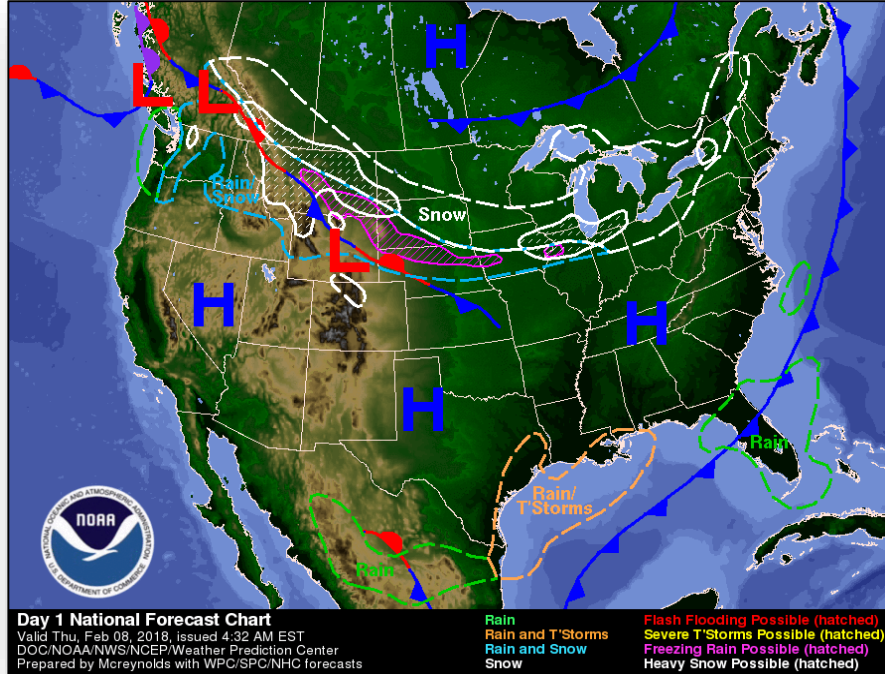
- Located 565 miles southeast of Guam

- No Watches or Warnings issued for Guam or CNMI



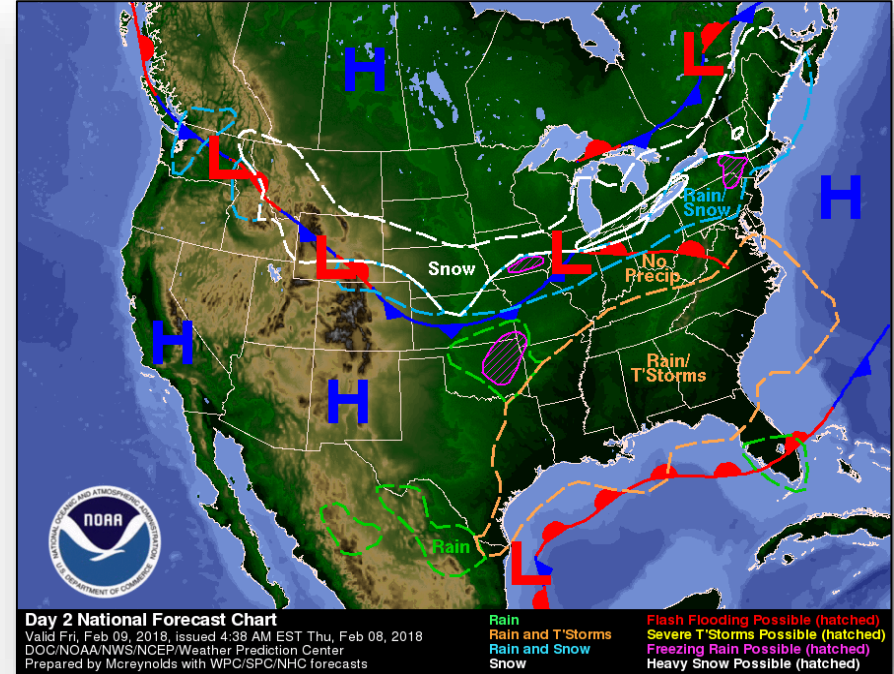
National Weather Forecast

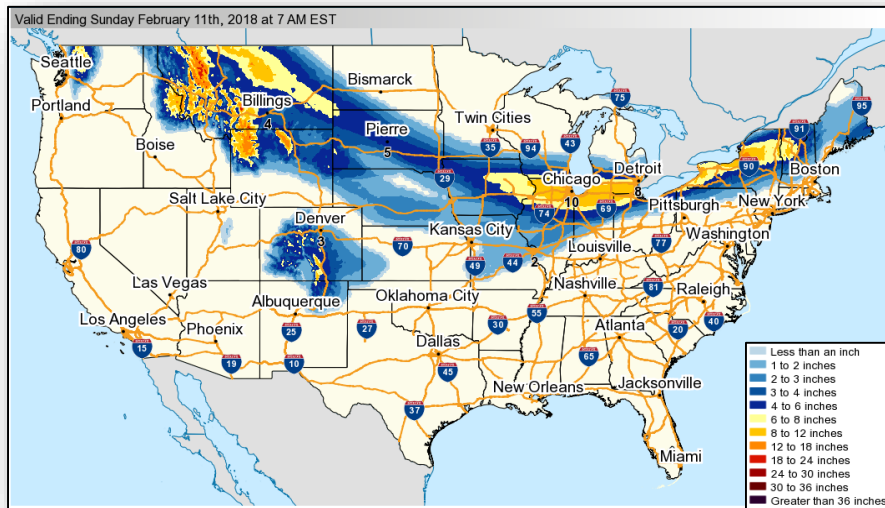


Tomorrow

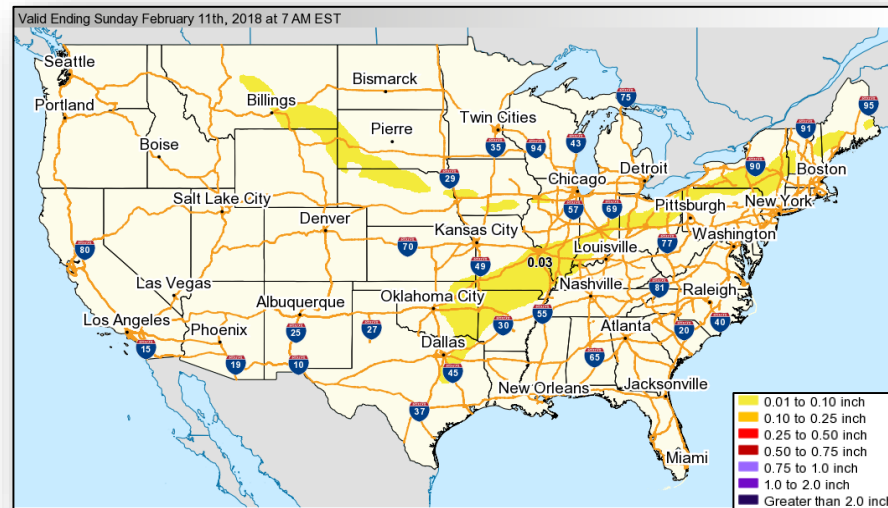
Winter Precipitation Outlook

Forecast Snowfall

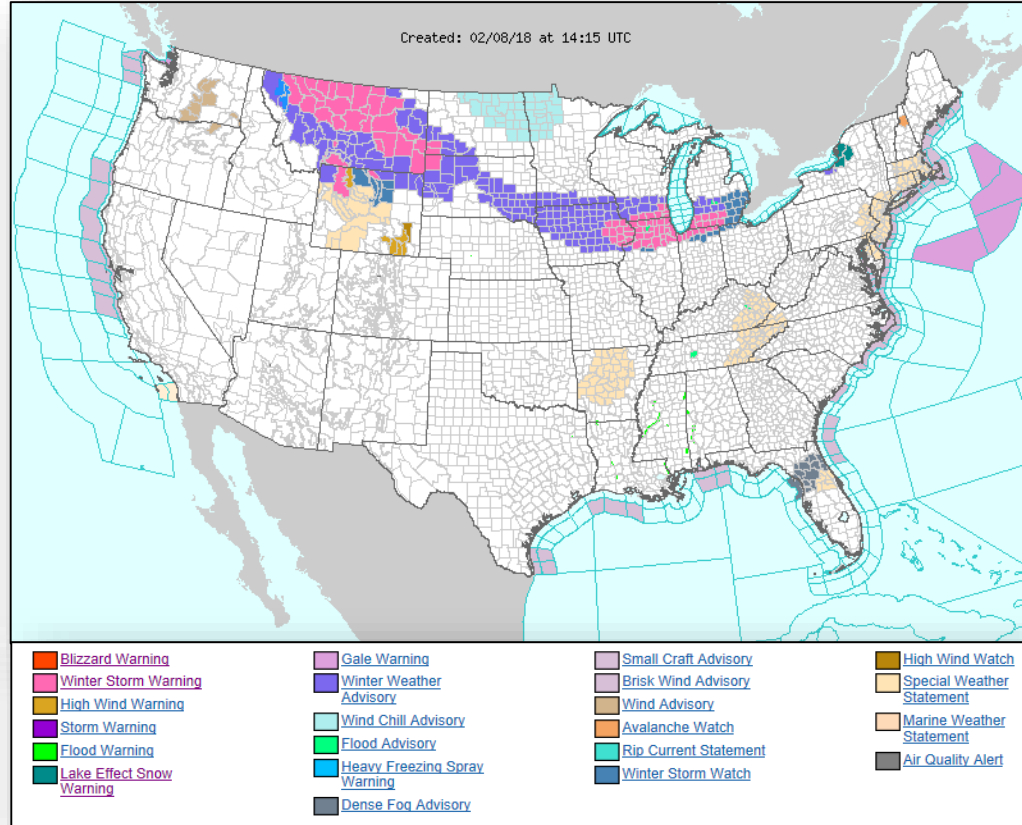


Forecast Ice Accumulation

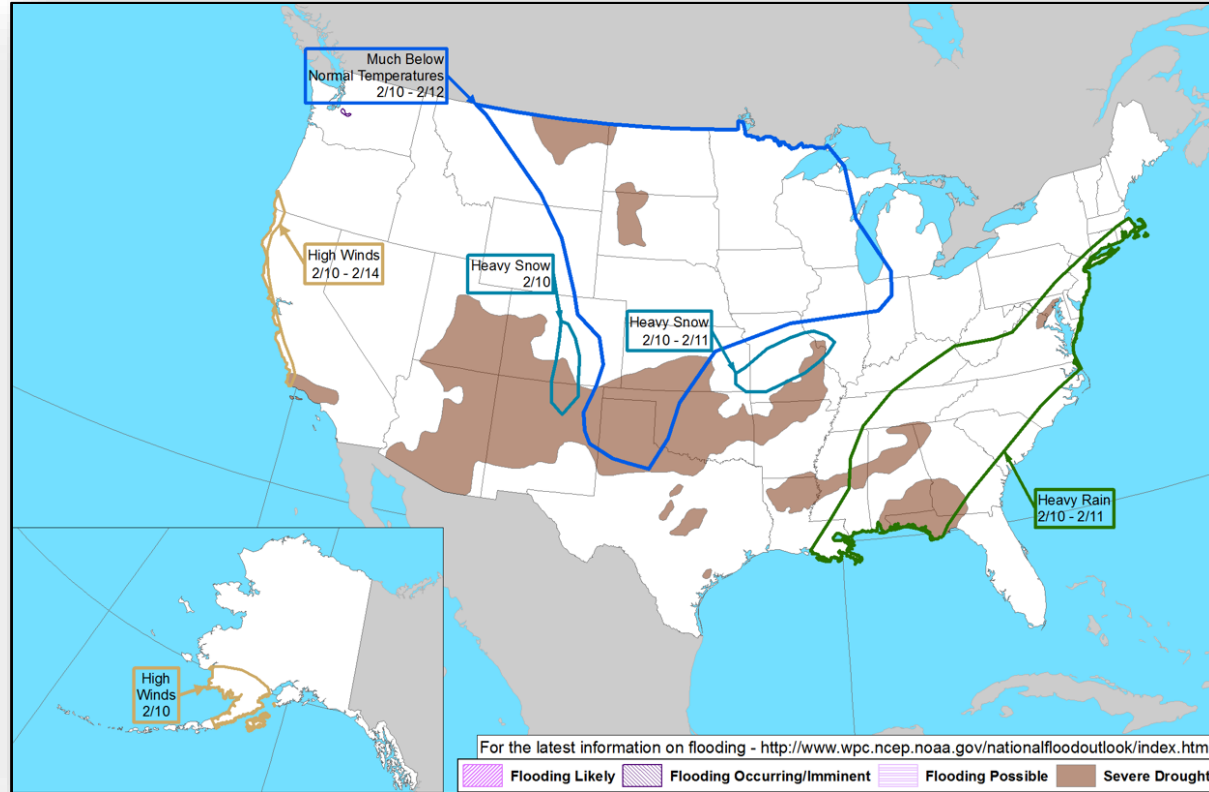

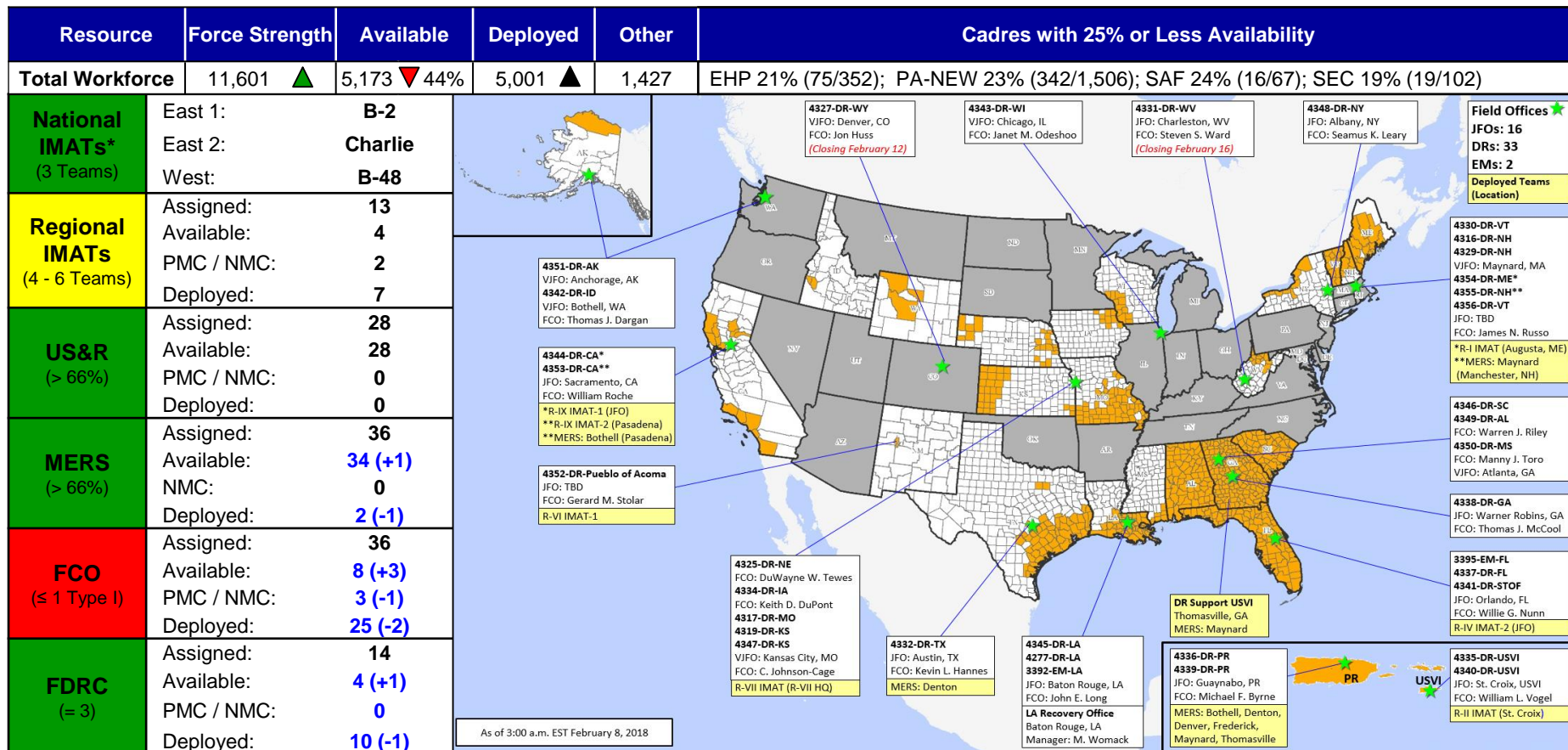
