







Total Forecast Snowfall




Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day





- FCO is William J. Doran III







COUNTY DESIGNATIONS









- IA & DSA are providing excellent support and outreach to survivors throughout affected areas.
- Anticipate that a significant shortfall in trained PA staff (specialists and managers) will continue to affect program delivery.
- Efforts to employ site inspectors and remote writers in 4238 have yielded less than expected; looking for alternate solutions.
