

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48 Hour Outlook





Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Hurricane Aletta (Advisory #15 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 495 miles SSW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 6 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 110 mph (Category 2)
- No threat to U.S. interests



Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)


- Located 400 miles S of Acapulco, Mexico

- No threat to U.S. interests




Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific





48 Hour Outlook








Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast






