- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

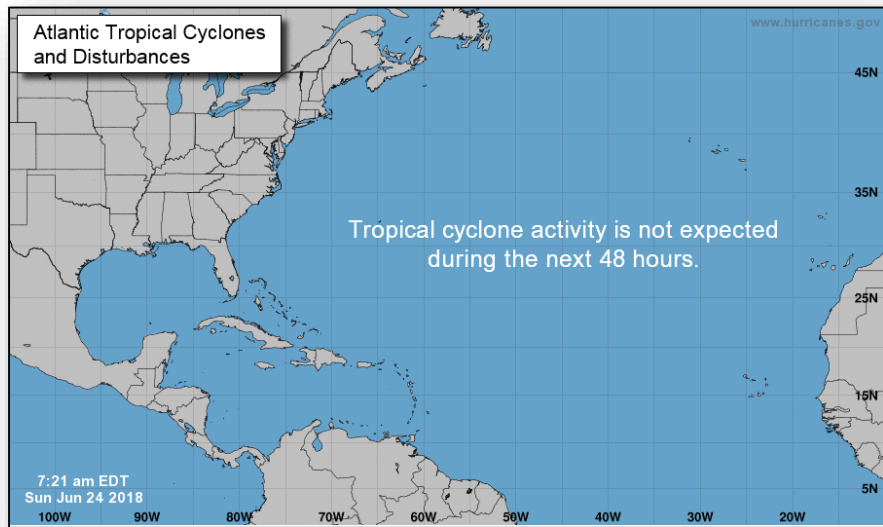
Significant Weather:

- Space Weather – Past 24 hours: none; next 24 hours: none

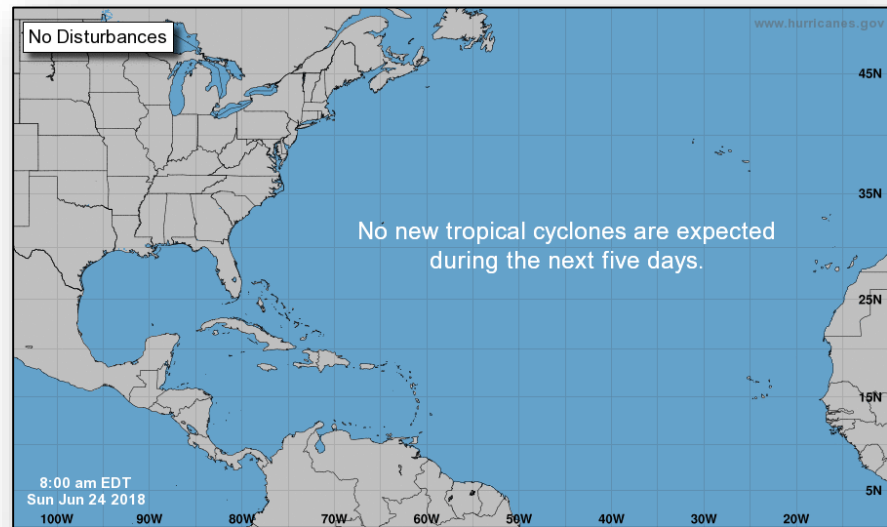

Tropical Depression Five-E (Advisory 2 as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

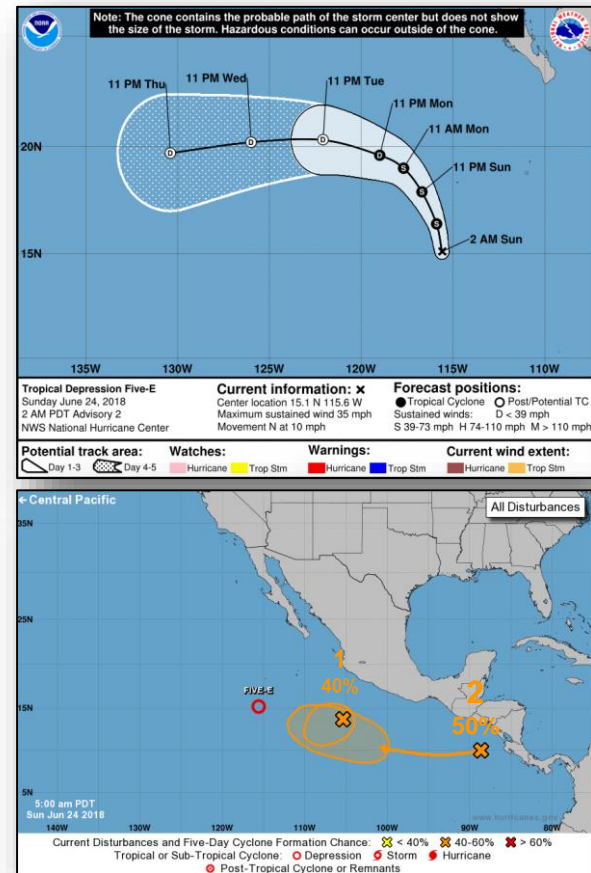
- 655 miles SW off southern tip of Baja California Peninsula, Mexico
- Moving N at 10 mph; max sustained winds 35 mph
- Expected to become a tropical storm today
- Weakening forecast to begin Monday
- No threat to U.S. interests

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Several hundred miles SW of Zihuatanejo, Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)
- No threat to U.S. interests

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

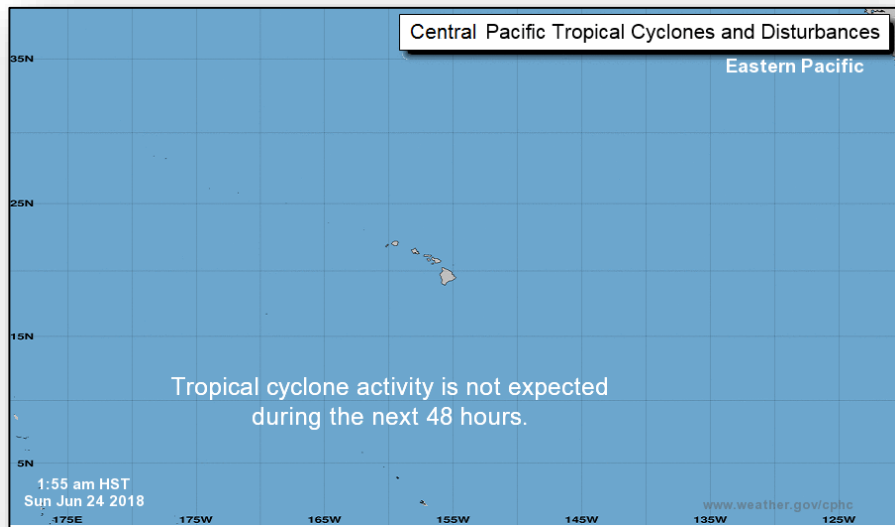
- Tropical wave W of Costa Rica and Nicaragua

- No threat to U.S. interests



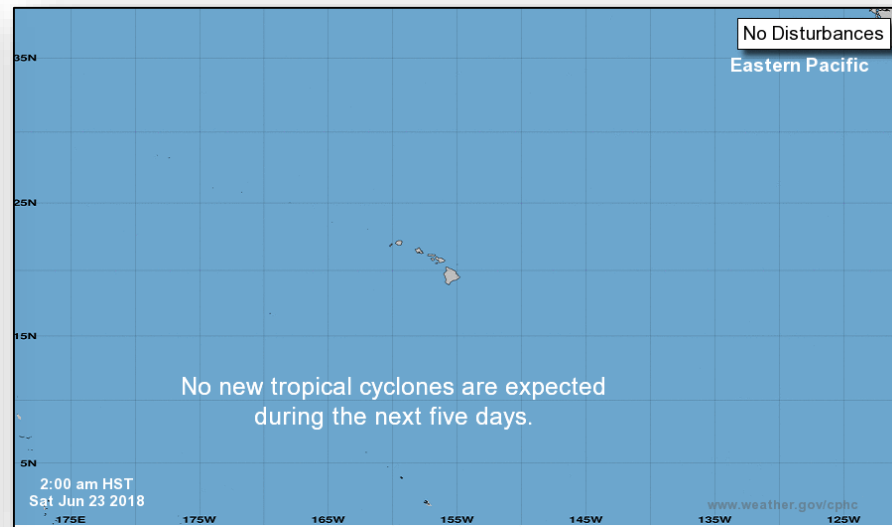

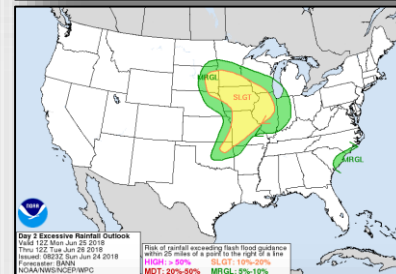
Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



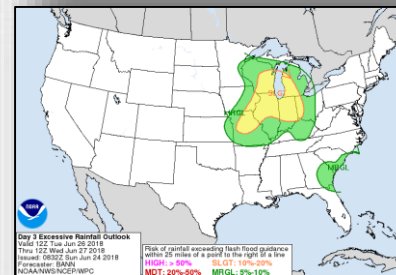

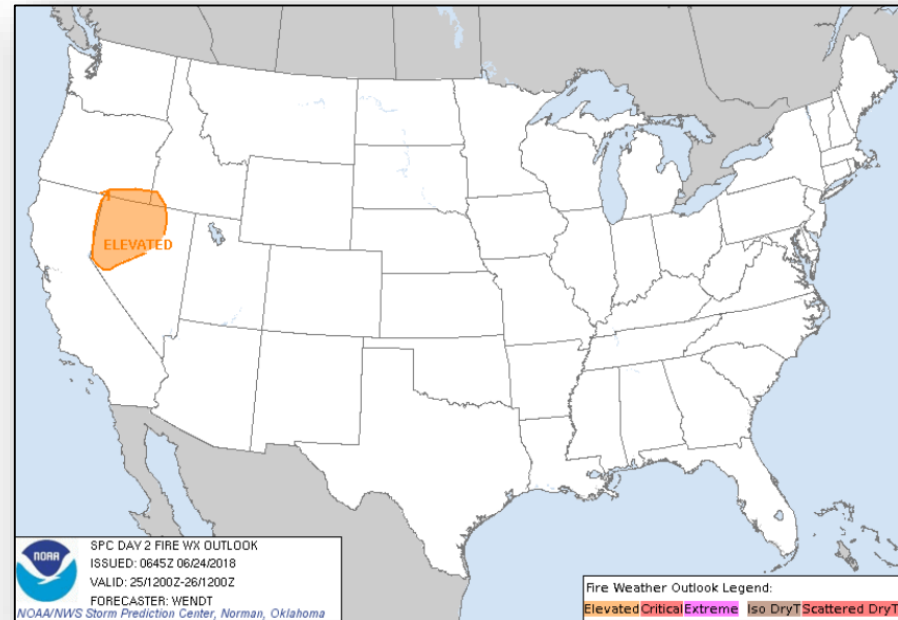
Fire Weather Outlook

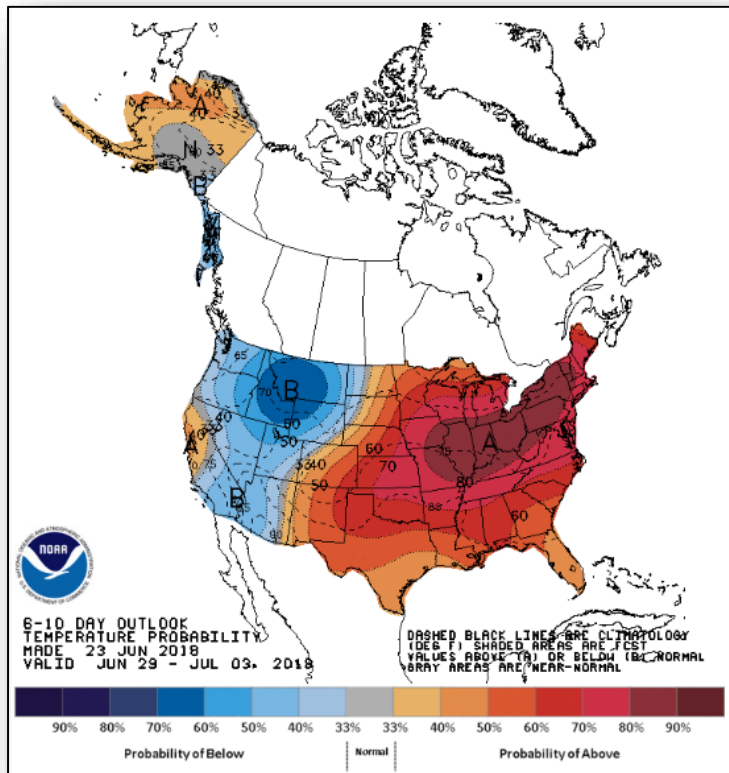

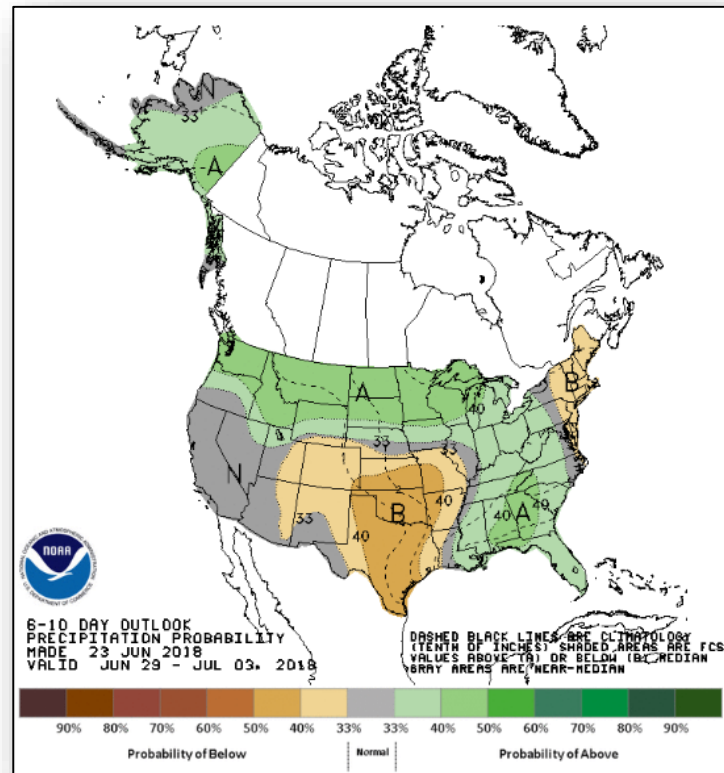

Temperature Probability



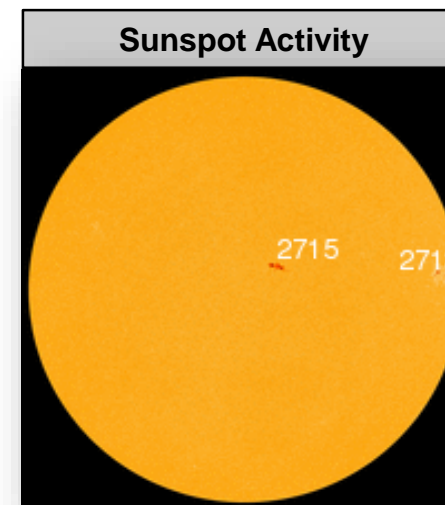
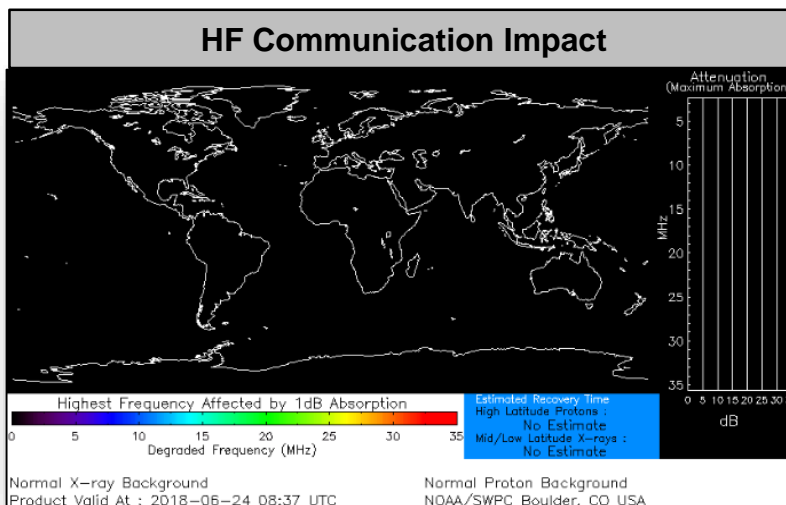
