Situation: The 41st President of the United States George Herbert Walker Bush passed away. The State Funeral is a predesignated National Special Security Event (NSSE).

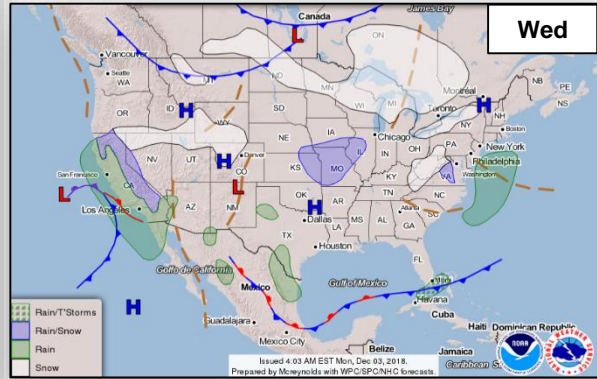
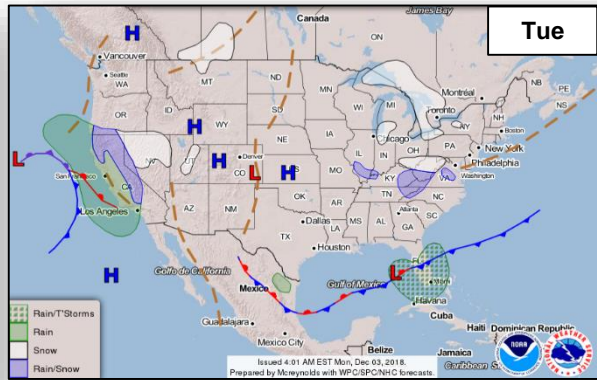
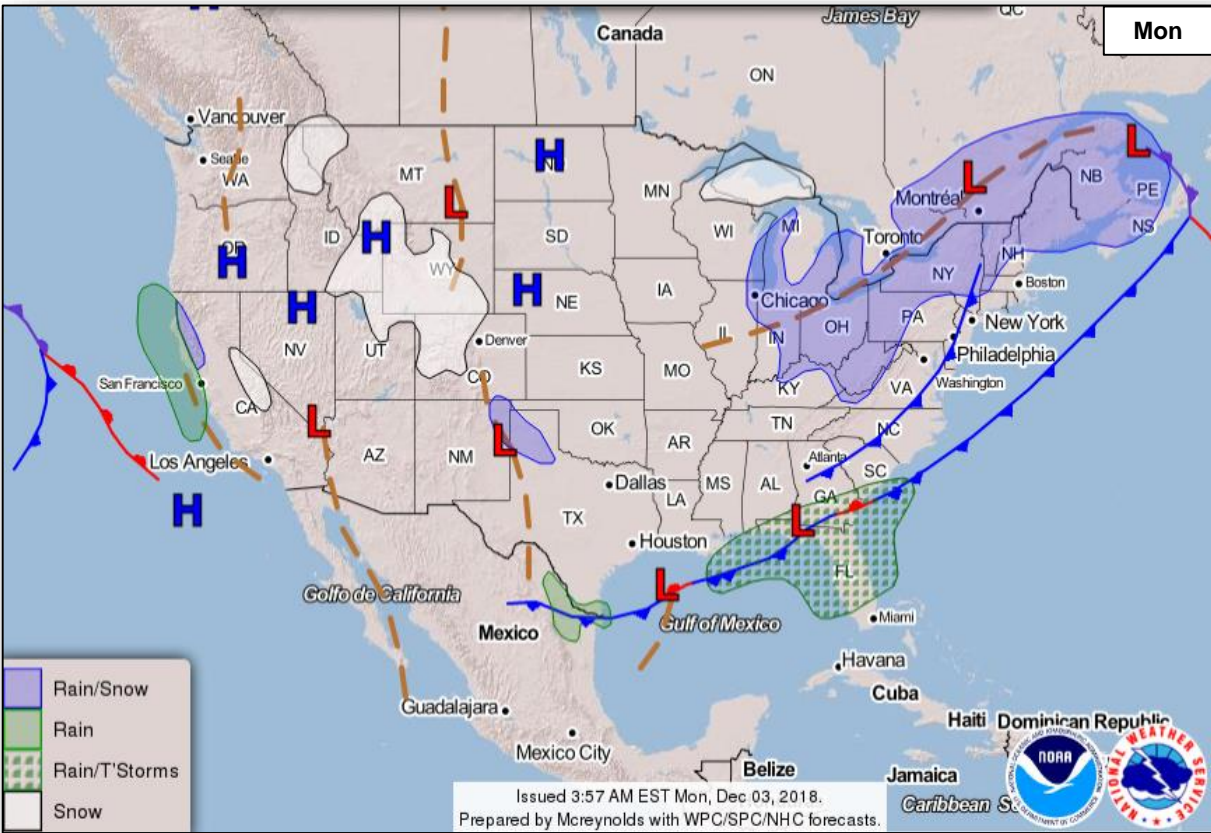
Current schedule of events (NCR):

- Body arrives Andrews Monday afternoon and goes directly to US Capitol for service. (No procession down Pennsylvania Avenue).
- Body lies in State at Capitol Rotunda following service through Wednesday morning for public viewing.
- Funeral at National Cathedral – Wednesday morning (tentatively 11:00 a.m.).
- Body departs for Texas via JB Andrews – Wednesday afternoon.

Preparations and Response (NCR):

- DCHSEMA EOC Full activation; Mon – Wed (Dayshifts)
- MD SEOC Partial activation; Mon – Wed (Dayshifts)
- VA SEOC Monitoring (previous tropical cyclone activity)
- FEMA Region III RRCC Alpha Team; Mon – Wed (Dayshifts)
 - LNOs to DCHSEMA, NCR JFHQ, USSS MACC, FBI WFO, US Capitol Police
 - ONCRC Emergency Response Team (ERT-A) to DCHSEMA
 - Region III IMAT and additional LNOs on alert
- FEMA NWC at Enhanced Watch, day shift only

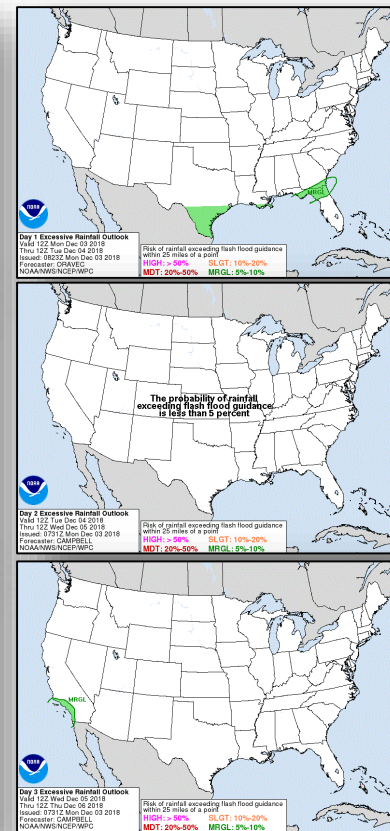
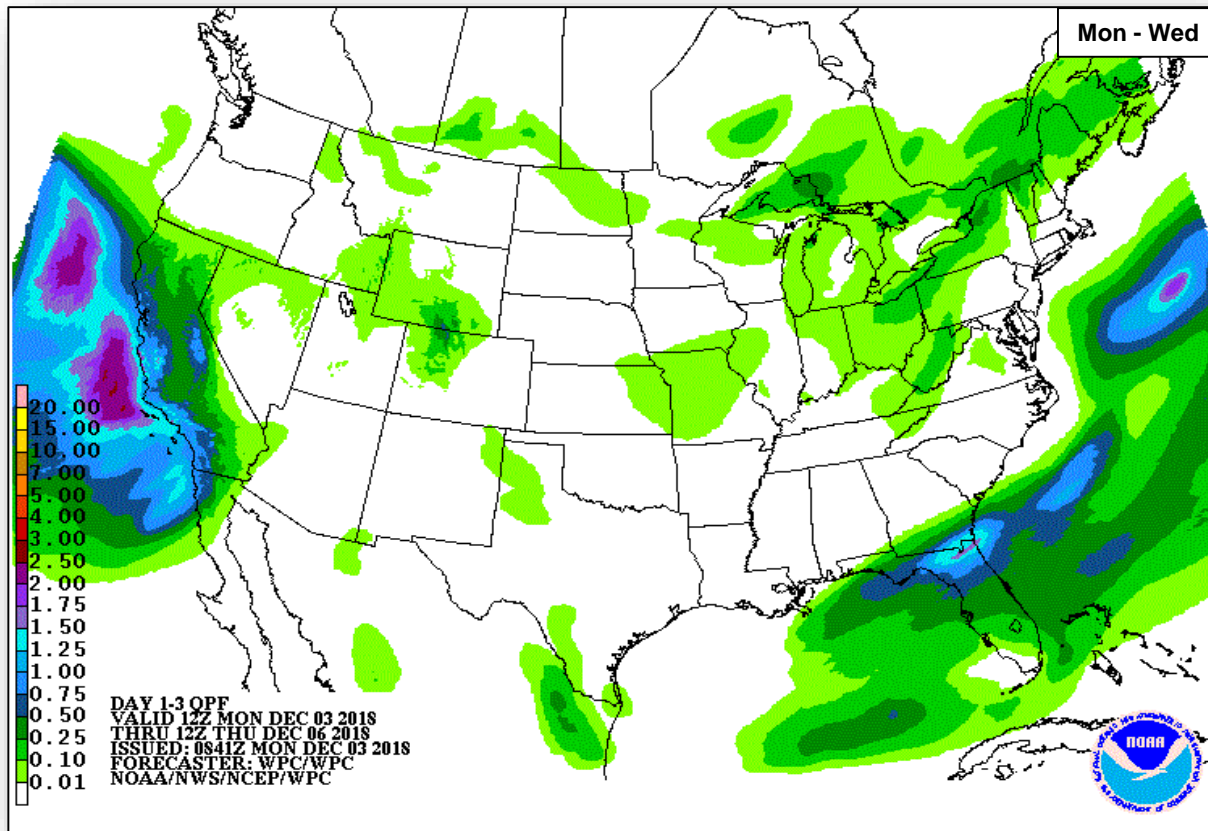
National Weather Forecast

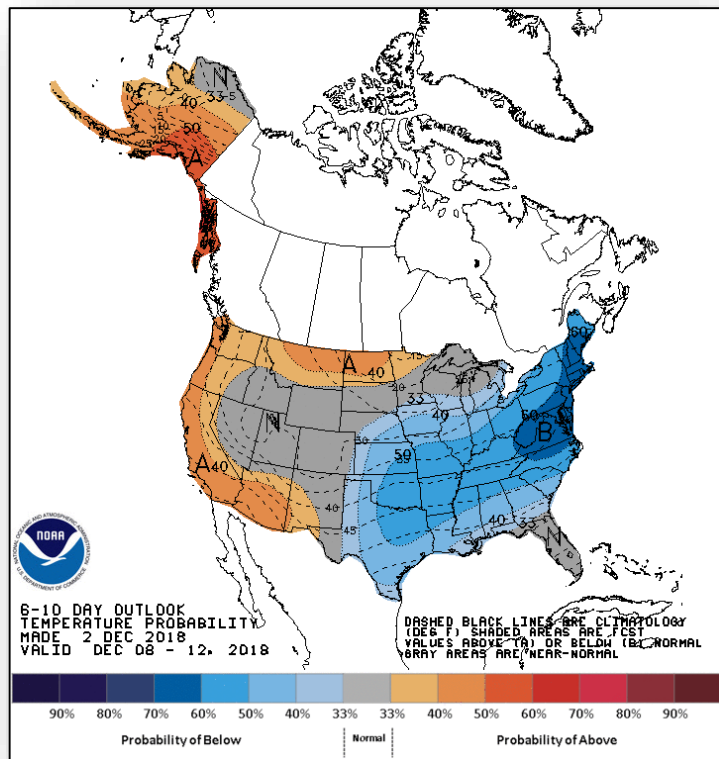

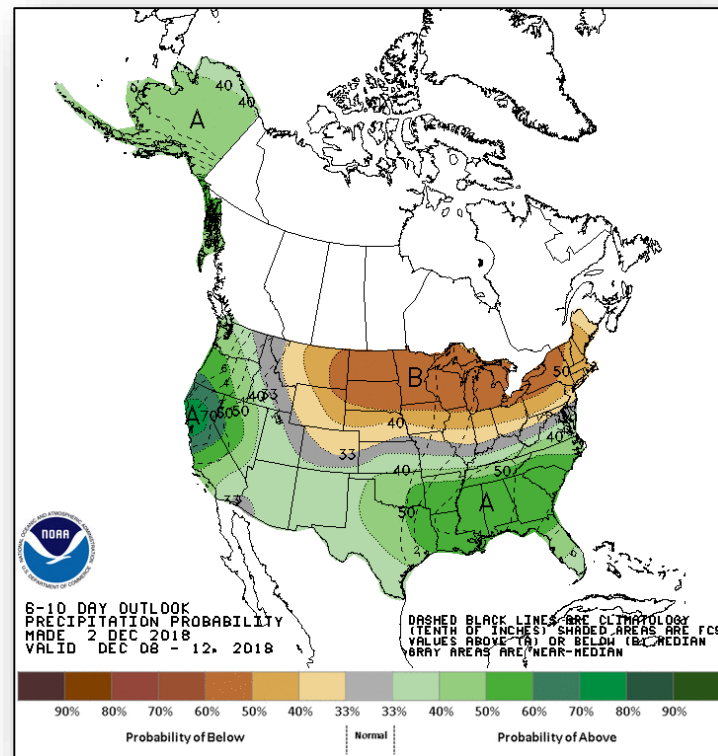
Long Range Outlooks – Dec 8-12

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

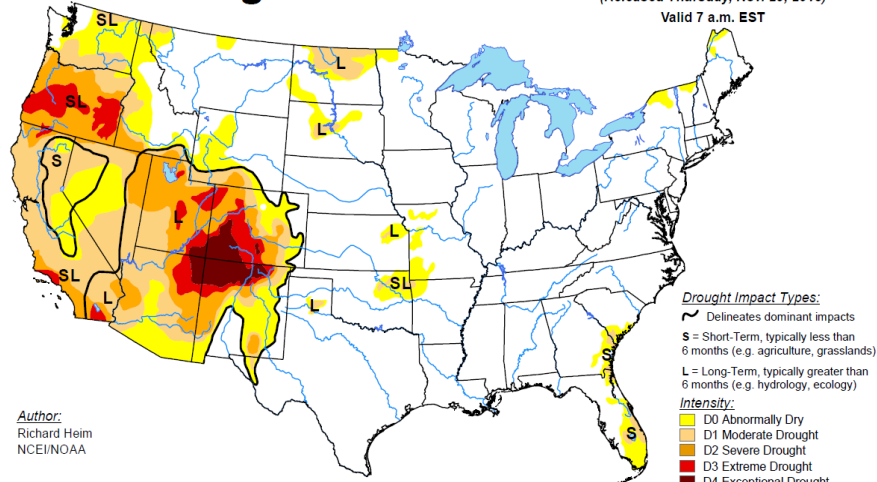
U.S. Monthly Drought Outlook



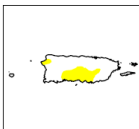
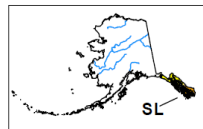

Drought Impact Types:
~ Delineates dominant impacts
S = Short-Term, typically less than 6 months (e.g. agriculture, grasslands)
L = Long-Term, typically greater than 6 months (e.g. hydrology, ecology)
Intensity:
D0 Abnormally Dry
D1 Moderate Drought
D2 Severe Drought
D3 Extreme Drought
D4 Exceptional Drought

The Drought Monitor focuses on broad-scale conditions. Local conditions may vary. See accompanying text summary for forecast statements.

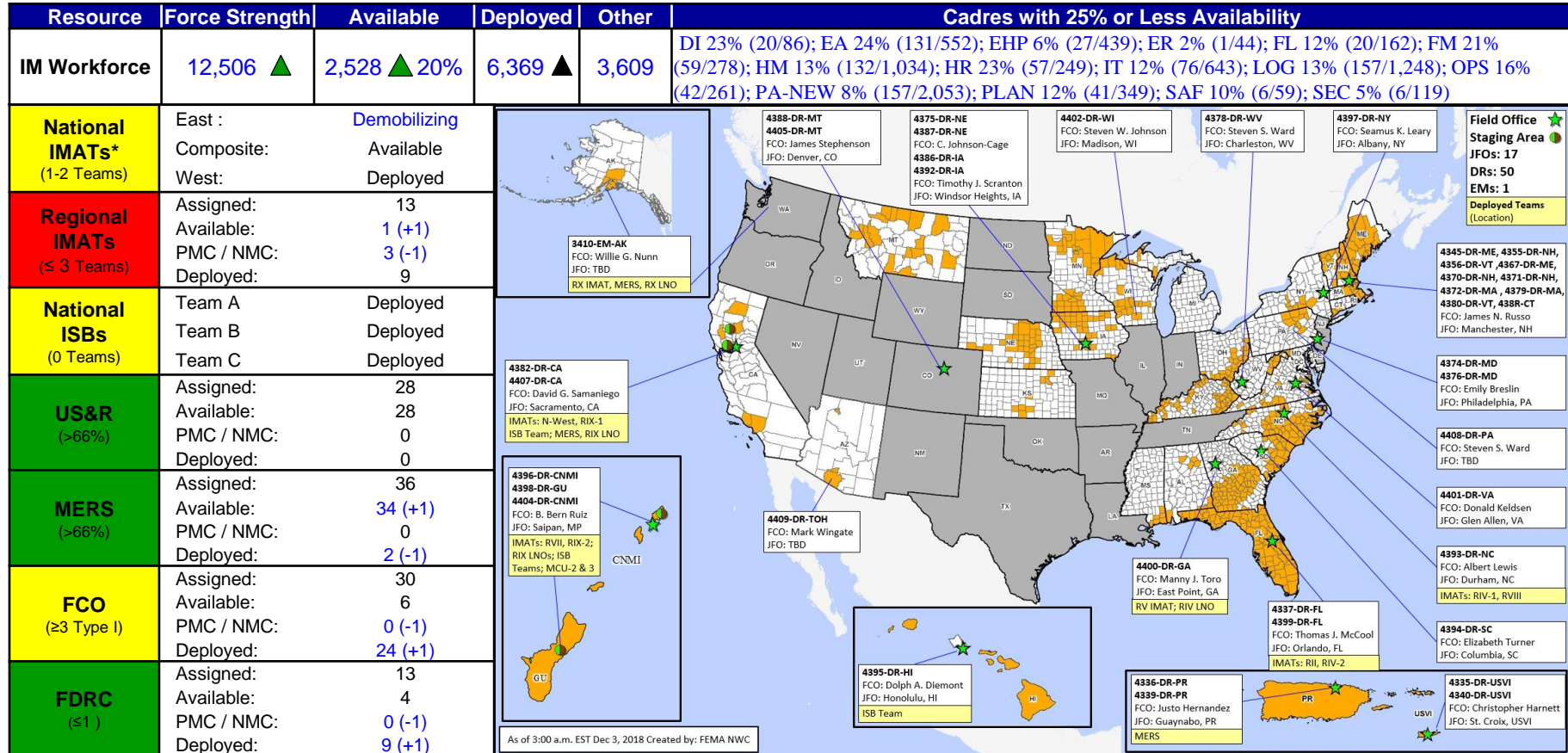
