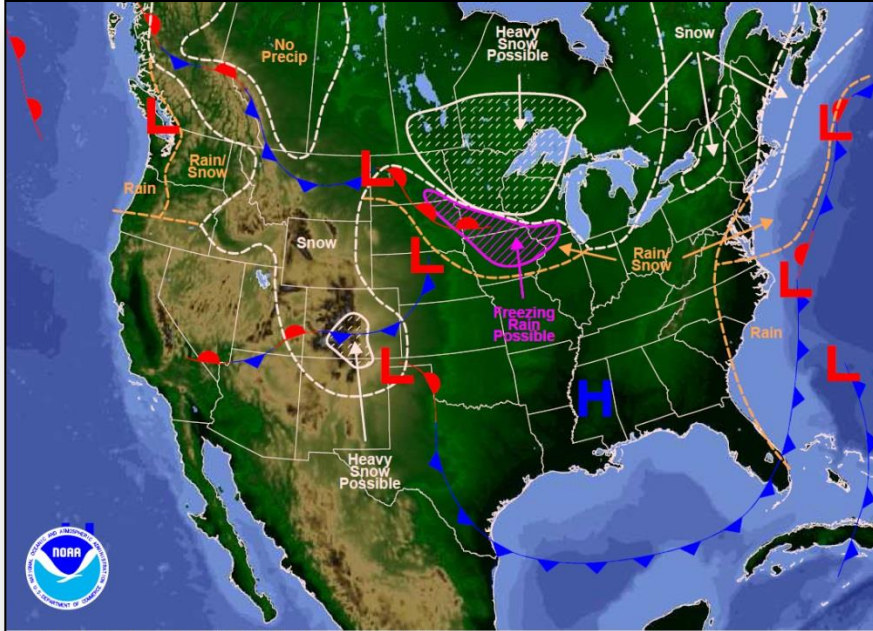

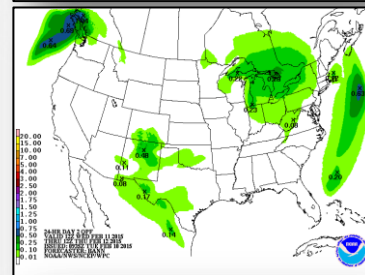
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day



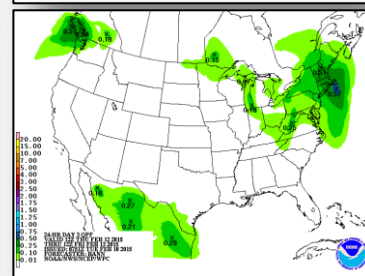

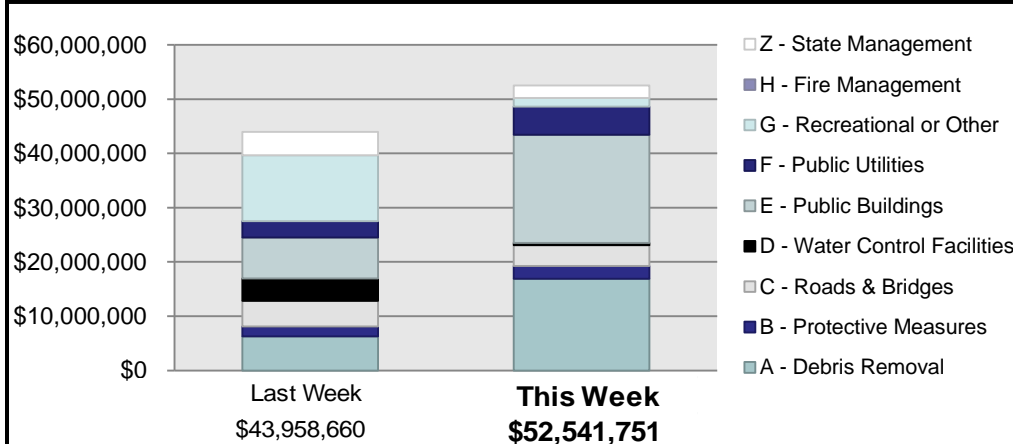

Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 1/26/2015 through 2/9/2015



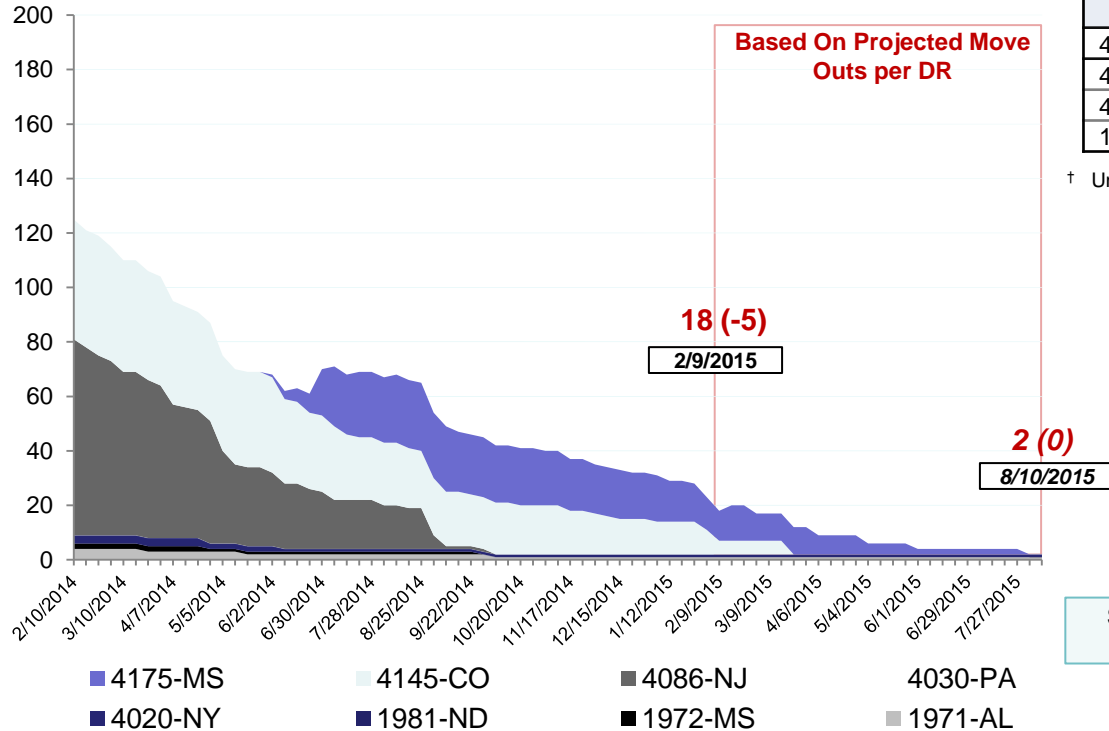
PA Highlights

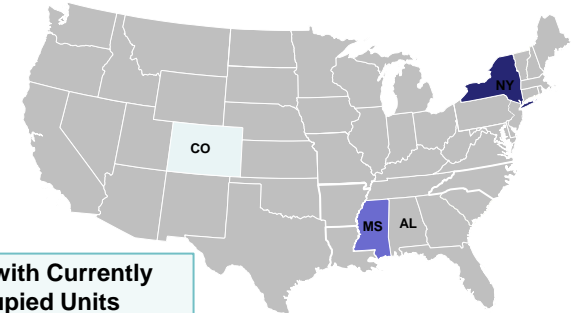


**Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State

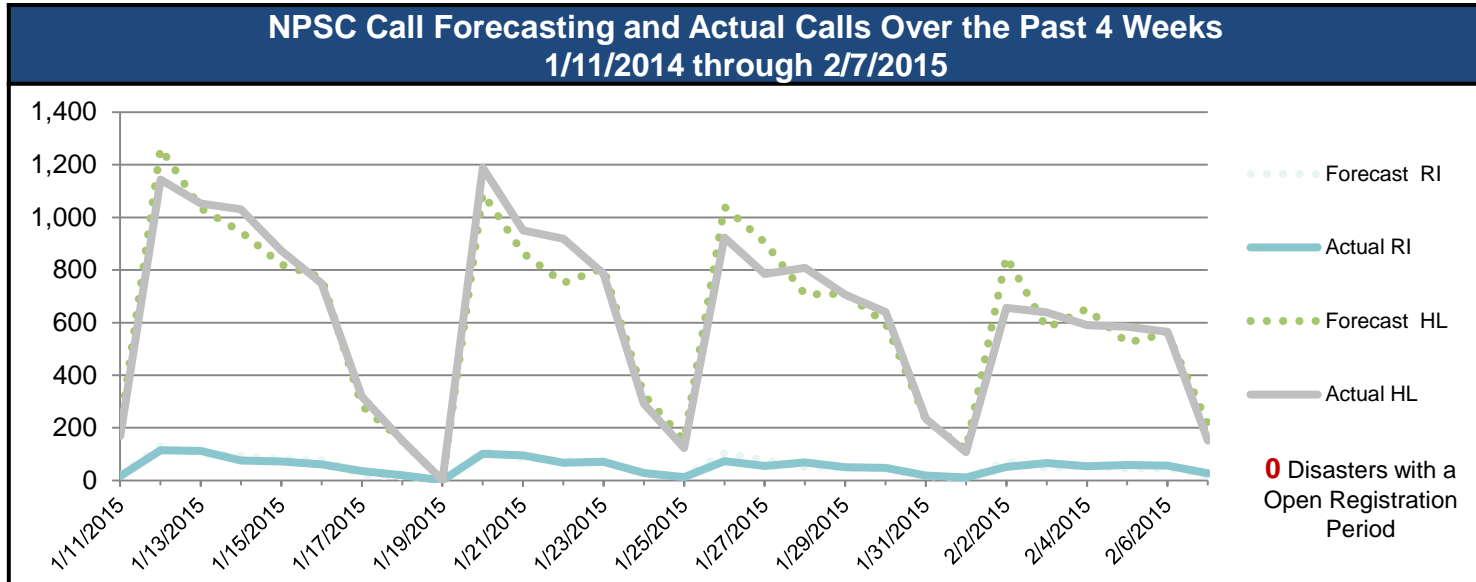

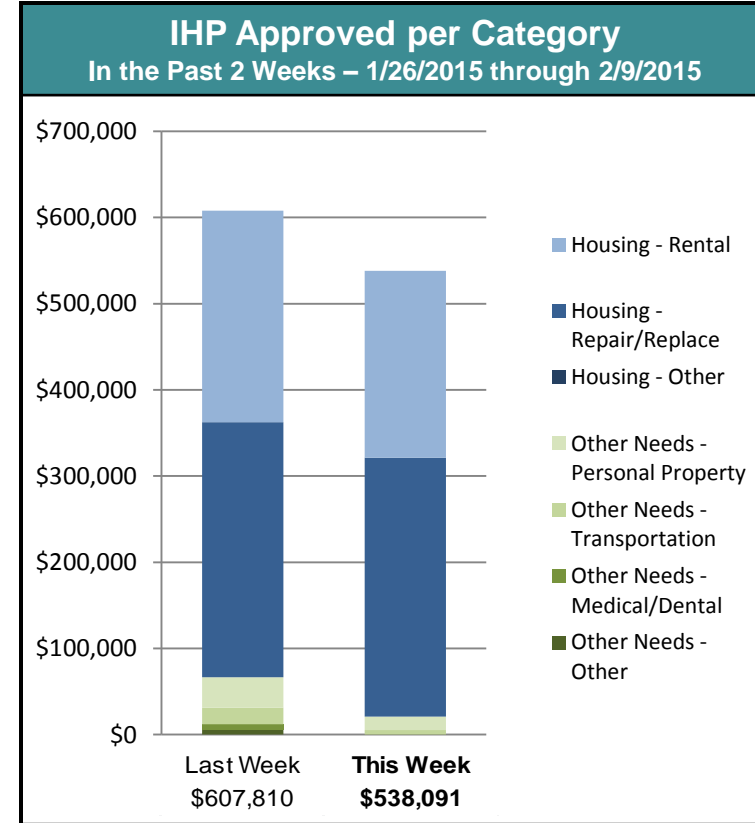
