# East Coast Winter Storm – FINAL



## Situation

Conditions are improving across the Northeast as the winter storm moves into Nova Scotia

## Impacts

### FEMA Regions I – IV

- **Fatalities/Injuries:** 6 fatalities
  - One fatality in VA due to hypothermia
  - Two fatalities in NC due to auto accidents
  - Three fatalities in SC
- **Power** (as of 5:30 a.m. EST)\*: Minimal outages throughout impacted areas
- **American Red Cross Shelters** (as of 5:30 a.m. EST):
  - MA – [Three](#) open with [27](#) occupants
- **Transportation:**
  - Air: Over 6.5K flights cancelled to date
  - Ground: Hazardous road conditions and rail delays as expected

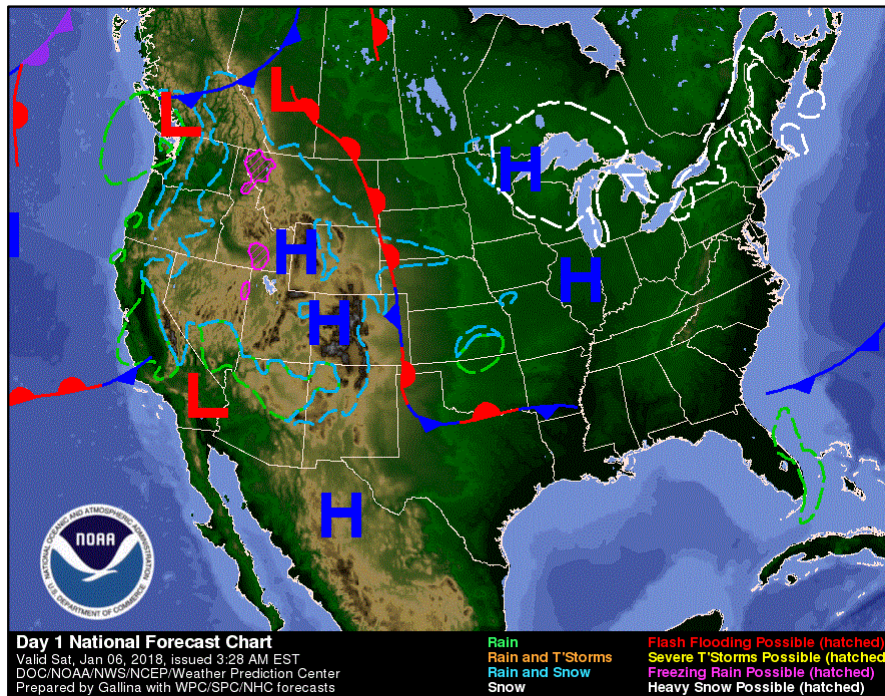

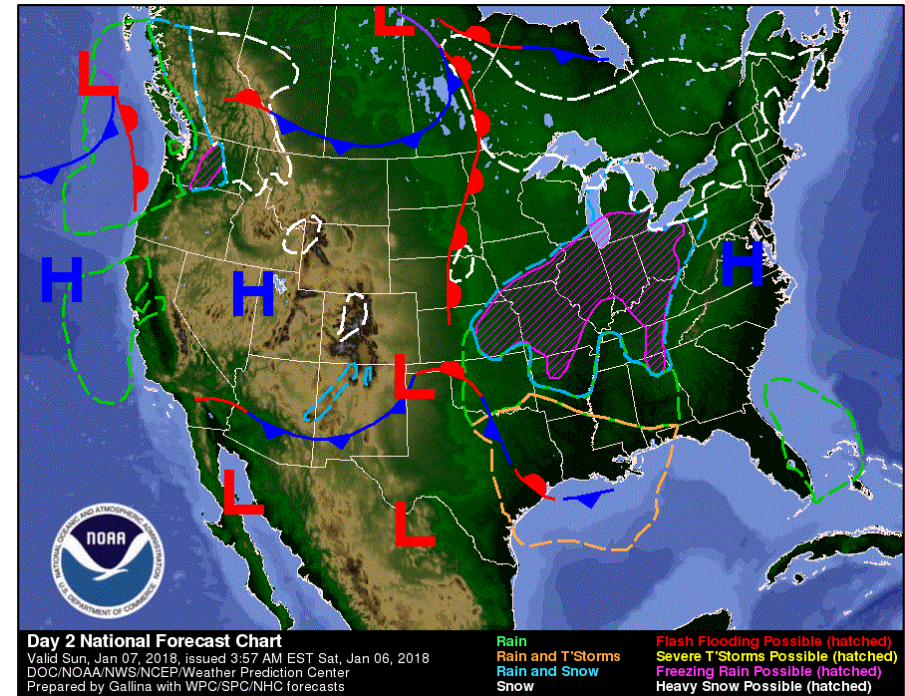

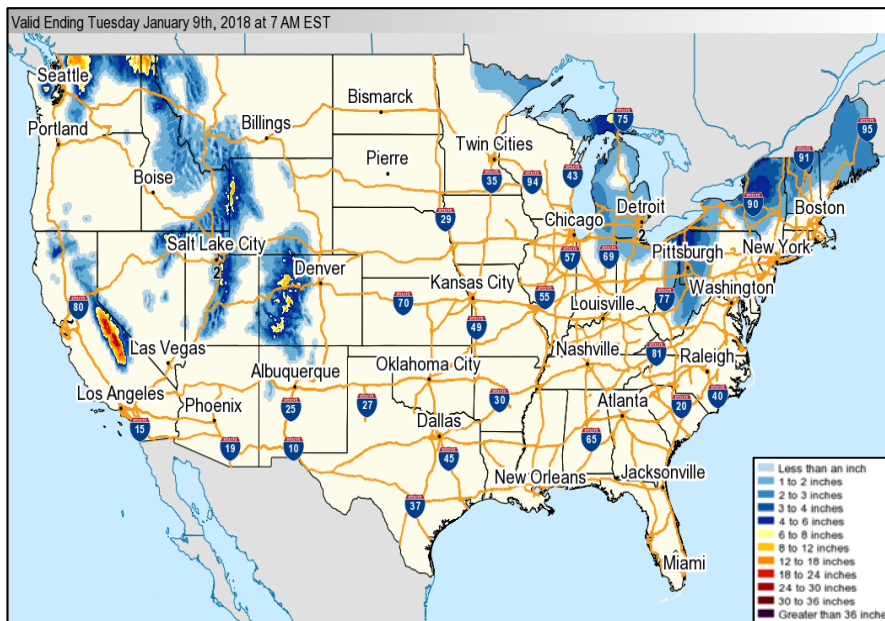

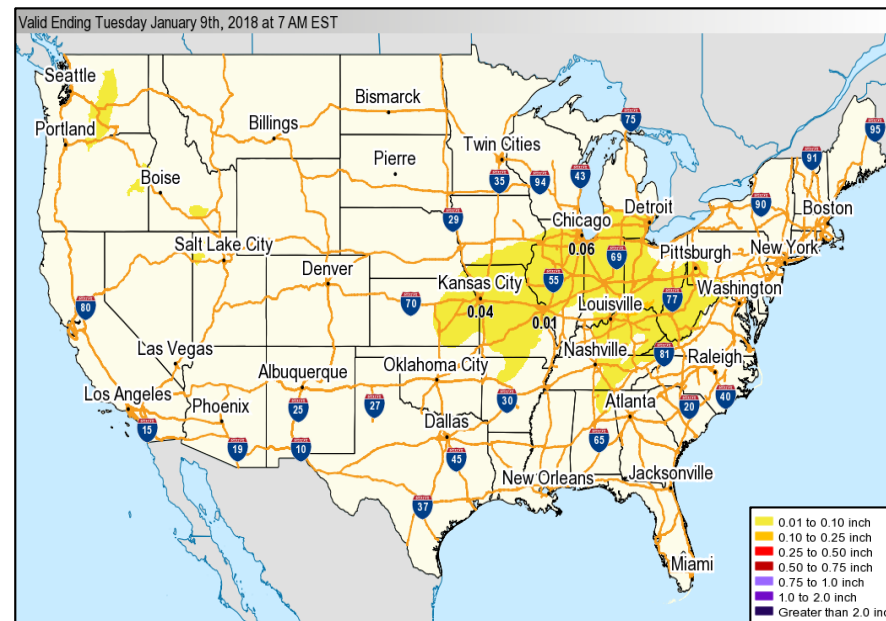
# Winter Precipitation Outlook



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***Forecast Snowfall***

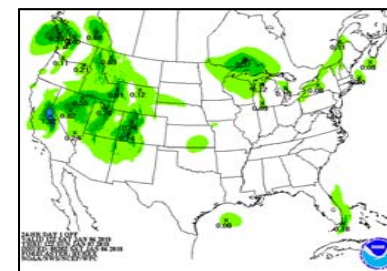
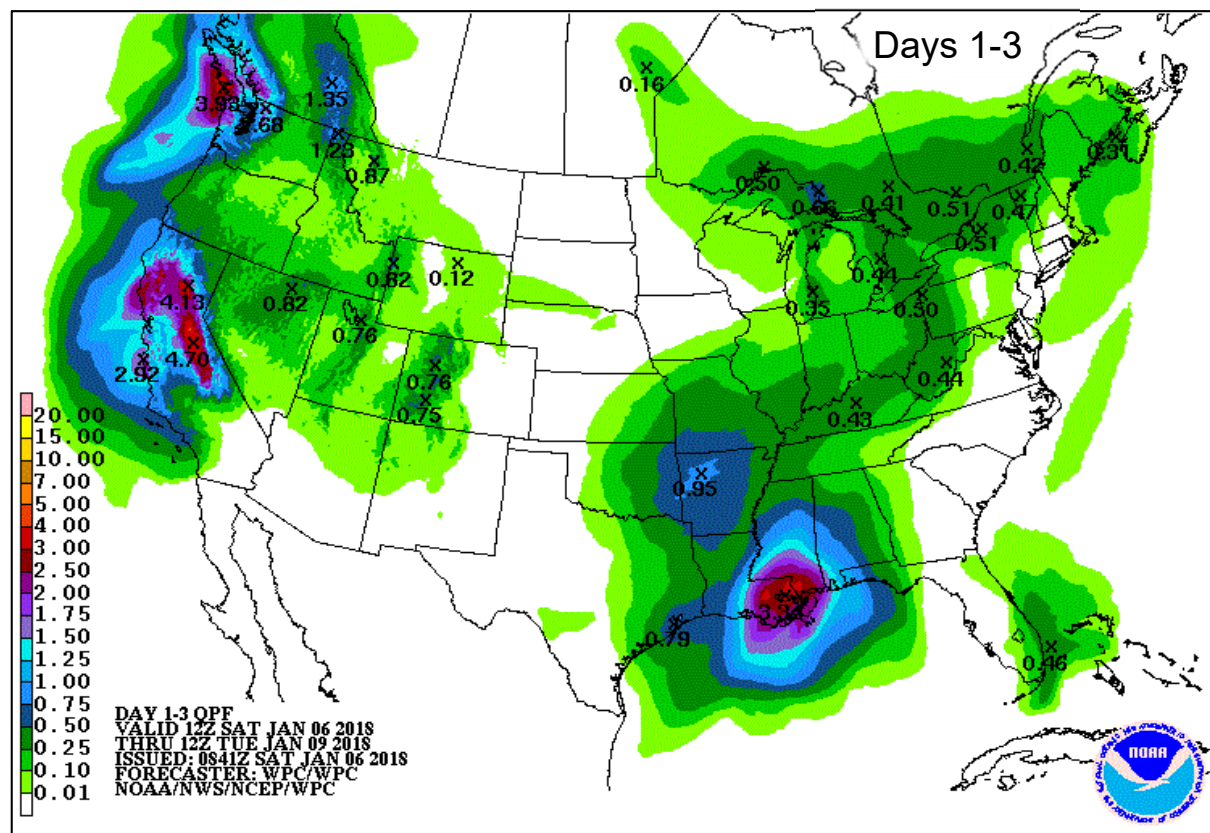


***Forecast Ice Accumulation***

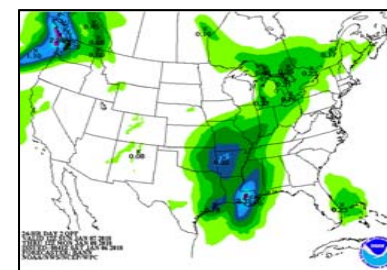
