Significant Activity – June 17-18



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Significant Events: None

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Disturbance 1: Medium (50%); Invest 93L: Medium (60%)
- Eastern Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests during the next 48 hours

Significant Weather:

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Southern Plains to Northeast
- Flash flooding possible – Lower Mississippi Valley to Northeast
- Rain and thunderstorms – Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley; Southern Plains to Southeast, Great Lakes and Northeast
- Red Flag Warnings: CA
- Space Weather:

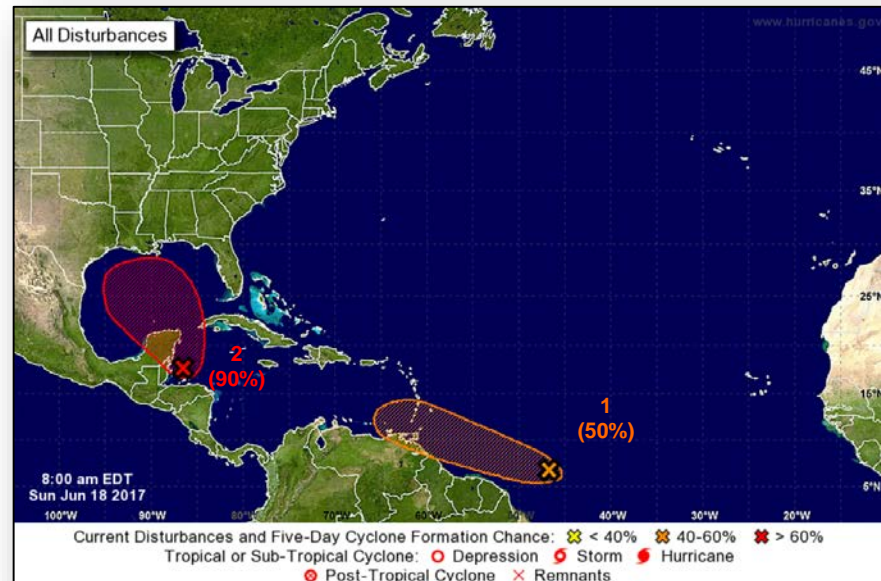
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Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 1,200 miles ESE of southern Windward Islands
- Moving W or WNW at 15-20 mph
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (50%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)

Invest 93L (Disturbance 2) (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

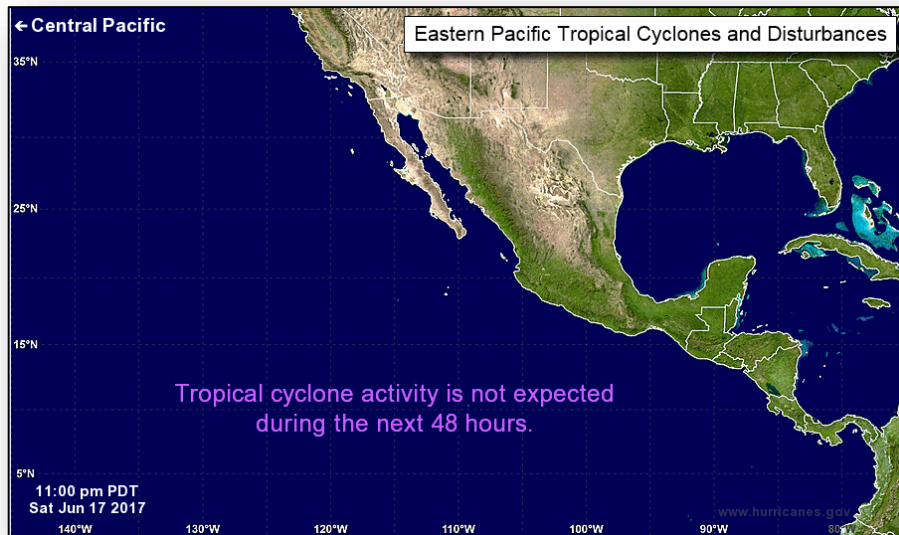
- Located over northwestern Caribbean Sea
- Moving slowly NW across Yucatan Peninsula
- Tropical cyclone likely to form
- USAF Hurricane Hunter scheduled for today, if needed
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (60%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

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48 Hour Outlook

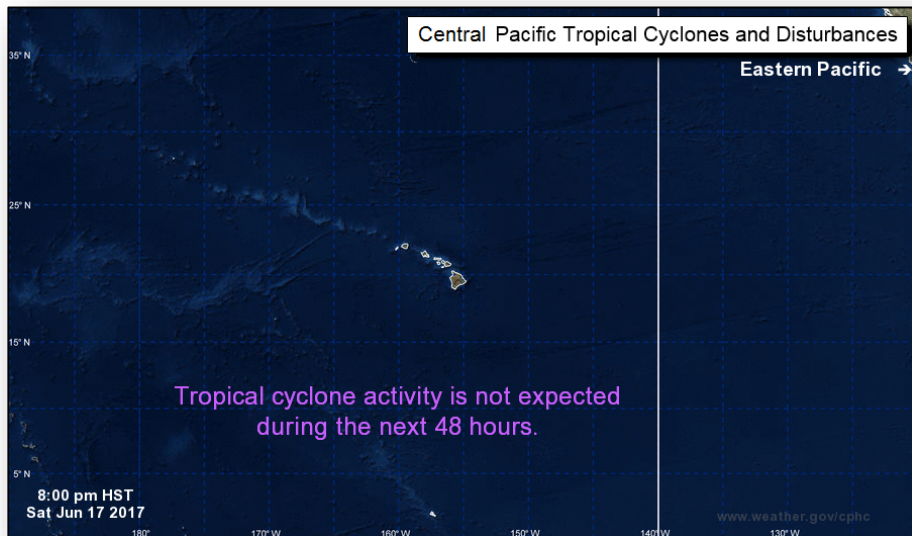


5 Day Outlook

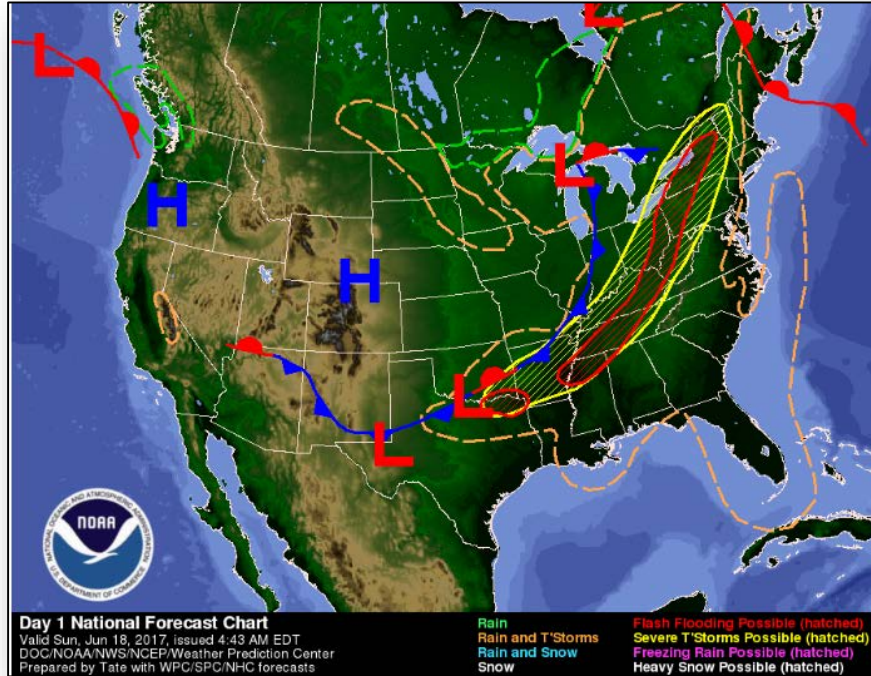

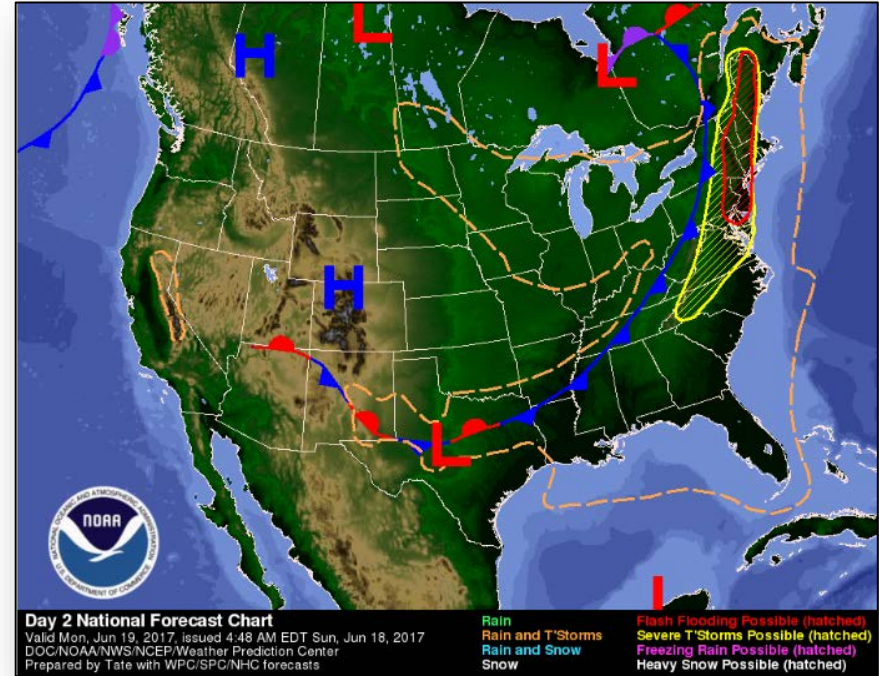

Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-2



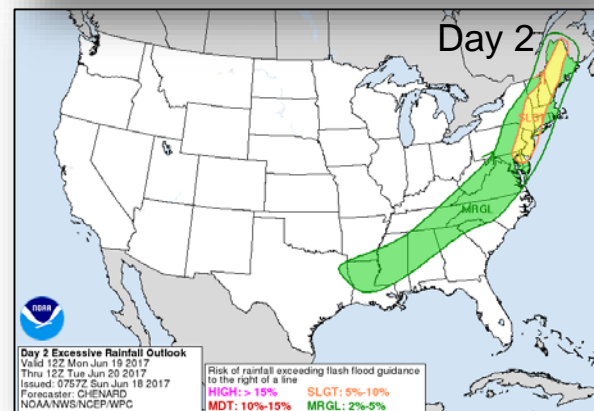
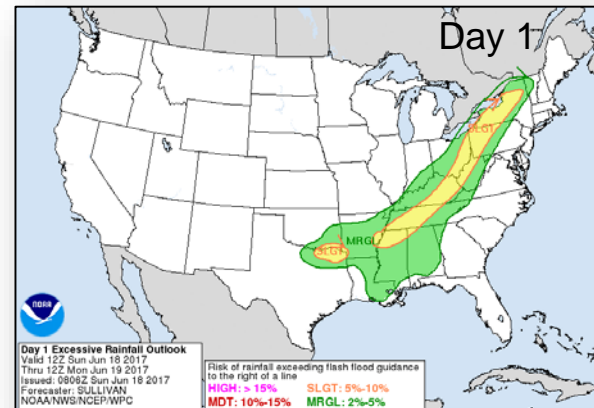
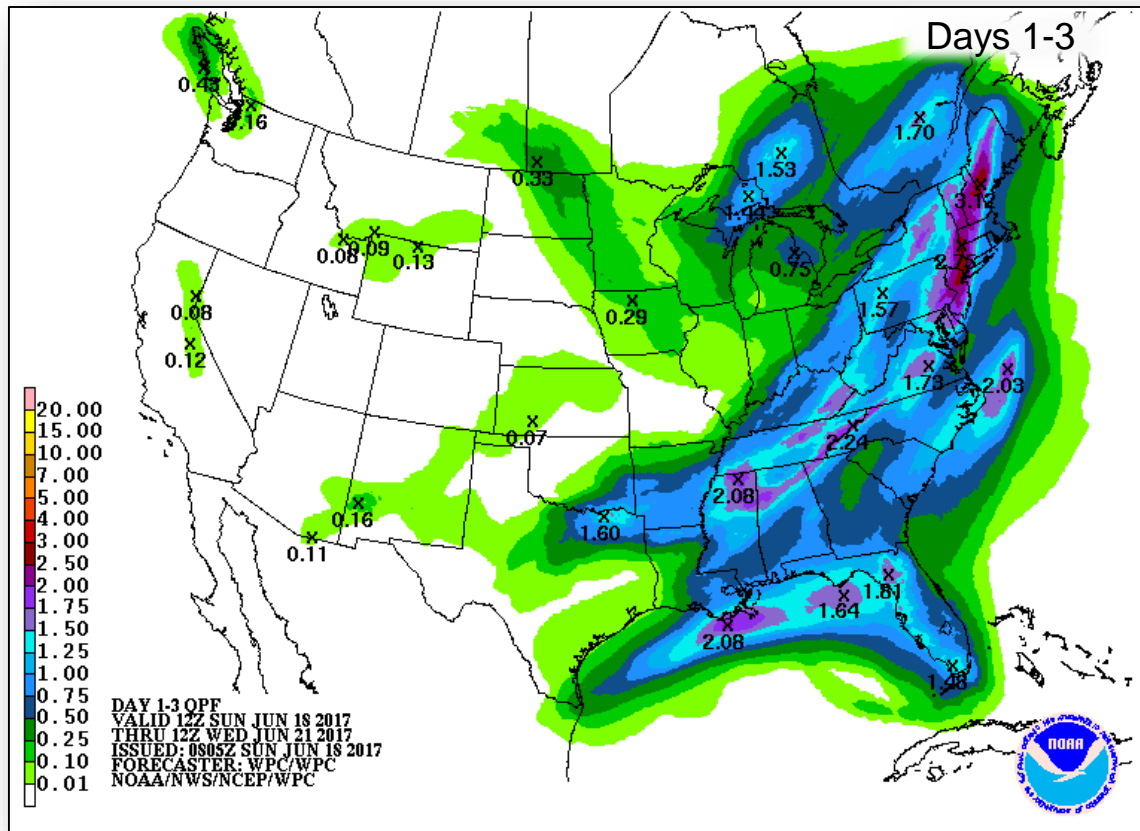
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 3-4



Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



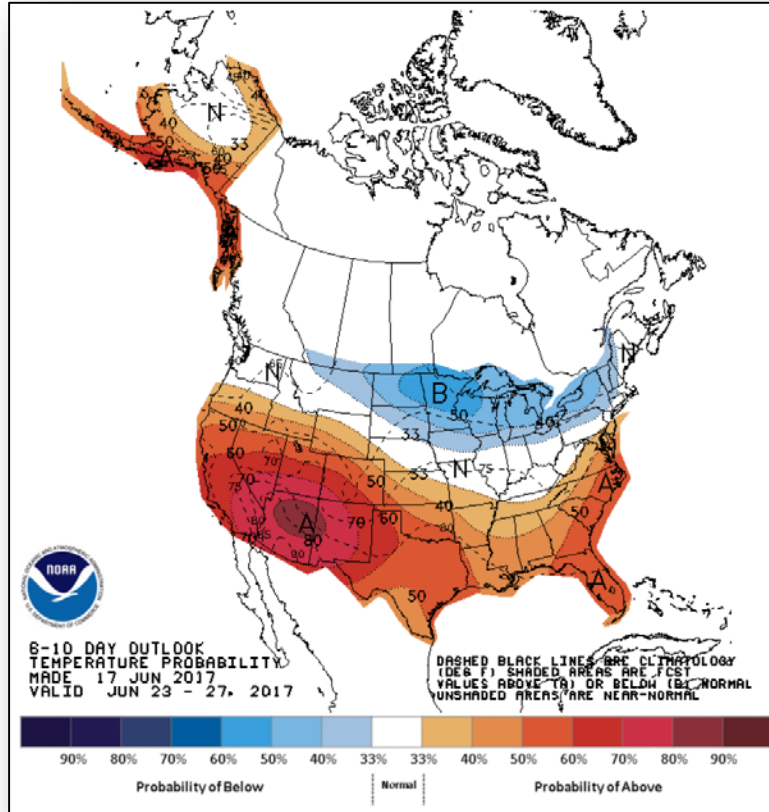
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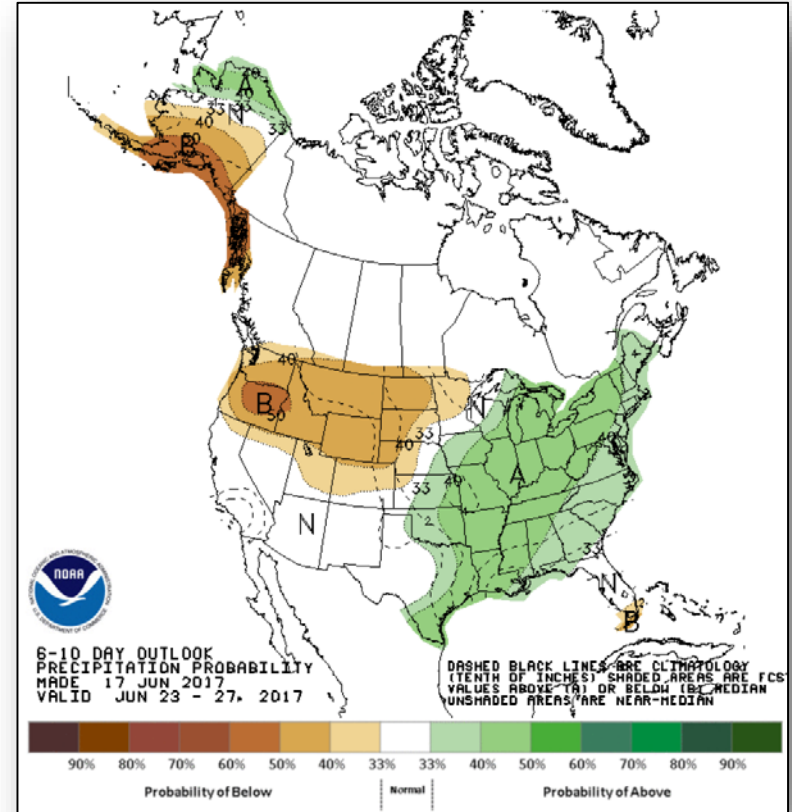
6-10 Day Outlooks



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6-10 Day Temperature Probability



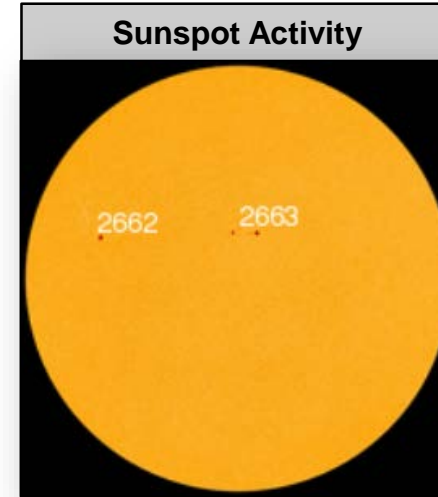
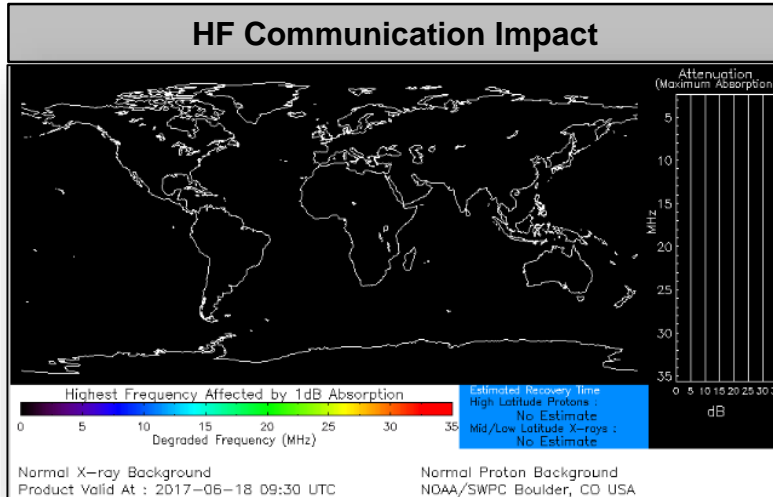
6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

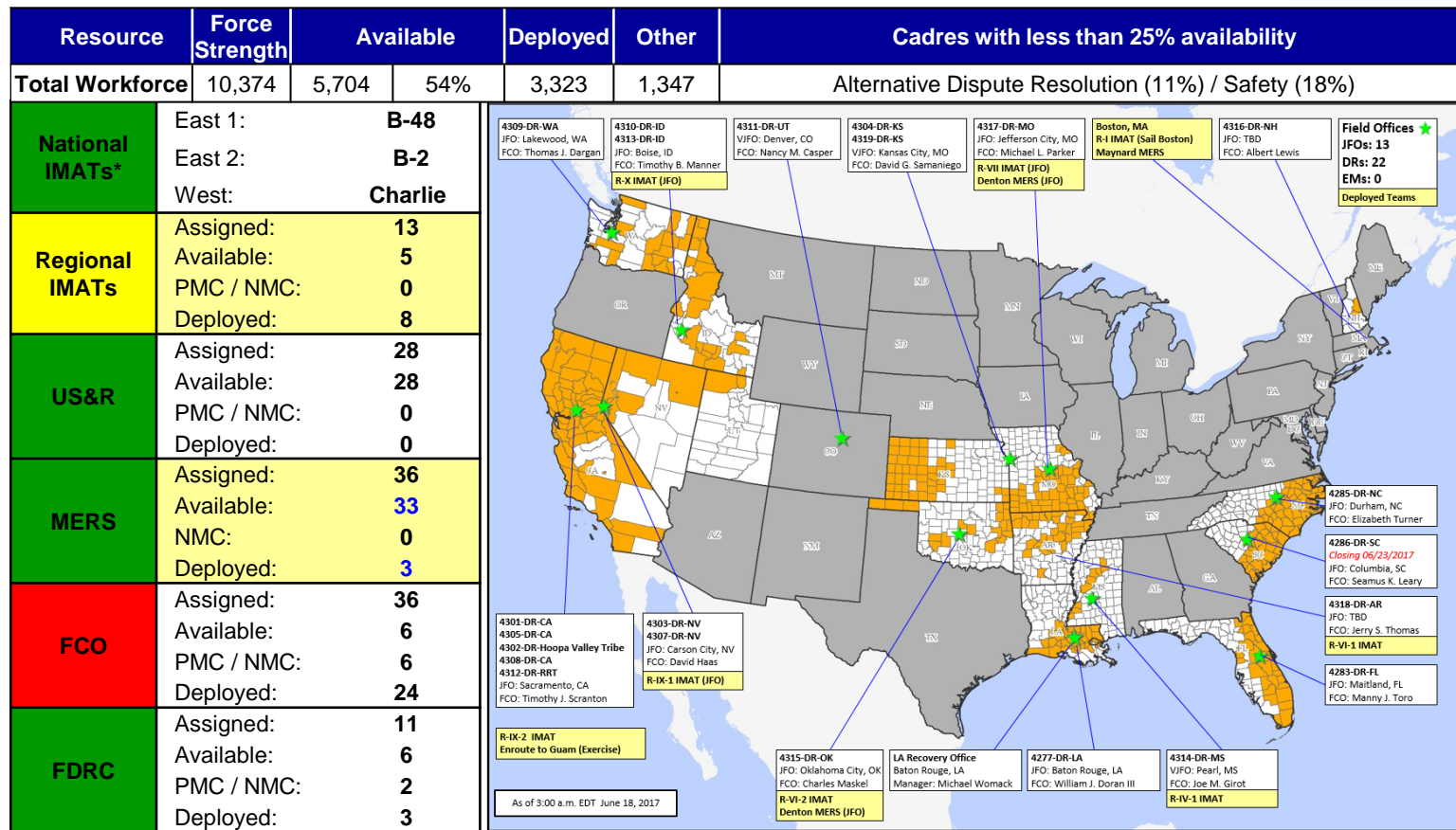
