# Precipitation Forecast



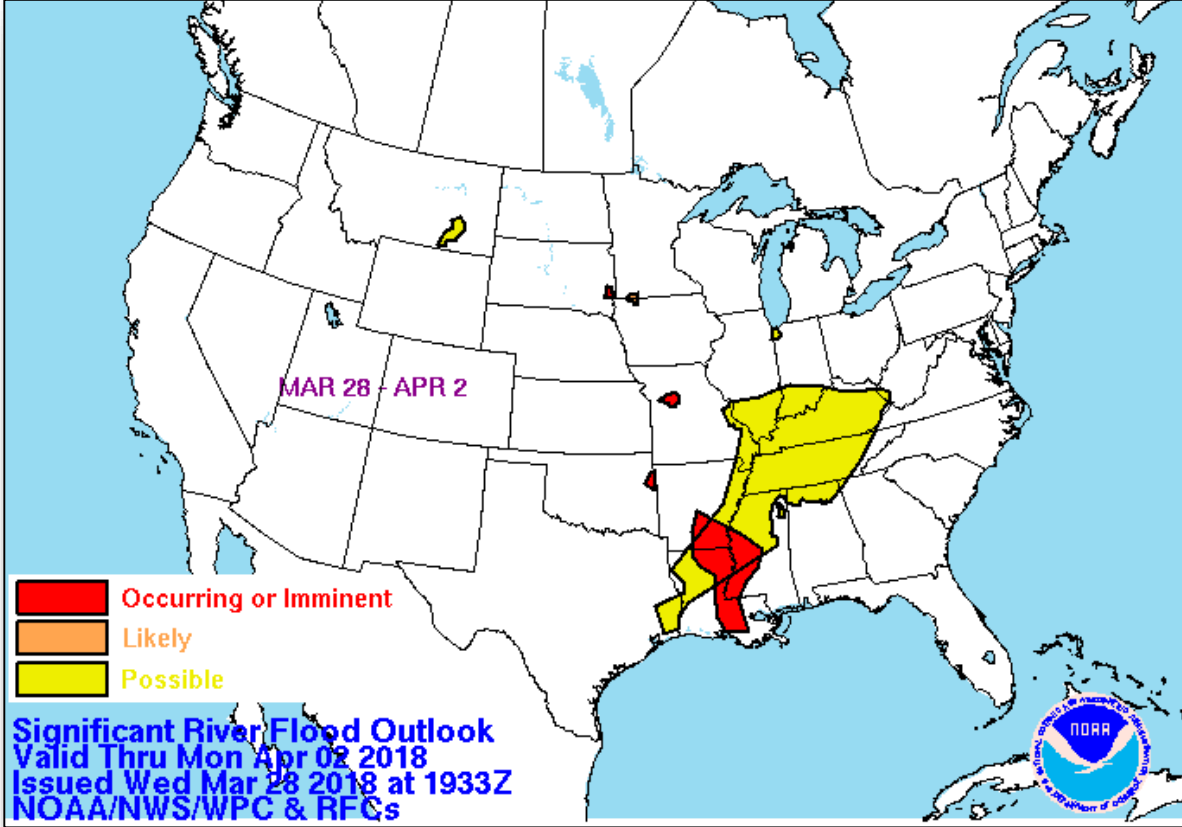

# Significant River Flood Outlook



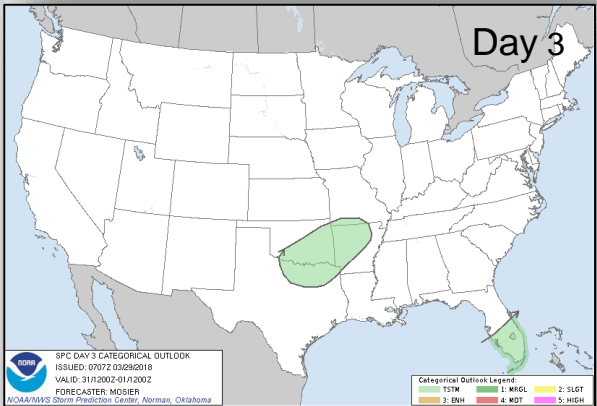
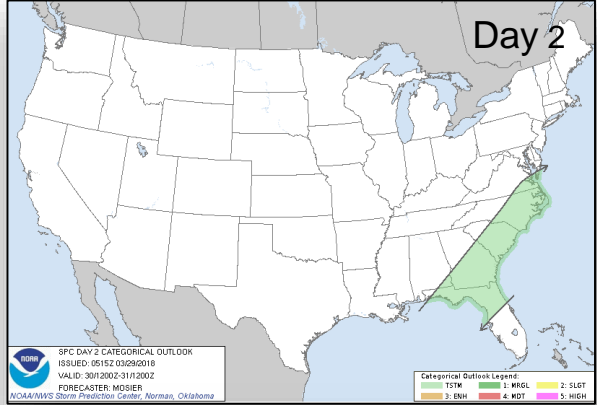
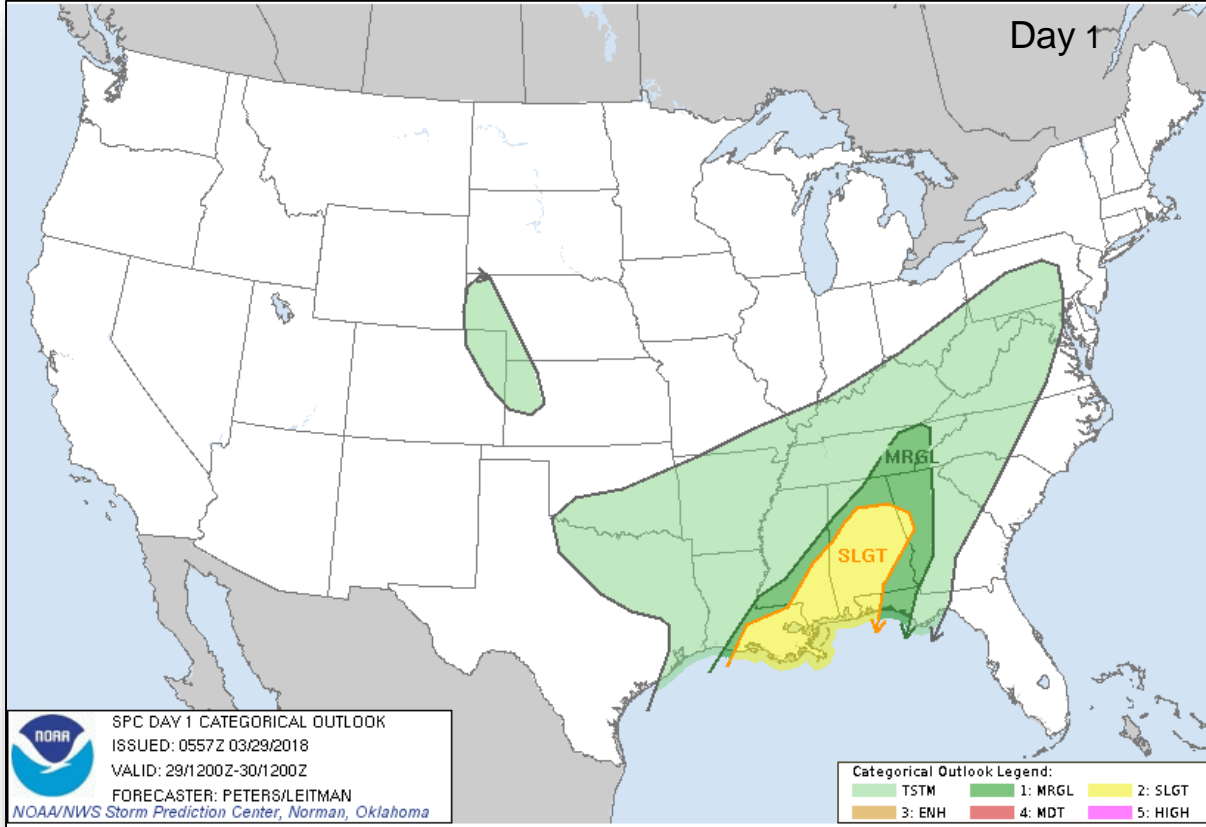

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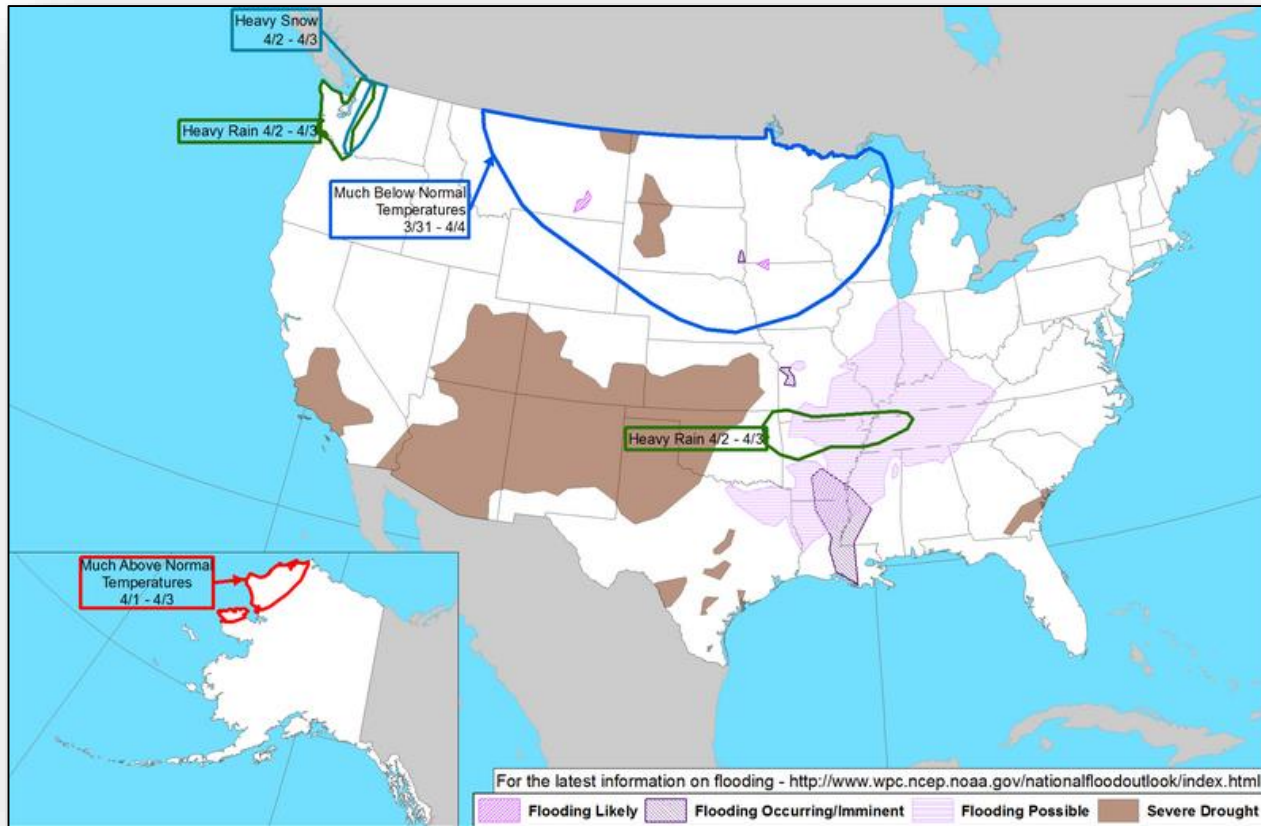




# Hazards Outlook – Mar 31 – Apr 4



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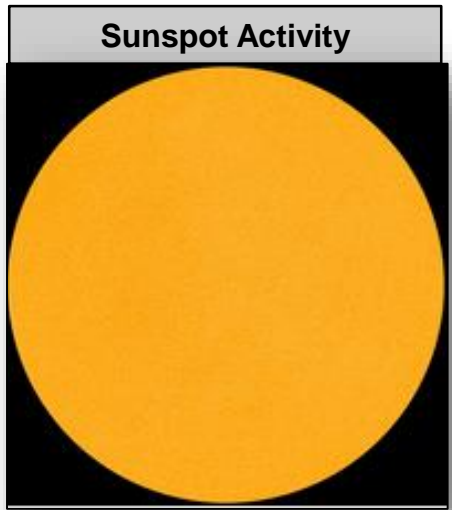
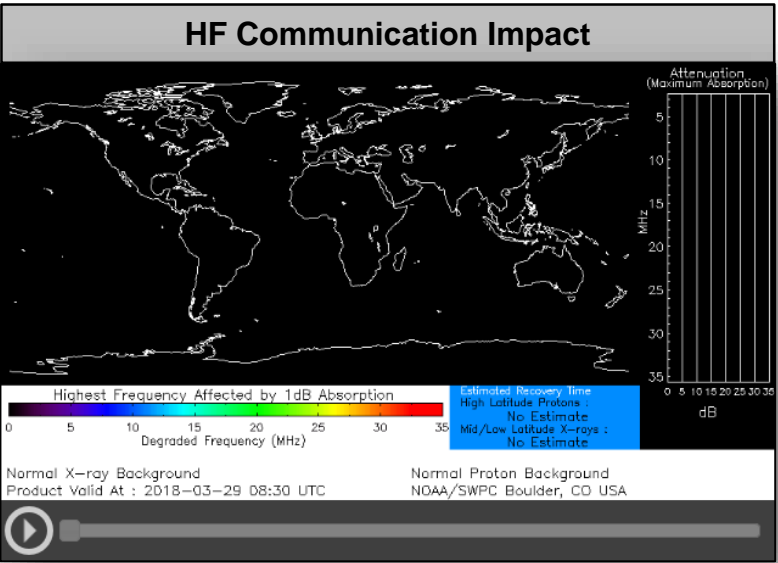
