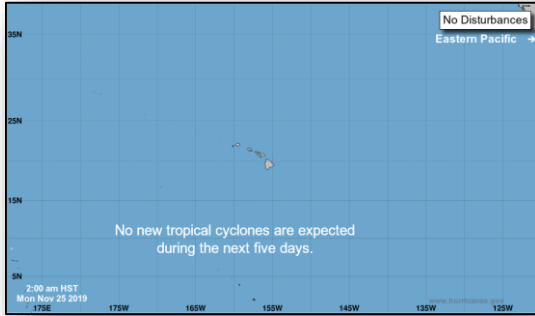
- Heavy snow possible for Central Rockies/Central Plains

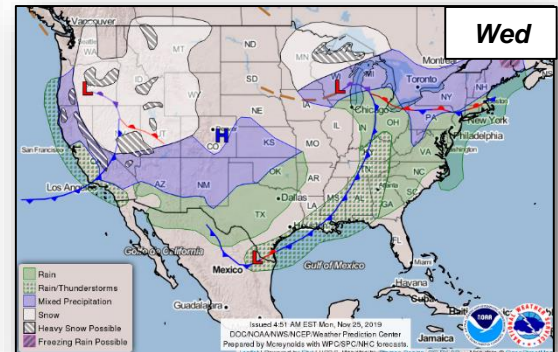

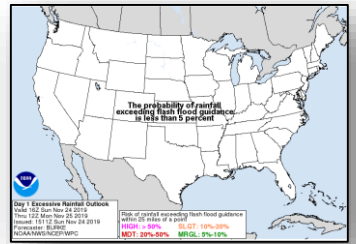

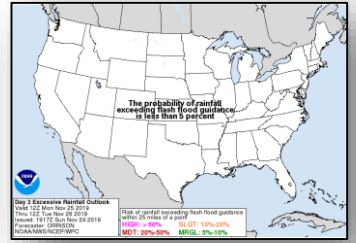

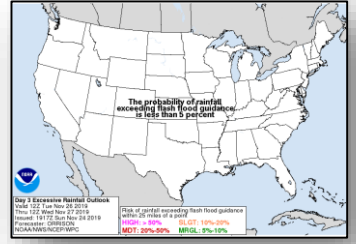
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

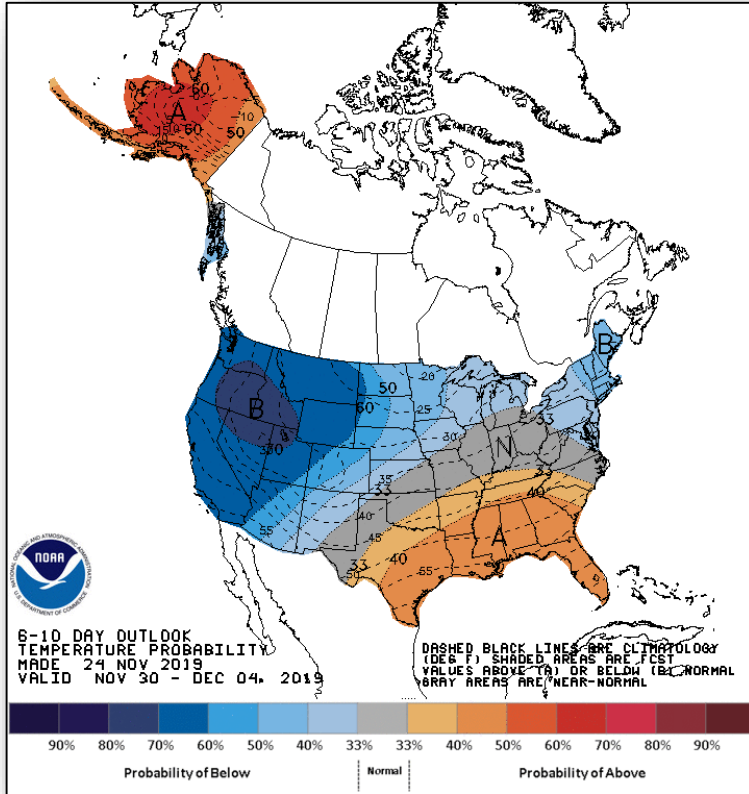

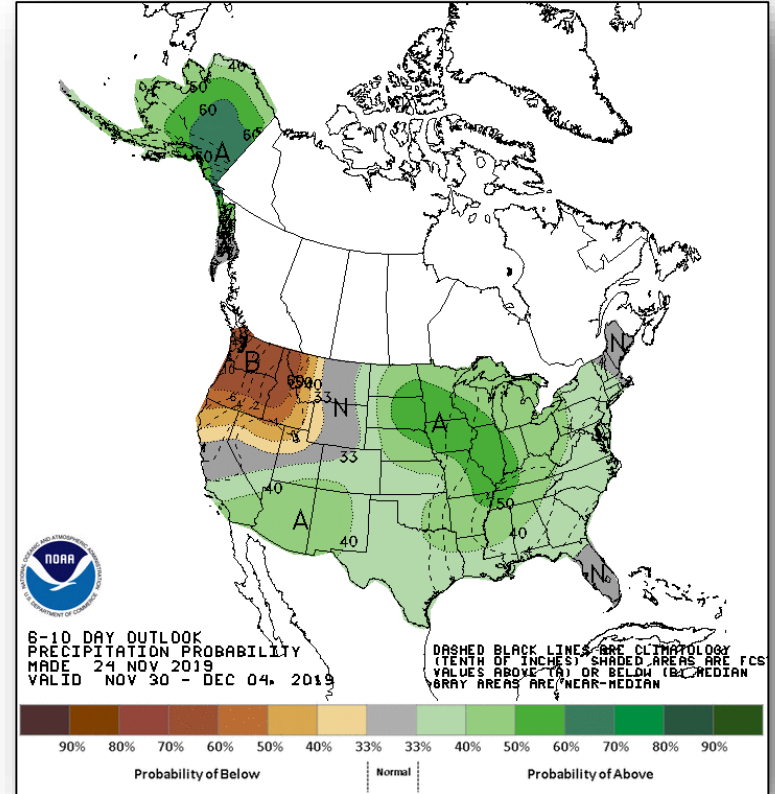

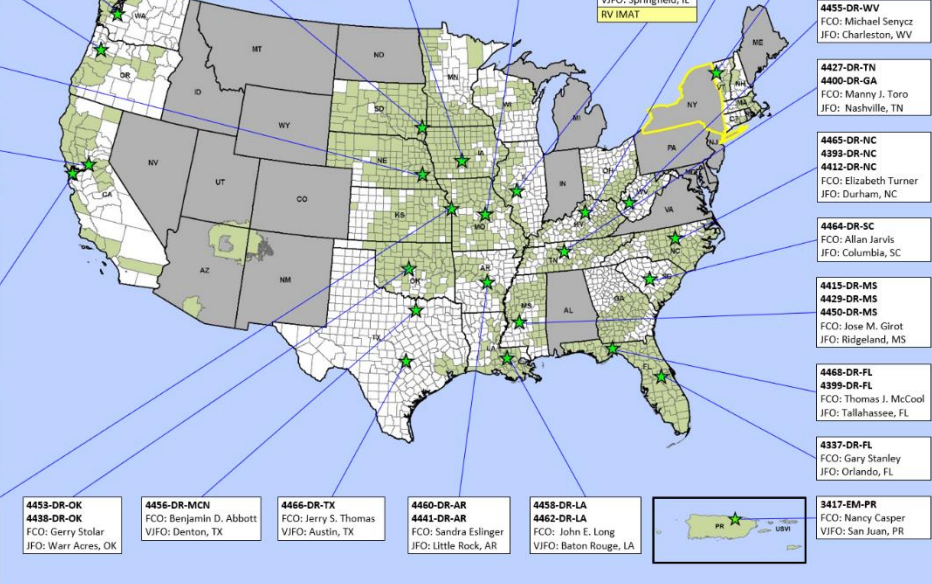
