Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1: High (70%) – No threat to U.S. interests
- Central Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central/Northern Plains to Great Lakes

- Amendment No. 1 to FEMA-4440-DR-SD

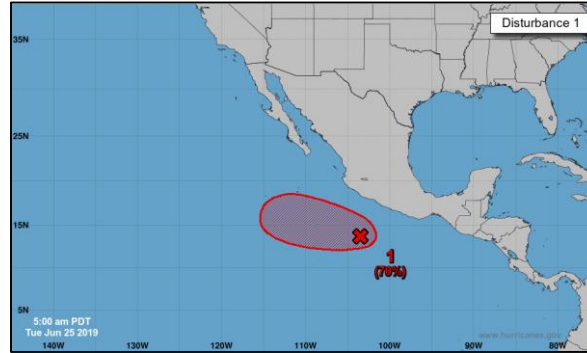
Tropical Outlook – Five Day

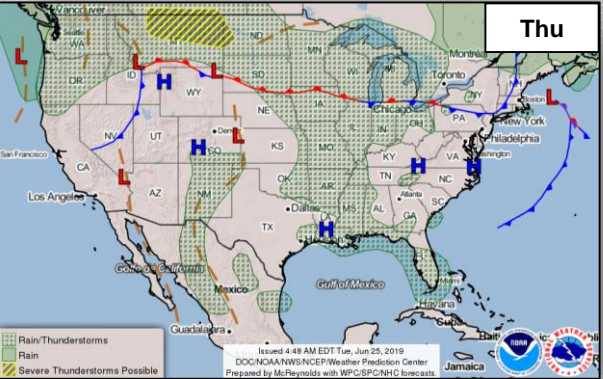
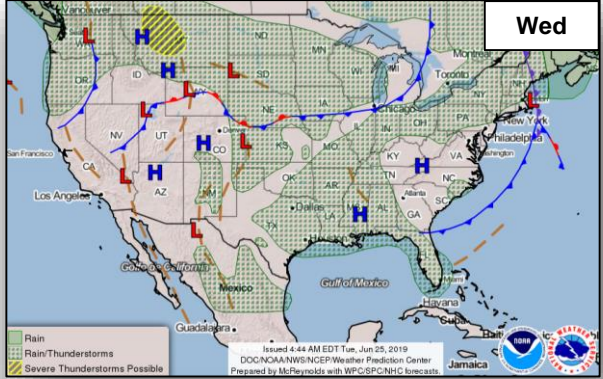
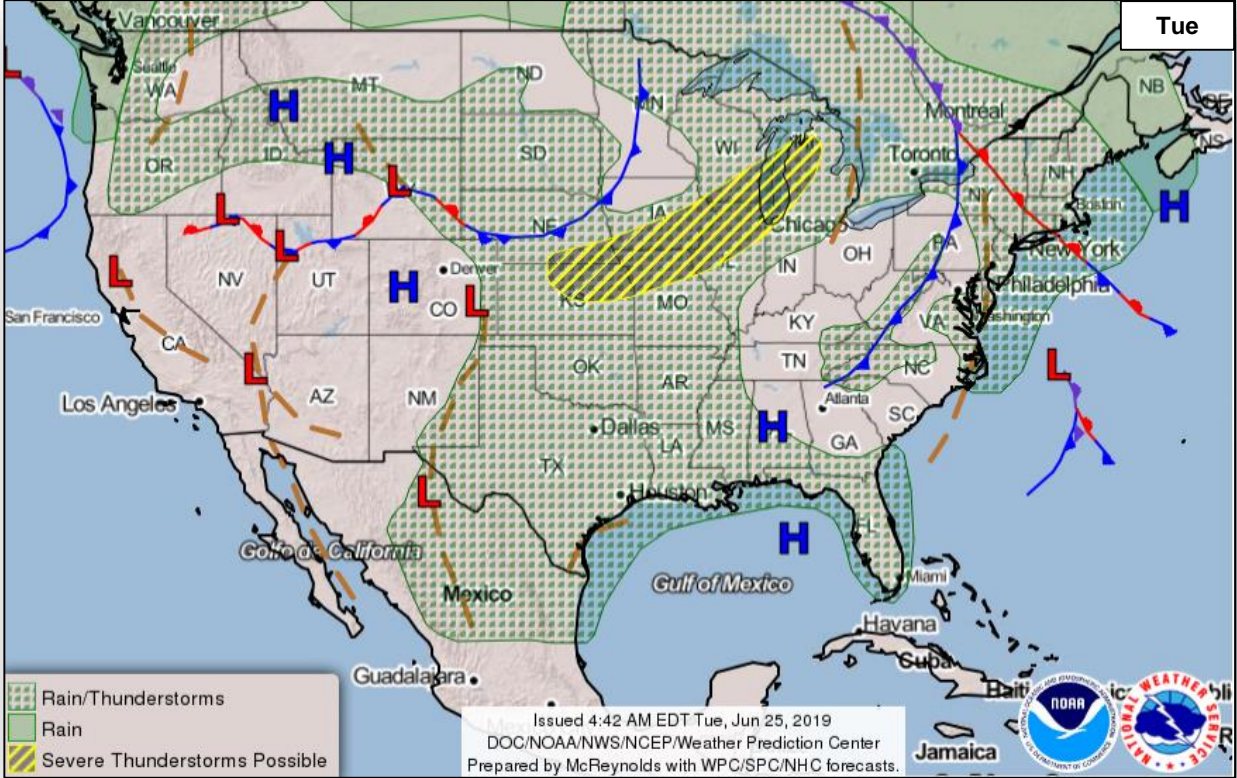
Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- No threat to U.S. interests

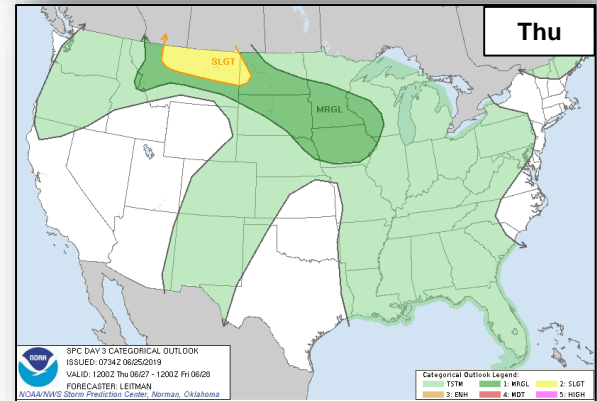
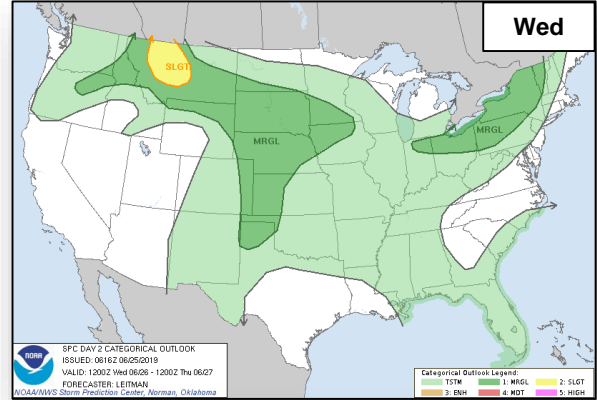
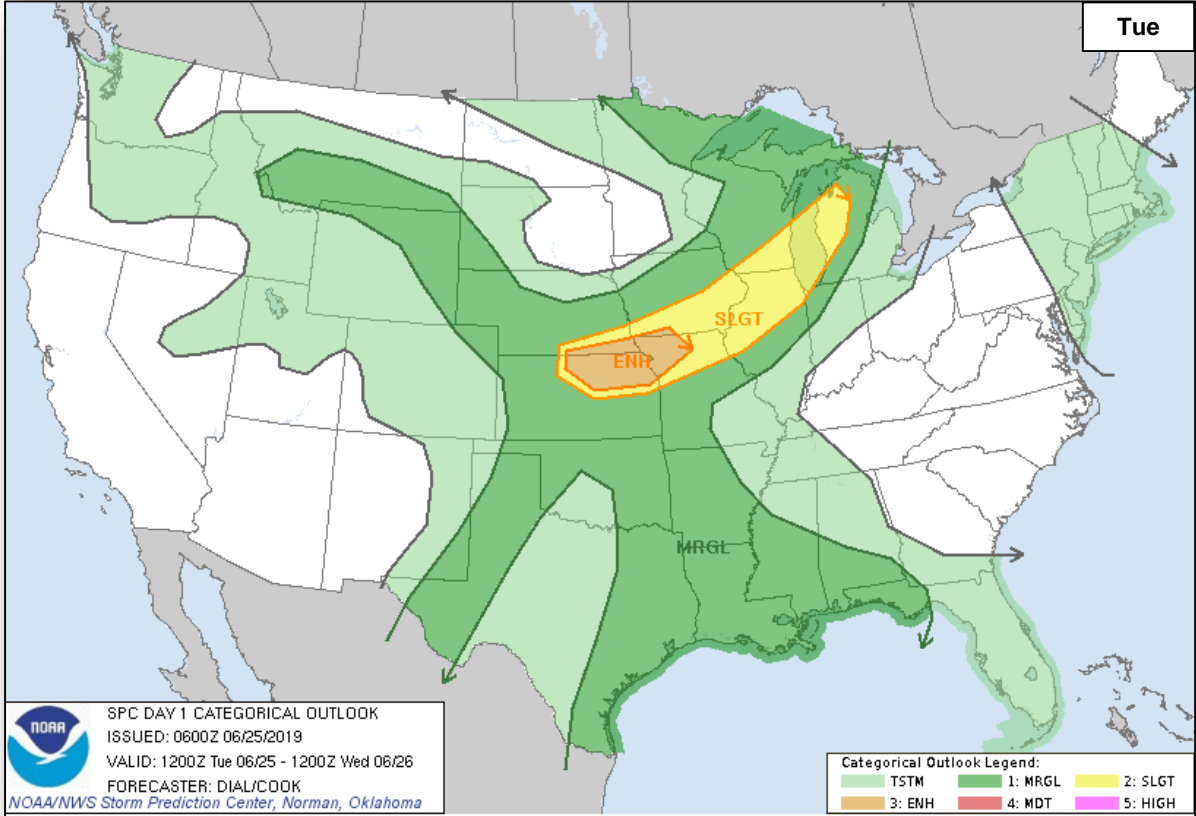
National Weather Forecast

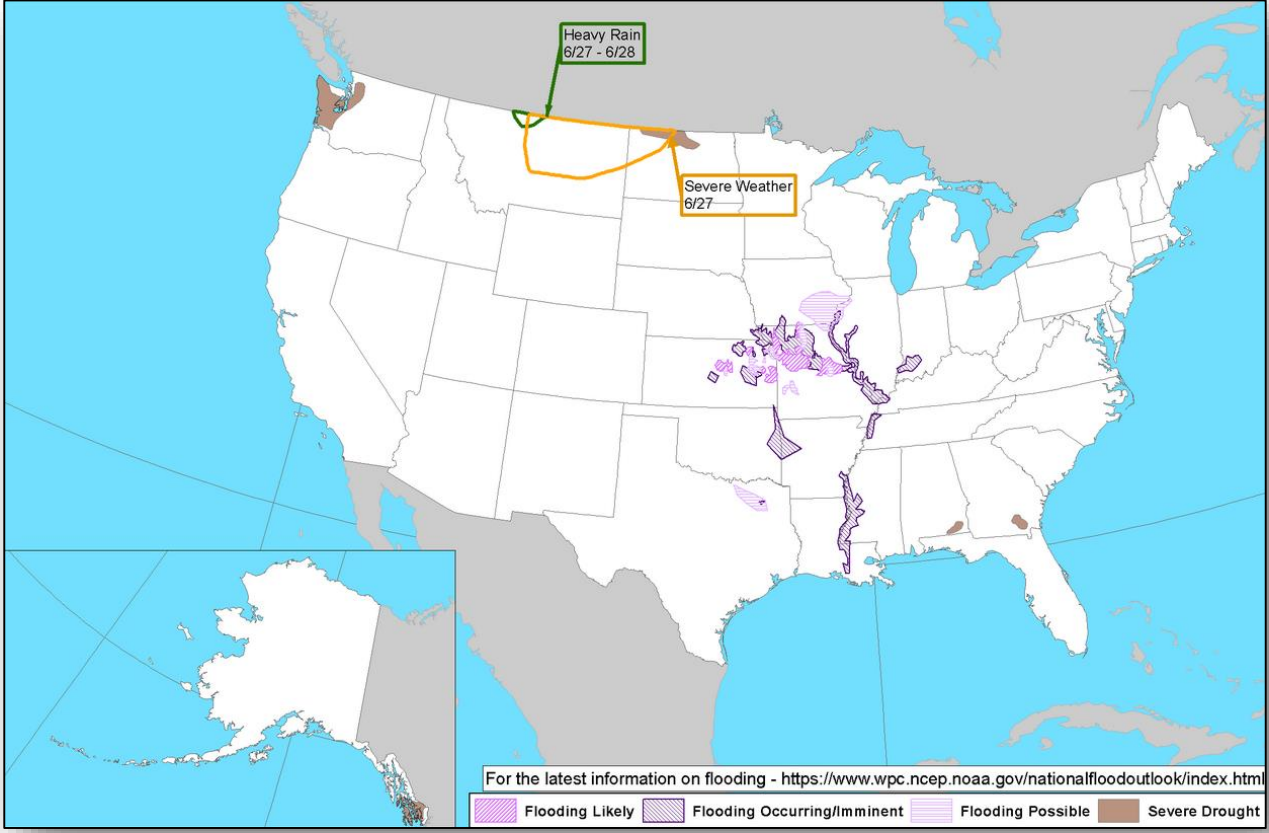
Severe Weather Outlook

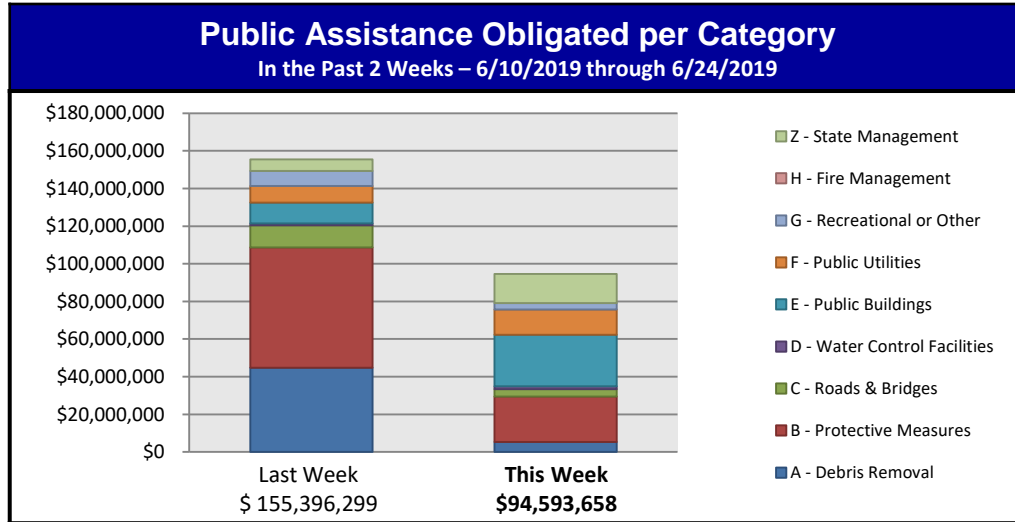

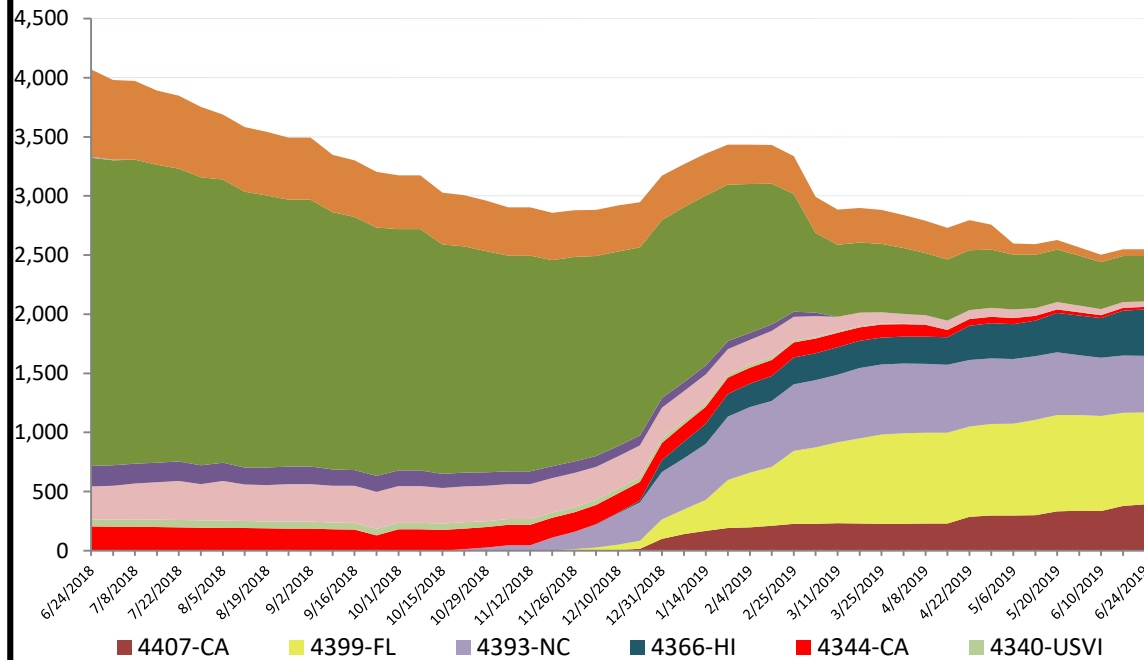

States with Currently Occupied Units

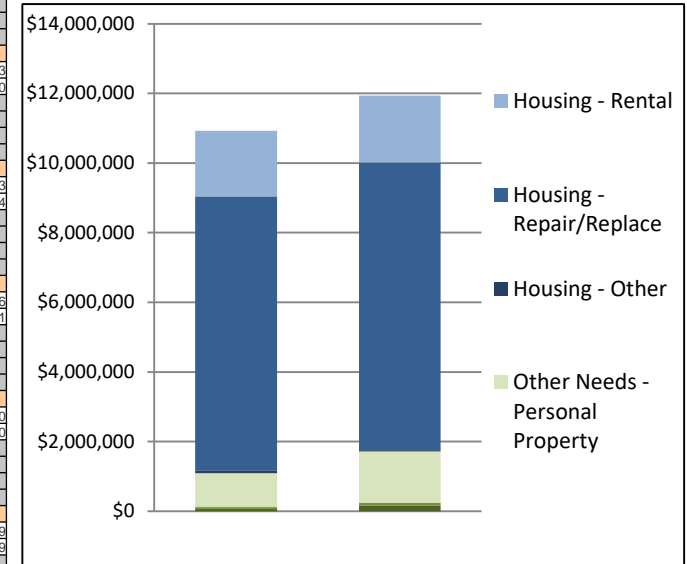
