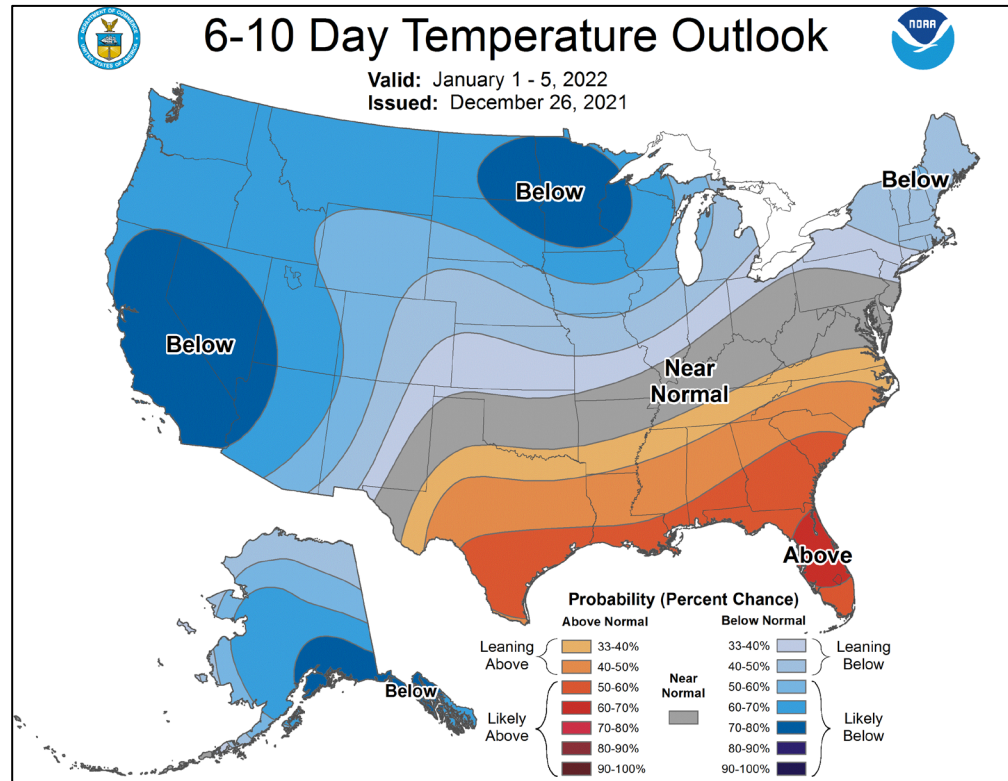
National Weather Forecast



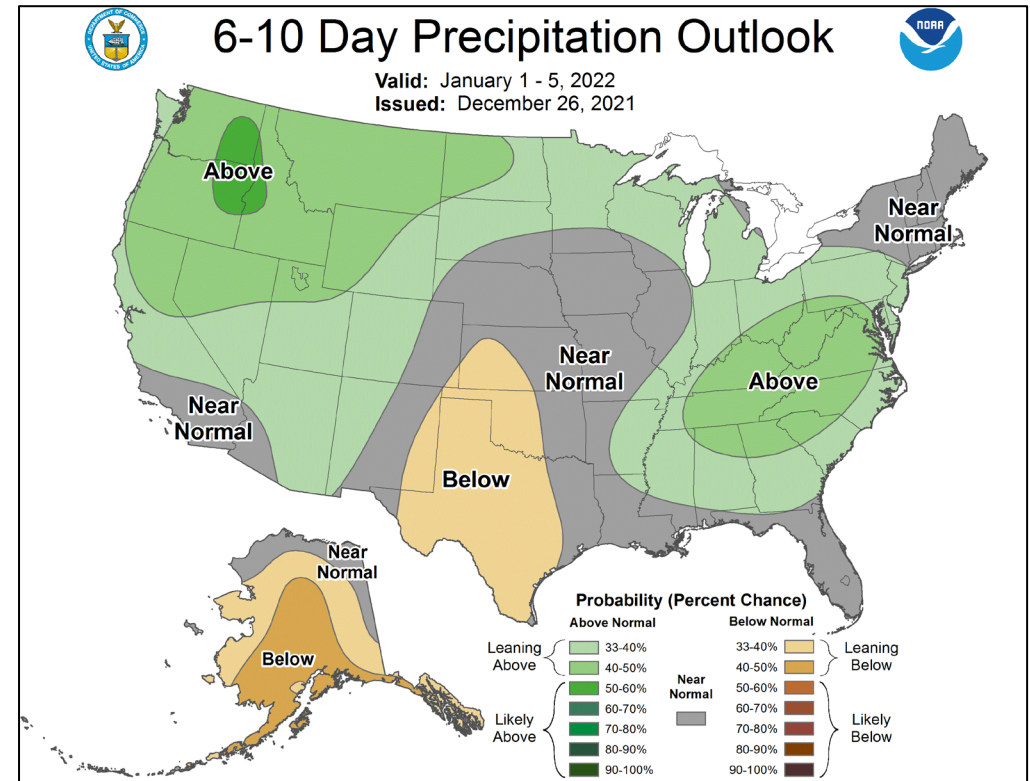

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

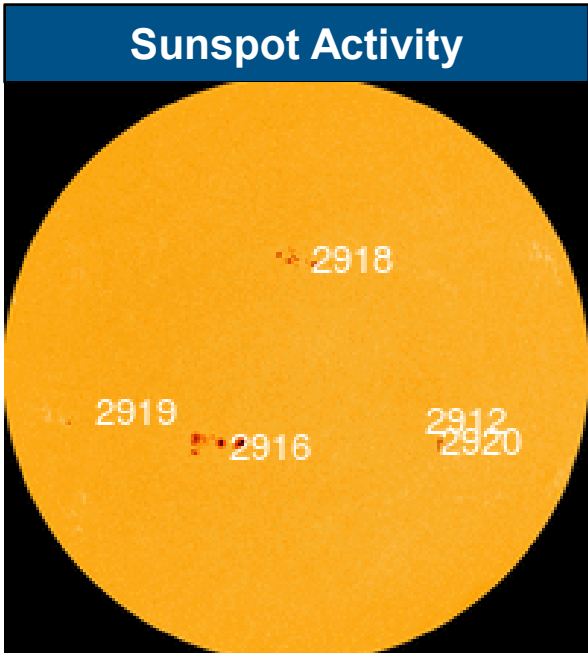
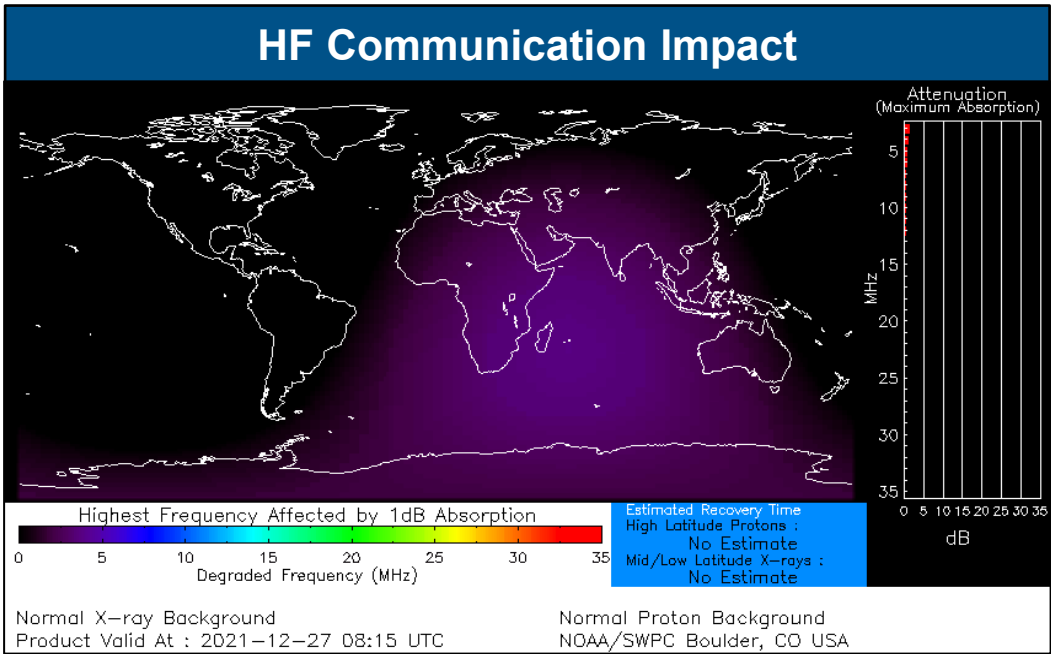
