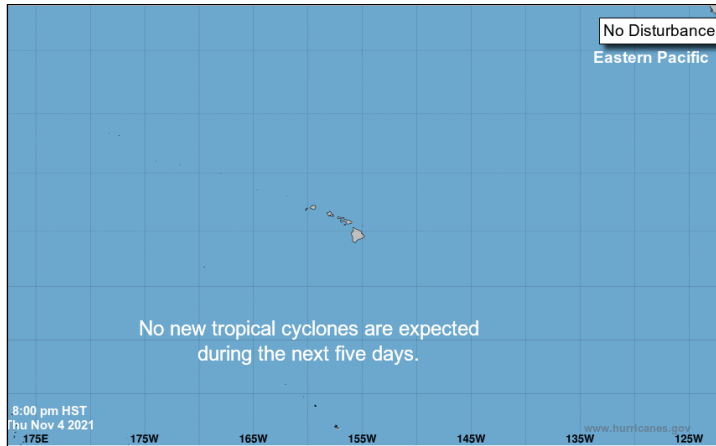

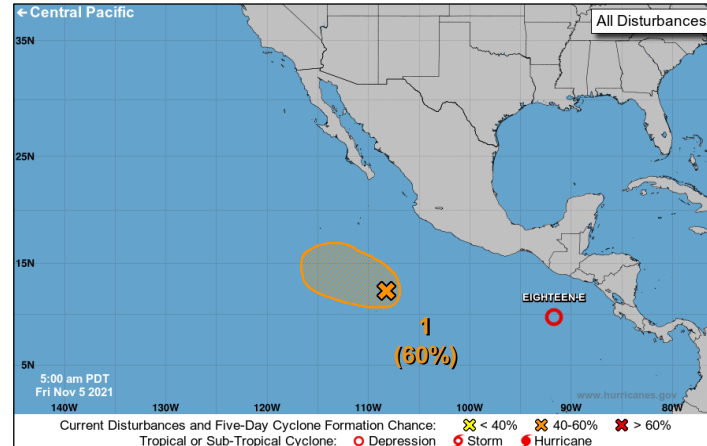

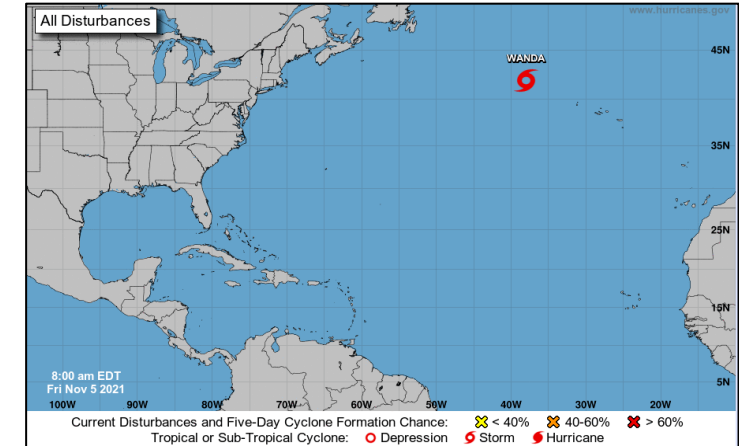
Tropical Depression Eighteen-E (Adv. #4 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

Tropical Storm Wanda (Adv. #22 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

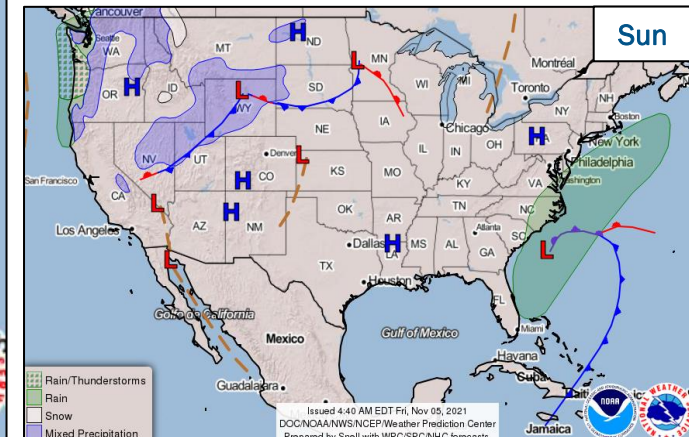
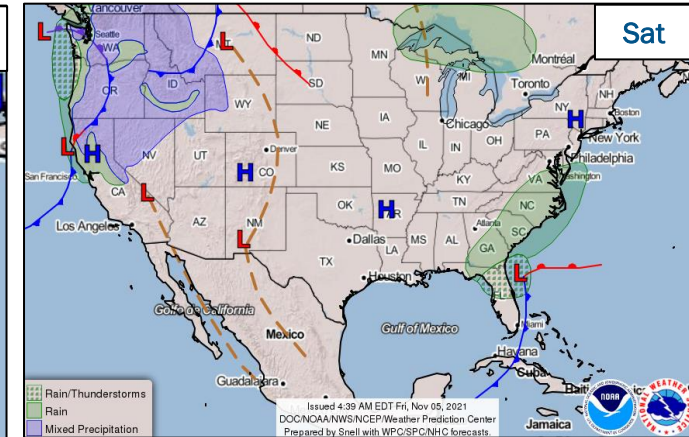
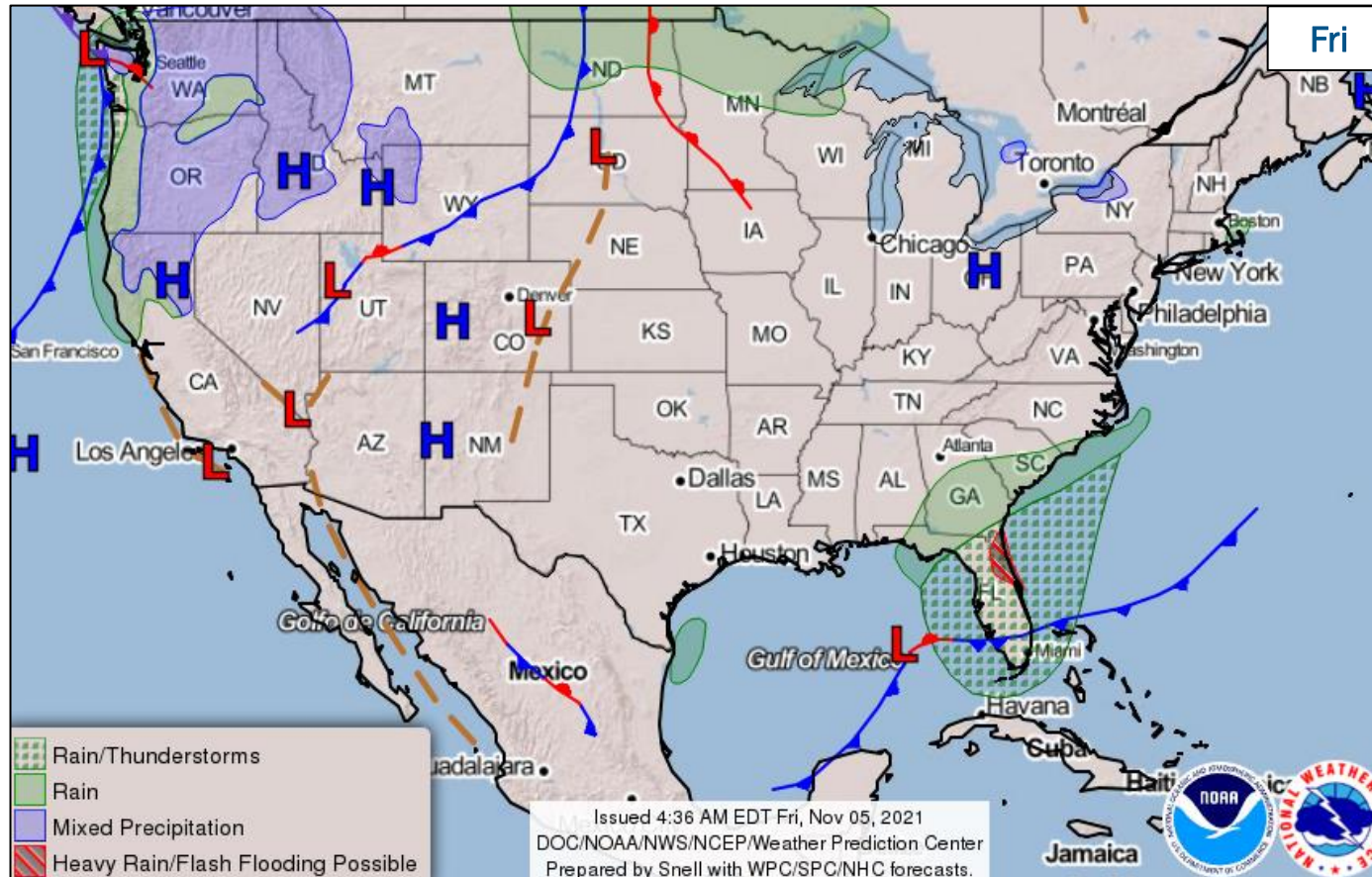
- 640 miles WNW of the Azores

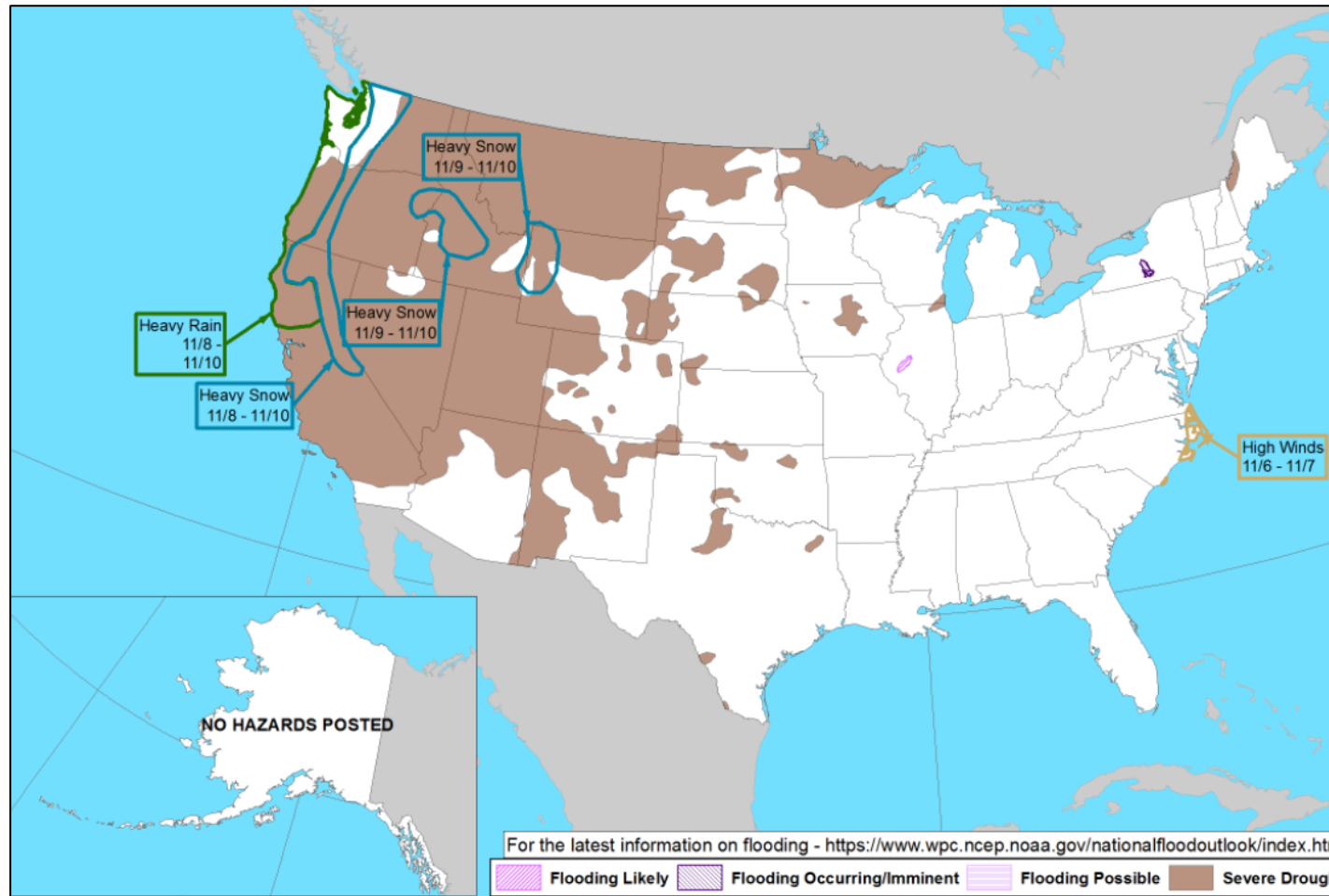
National Weather Forecast

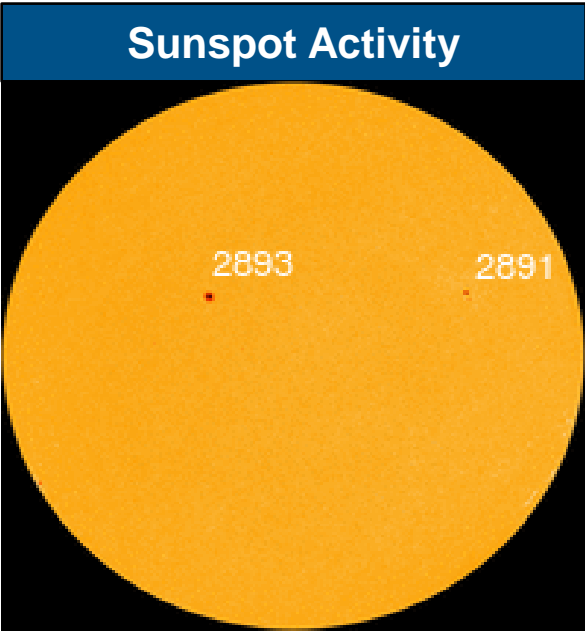
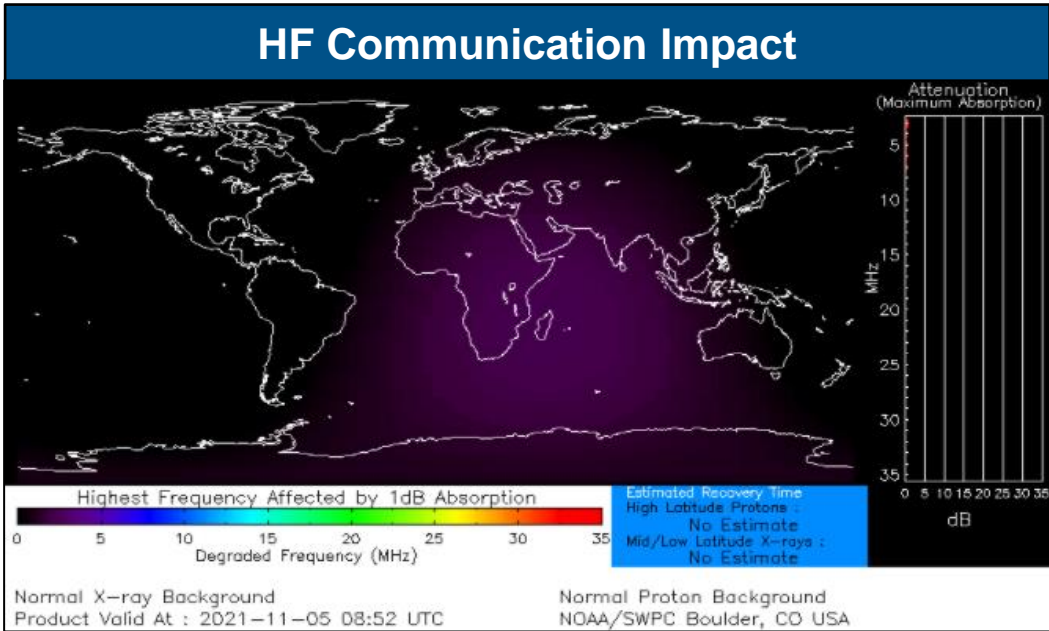
Hazards Outlook – Nov 7-11
