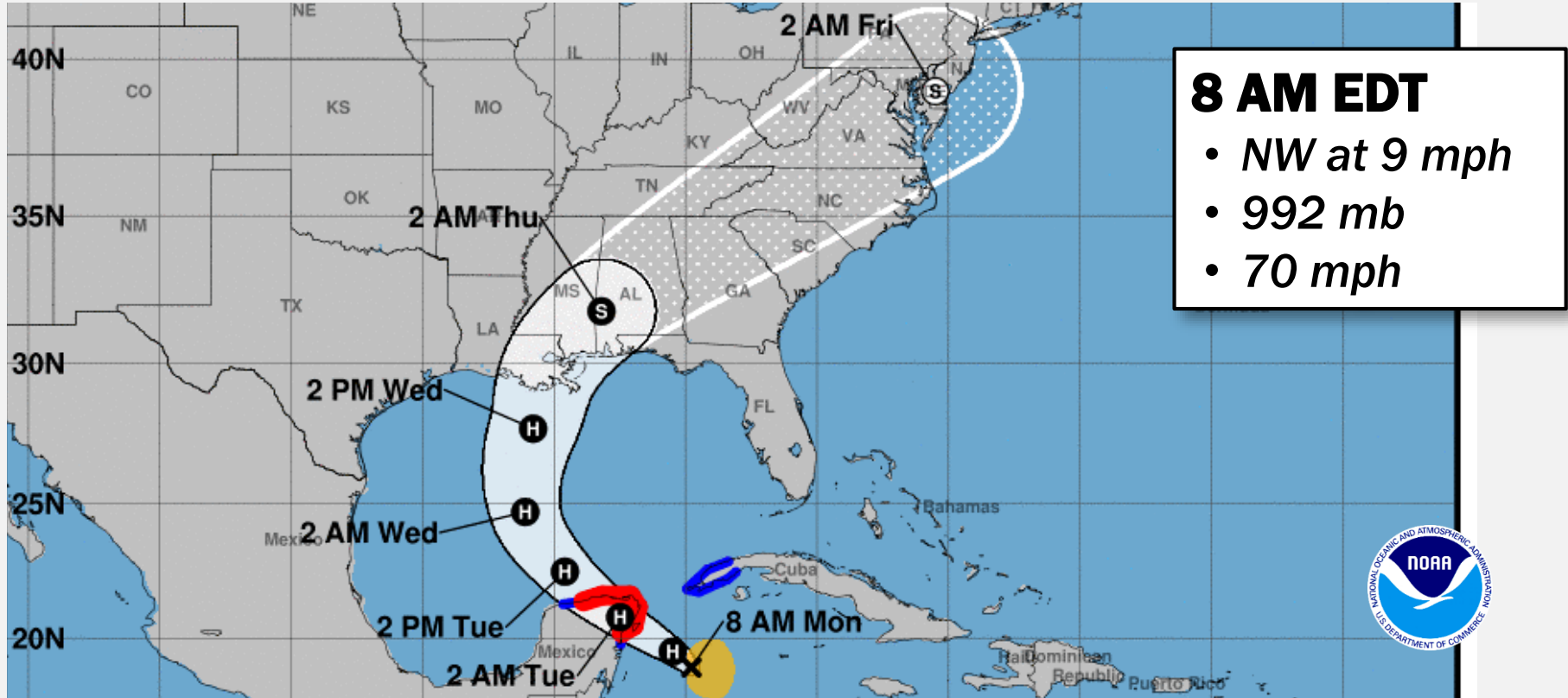

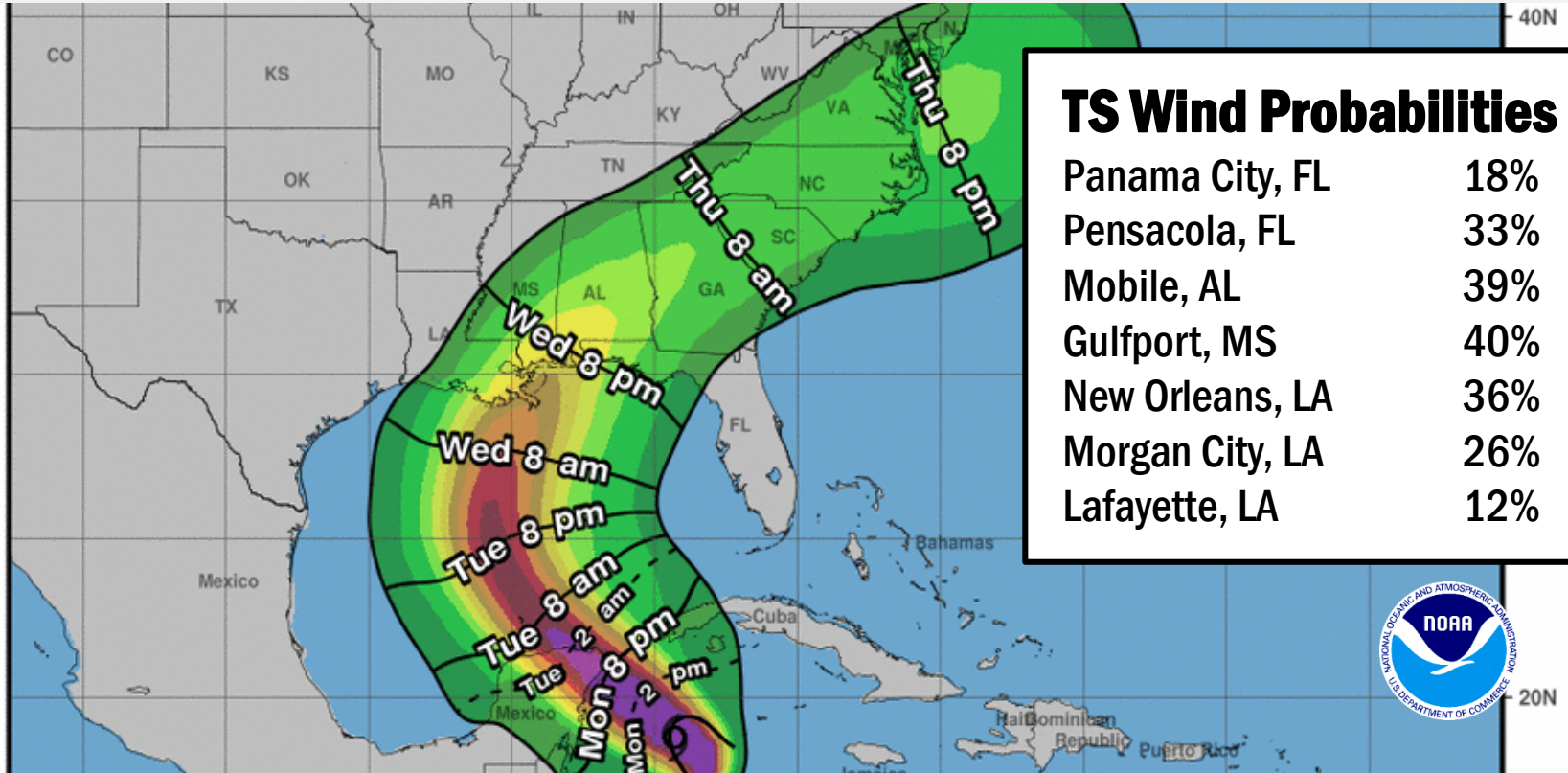

FORECAST TRACK



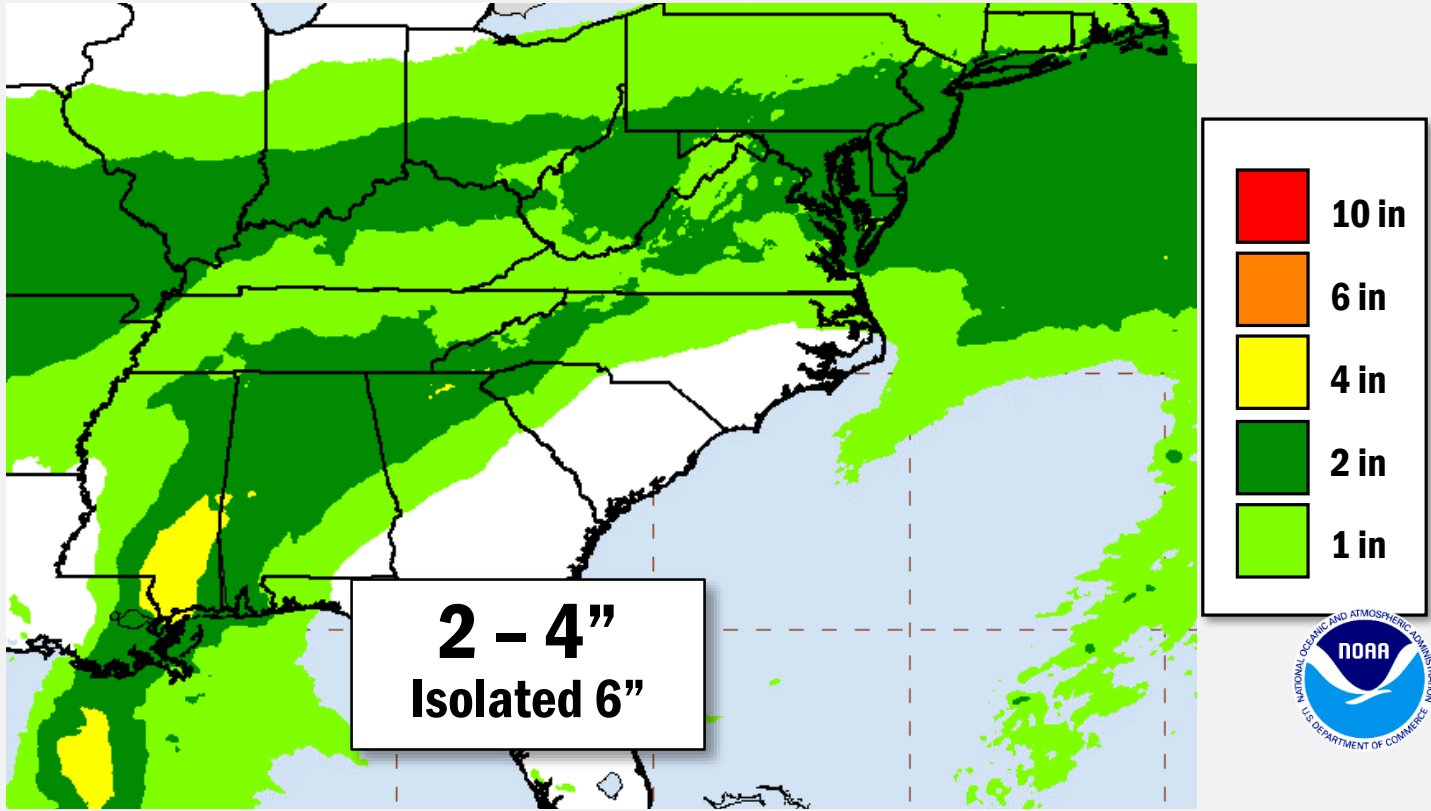

5 DAY RAINFALL



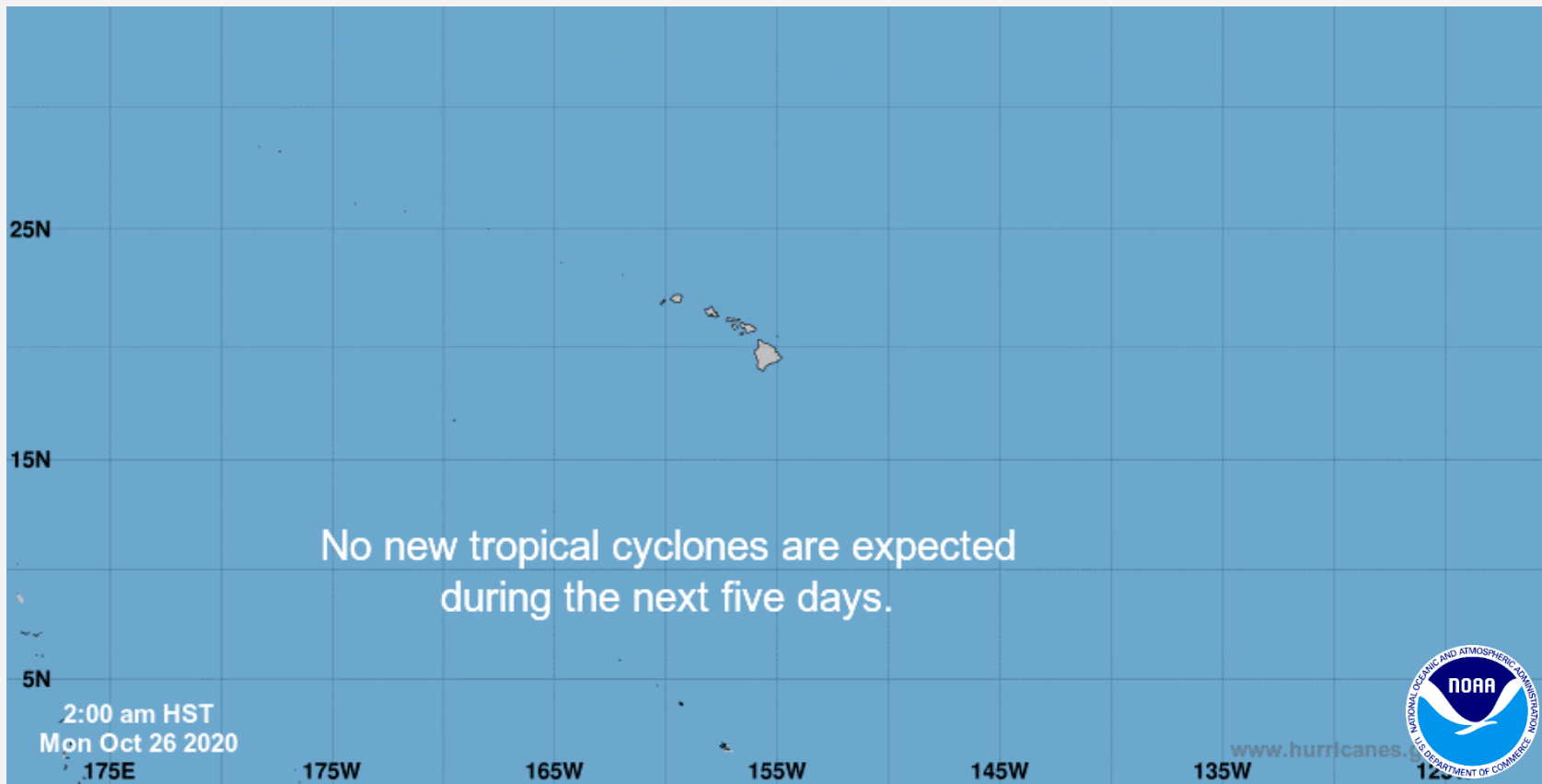

Tropical Cyclone Zeta – Preparation



Current Situation: Zeta is forecast to reach the central Gulf coast on Wednesday, at or near hurricane strength.

Potential Impacts:

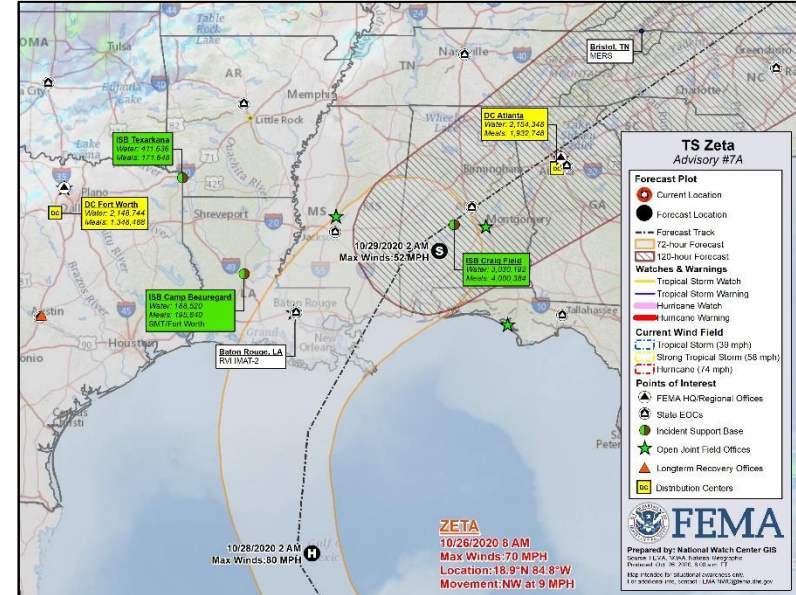
- Rainfall totals of 2 to 4 inches; local amounts of 6 inches expected across portions of the U.S. Gulf Coast and southern U.S. by Wednesday
- Heavy rainfall will spread north into the Tennessee Valley, Southern Appalachians, and portions of the Mid-Atlantic states later in the week

State/Local Preparations and Continuing Response:

- LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Laura, TC Delta, and COVID-19)
 - 1 congregate shelter / 50 occupants; non-congregate / 3,278 occupants (TC Delta)
- AL EOC at Partial Activation (TC Sally, TC Delta, and COVID-19)
- MS EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta and COVID-19)
- FL EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)

FEMA/Federal Preparations and Continuing Response:

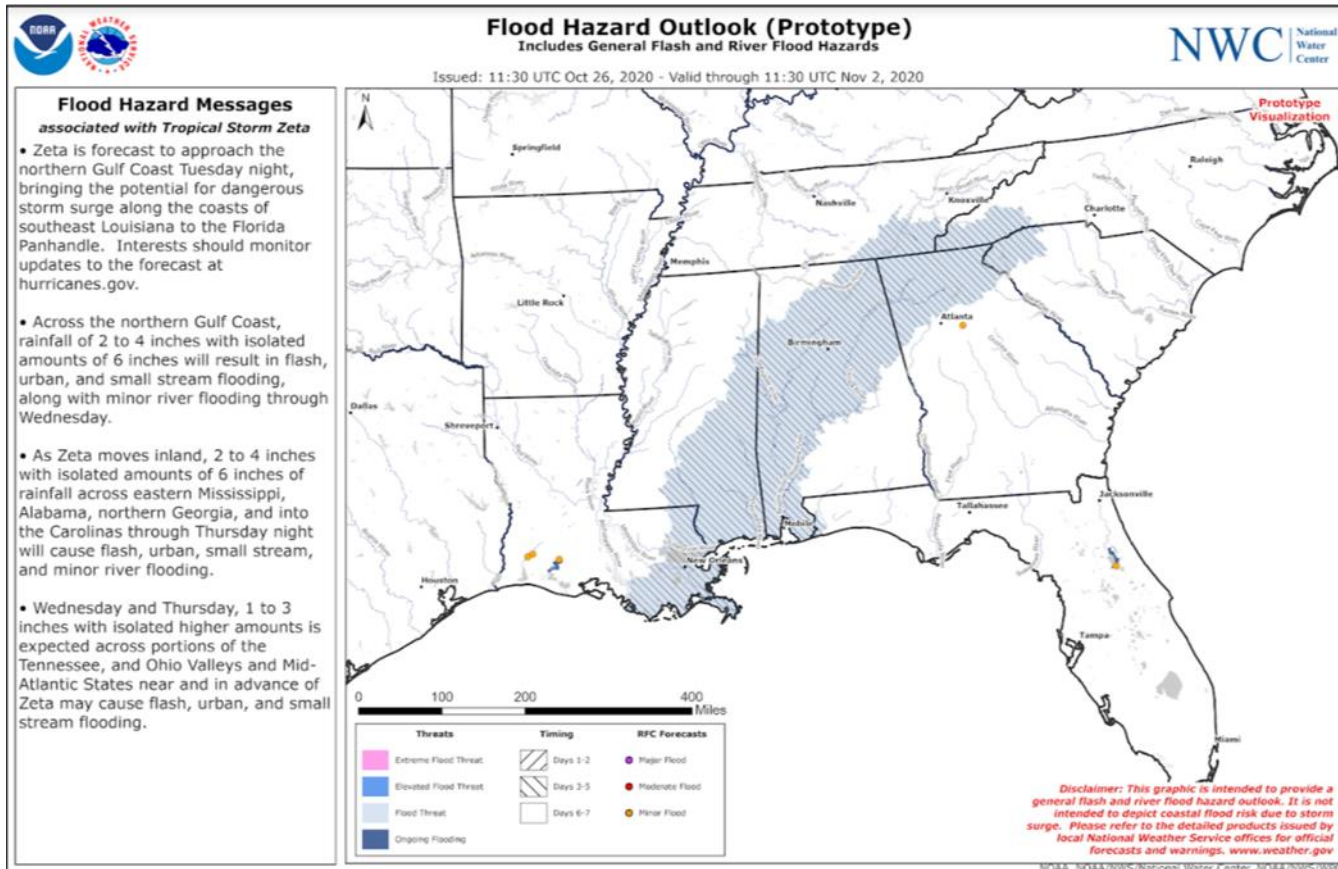
- NRCC at Level III (COVID-19)
- FEMA RIV RRCC Rostered; RWC is Rostered for possible Enhanced Watch
 - IMAT-1 and 2 are FMC
 - JFO operating in Canton, MS (TC Delta)

 - JFO operating in Montgomery, AL (TC Sally)
- FEMA RVI RRCC at Level III (COVID-19); RWC Monitoring
 - IMAT-1 is FMC, TX; IMAT-2 deployed to Baton Rouge, LA (TC Laura)
 - SMT deployed in Camp Beauregard, LA (TC Delta)
 - VJFO operating in Baton Rouge, LA (TC Delta)



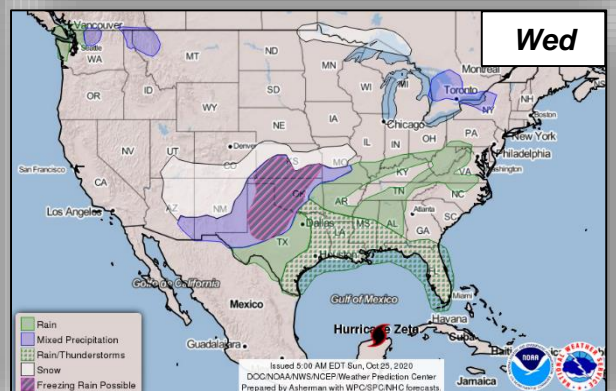
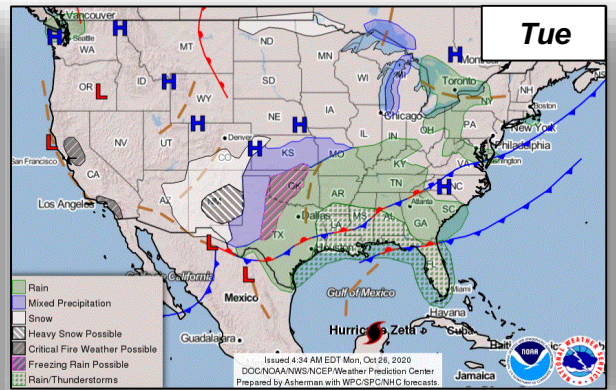
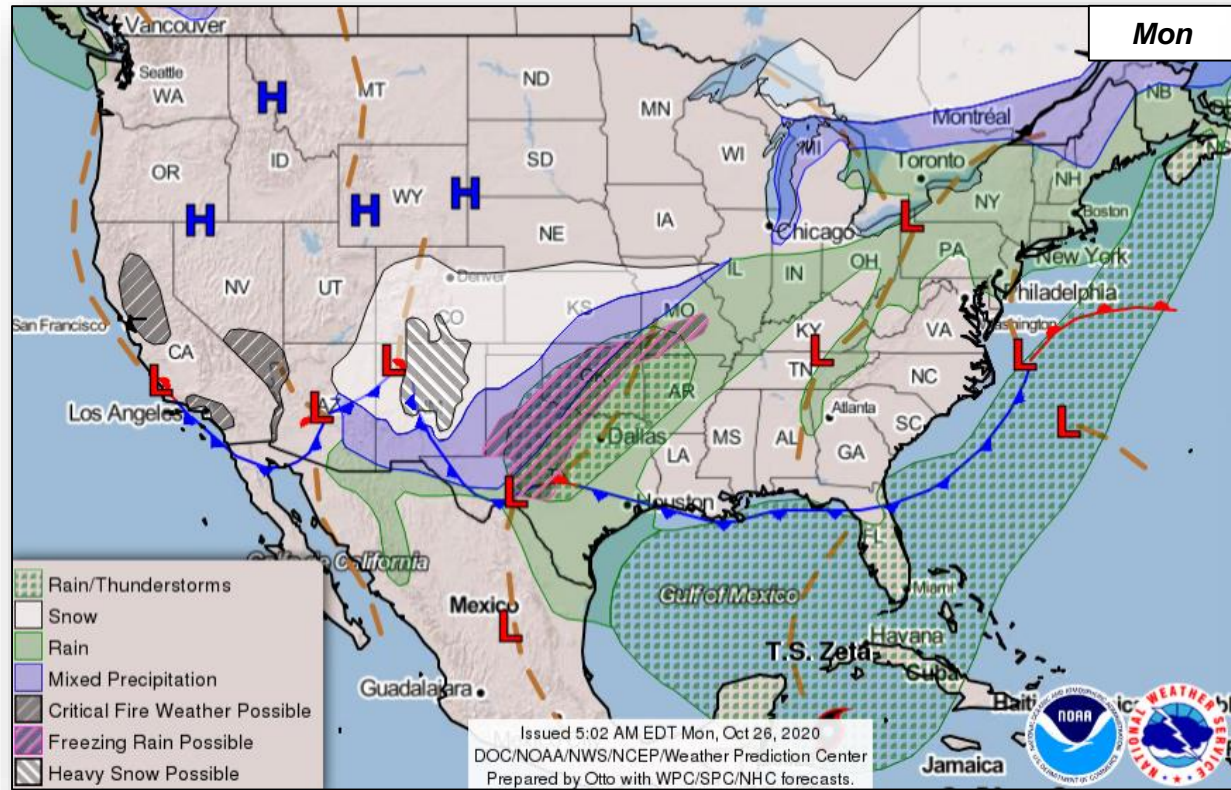
Flood Hazard Outlook



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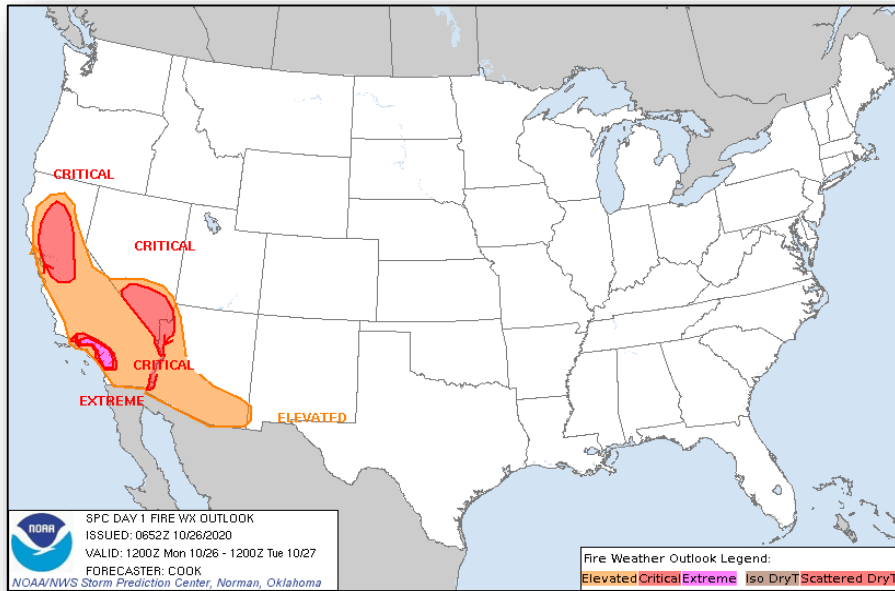

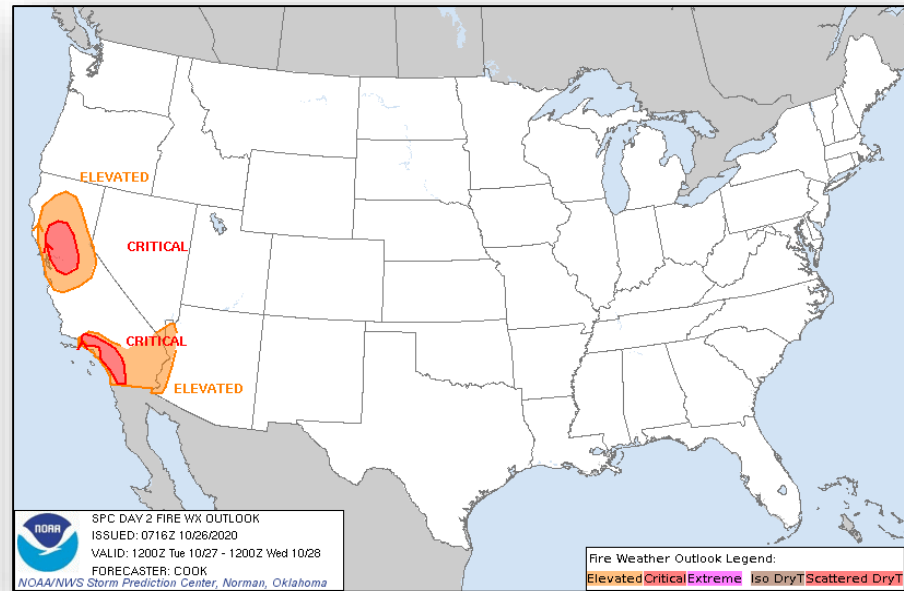

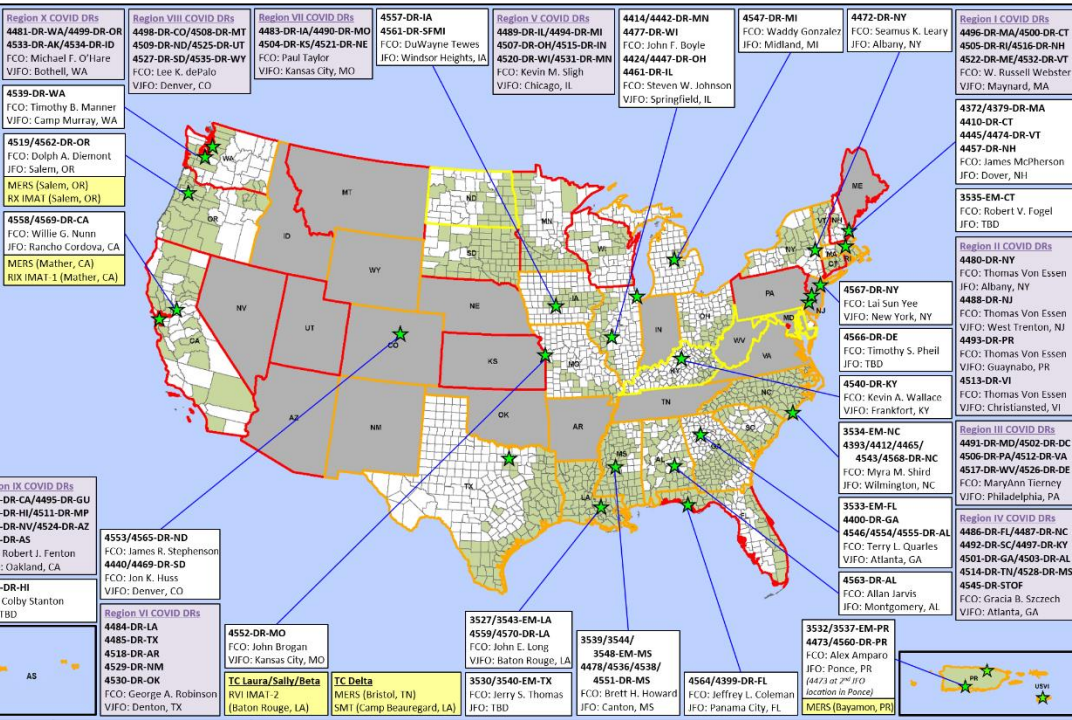
