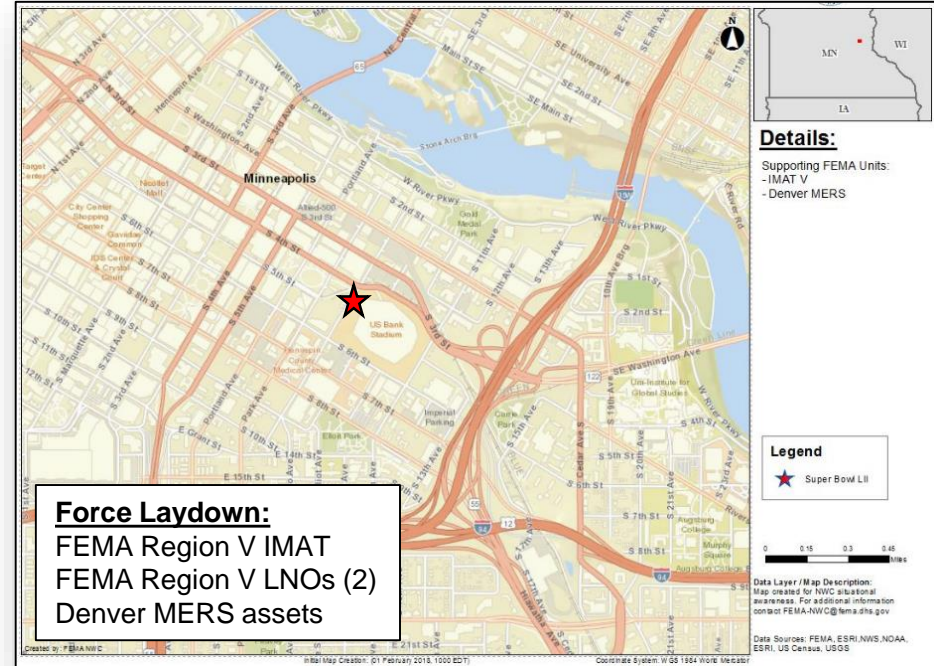
- Designated SEAR 1 Event this Sunday at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, MN

Preparations / Response

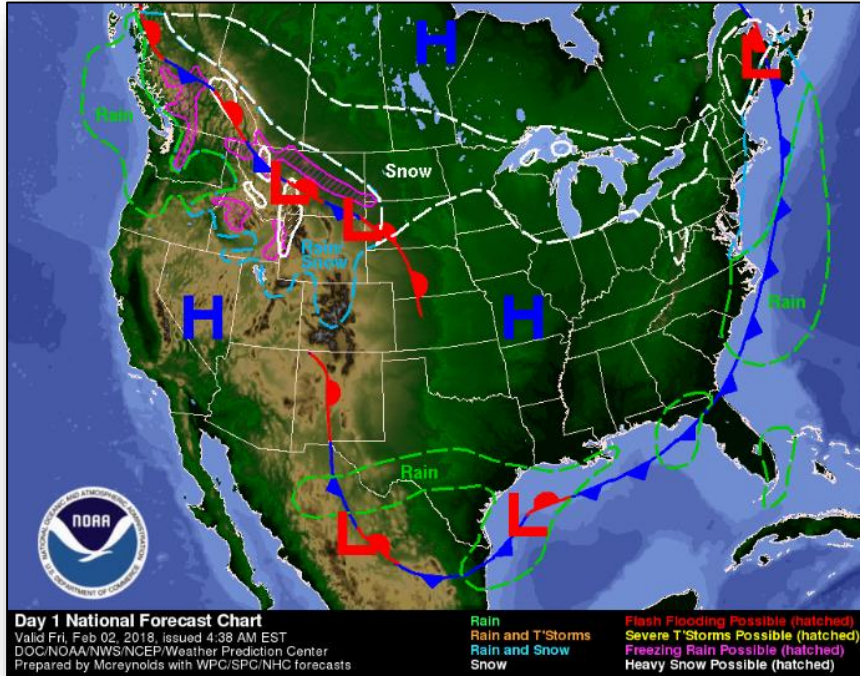
- MN EOC at Partial Activation

- FEMA NWC continues to monitor



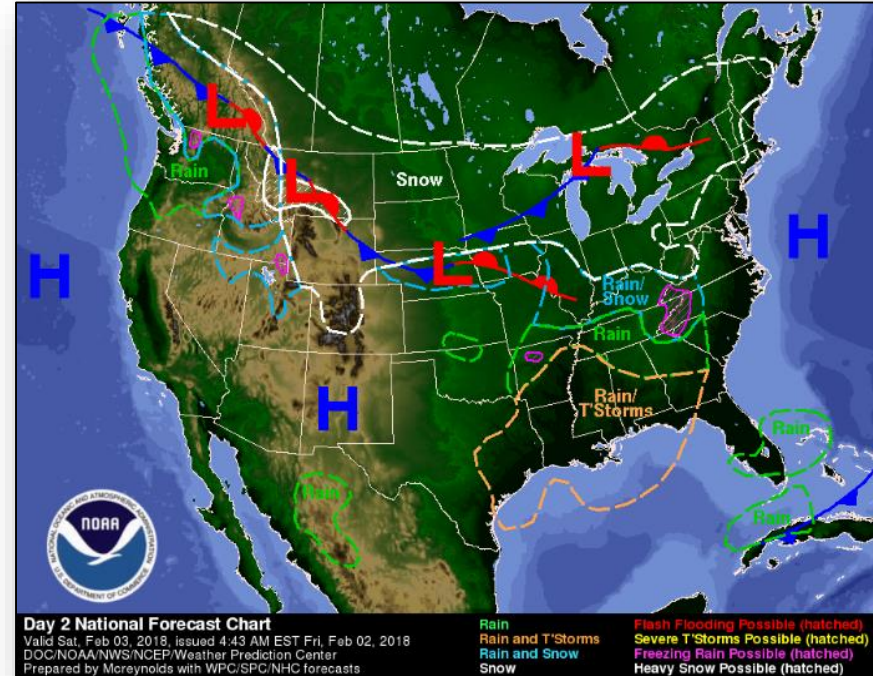

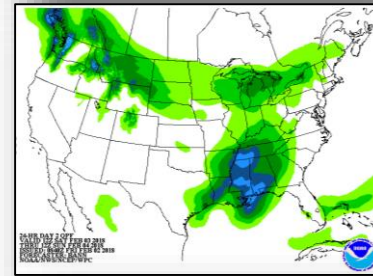
Precipitation Forecast



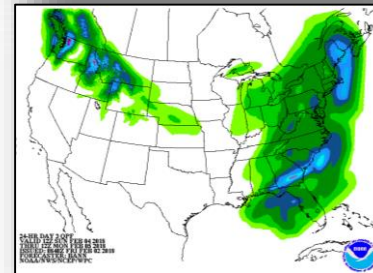
