 - Next 24 hours: None predicted

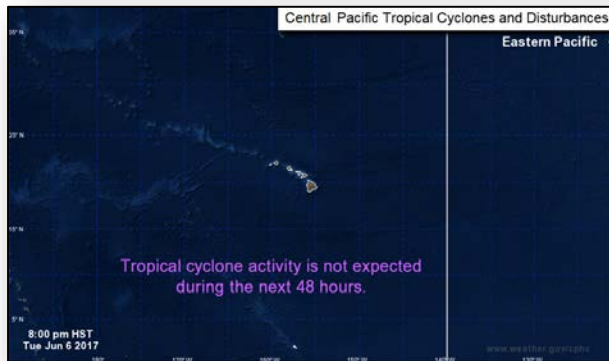

Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



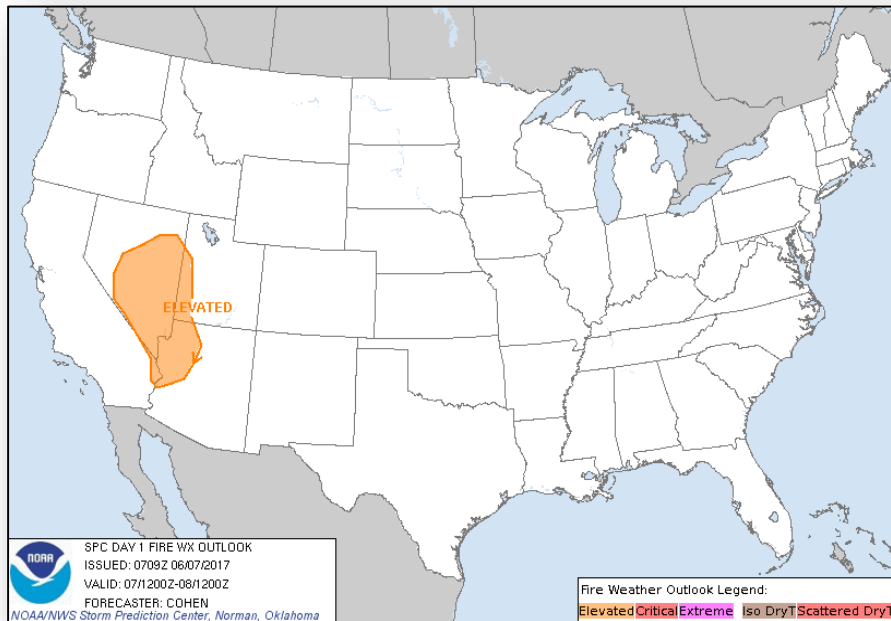
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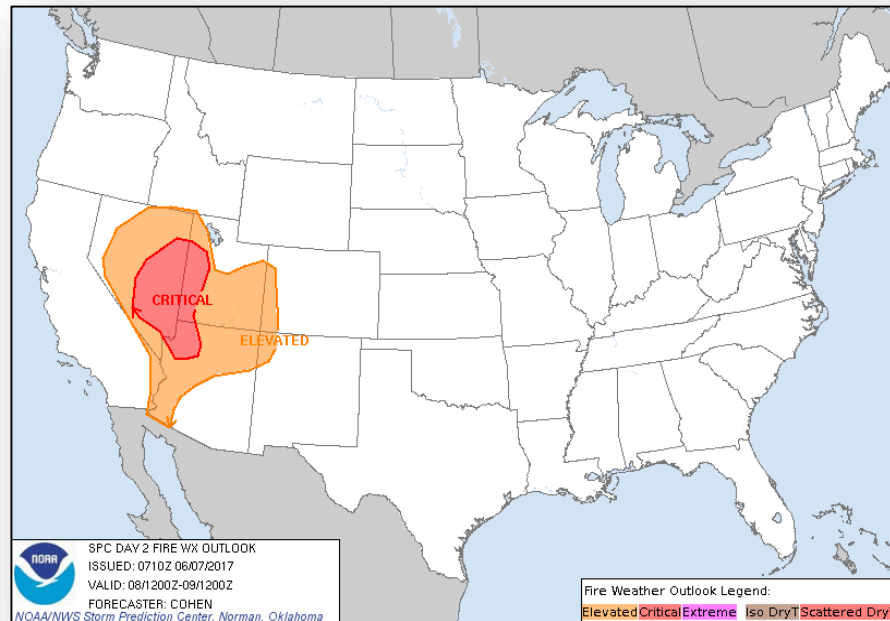
Fire Weather Outlook

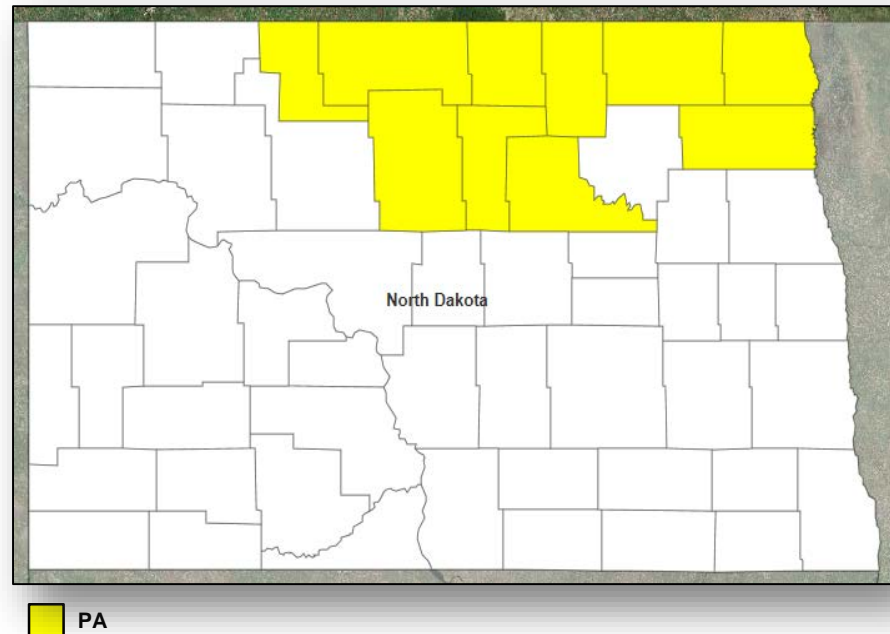
Declaration Request



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North Dakota

- Governor requested a Major Disaster Declaration on June 5, 2017
- For flooding that occurred February 17 – April 29, 2017
- Requesting:
 - Public Assistance for 10 counties and 1 Tribe*
 - Hazard Mitigation statewide



* The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Reservation falls wholly within the boundary of Rolette County

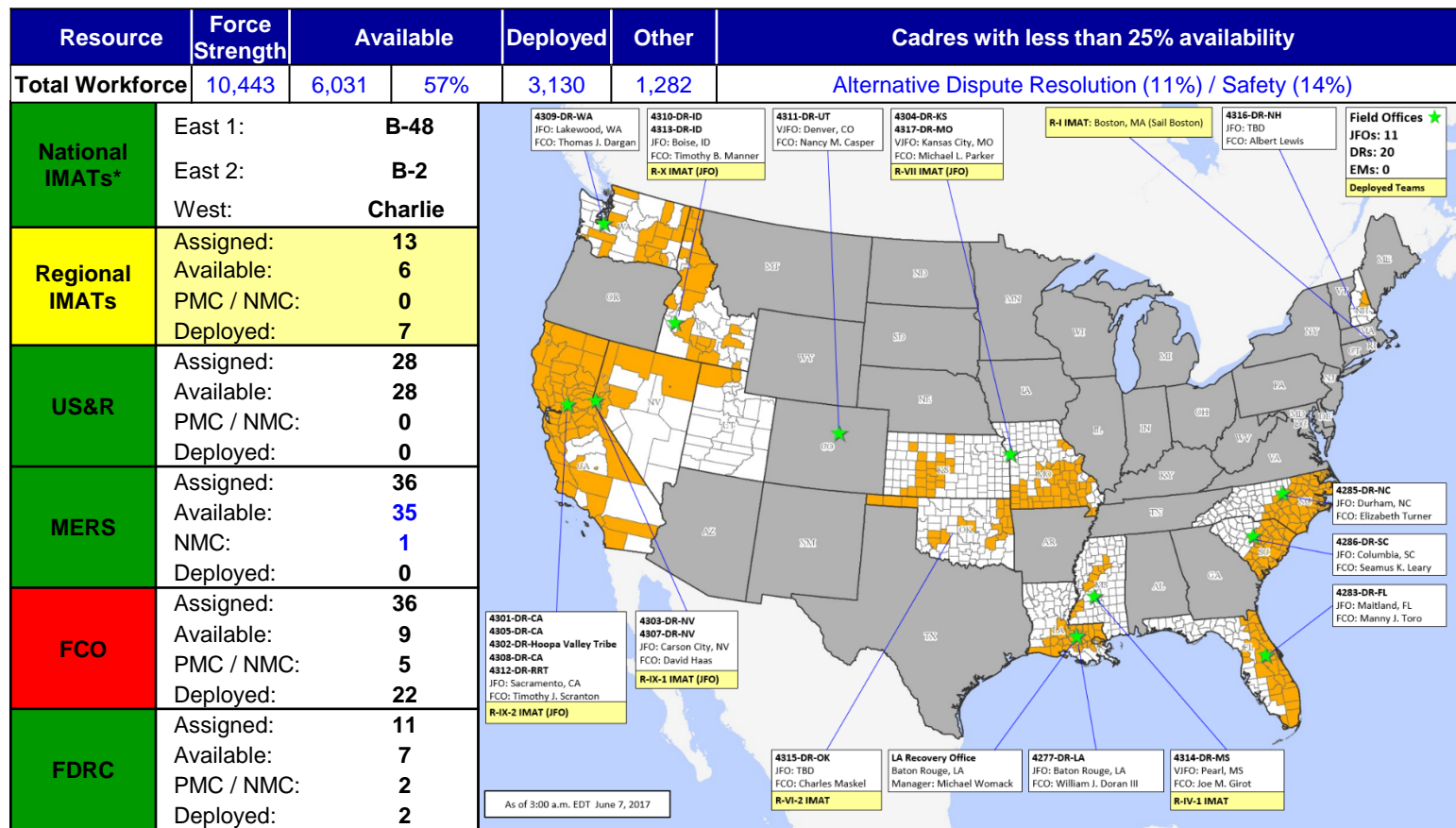
