- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible – TX, OK, AR, & MO

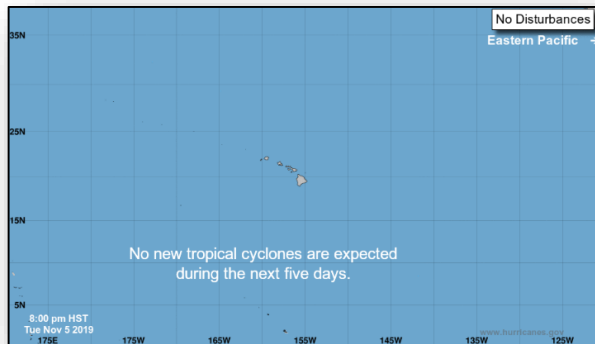
## **Tropical Activity:**

# National Weather Forecast





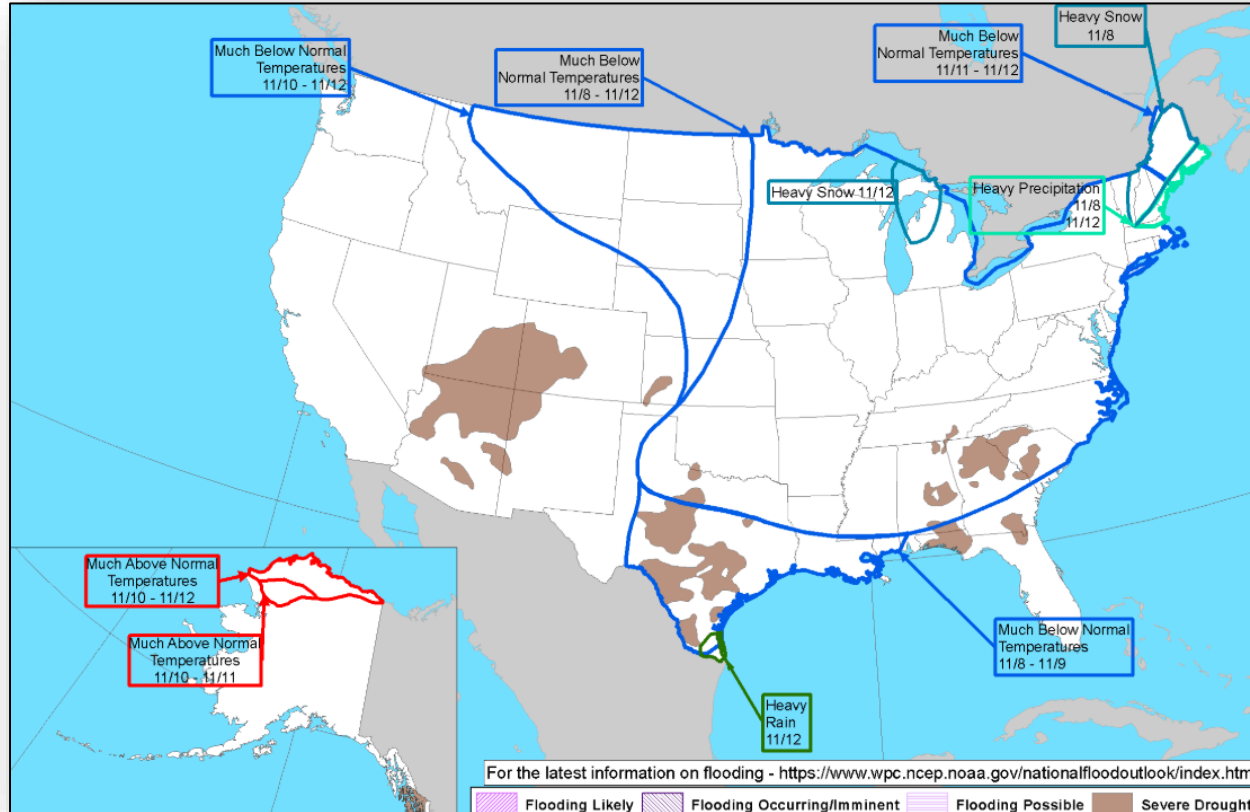
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

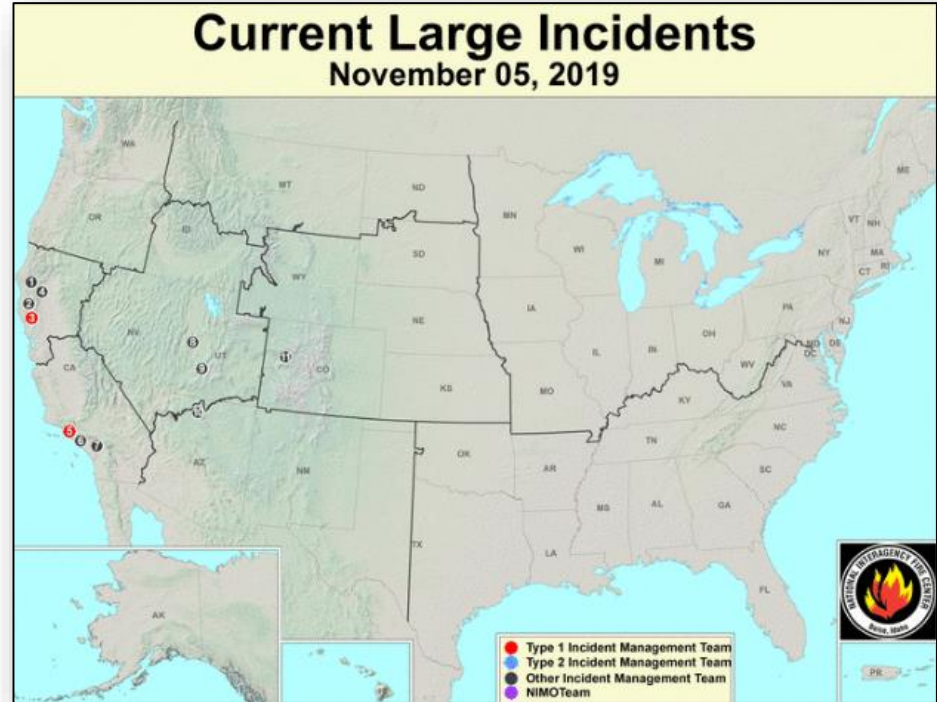
