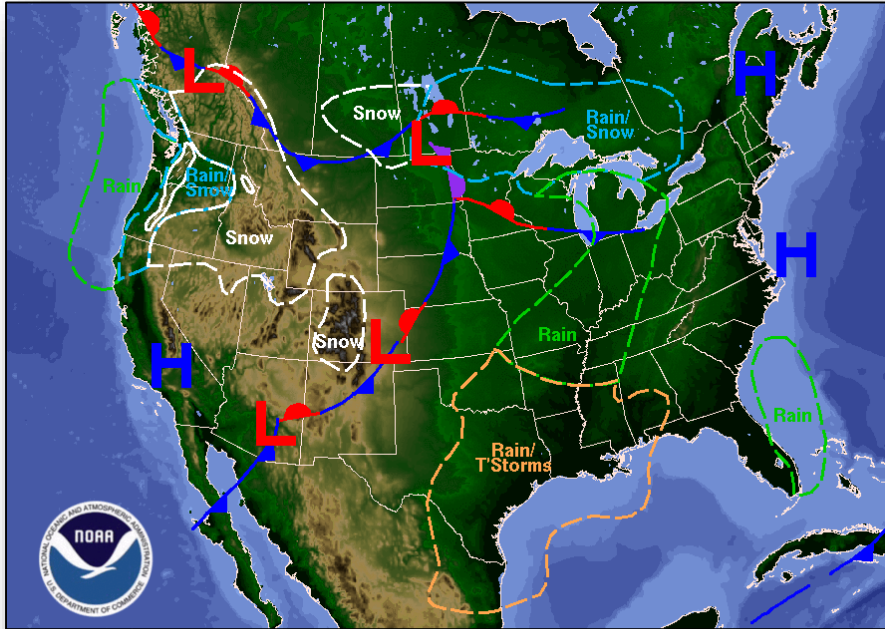

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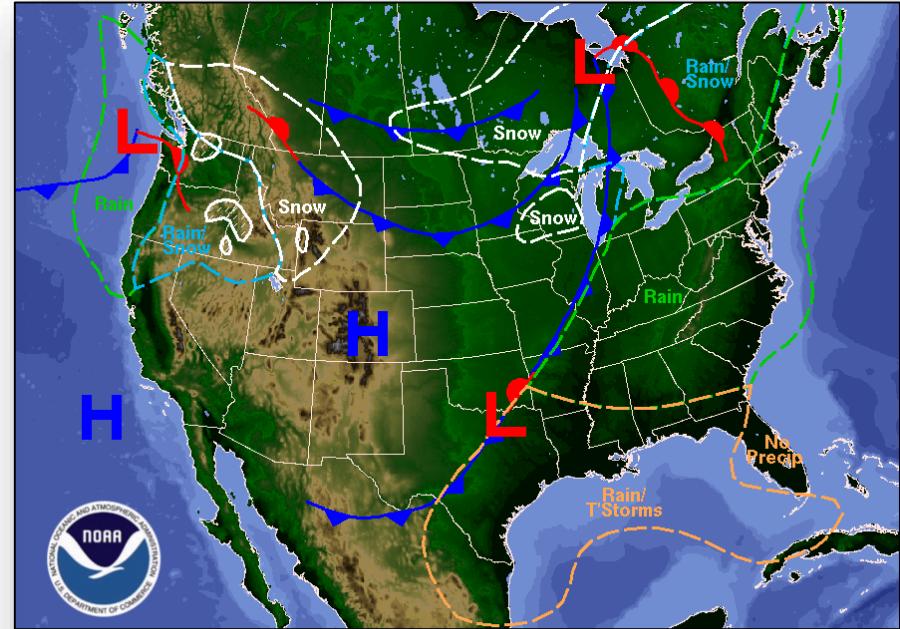


Day 1 National Forecast Chart

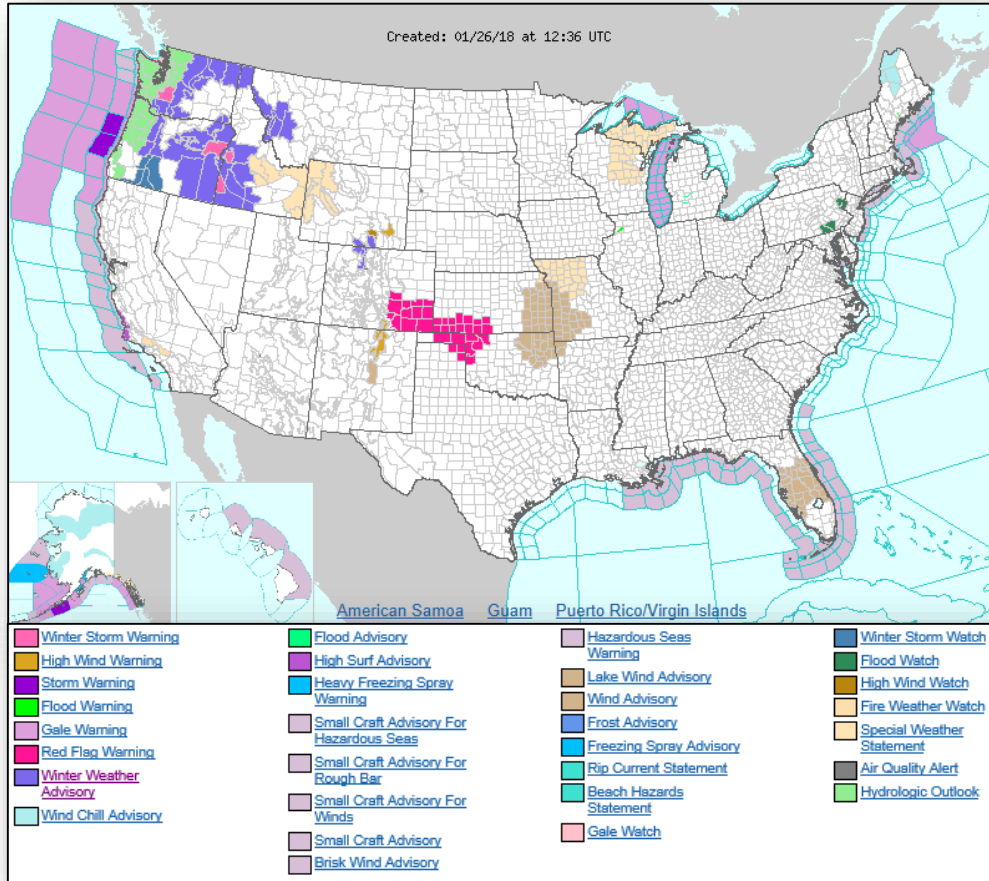

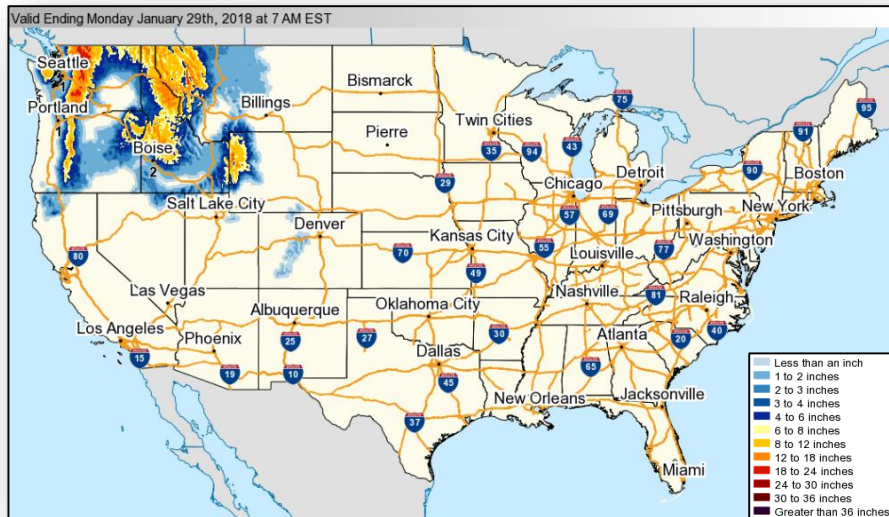

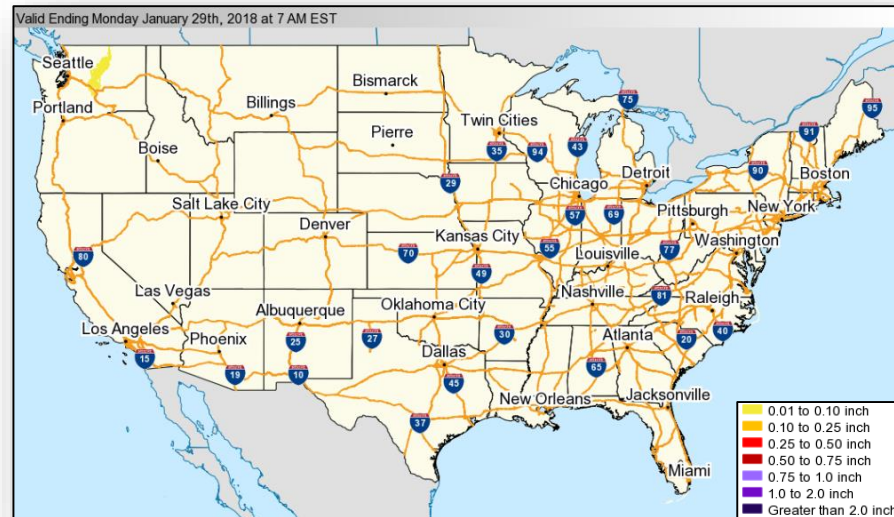
# Winter Precipitation Outlook



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***Forecast Snowfall***



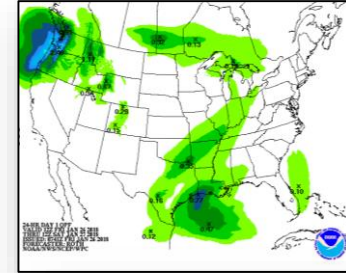
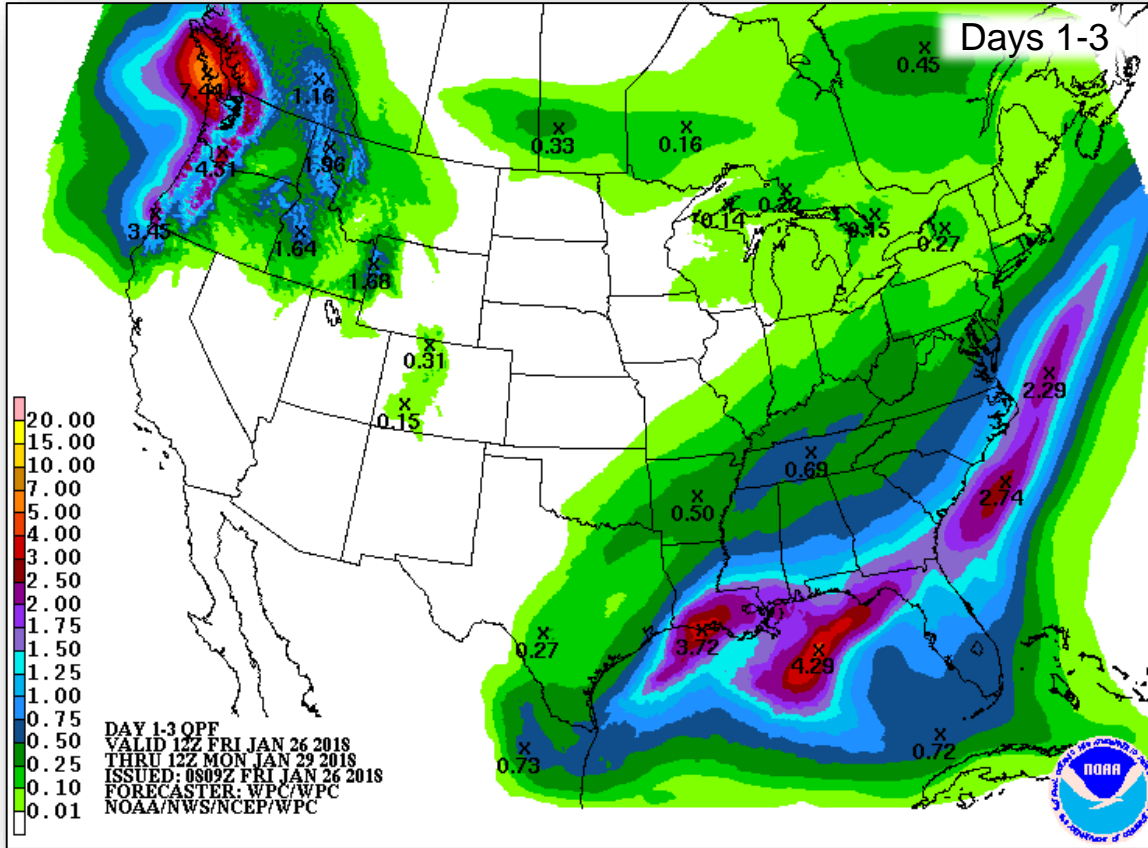
***Forecast Ice Accumulation***



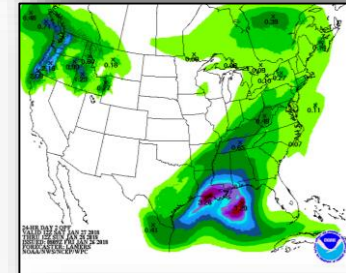
