- Western Pacific – No activity

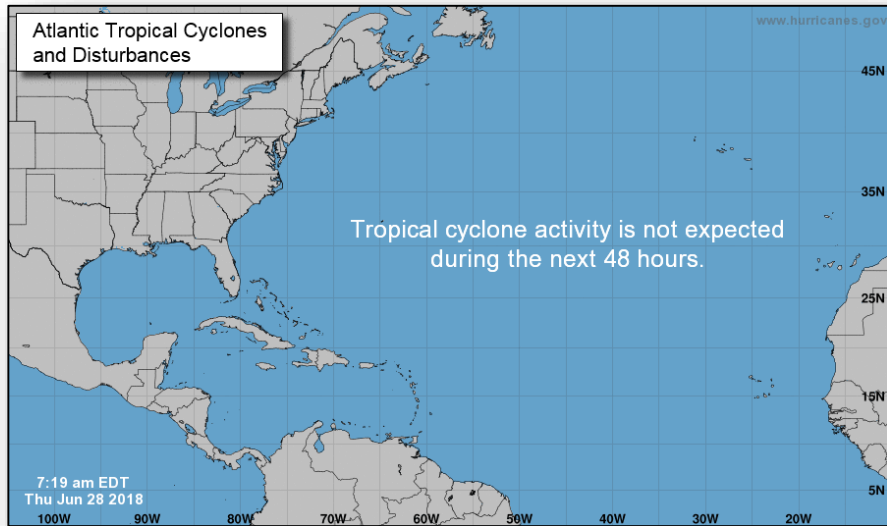

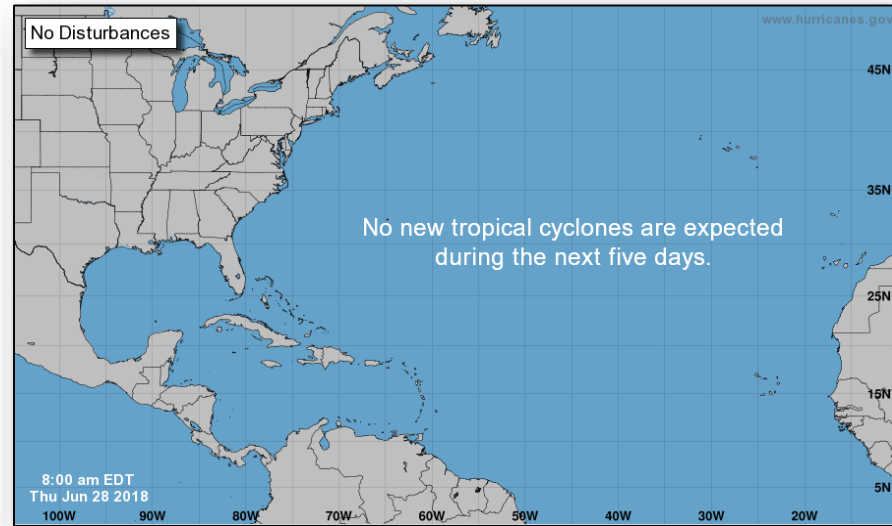

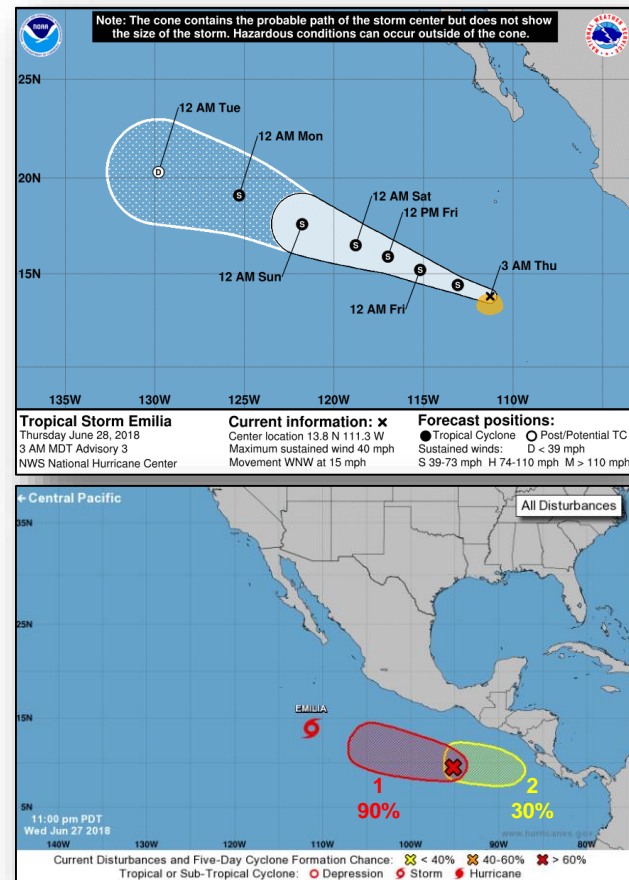
- 635 miles south of Baja California, Mexico

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

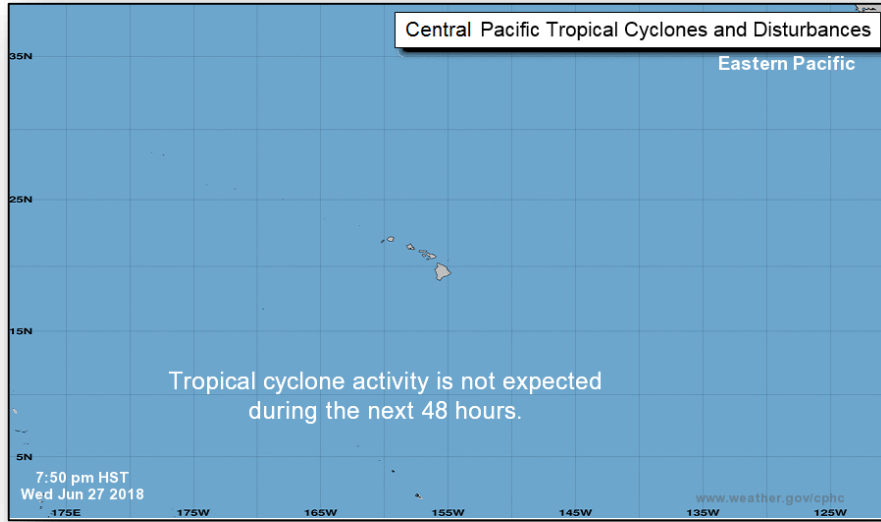
- Moving W to NW over southern Central America, then into the eastern Pacific by Friday

- No threat to U.S. interests



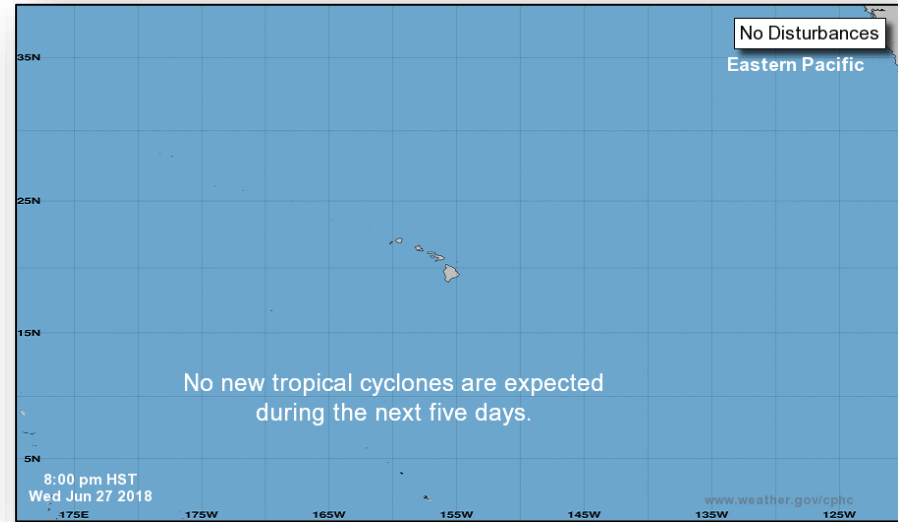
Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific

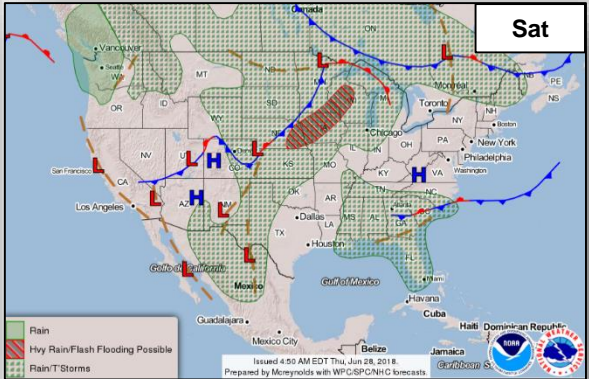
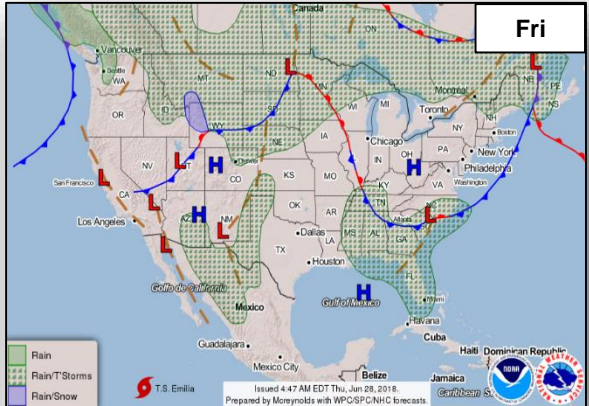
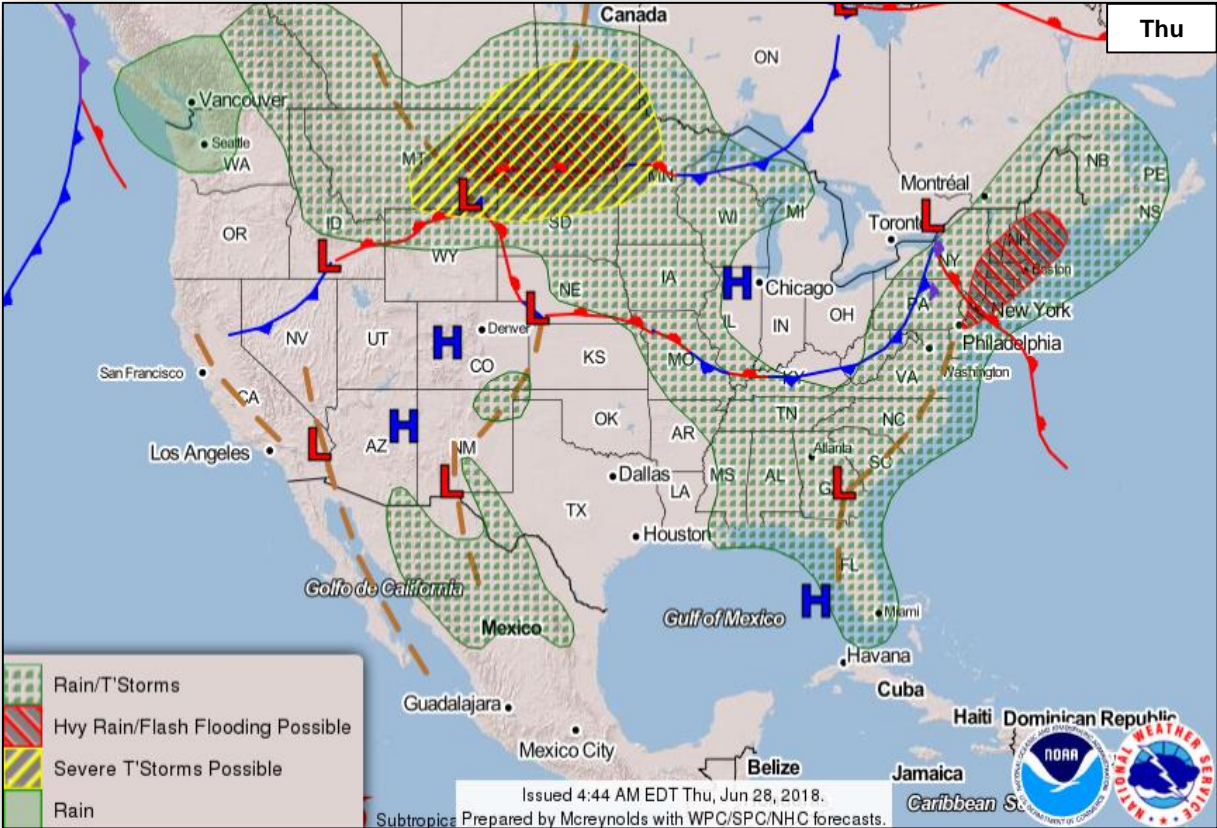

National Weather Forecast



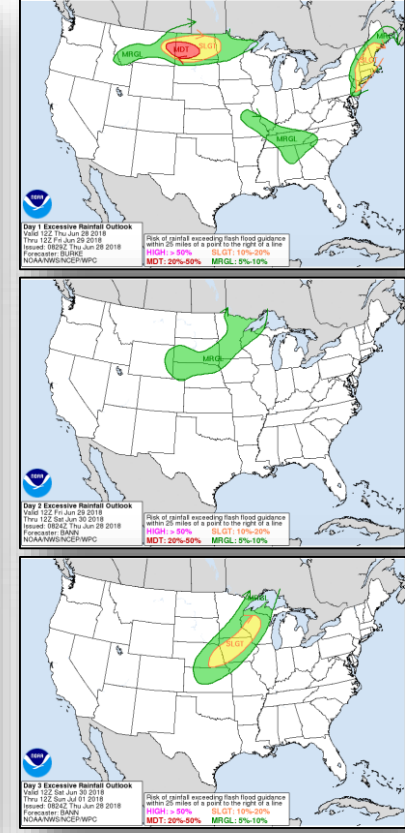
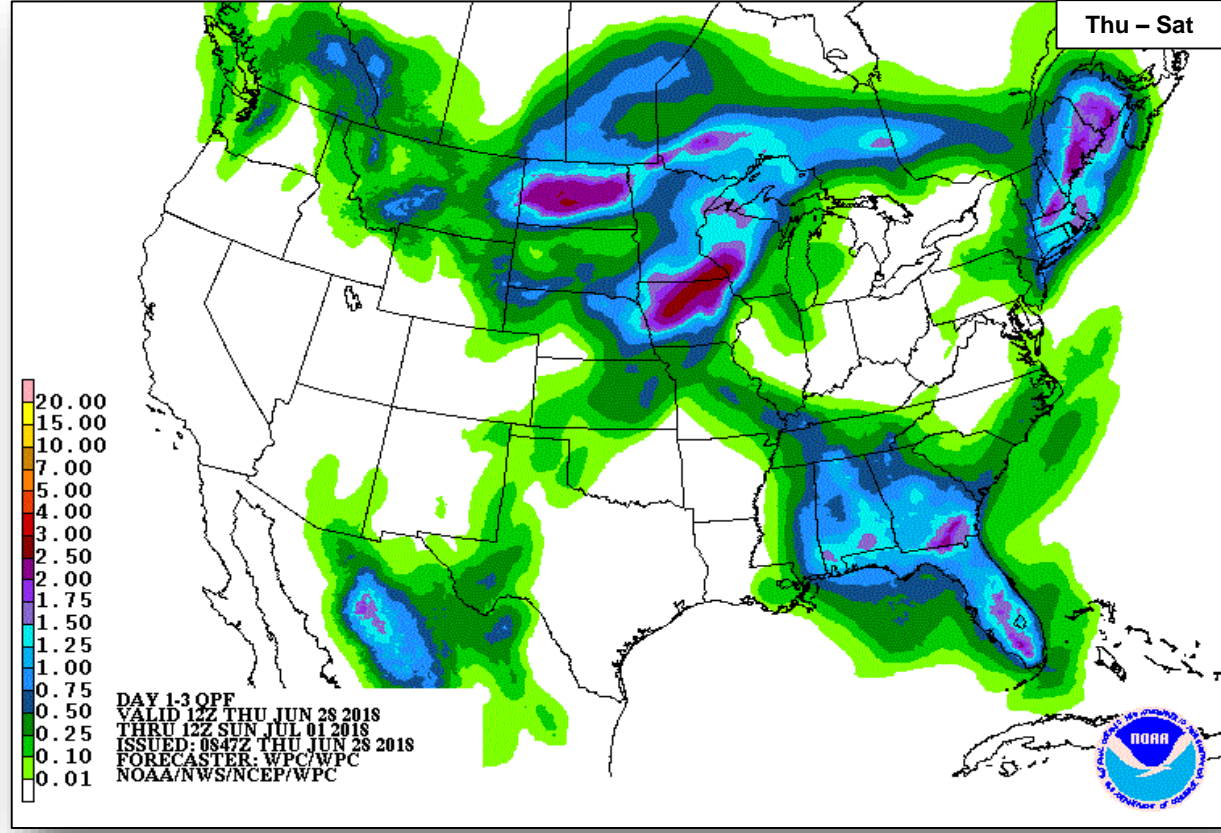
