# Kincade Fire – CA



## **Situation:**

Kincade Fire is currently threatening several towns in Sonoma County. Critical fire weather conditions and Red Flag Warnings are in effect.

## **Lifeline Impacts:** *(Region IX SLB and Incident Report)*

### **Safety and Security**

- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 185,980 people
- 3 tribes evacuated (Dry Creek Rancheria, Cloverdale Rancheria of Pomo Indians of California, Lytton Rancheria of California)

### **Food, Water, Shelter**

- 14 shelters open with 3,211 occupants

### **Health & Medical**

- 3 hospitals, 2 nursing homes, and 1 dialysis center evacuated

### **Energy (Power & Fuel)**

- 1 million customers without power due to a combination of fire and Public Safety Power Shutoff
- Geyserville Geothermal Power Plant threatened with some damage

### **Communications**

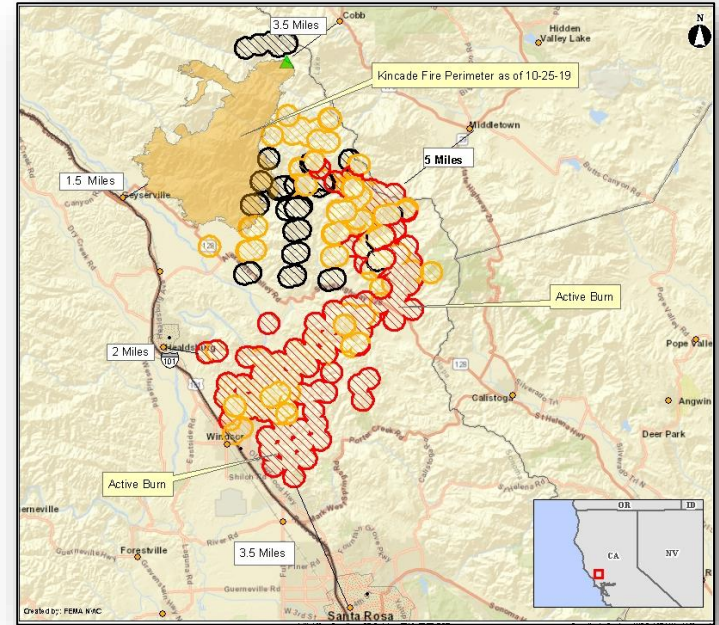
- Vulnerability assessments ongoing

### **Transportation**

- Major road closures (portions of Highway 101 and SR 128)

### **State/Local Response:**

- CA EOC at Full Activation
- Governor declared a statewide emergency
- National Guard has been activated



### **FEMA/Federal Response:**

- FMAG FEMA-5295-FM-CA approved October 24
- Region IX RWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
- Region IX IMAT- 1, select ESFs, and 2 LNOs deployed to CA EOC
- ISB/SMT and MERS deployed to CA
- NWC at Steady State, continues to monitor

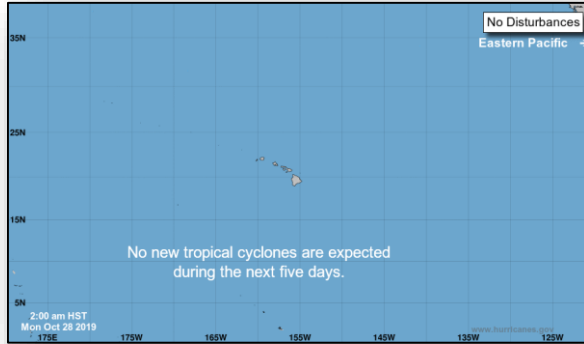

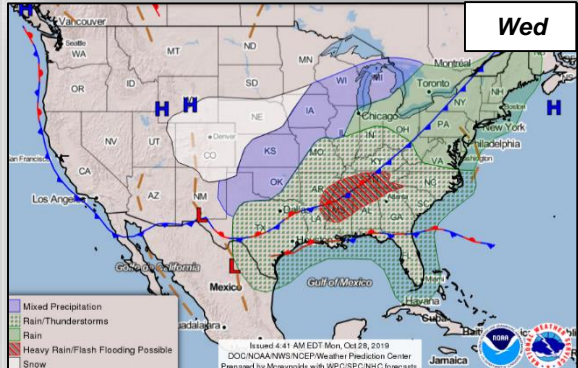
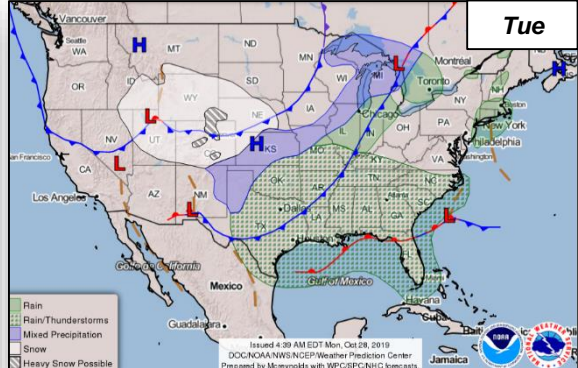
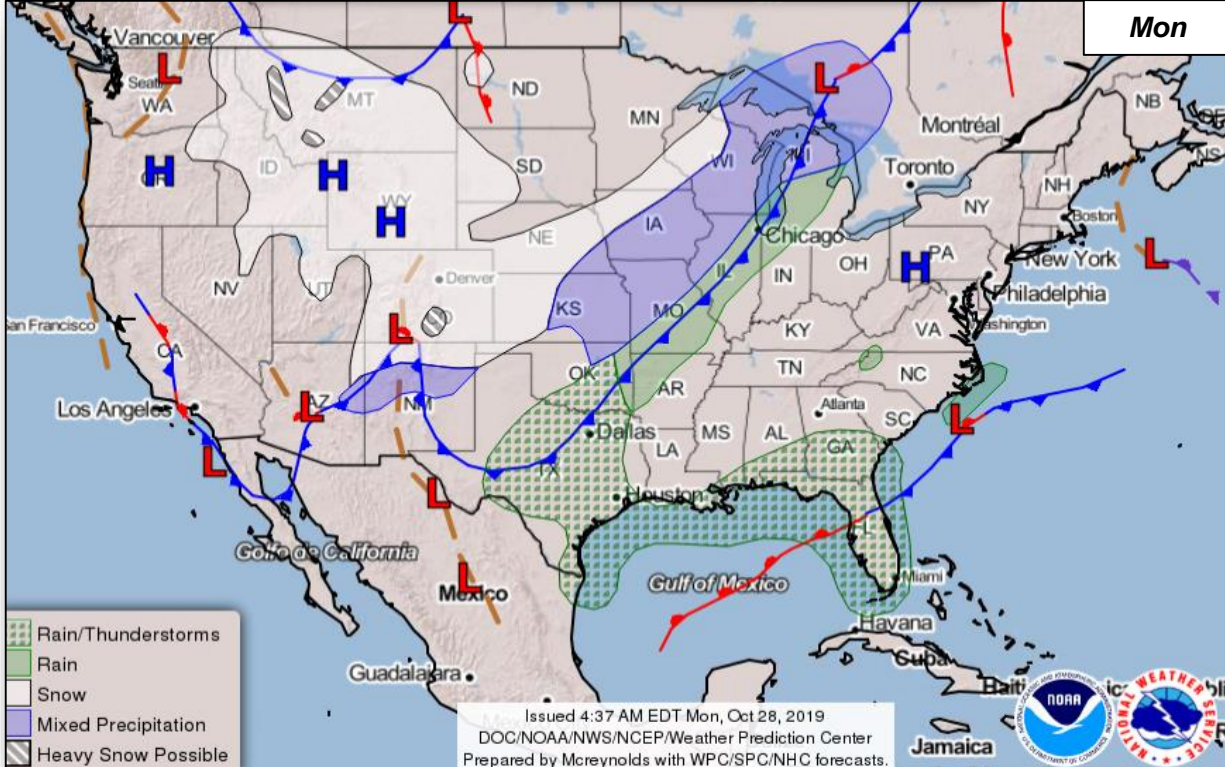
## **Disturbance 1** (As of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

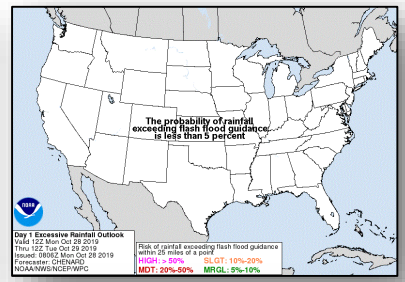
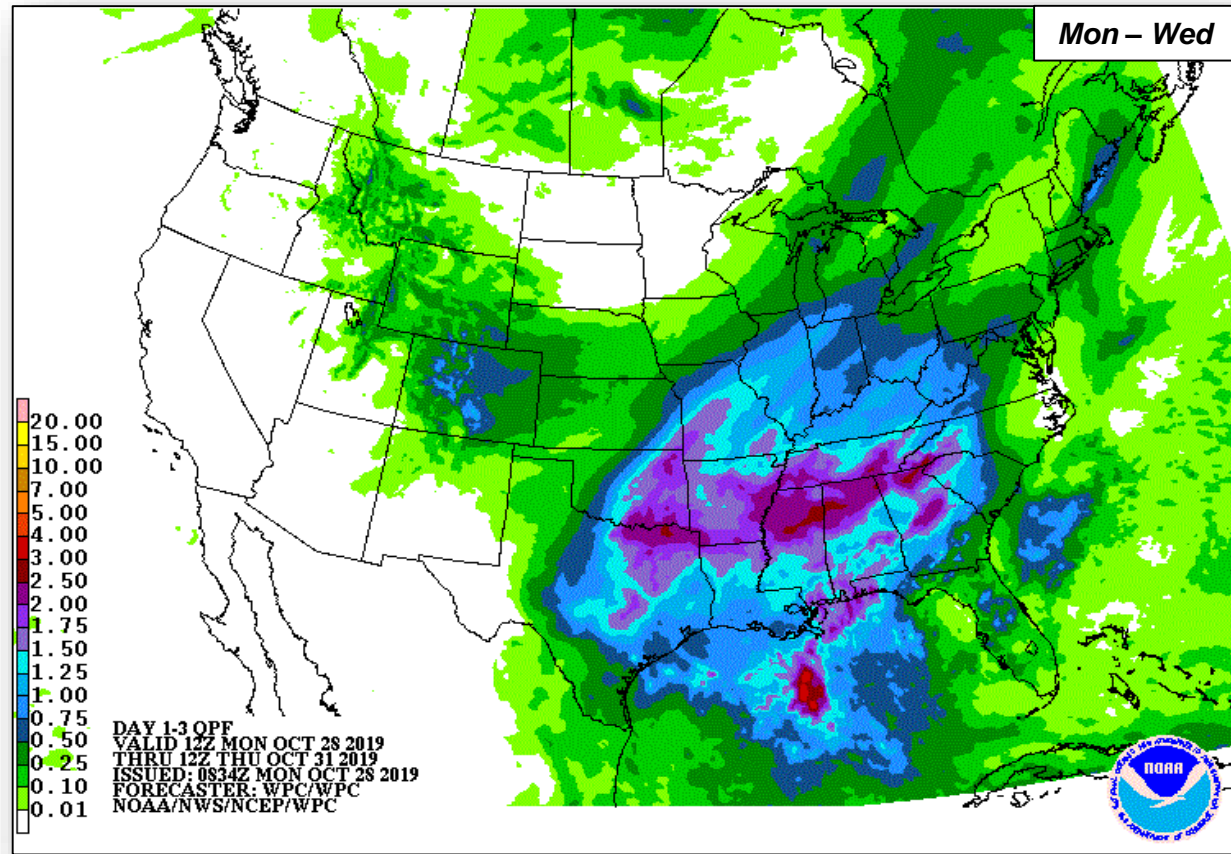
## **Tropical Storm Pablo** (Advisory #11 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 725 miles NE of Lajes Air Base in the Azores
- Moving N at 5 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph

- Expected to become post-tropical later this morning and dissipate on Tuesday

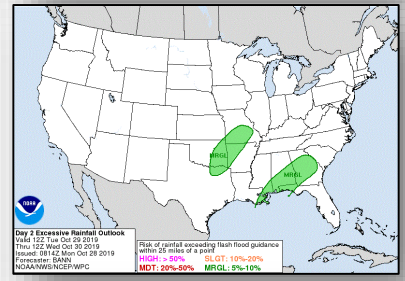

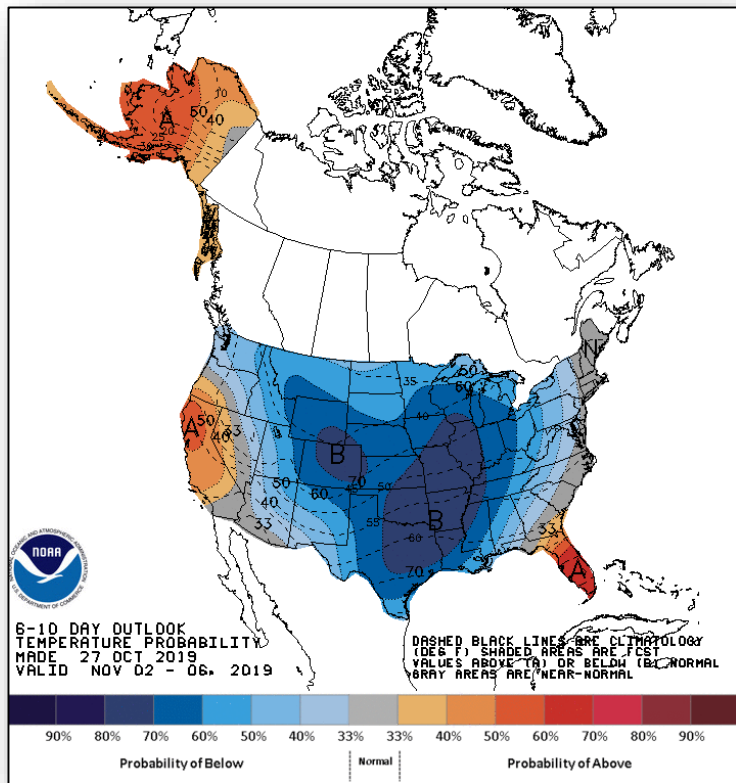

**6-10 Day Temperature Probability**



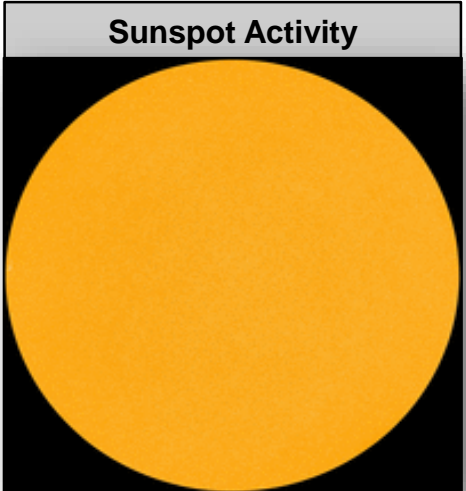
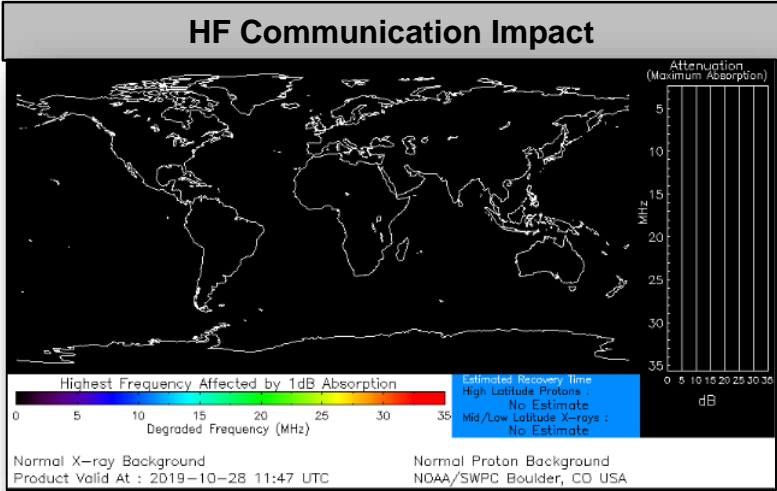
**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**
