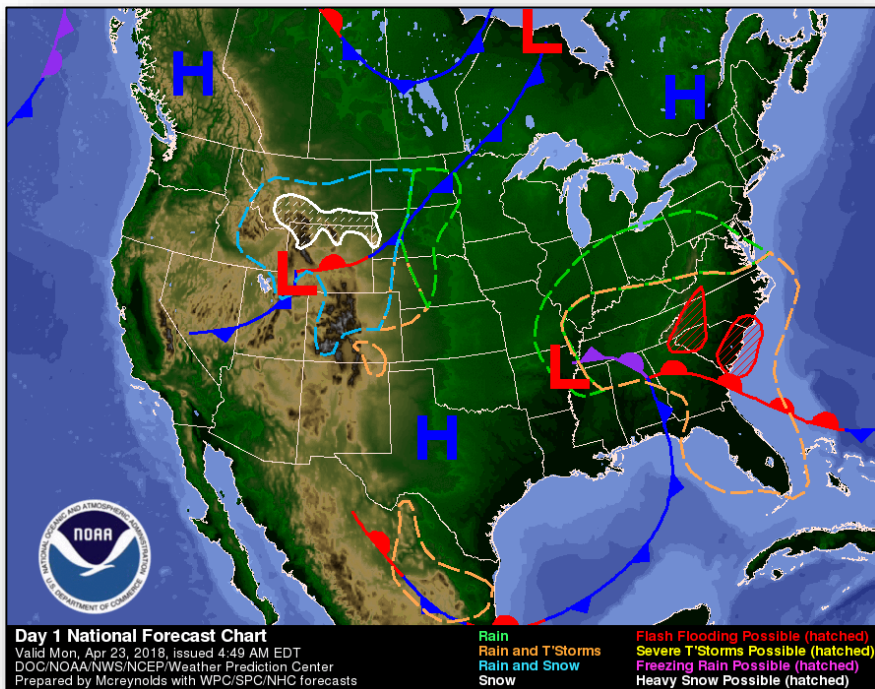

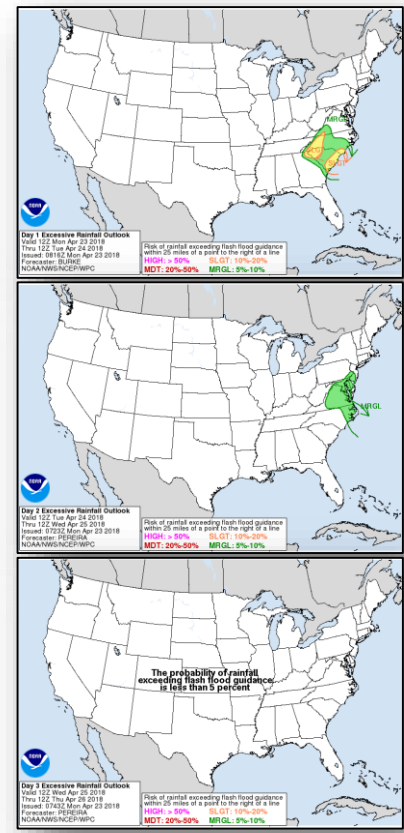
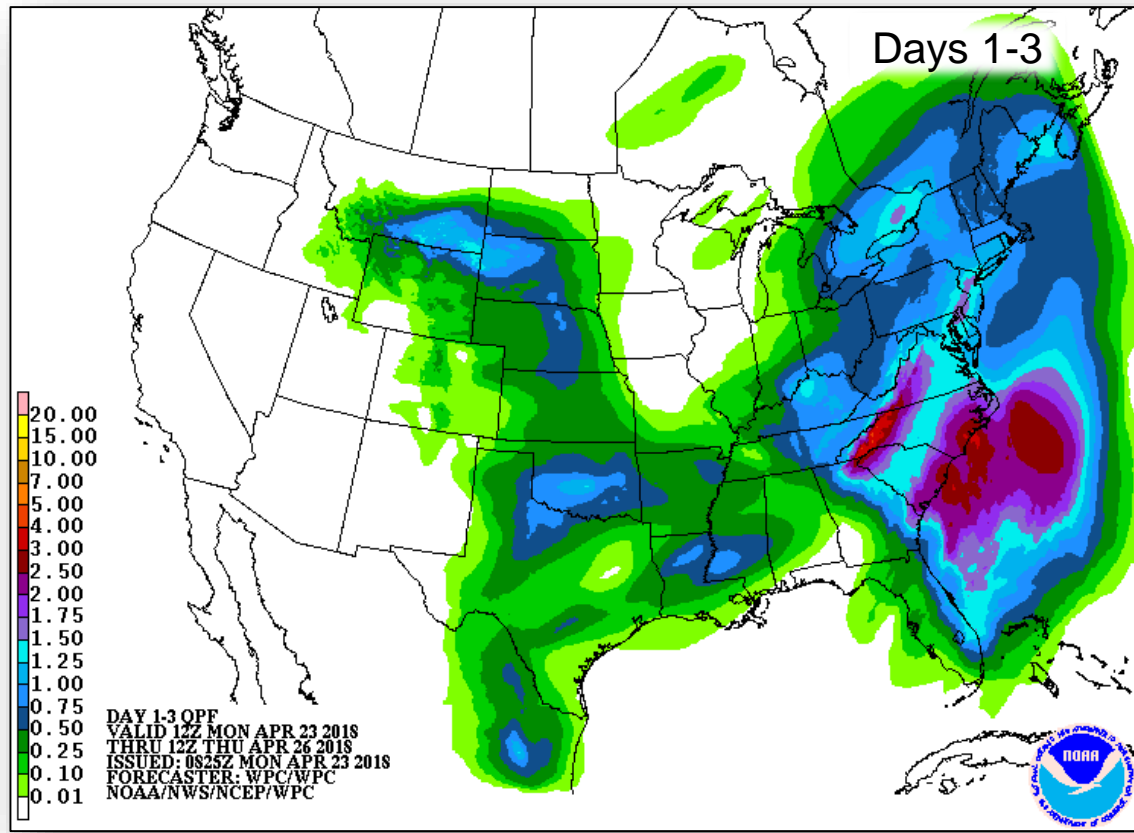
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Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



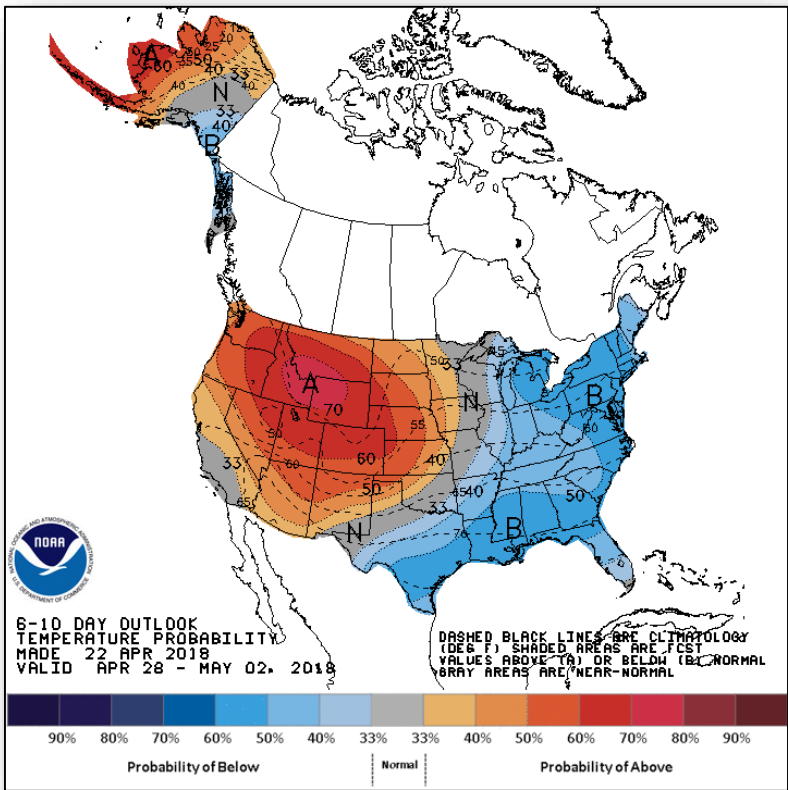
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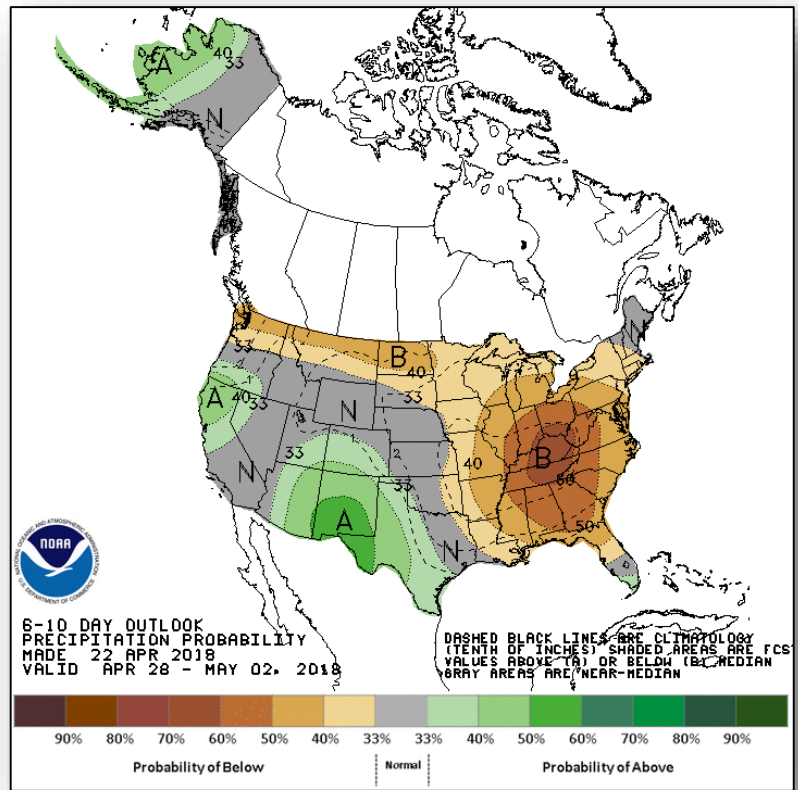
6-10 Day Outlooks

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

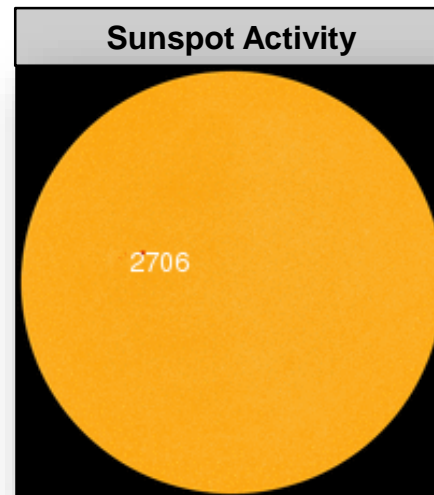
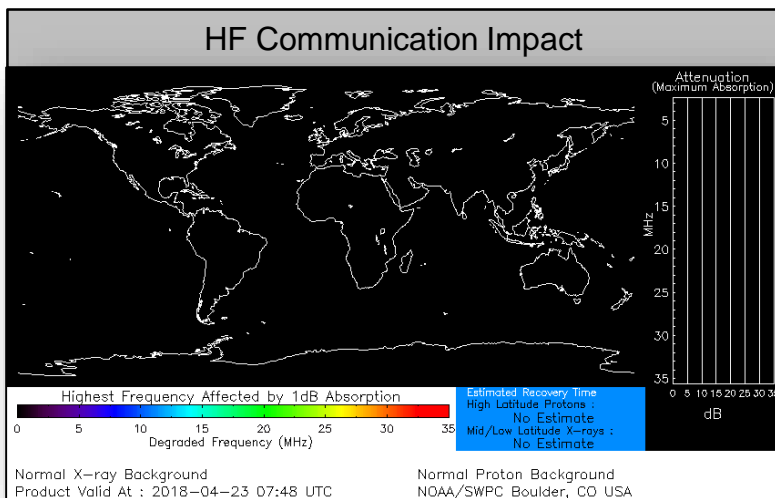
