## **FEMA Daily Ops Brief for March 2, 2017**

### **Significant Events:**

- Severe Weather – Midwest to East Coast (Final)
- FEMA Region III Thunderbolt Exercise – ERG to COOP (one day only)

### **Significant Weather:**

- Heavy Snow – WA
- Snow – Pacific Northwest to Great Lakes,
- Elevated/Critical fire weather areas – TX, OK, KS, and NE
- Space Weather: Past 24 hours – Moderate with Geomagnetic storms reaching G2 have occurred; next 24 hours – Minor with G1 Geomagnetic Storms predicted

**Tropical Activity:** No activity affecting U.S. interests

**Earthquake Activity:** No significant activity

# Severe Weather – Eastern U.S. (Final)



**Summary:** Multiple tornado touchdowns, damaging straight-line winds and hail impacted the Midwest to the Mid-Atlantic February 28 – March 1. System continued to move east/northeast overnight with less severe activity. 26 preliminary tornadoes reported, the majority in rural areas with only minor damage with more significant impacts reported in IL, IN, and MO.

## Impacts

### Illinois:

- 2 fatalities and 10 injuries confirmed; 13 homes destroyed and dozens damaged, including a nursing home
- LaSalle (pop.112k) and Jackson (pop. 60k) counties sustained heavy damage; assessments are ongoing

### Missouri:

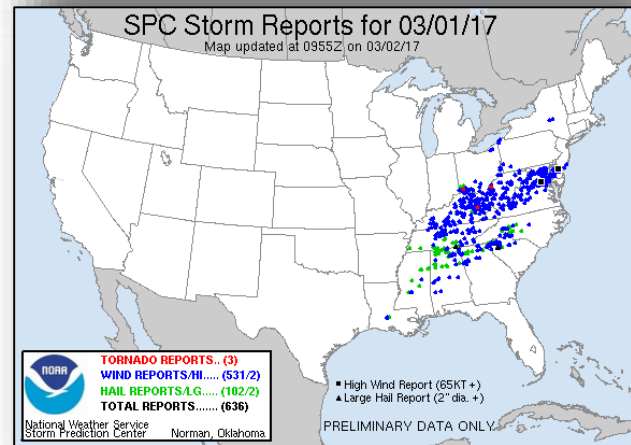
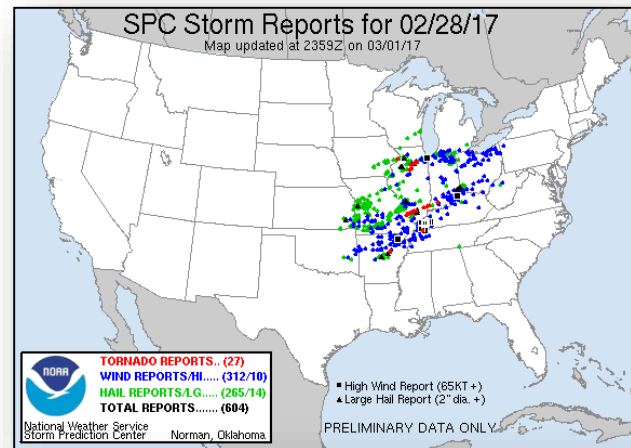
- 1 fatality and 10 injuries
- 25-30 homes damaged

### Indiana:

- No fatalities or injuries reported
- 12 homes destroyed, others with minor damage

## Response

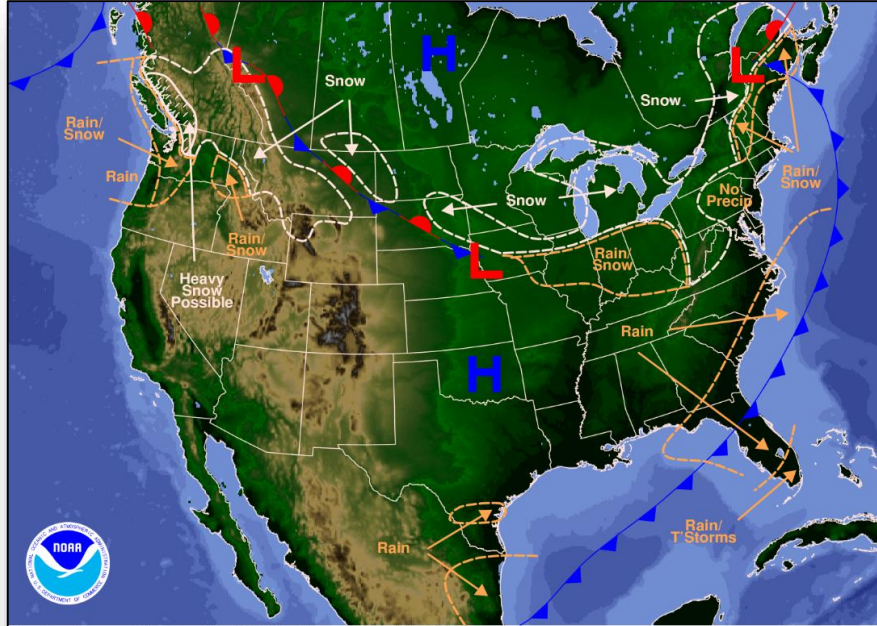
- IL EOC remains at Partial Activation

# National Weather Forecast

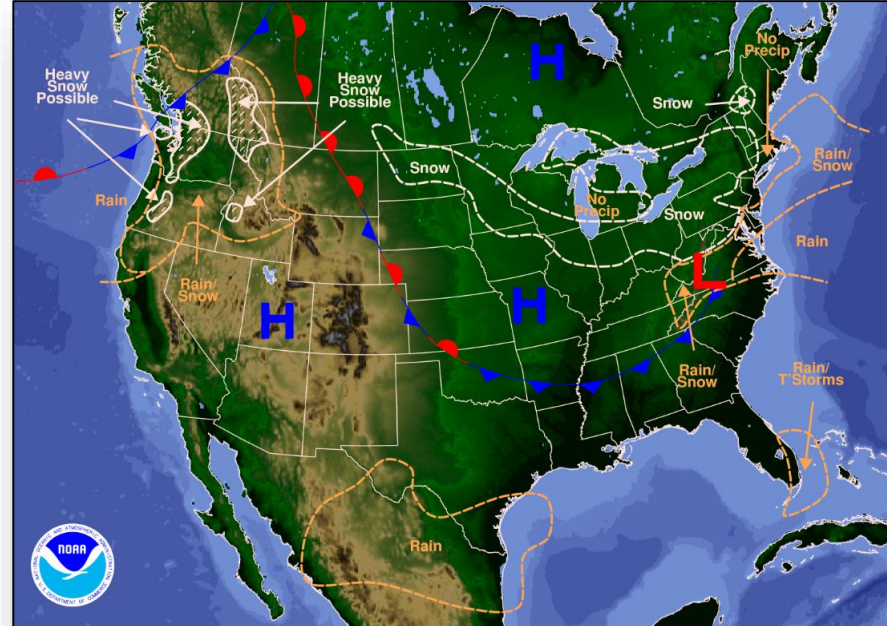

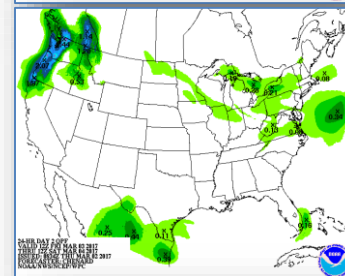
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



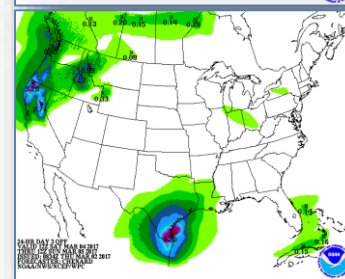

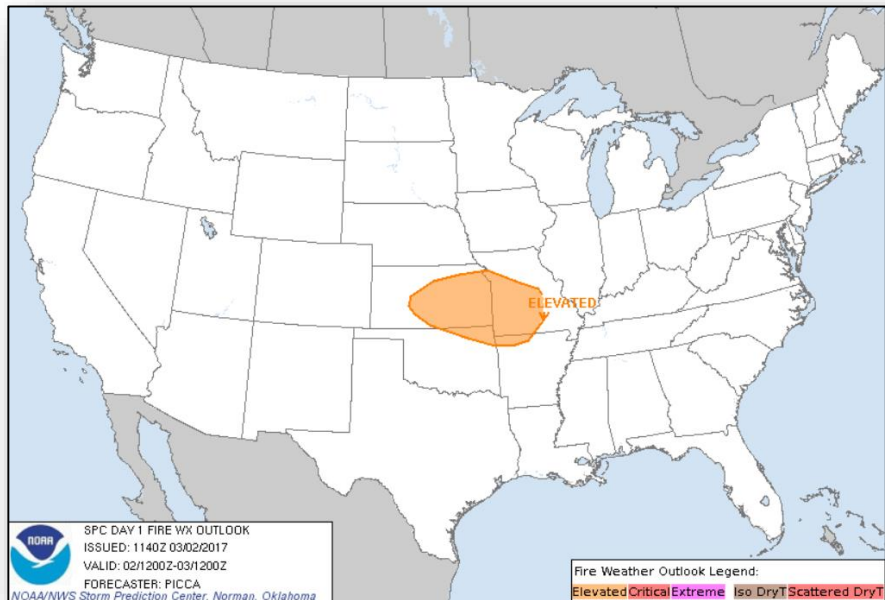

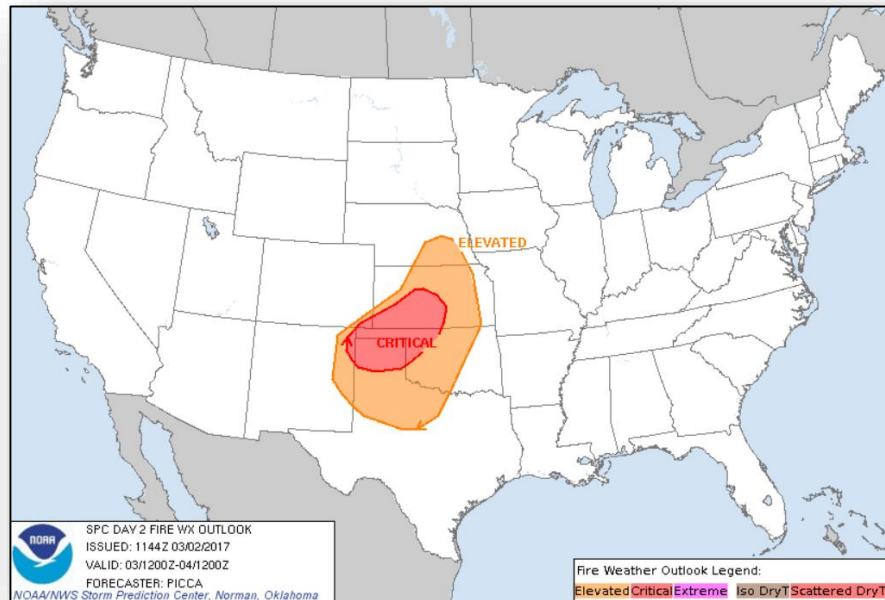
# Fire Weather Outlook

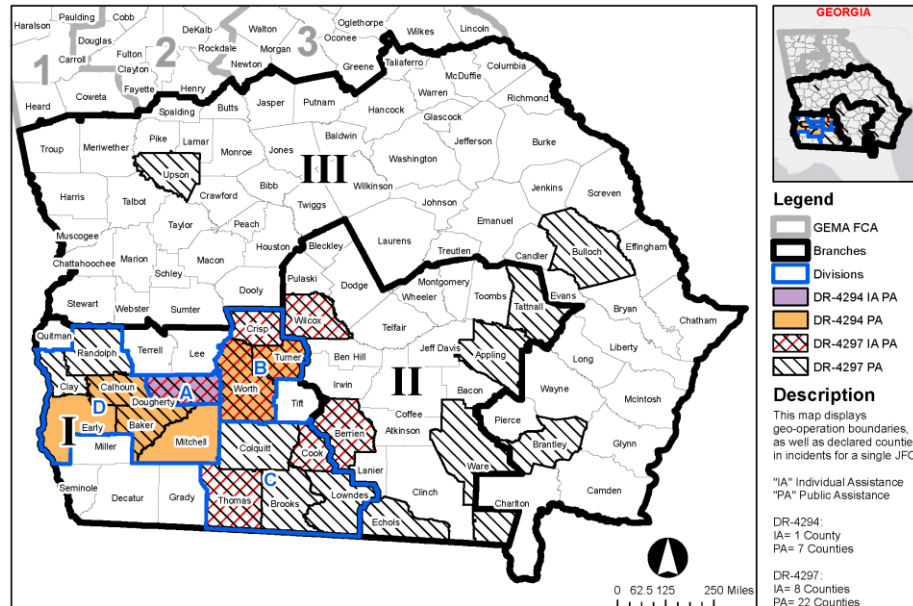

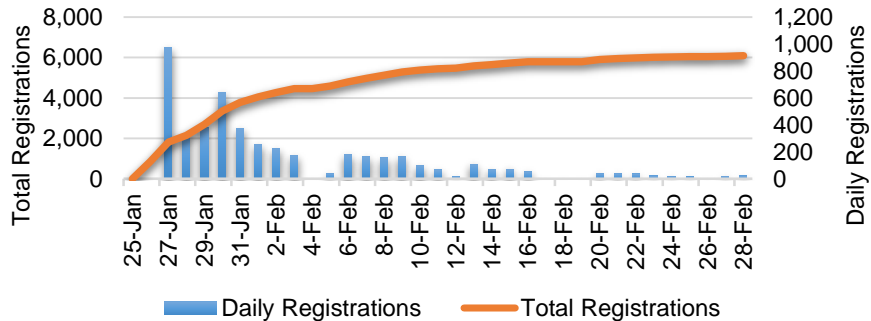

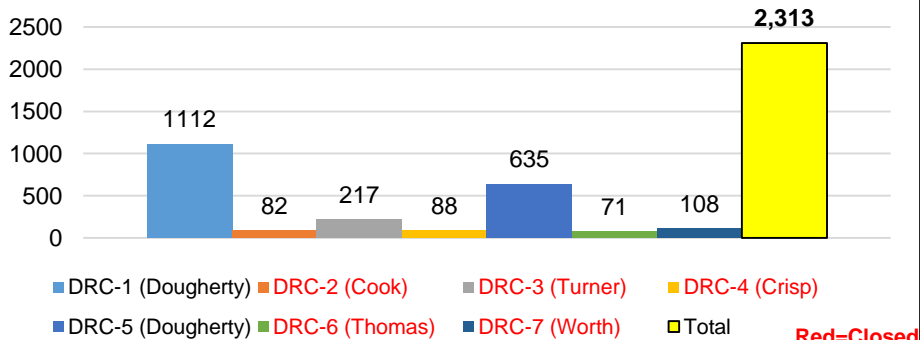

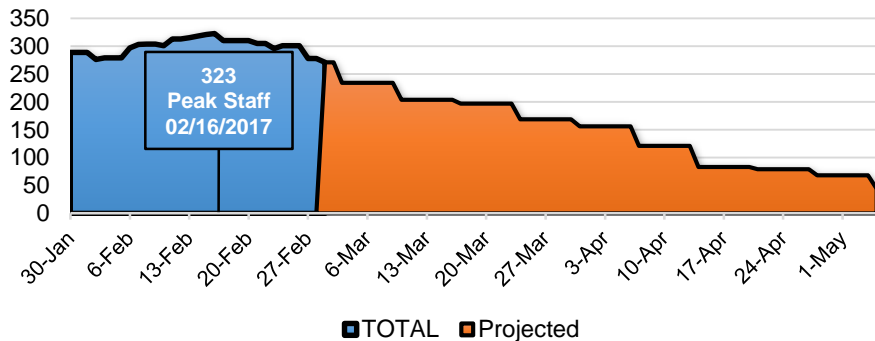

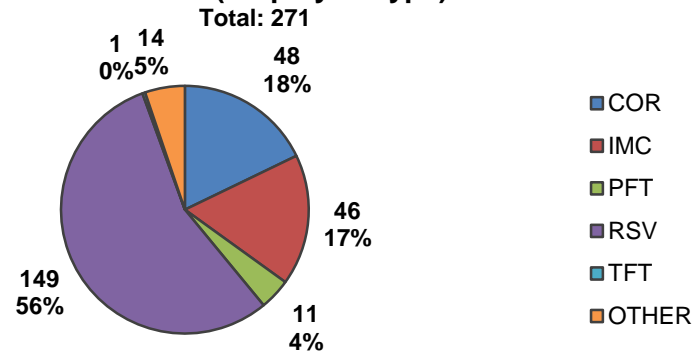


### Finance/Administration (As of 03/01/2017)

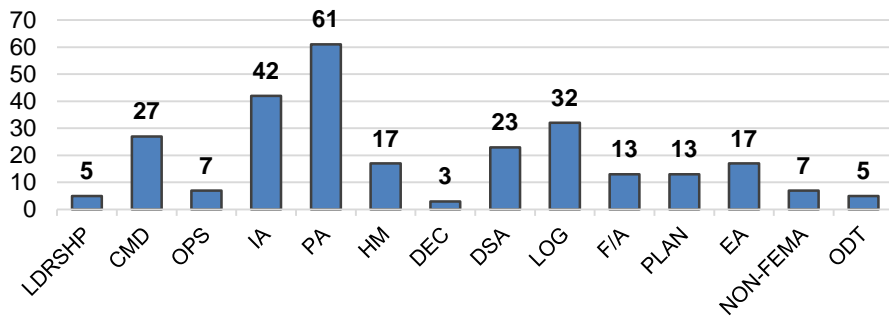


Workforce (Employee Type)



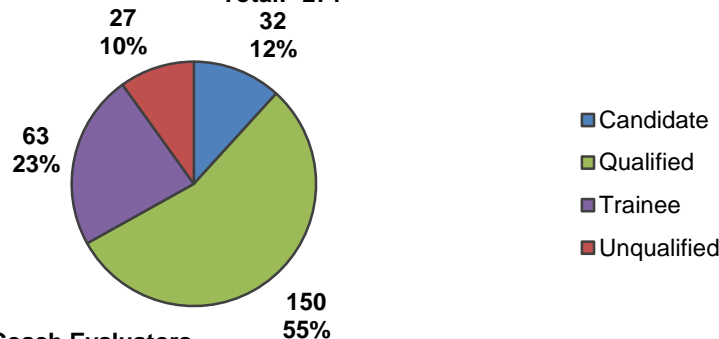
Workforce (Program Area)

### Accomplishments/Challenges

- N-IMAT West arrived Pre-Declaration – Demobilizing 03/03/2017
- DSA presence in impacted counties within 24 hours
- IA Mission to transition to R-IV 03/31/2017
- Proactive Hazard Mitigation Community Education & Outreach (CEO) within impacted counties
- Expanded the rollout of the new PA Delivery Model to manage multiple incidents
  - On-going large effort of training to build the capacity/strengthen the bench to implement the new PA Delivery Model
  - JFO now working with Denton CRC on implementing the new PA Delivery Model in 3 events at varying stages
