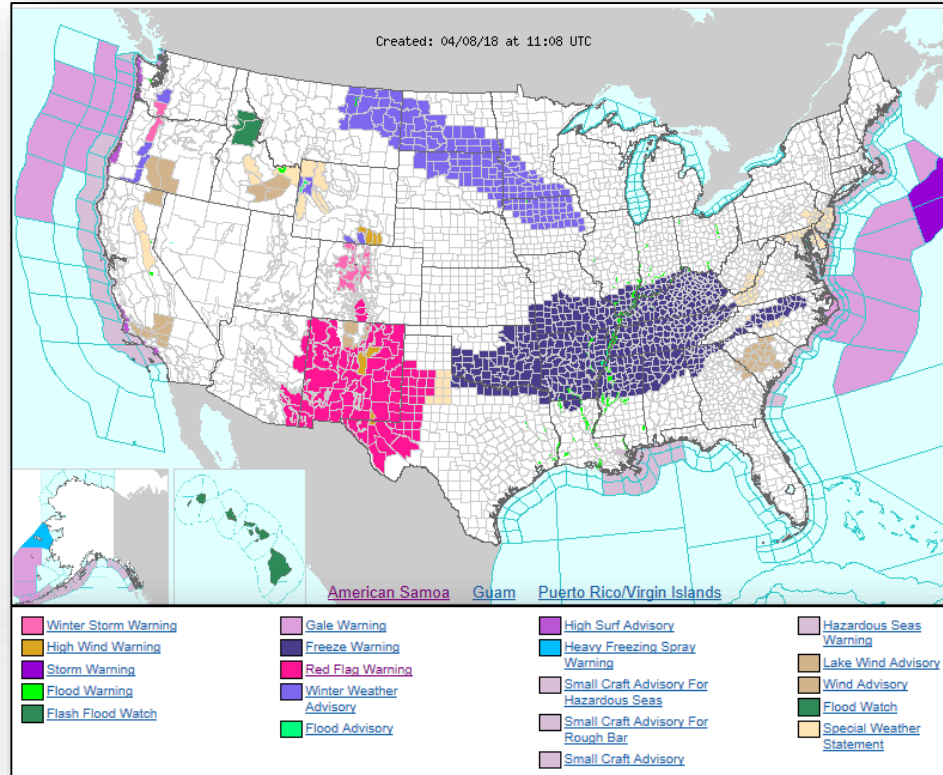

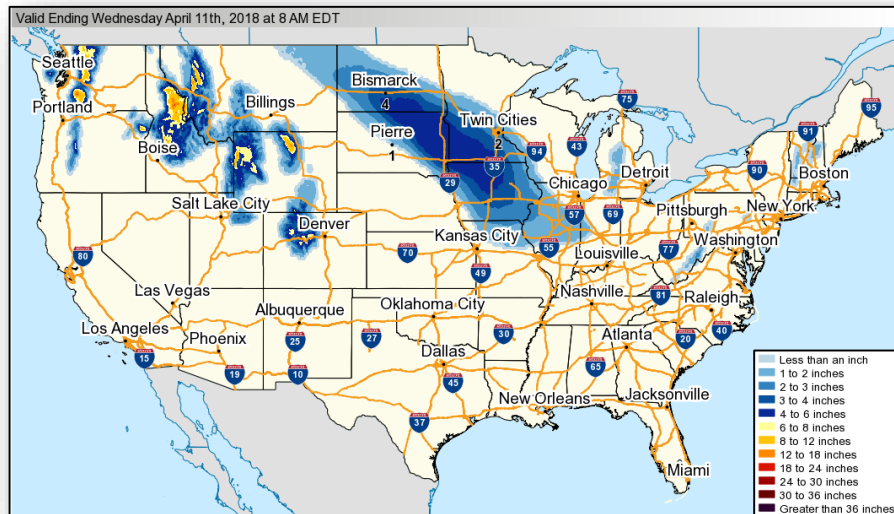

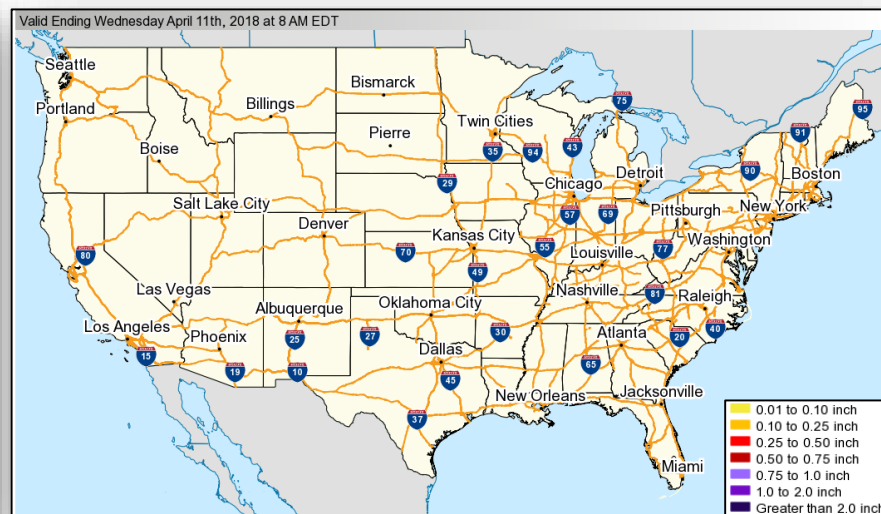
Winter Precipitation Outlook

Forecast Snowfall

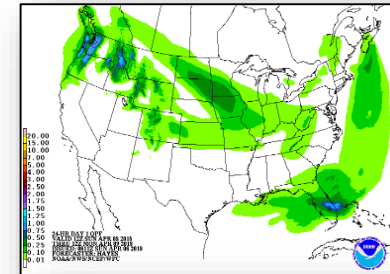
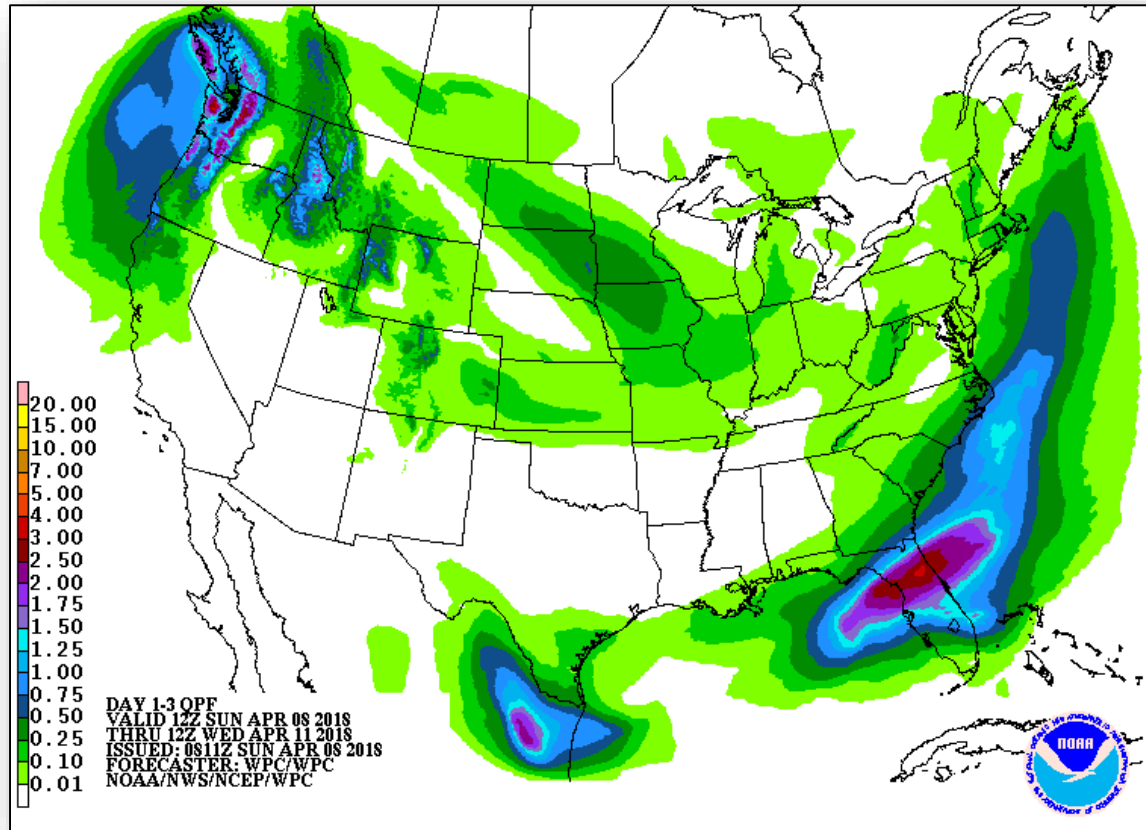


Forecast Ice Accumulation

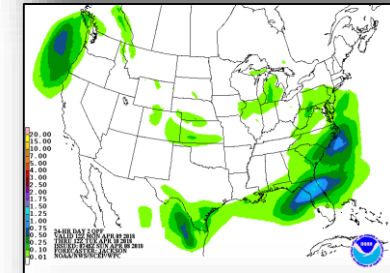
Precipitation Forecast



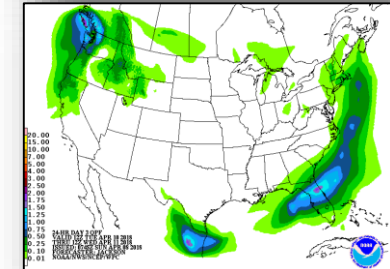

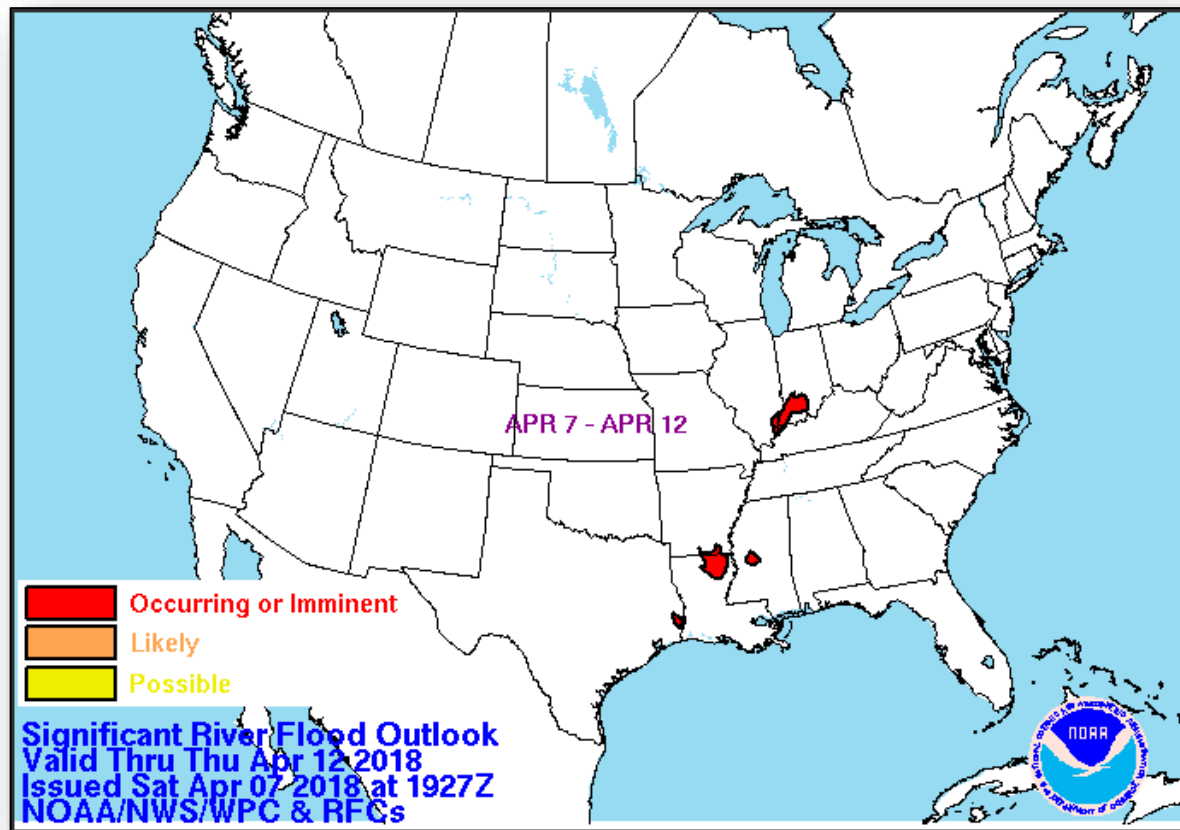

Significant River Flood Outlook



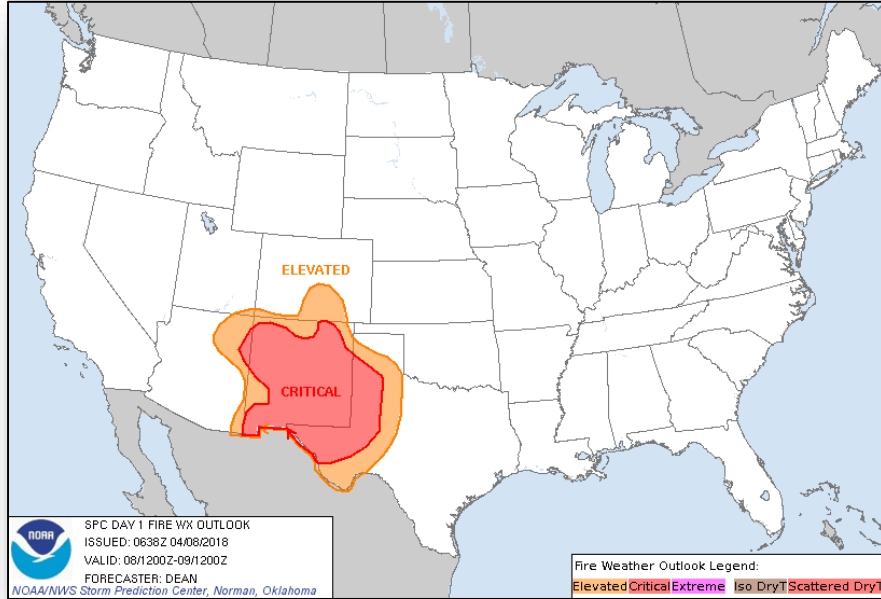

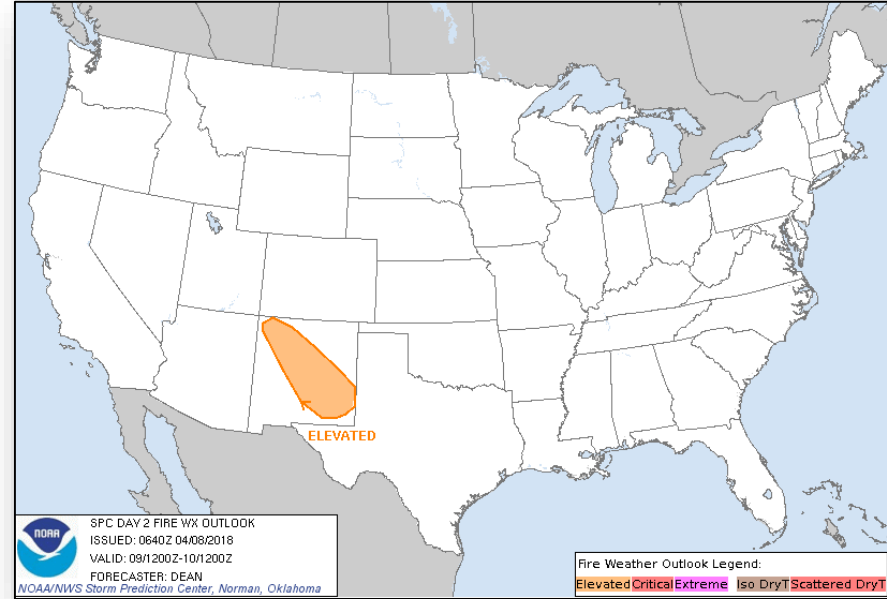
Fire Weather Outlook

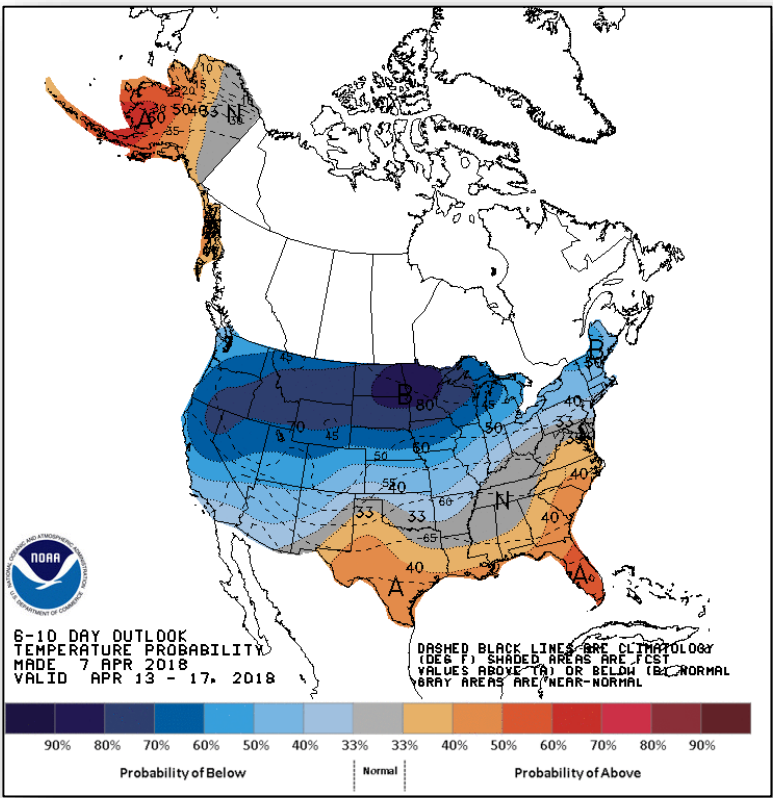

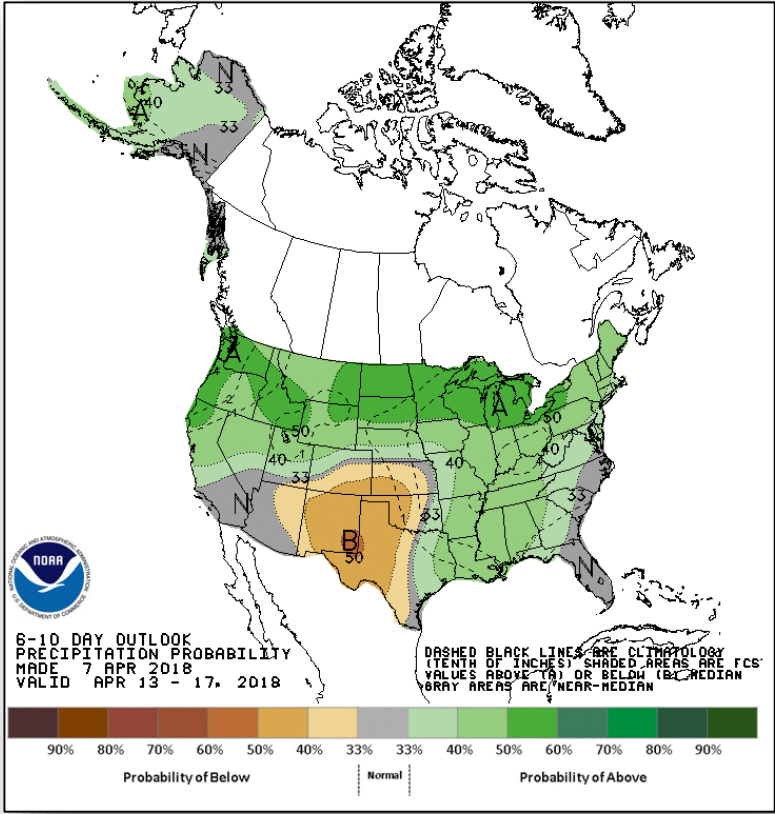

6-10 Day Temperature Probability



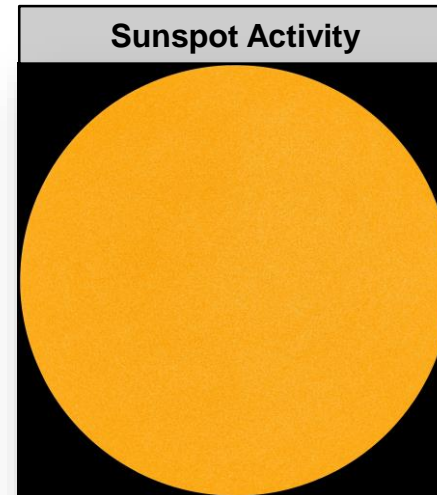
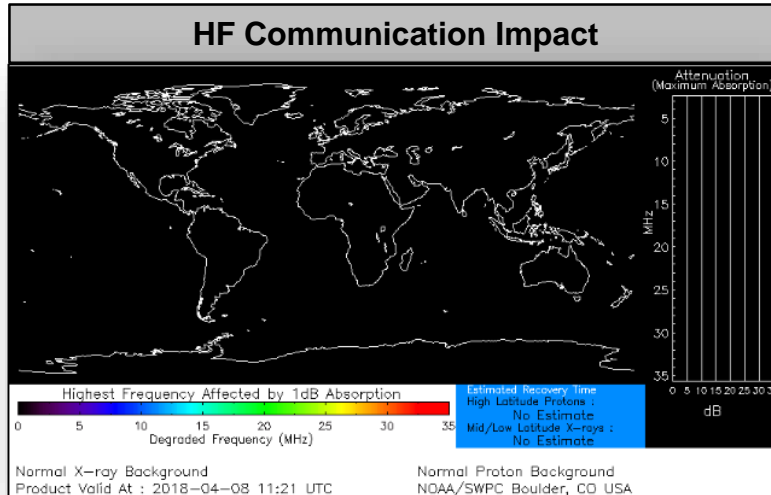
6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
