National Weather Forecast



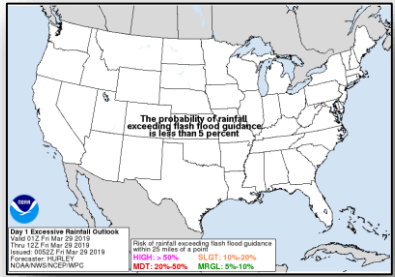
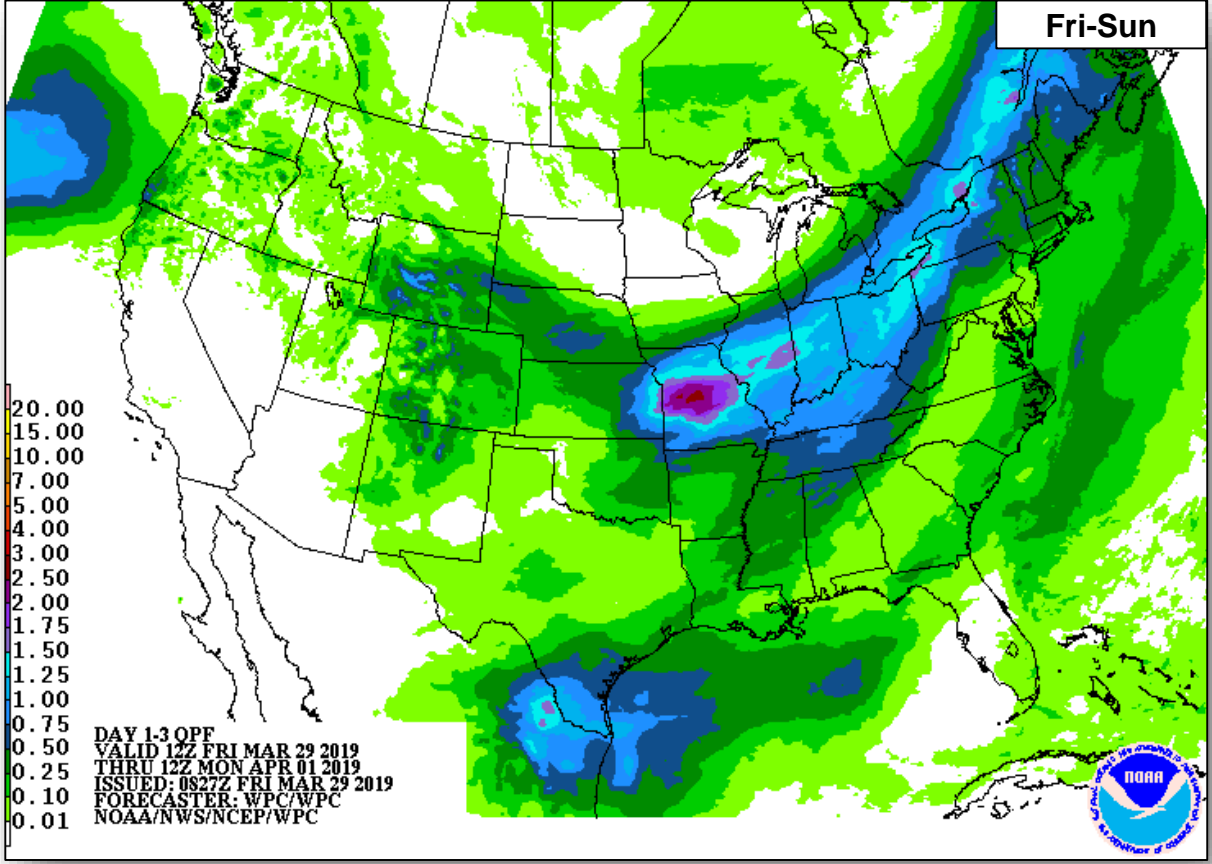
Severe Weather Outlook



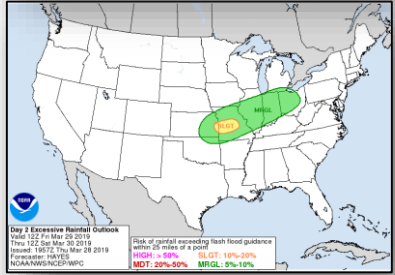
Precipitation Forecast



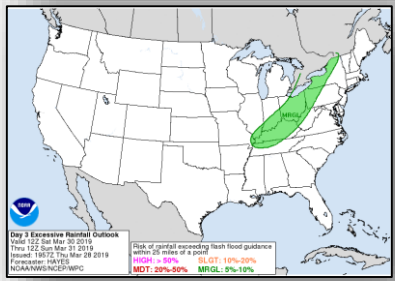

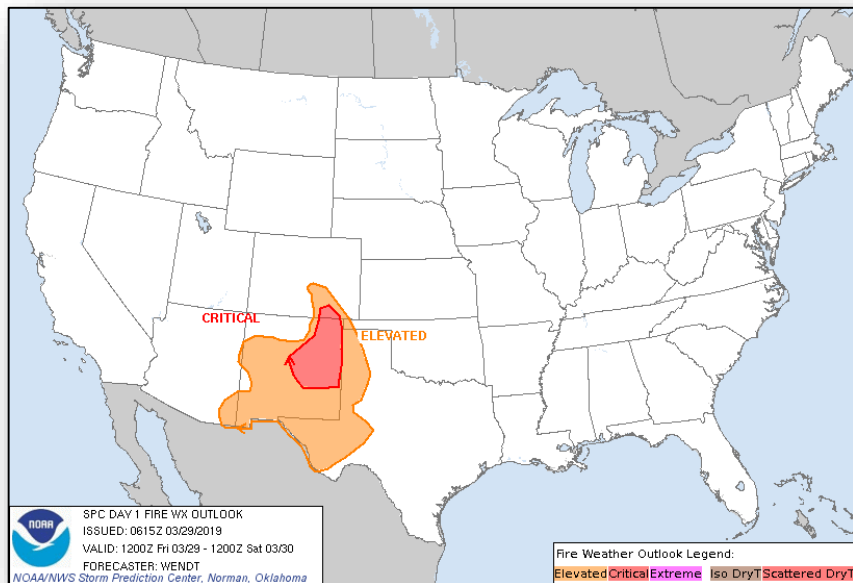

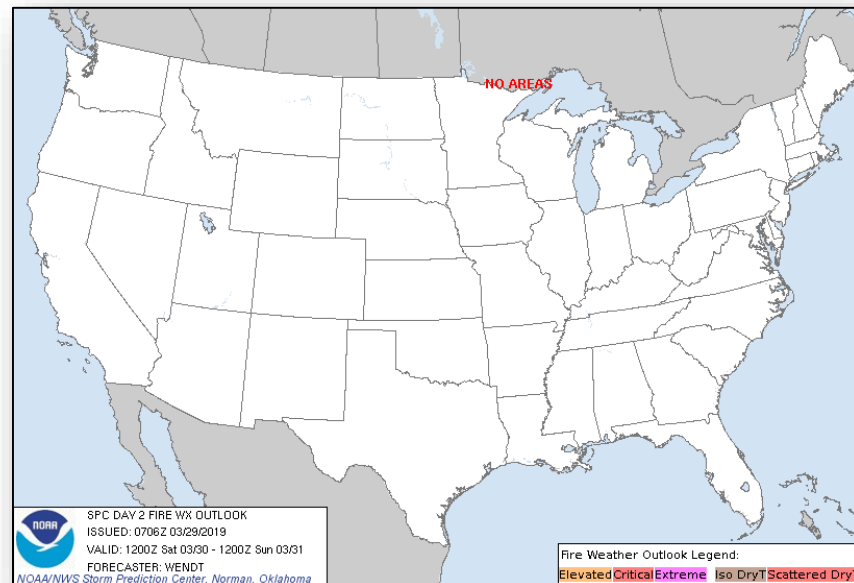
Fire Weather Outlook

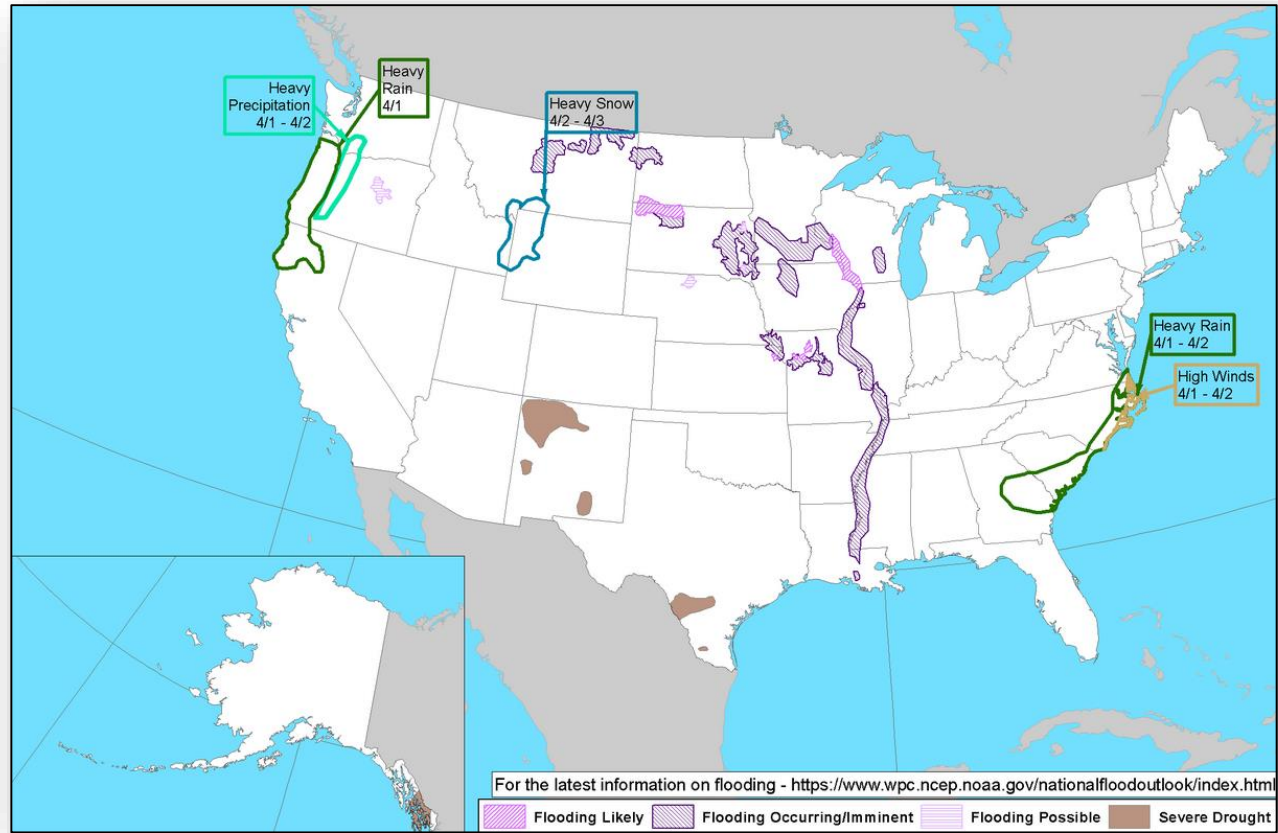

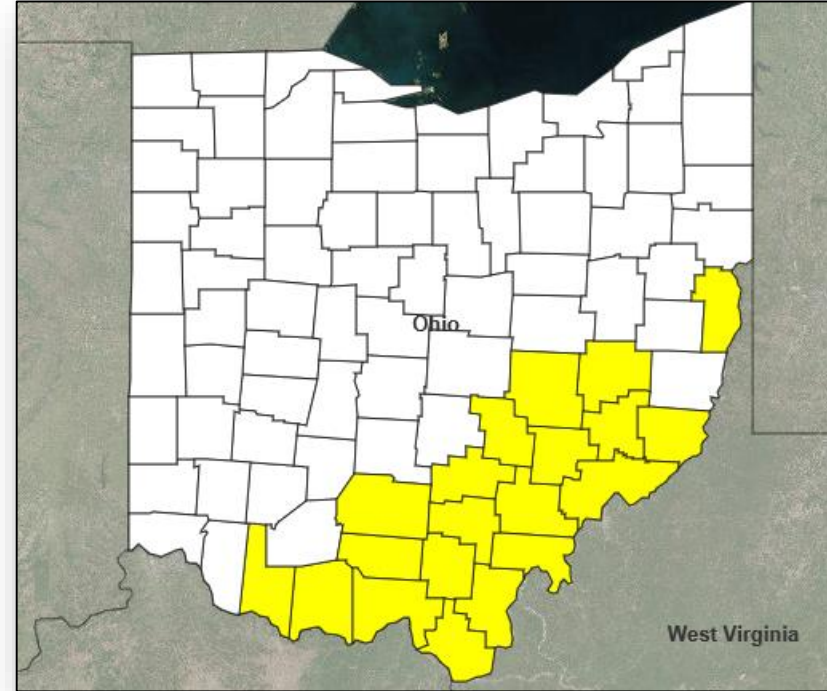

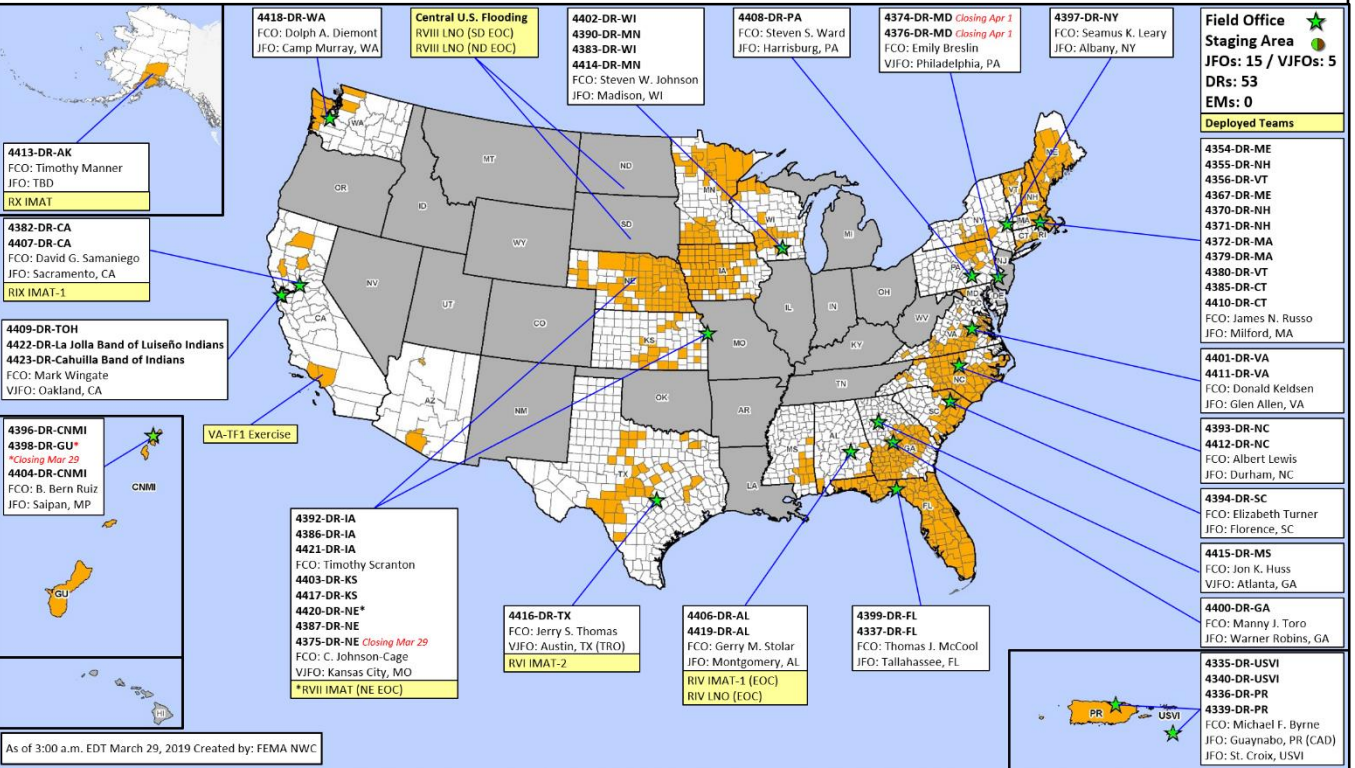
