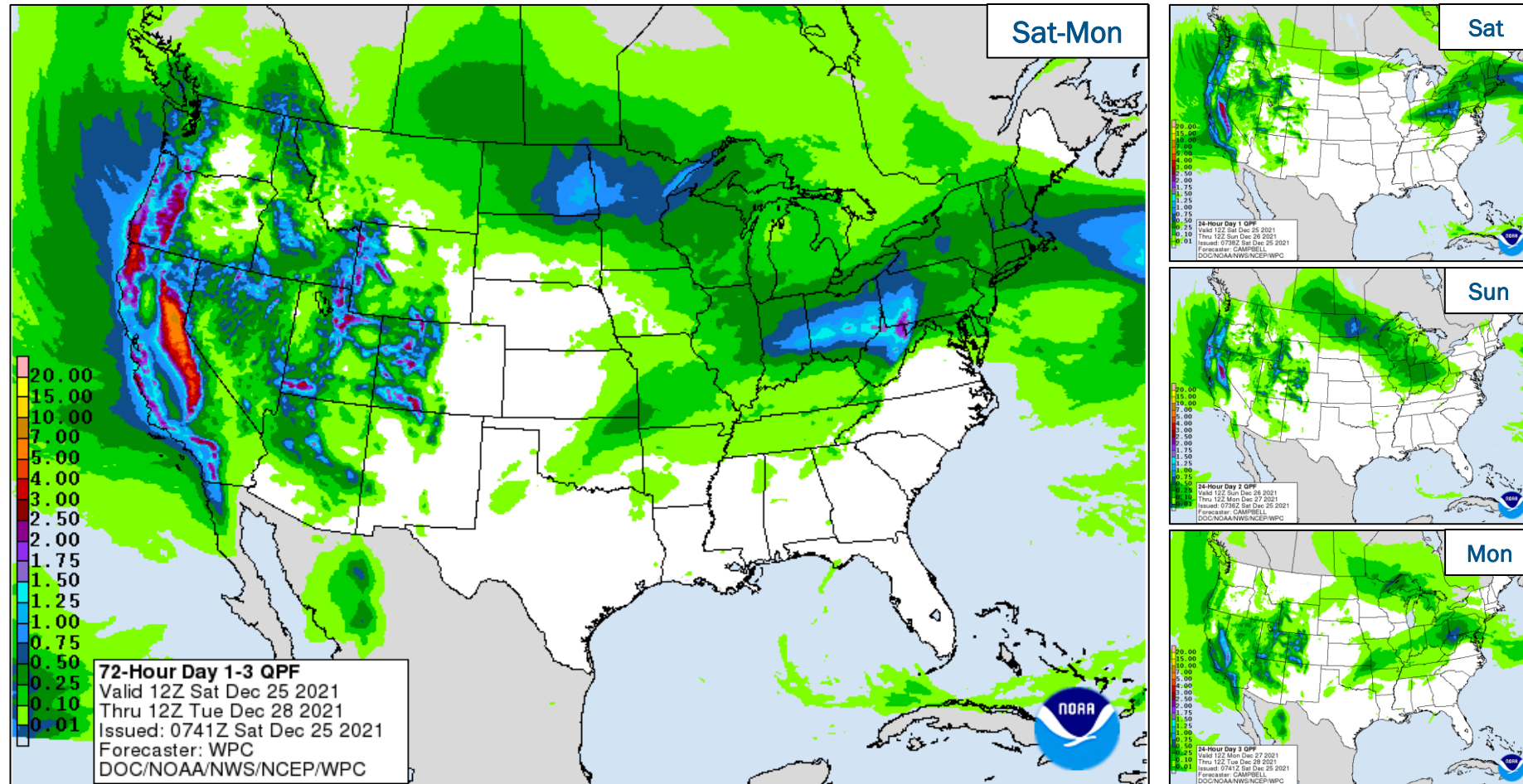

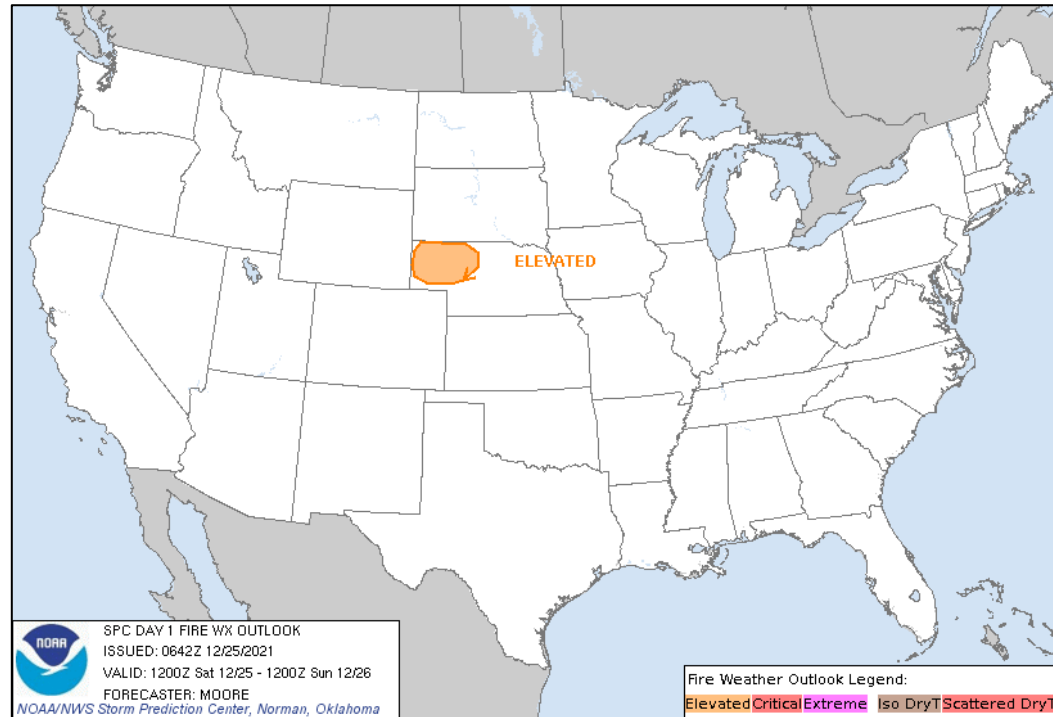
Precipitation Forecast



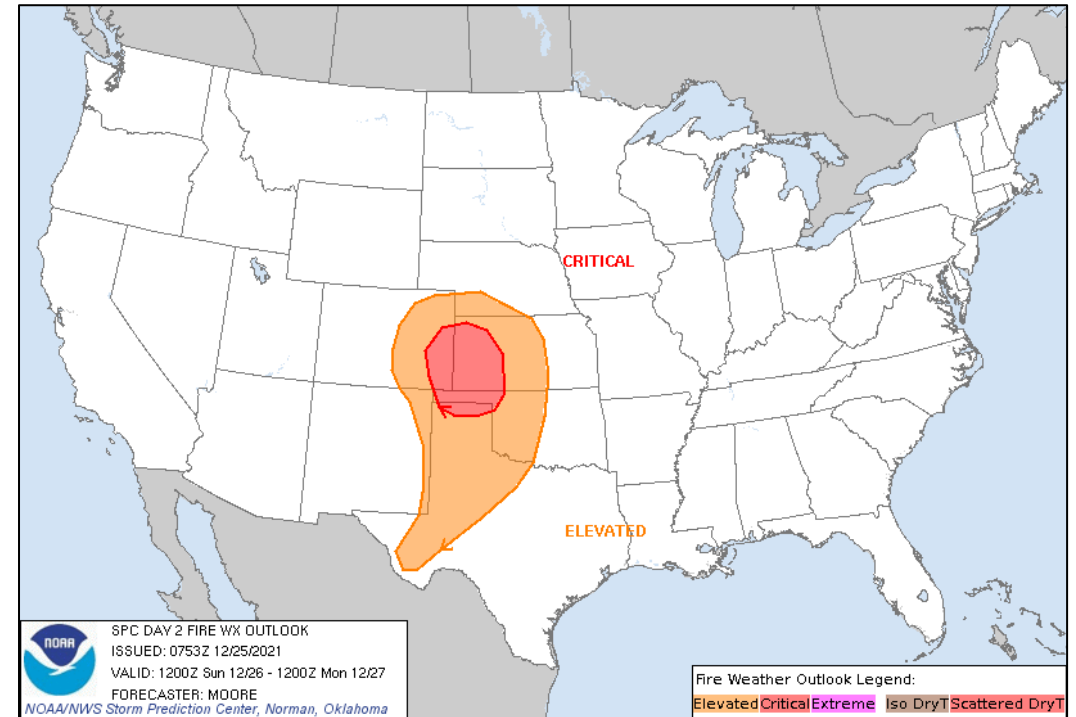

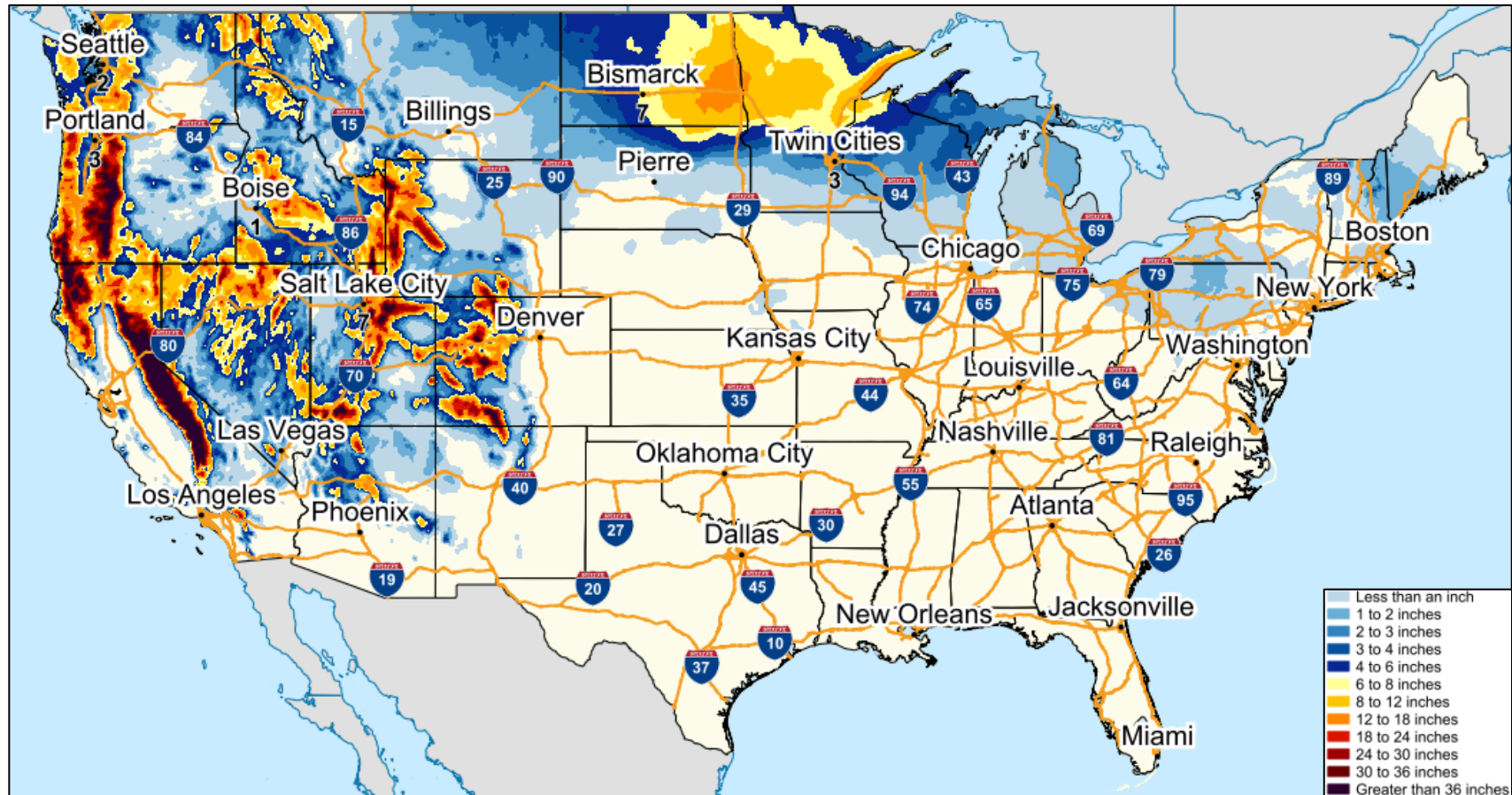

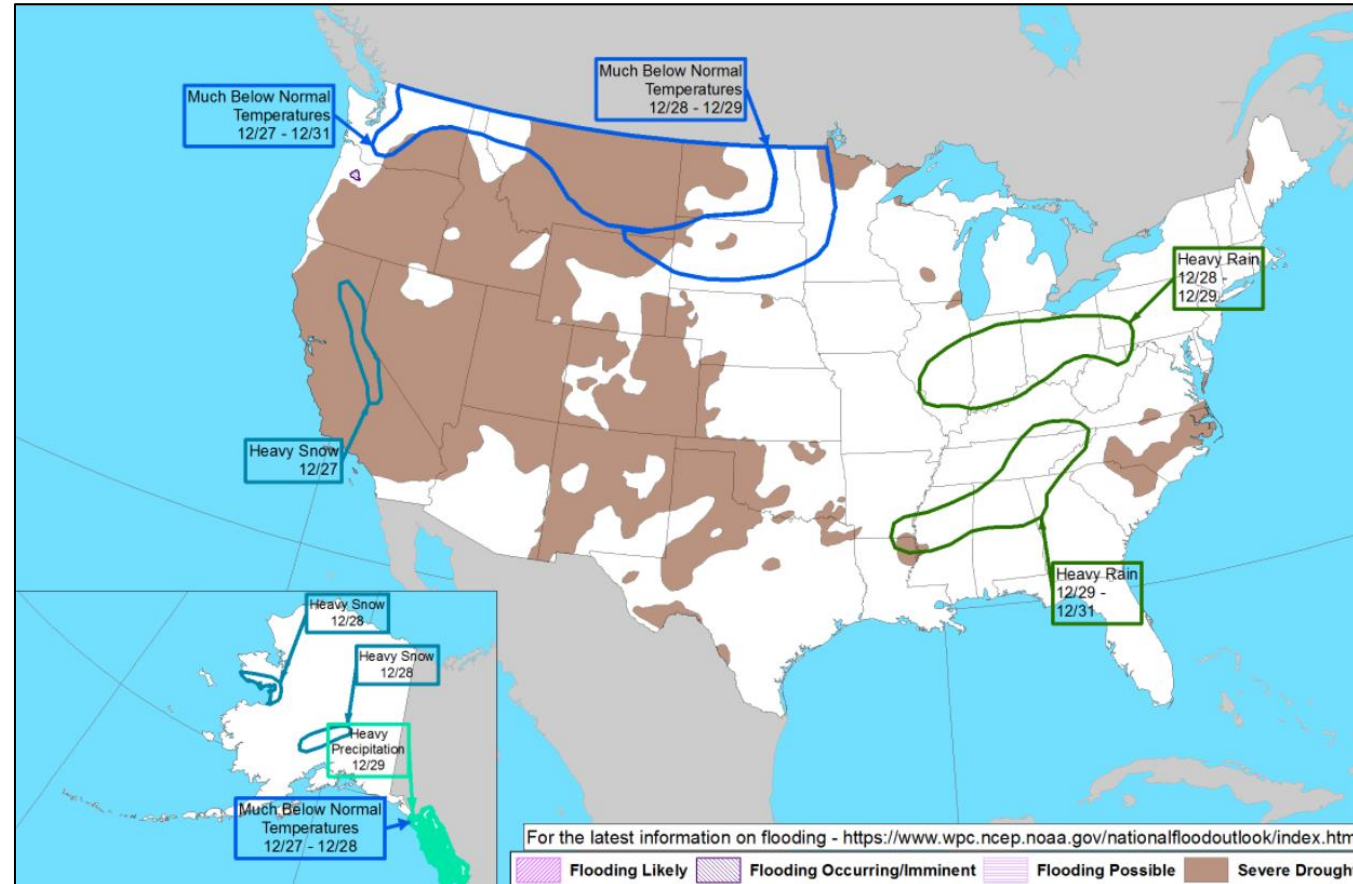
Forecast Snowfall

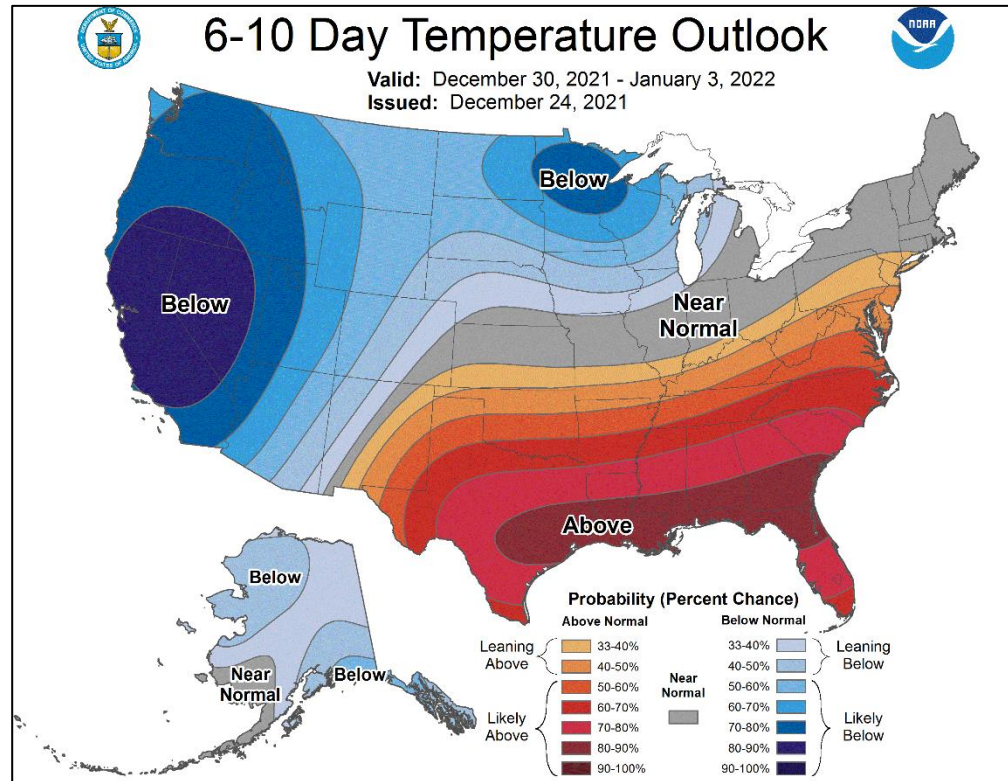
Hazards Outlook – Dec 27-31



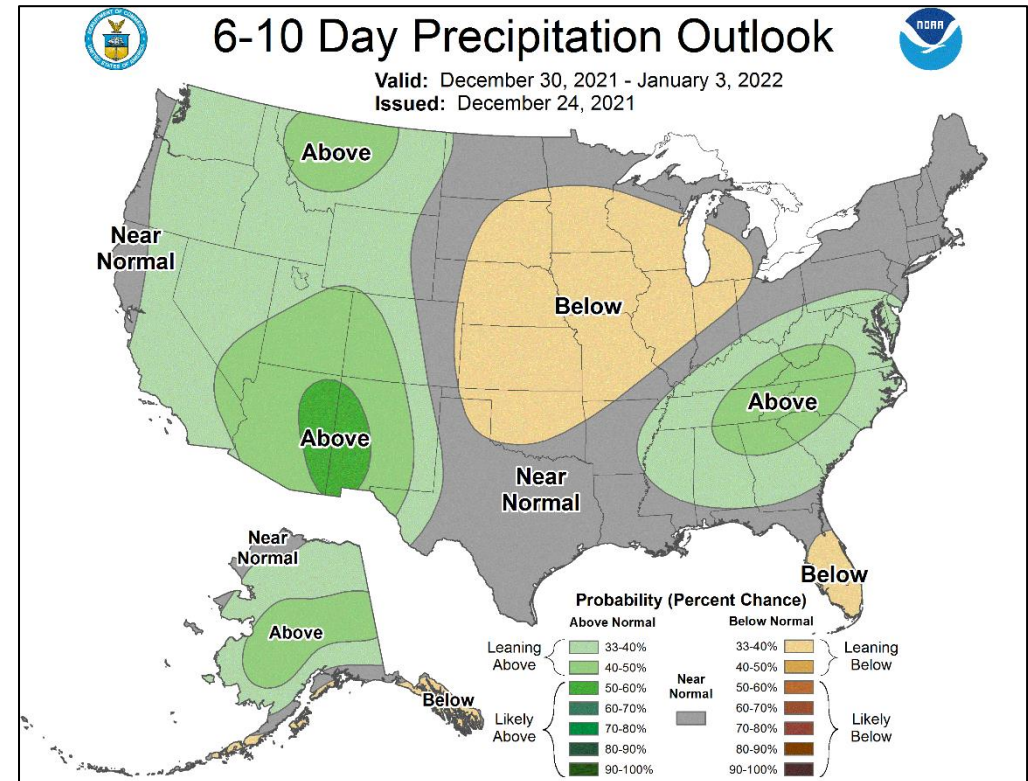

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

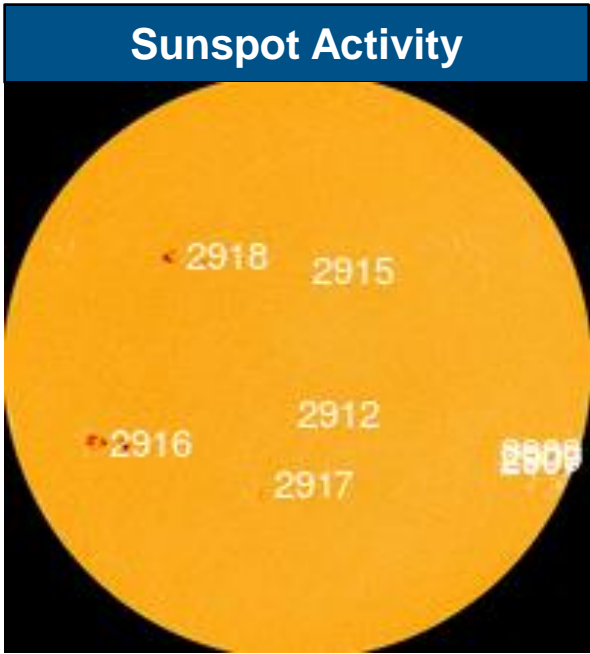
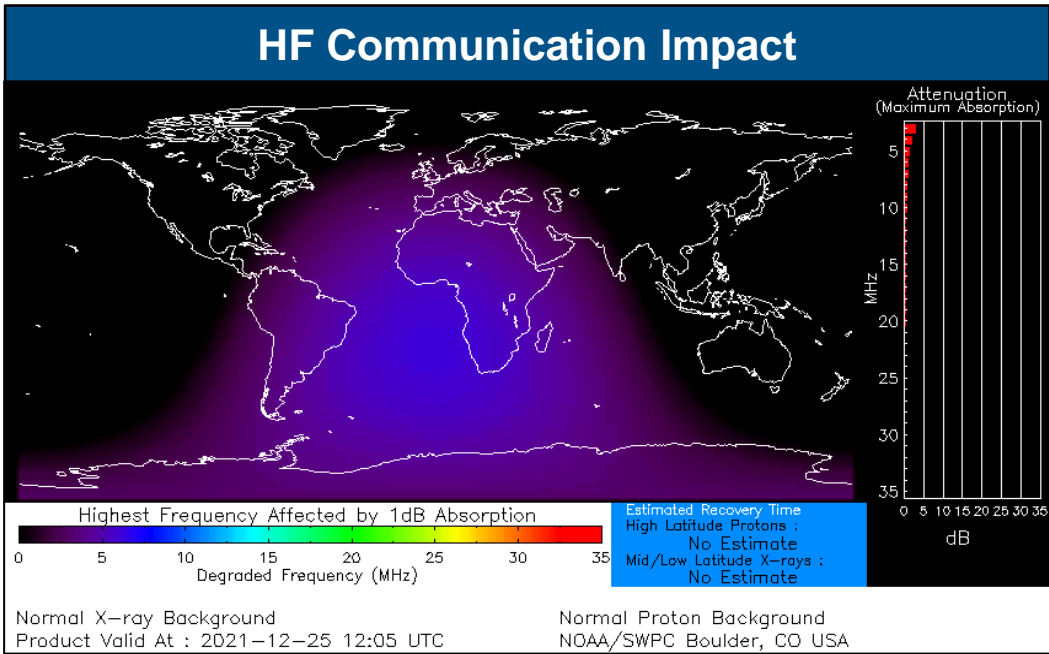
