Wildfires – CA



Situation:

- The Getty Fire began October 28, 2019 and is burning near UCLA, the Getty Museum, several schools, and a nursing home in and around the Los Angeles communities of Bel Air, Brentwood, Mandeville, Crestwood Hills, and Westgate (combined pop 20k); 656 acres burned; 5% contained

Lifeline Impacts: (Region IX SLB and FAMWEB)

Safety and Security:

- Mandatory evacuations:
 - Kincade Fire: 189,980 people and 3 tribes in Sonoma County
 - Getty Fire: 16,494 people

Food, Water, Shelter:

- Shelters: (ESF-6 as of 6:10 a.m. EST 10/29)
 - Kincade Fire: 16 (-1) open with 2,827 (-409) occupants
 - Getty fire: 4 open with 19 occupants

Energy: (Eagle-1 as of 7:30 a.m. EST 10/29)

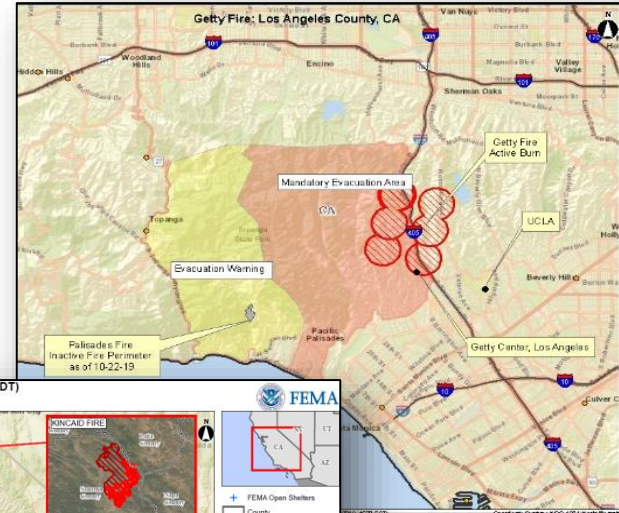
- 441,000 precautionary planned outage possible up to 1 million residents

State/Local Response

- CA EOC at Full Activation
- Governor declared a statewide emergency
- National Guard has been activated

FEMA/Federal Response:

- FMAG FEMA-5295-FM-CA approved October 24 for Kincade
- FMAG FEMA-5297-FM-CA approved October 28 for Getty
- Region IX RWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
- Region IX IMAT- 1, select ESFs, and 2 LNOs deployed to CA EOC
- ISB/SMT and MERS deployed to CA
- NWC at Steady State, continues to monitor

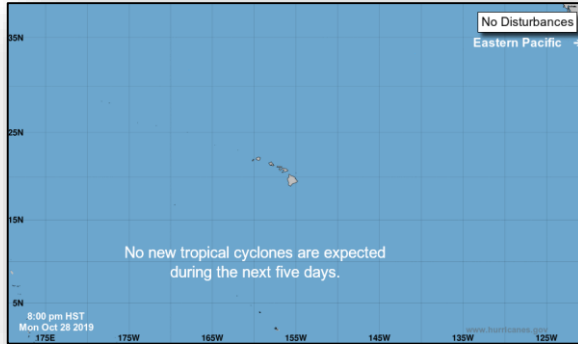

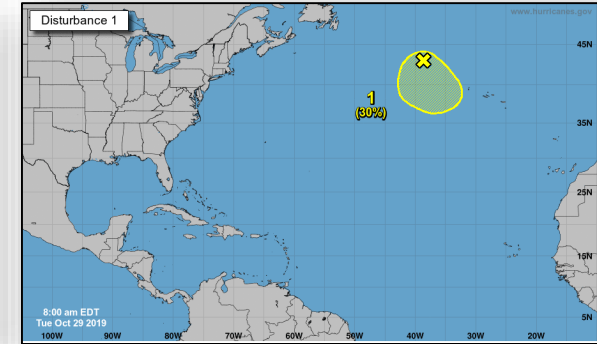

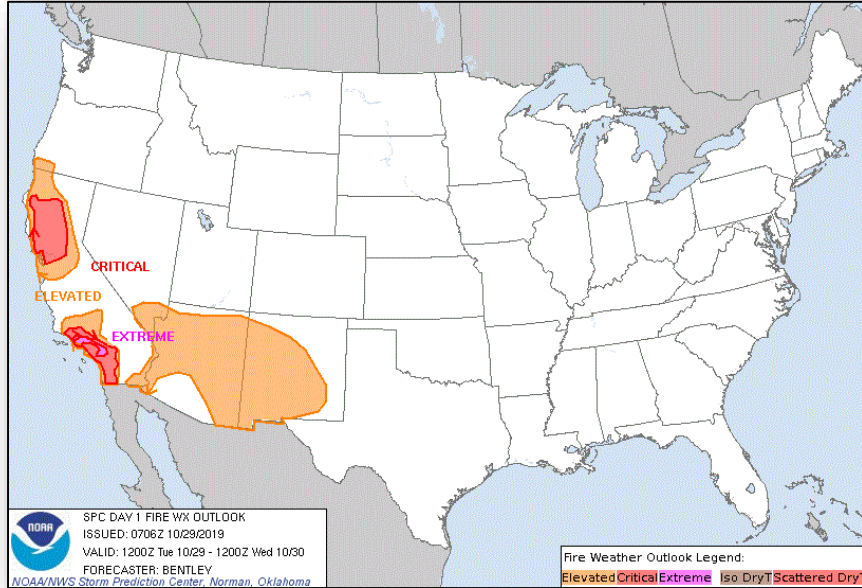
National Weather Forecast



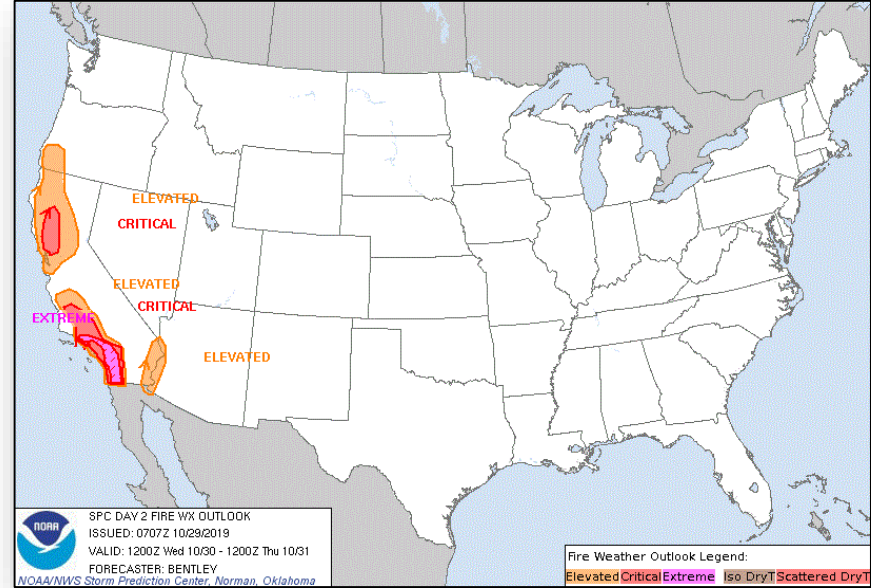
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



Fire Weather Outlook

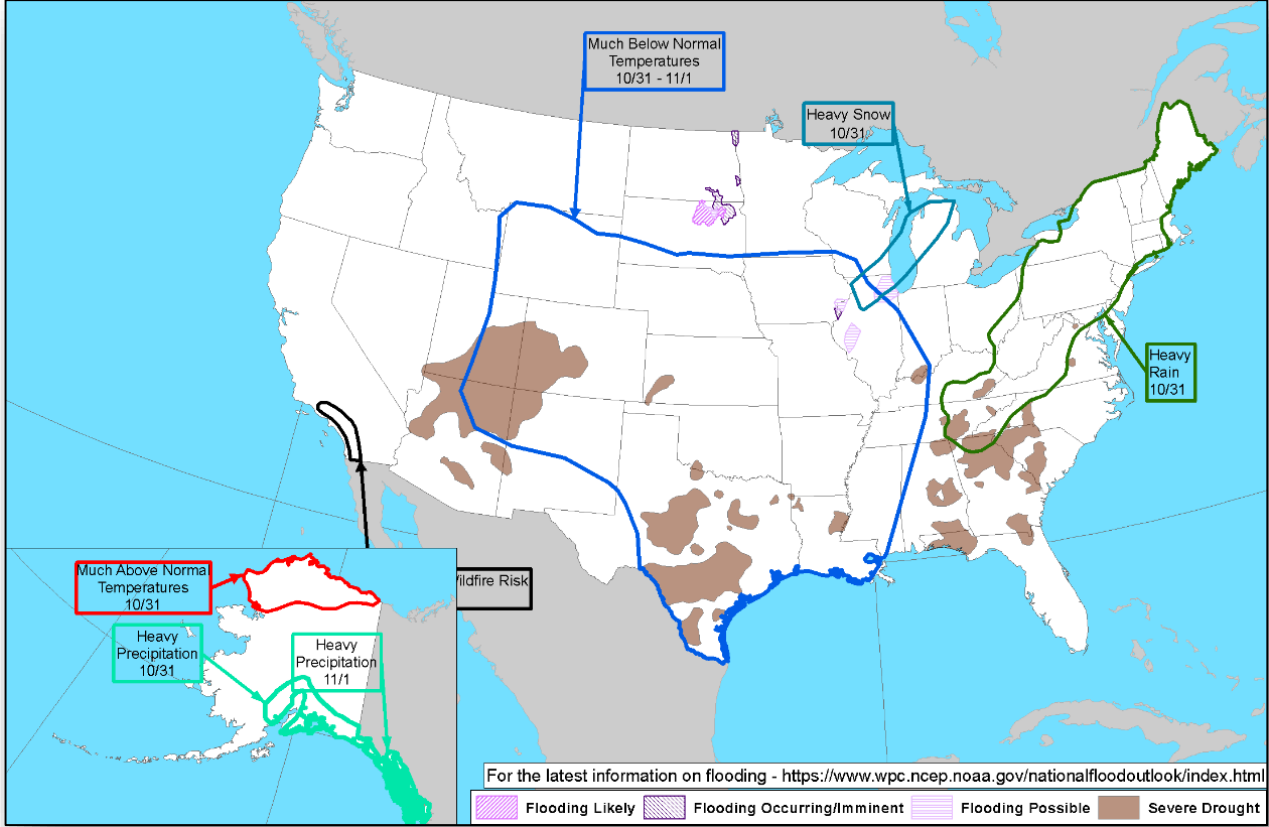

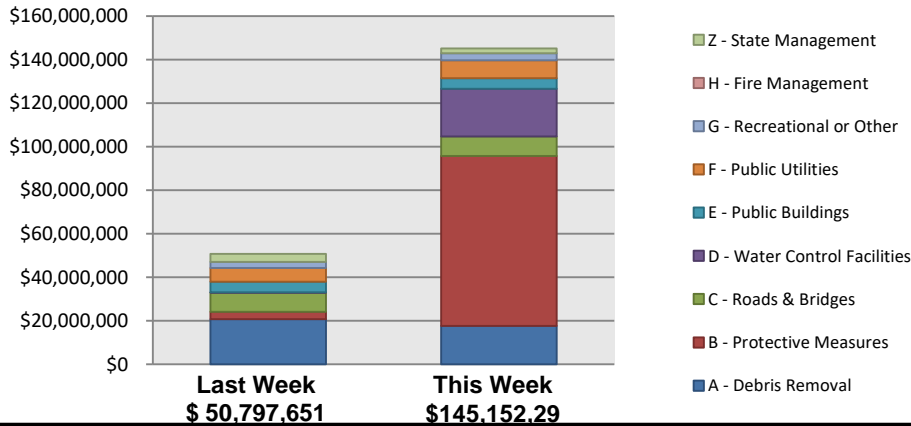

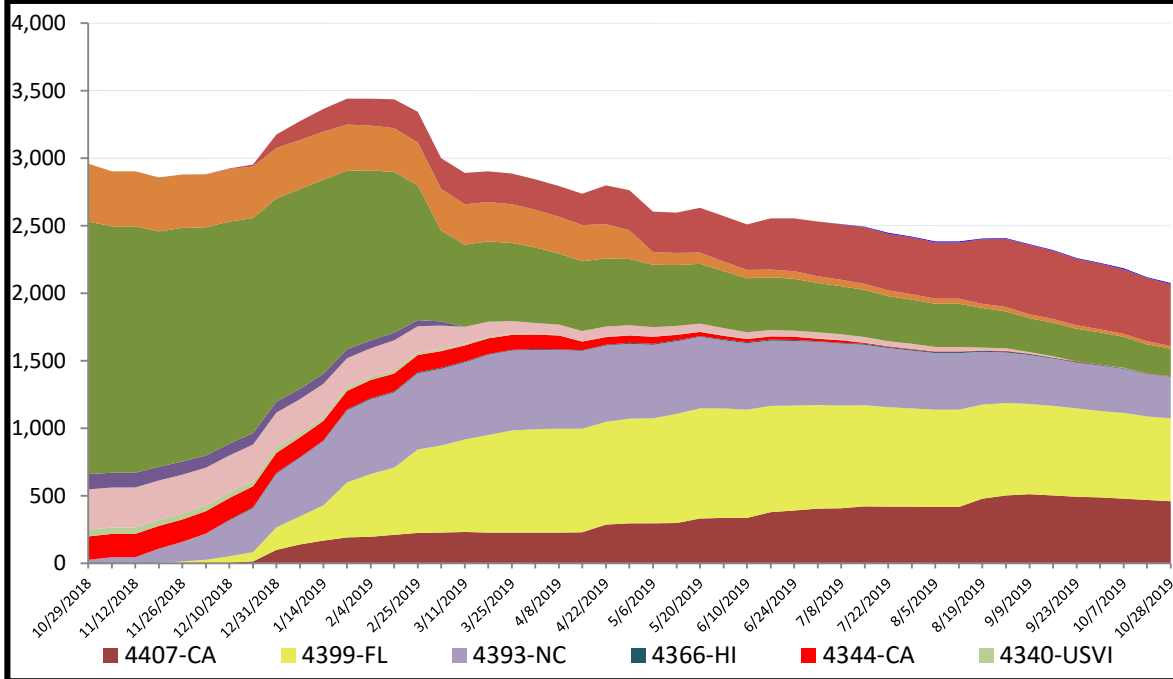

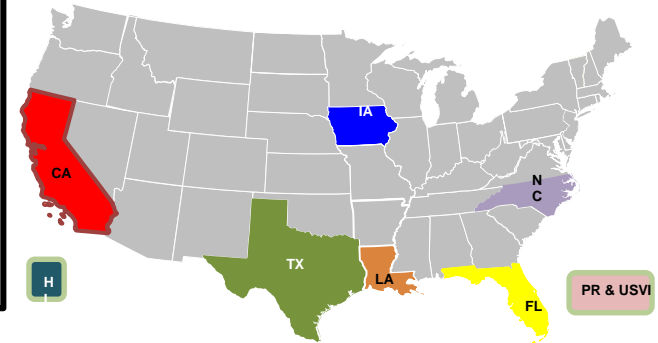


Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State

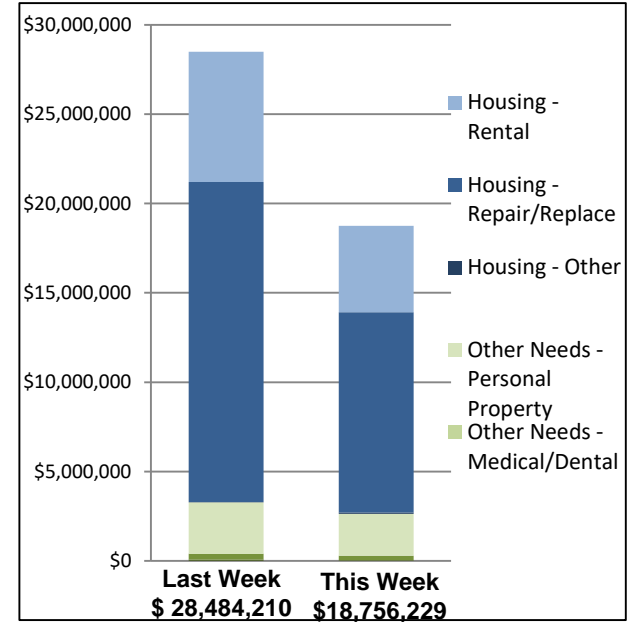
States with Currently Occupied Units
