



National Weather Forecast







Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast





Severe Weather Outlook






Declaration Approved

- The President approved a Major Disaster Declaration on December 18, 2018
- For Tropical Storm Michael that occurred October 9-16, 2018
- Provides:
 - Public Assistance for 25 counties and two independent cities
 - Hazard Mitigation for the entire commonwealth


