Significant Events: 58th Presidential Inauguration

Significant Weather:

- Flash flooding possible – California, Lower Mississippi Valley
- Severe Thunderstorms possible – Lower Mississippi Valley
- Freezing rain – Northern Plains, Great Lakes, Northeast
- Heavy snow – California, Central Great Basin/Four Corners area, and Southwest
- Snow – Northern Intermountain to Northern/Central Plains, Central Great Basin and Central Rockies
- Rain and snow – Northern Intermountain to CA, Central Great Basin to Southwest and Southern Rockies; Northern/Central Plains, Great Lakes and Northeast
- Rain and thunderstorms – Southern Plains to Southeast, Ohio valleys to Southern Appalachians

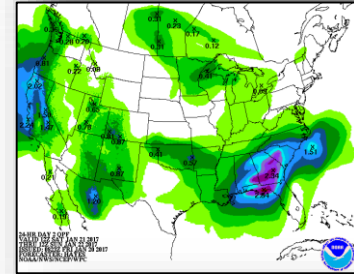
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



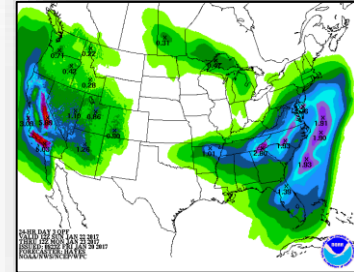

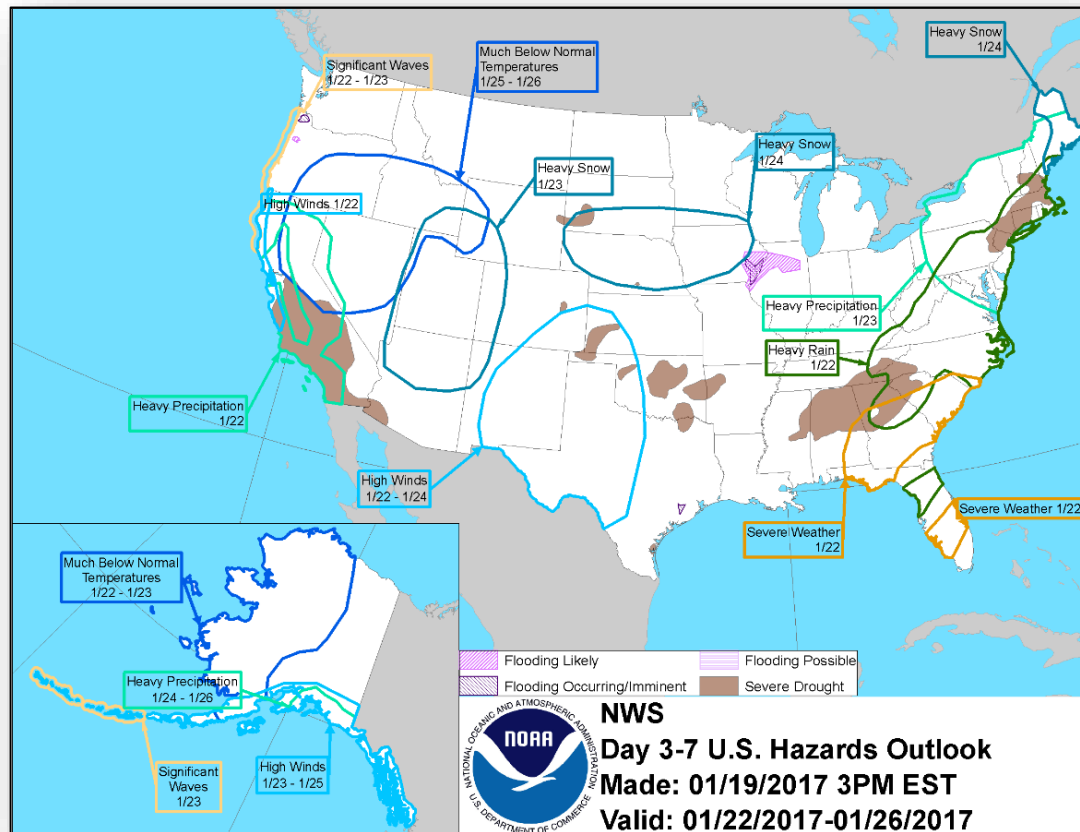
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3



Hazards Outlook – Jan 22-26



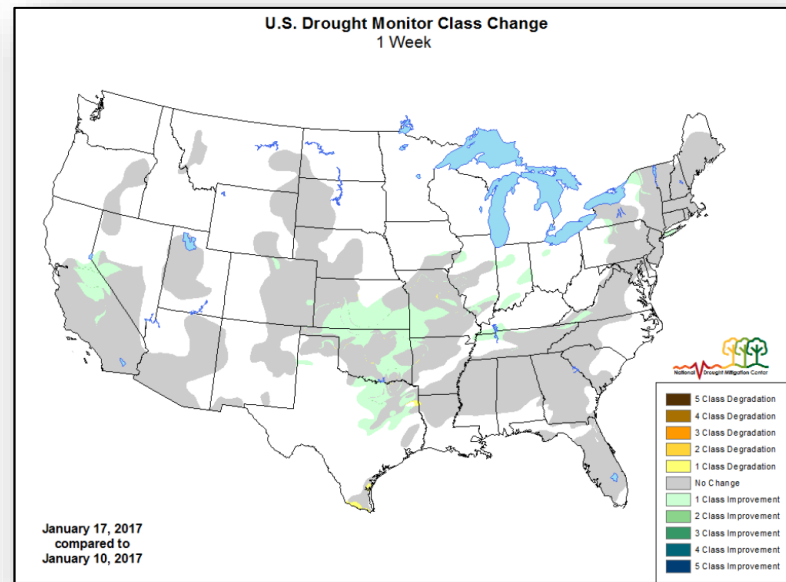
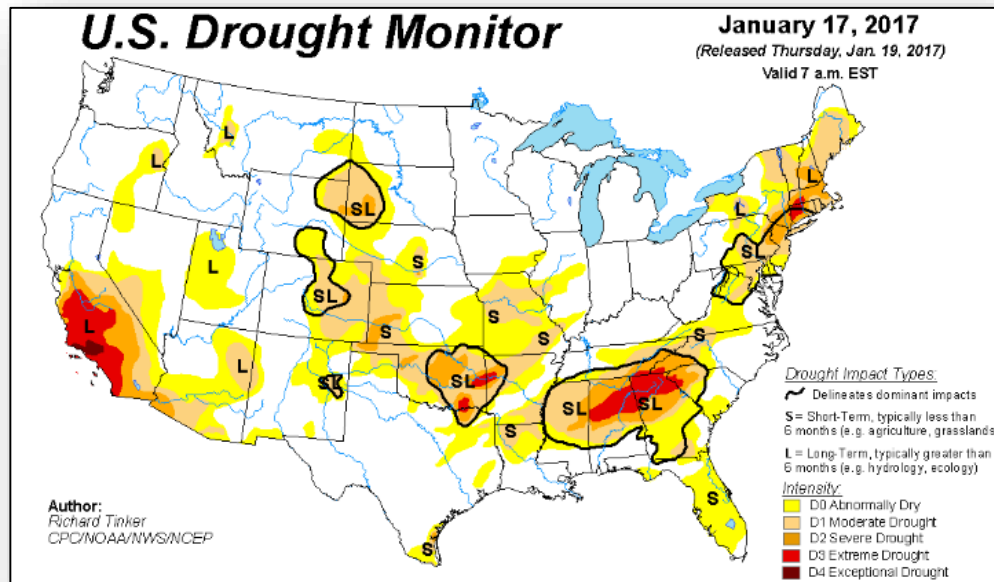

 - Hazard Mitigation for Kivalina Village

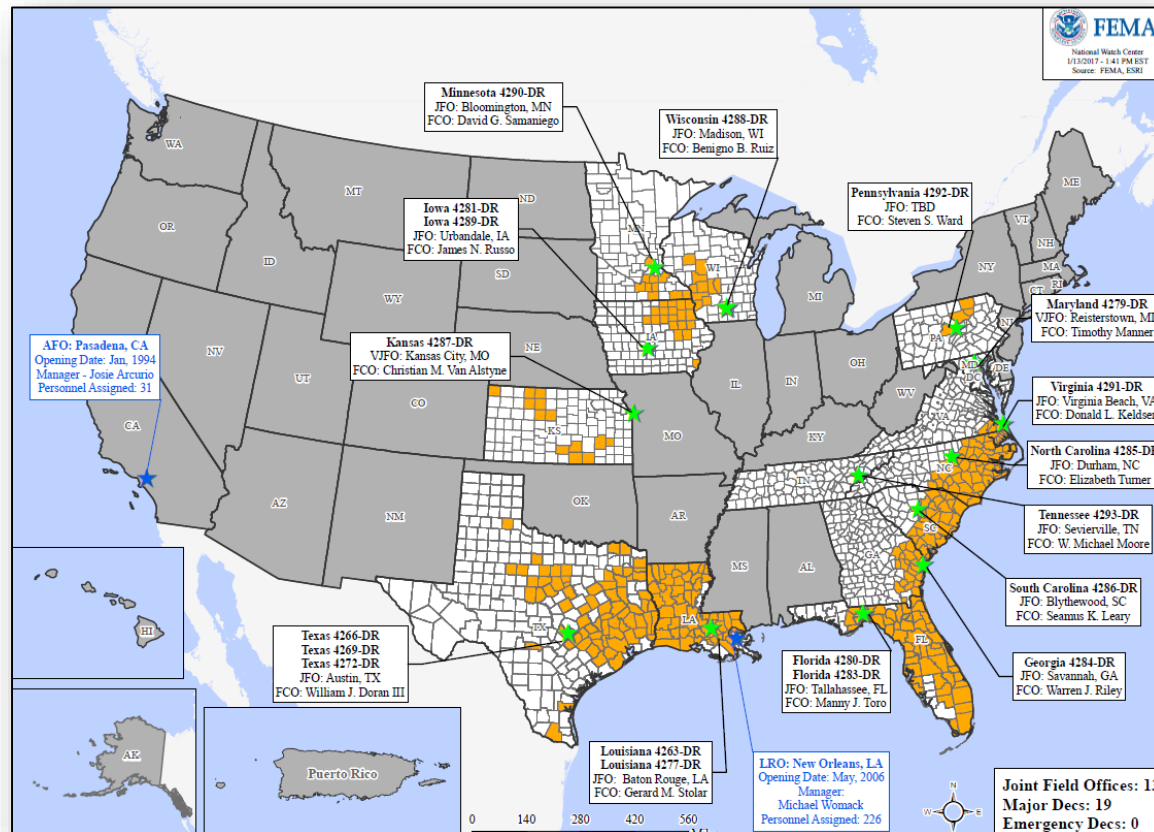
