Significant Weather:

- Significant ice and snow – Southern Plains to the Mid-Atlantic
- Heavy showers and mountain snow – western Washington and Oregon

Winter Weather – Southern U.S.



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Situation: Winter storm delivering ice and snow to the interior southeast U.S. and portions of the Mid-Atlantic through the weekend. **Substantial snowfall accumulations from NC to VA. Freezing rain is possible across NC**

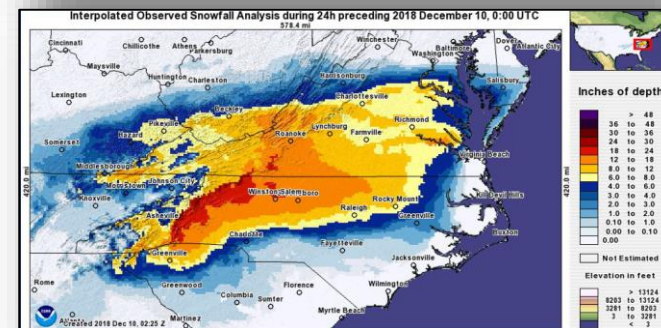
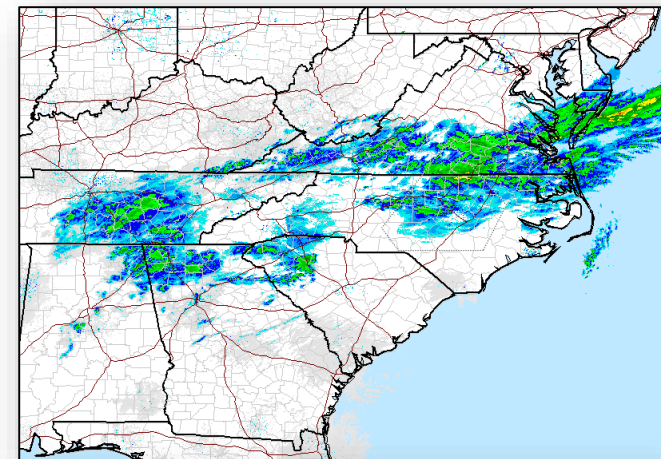
- Fatalities / Injuries: None reported
- Evacuations: None reported
- Shelters: 15 shelters open with 203 occupants in NC
- **Power Outages (as of 7:30 a.m. EST)***
 - VA: 58k (Peak: 92k)
 - NC: 132k (Peak: 235k)
 - SC: 54k (Peak: 102k)
 - GA: 6k (Peak: 29k)
 - AL: 5k (Peak: 38k)
- Transportation:
 - AMTRAK cancelled or modified service in VA, NC, and SC through Dec 11
 - Significant snow and ice accumulation impacting travel along I-26, I-85, and I-95, primarily in the mountains of NC
 - Over 700 commercial flights cancelled throughout NC

State Response

- NC and VA Governors declared States of Emergency
- NC EOC at Partial Activation; NC National Guard activated
- **AR EOC returned to Normal Operations**
- **SC EOC at monitoring**

Federal Response

- Region IV Enhanced Watch rostered
- FEMA NWC is monitoring; Enhanced Watch rostered
- ARC has identified warming shelter locations

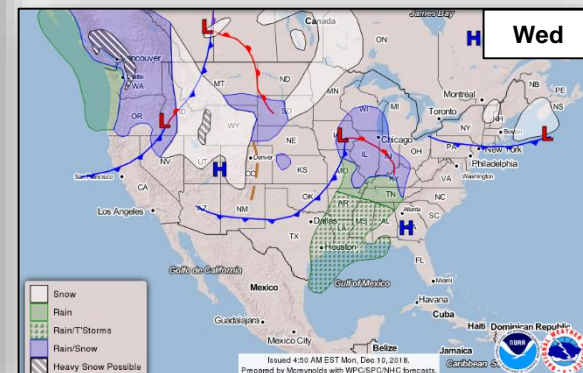
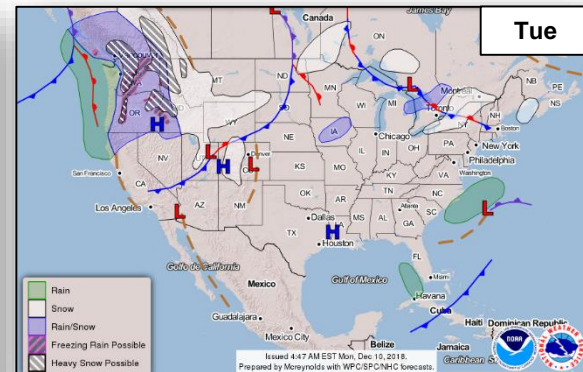
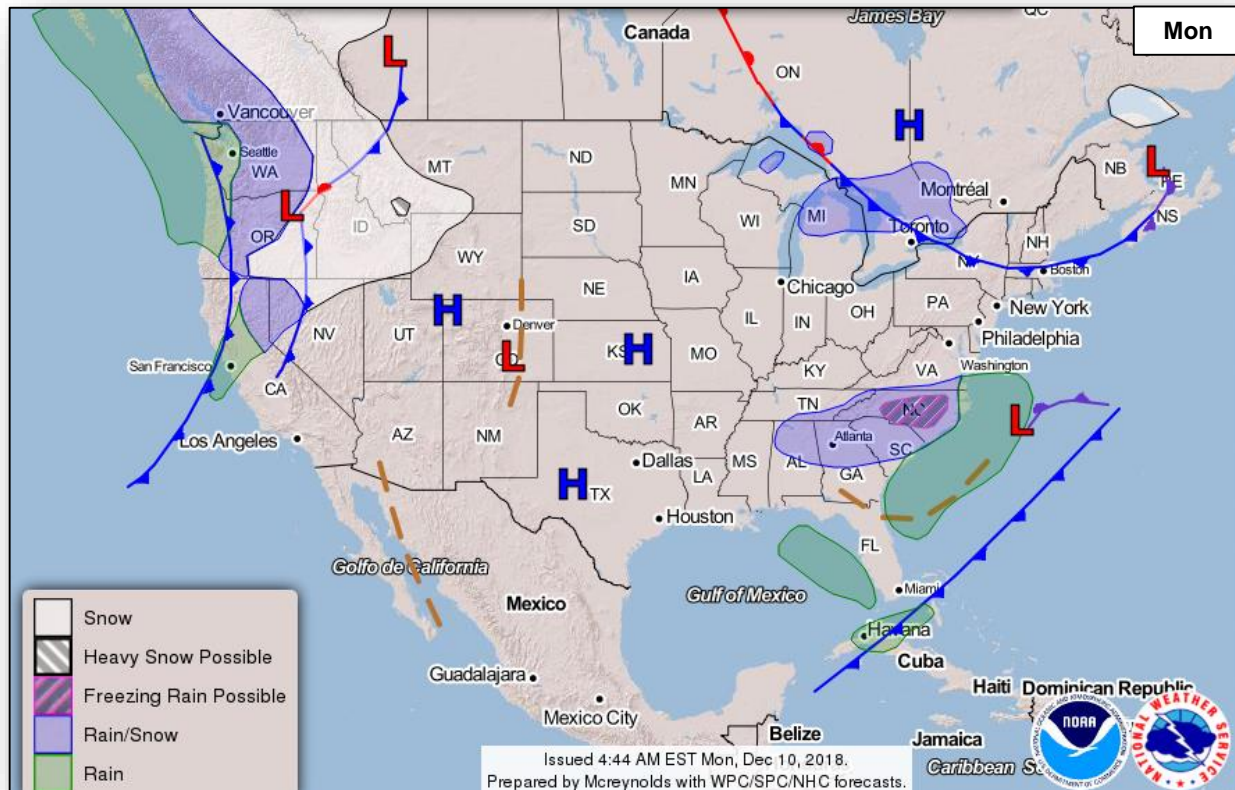

National Weather Forecast



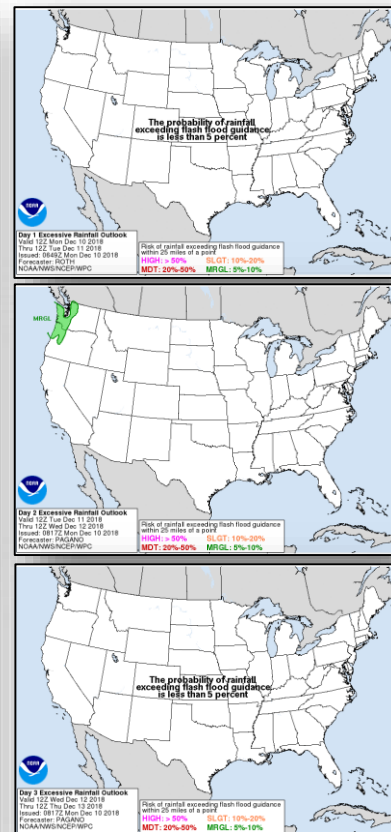
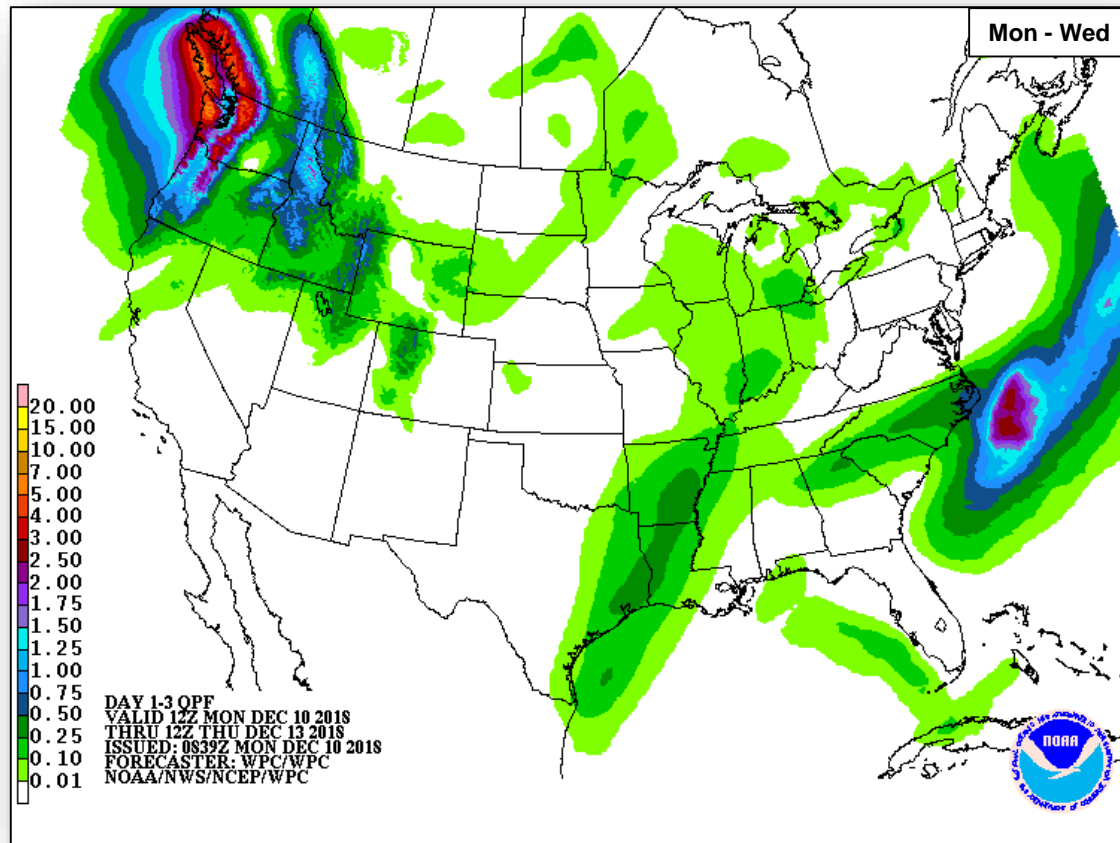
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Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



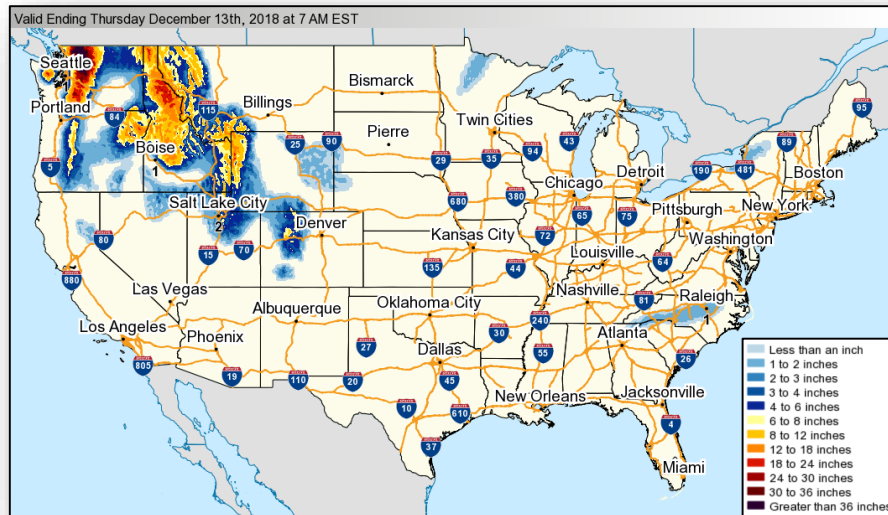
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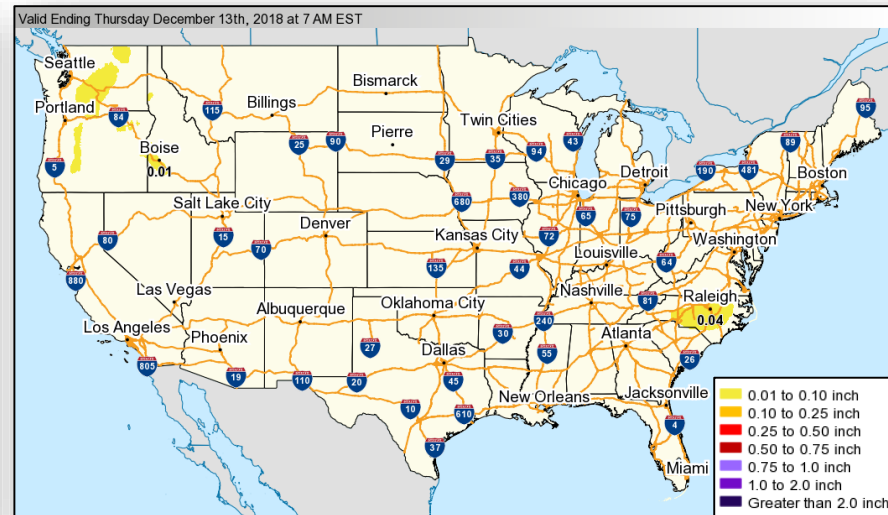
Winter Precipitation Outlook



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Forecast Snowfall

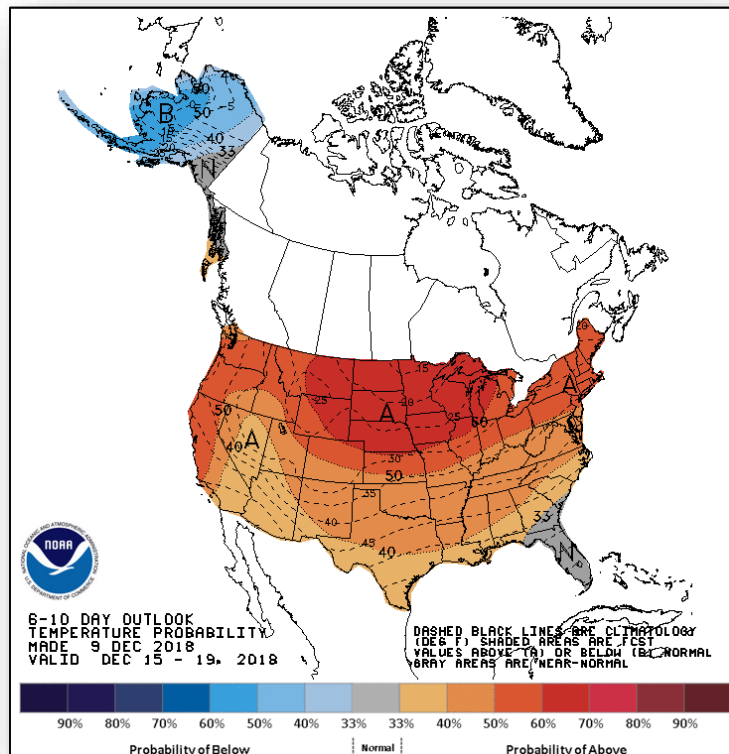


Forecast Ice Accumulation

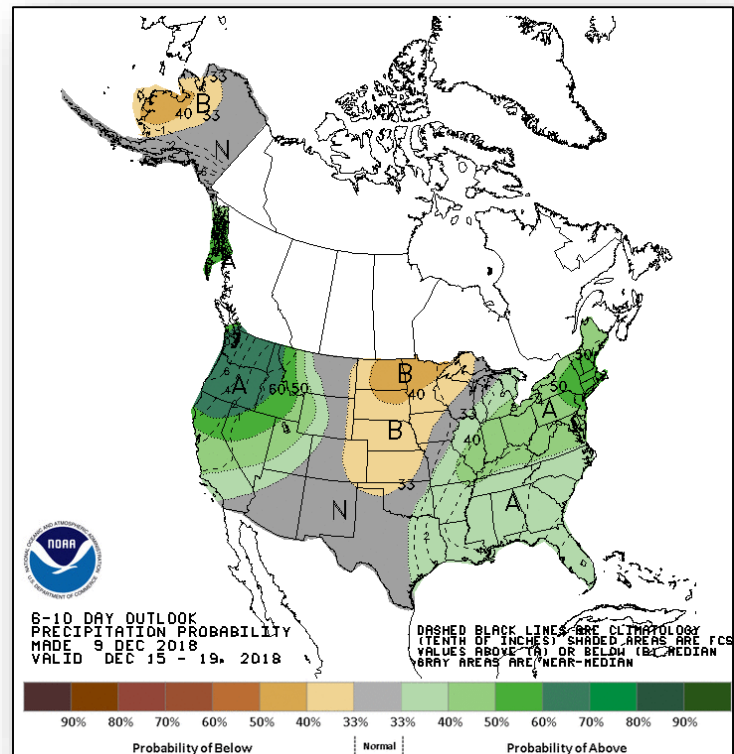
Long Range Outlooks – Dec 15-19
