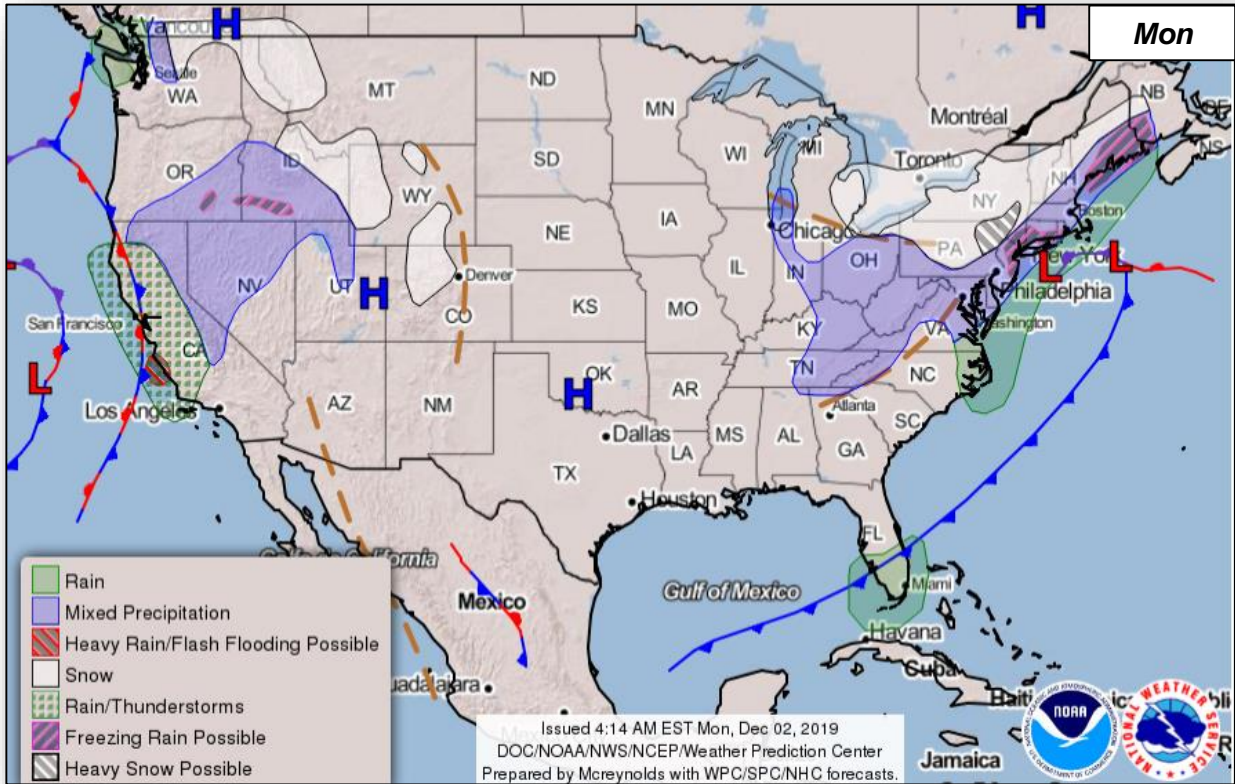
## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Locally heavy rain, possible burn scar flooding – California coastline

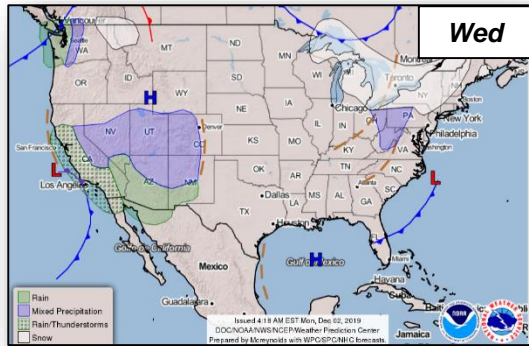
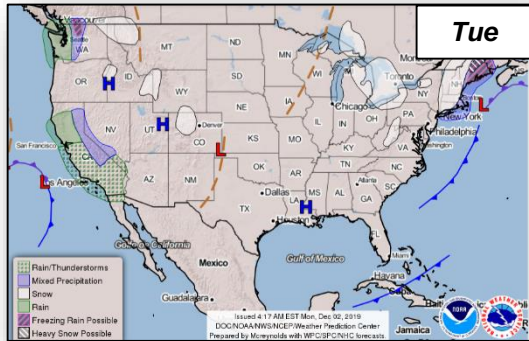

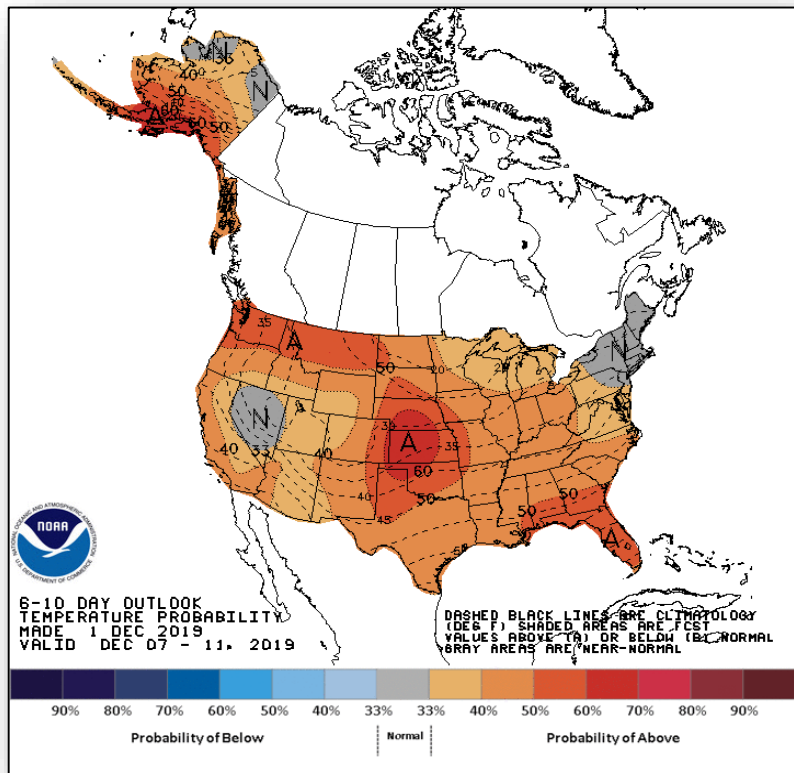
# National Weather Forecast



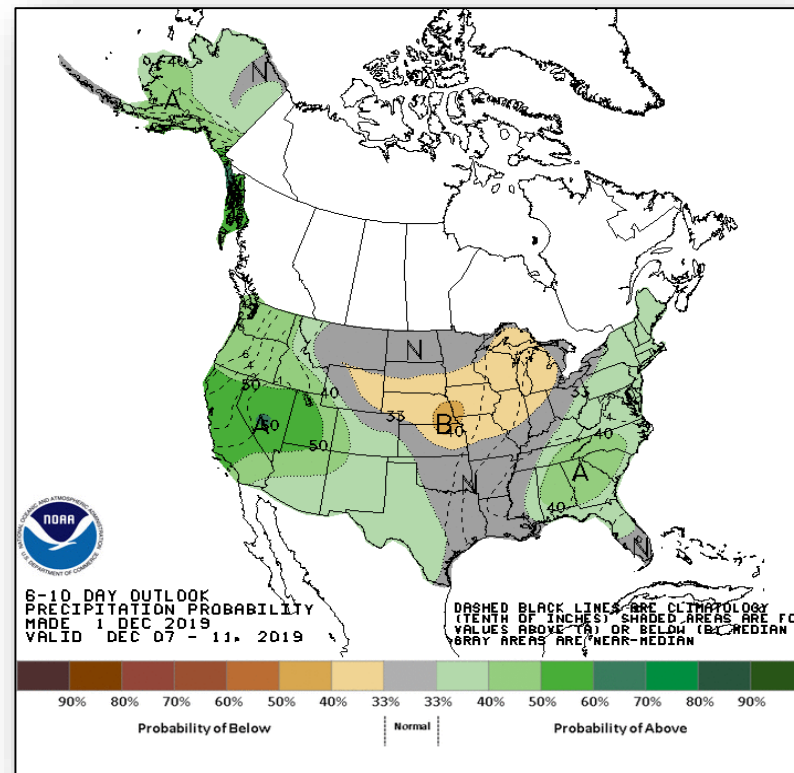

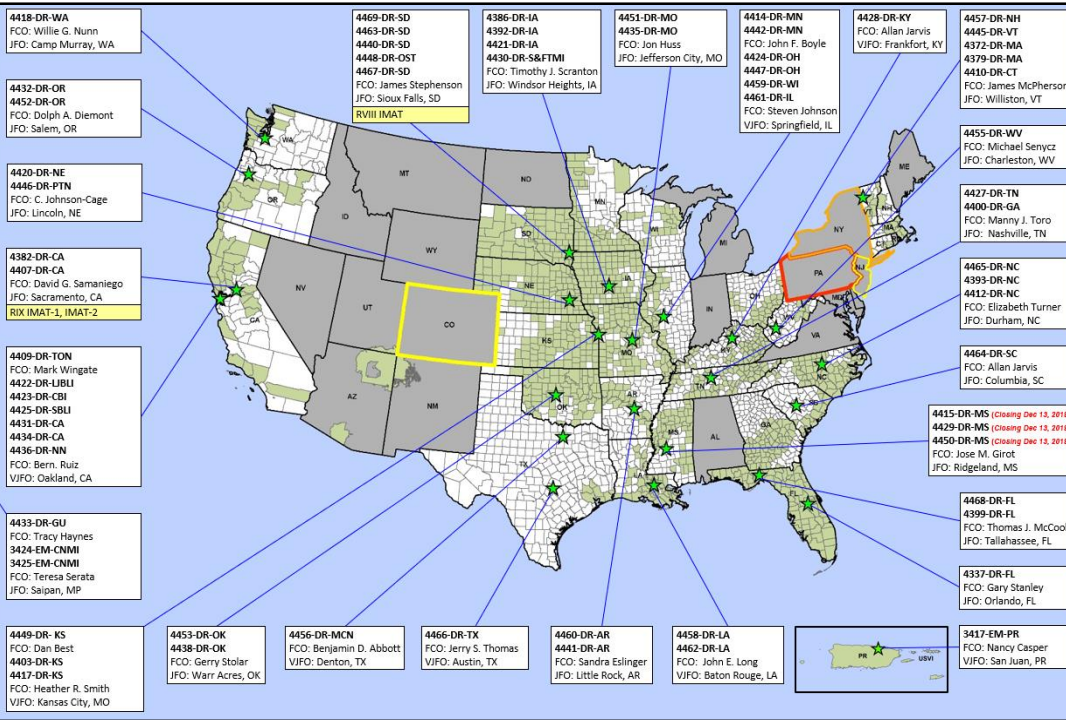
