Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3

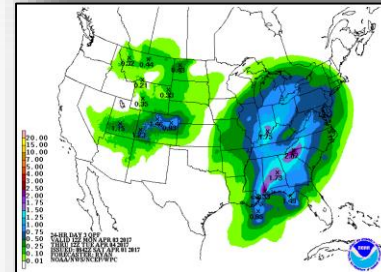
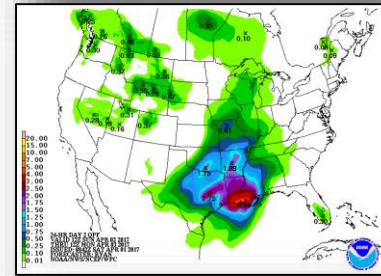
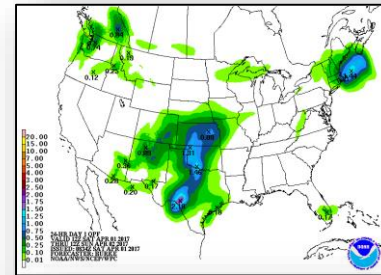
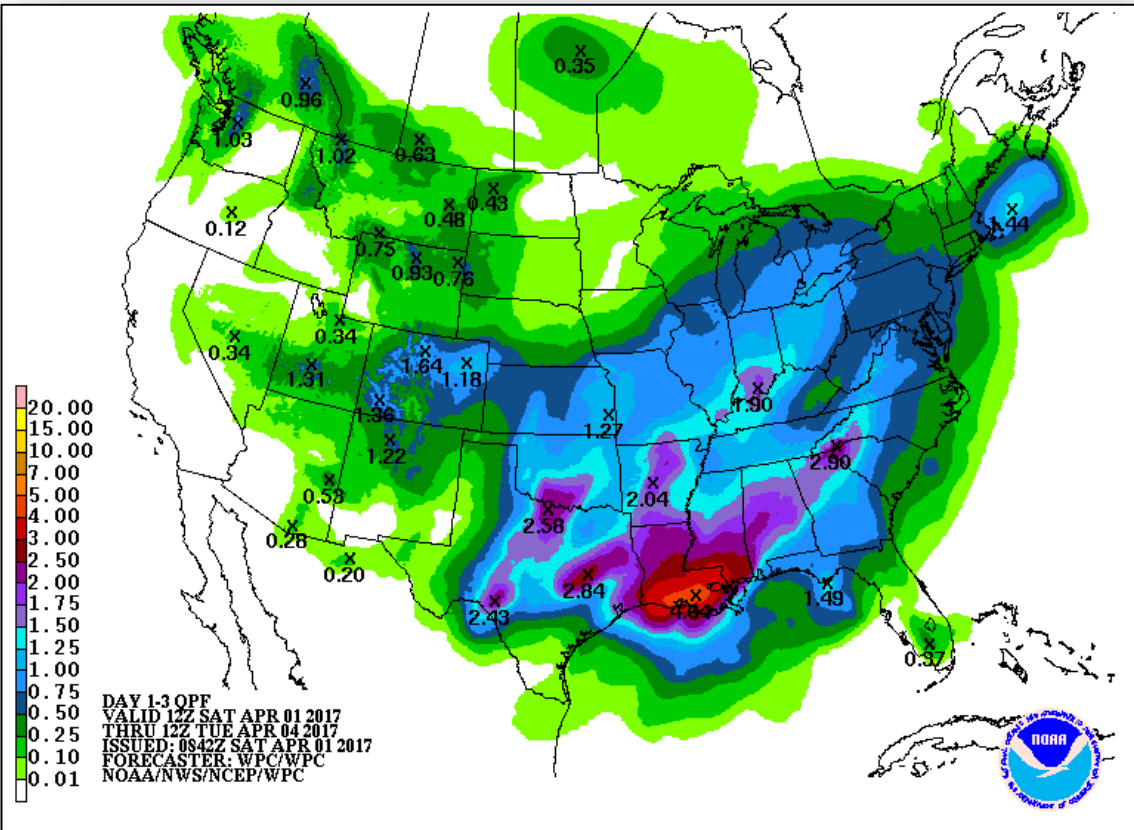

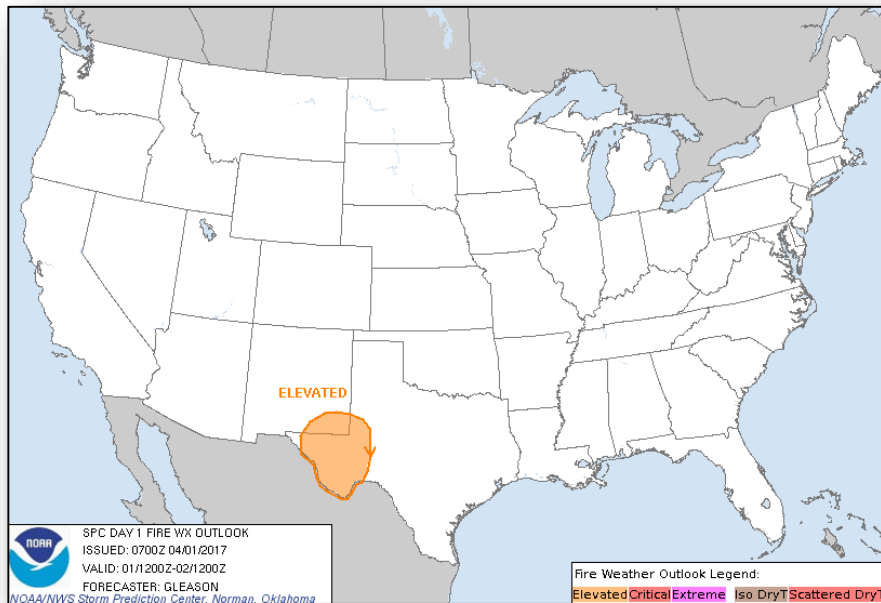
Snowfall Forecast



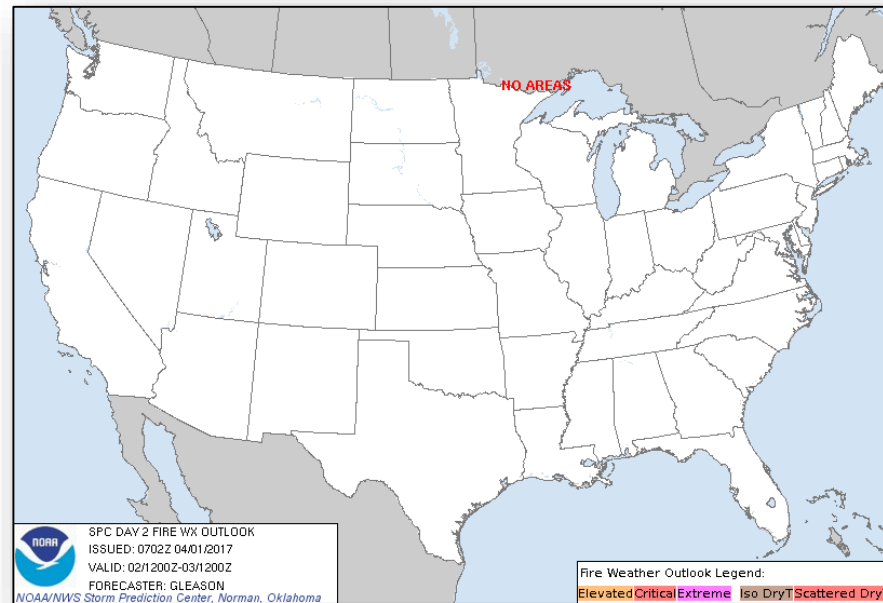

Idaho

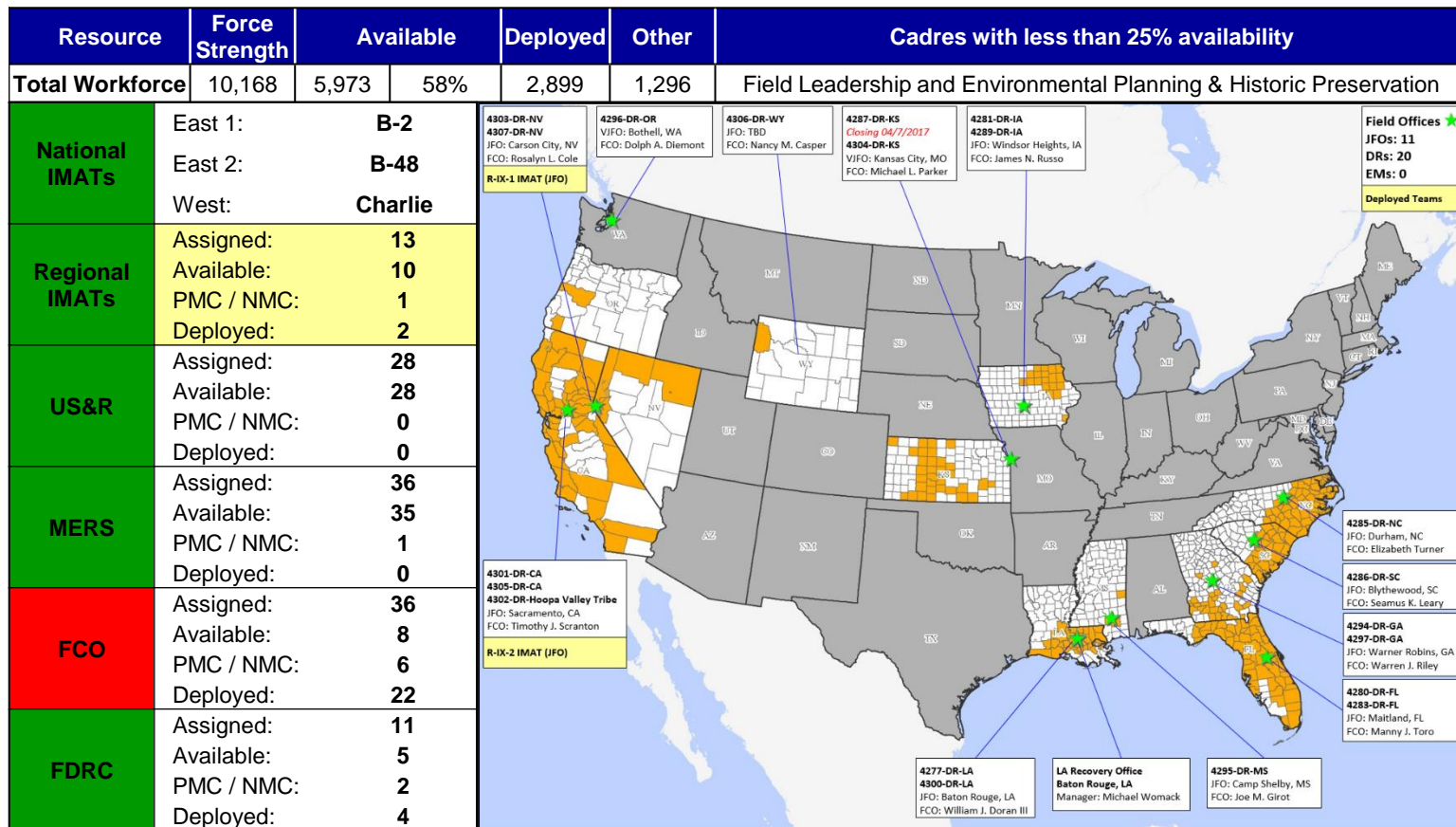
- Governor requested a Major Disaster Declaration on March 30, 2017 for the State of Idaho
