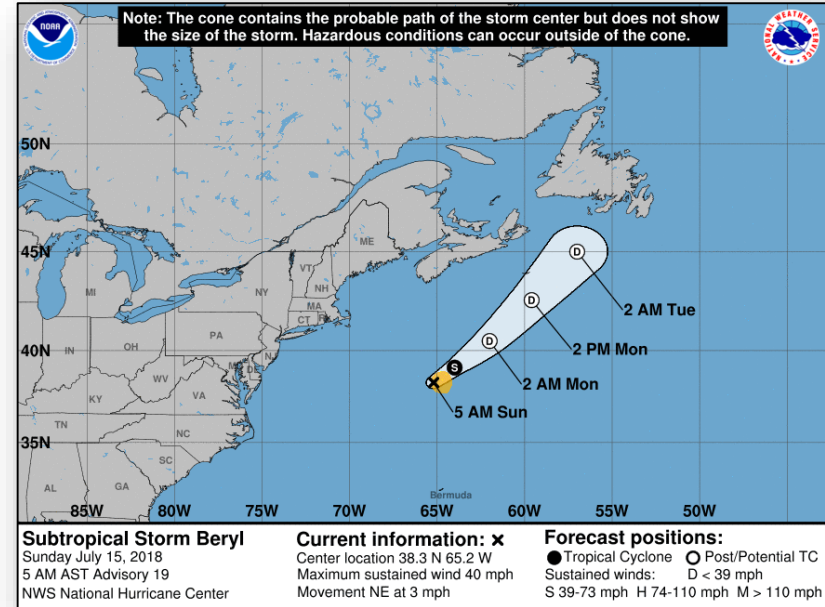

# Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



## Subtropical Storm Beryl (Advisory #19 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 445 miles south of Halifax, Nova Scotia
- Moving northeast at 3 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Expected to degenerate into a remnant low by early Monday

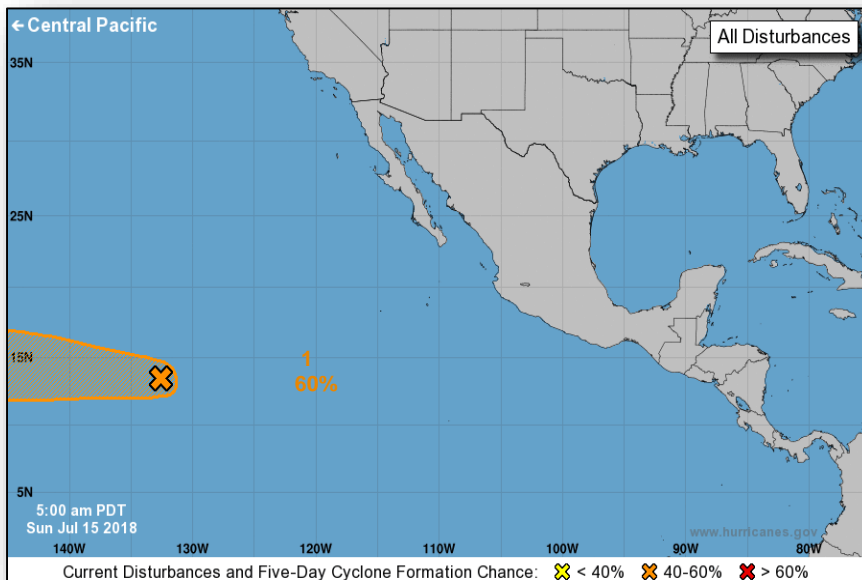


# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

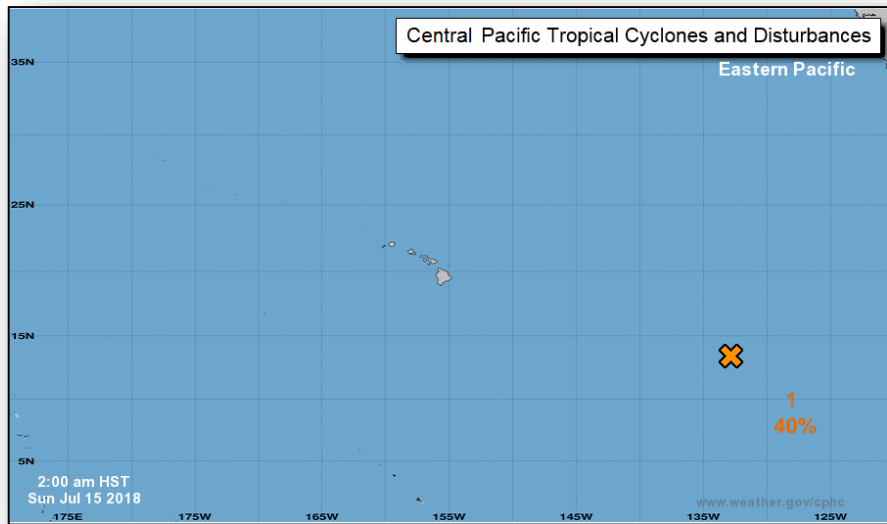


## Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

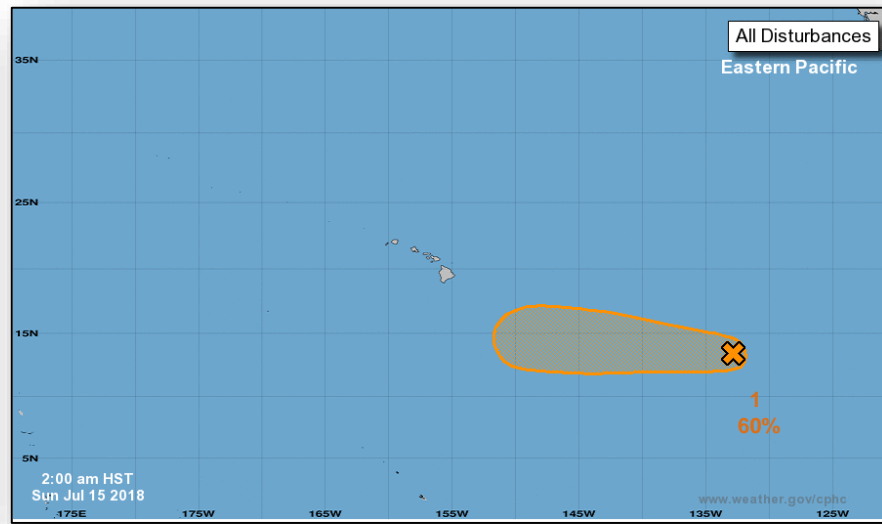
- 1,500 miles ESE of the southern tip of the Hawaiian Islands
- Moving westward into the Central Pacific basin
- A tropical depression could form in the next couple days

- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)

**48 Hour Outlook**

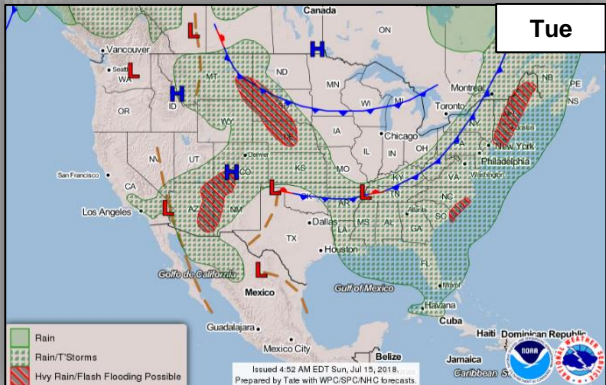
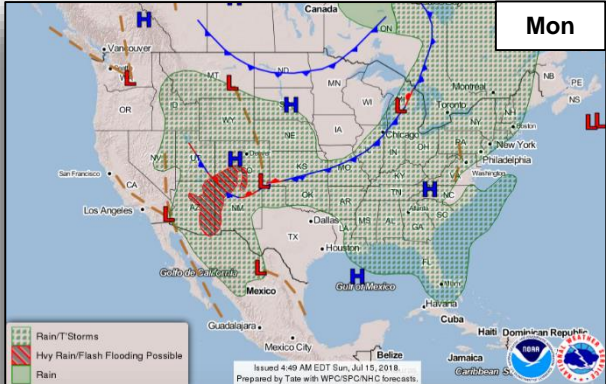
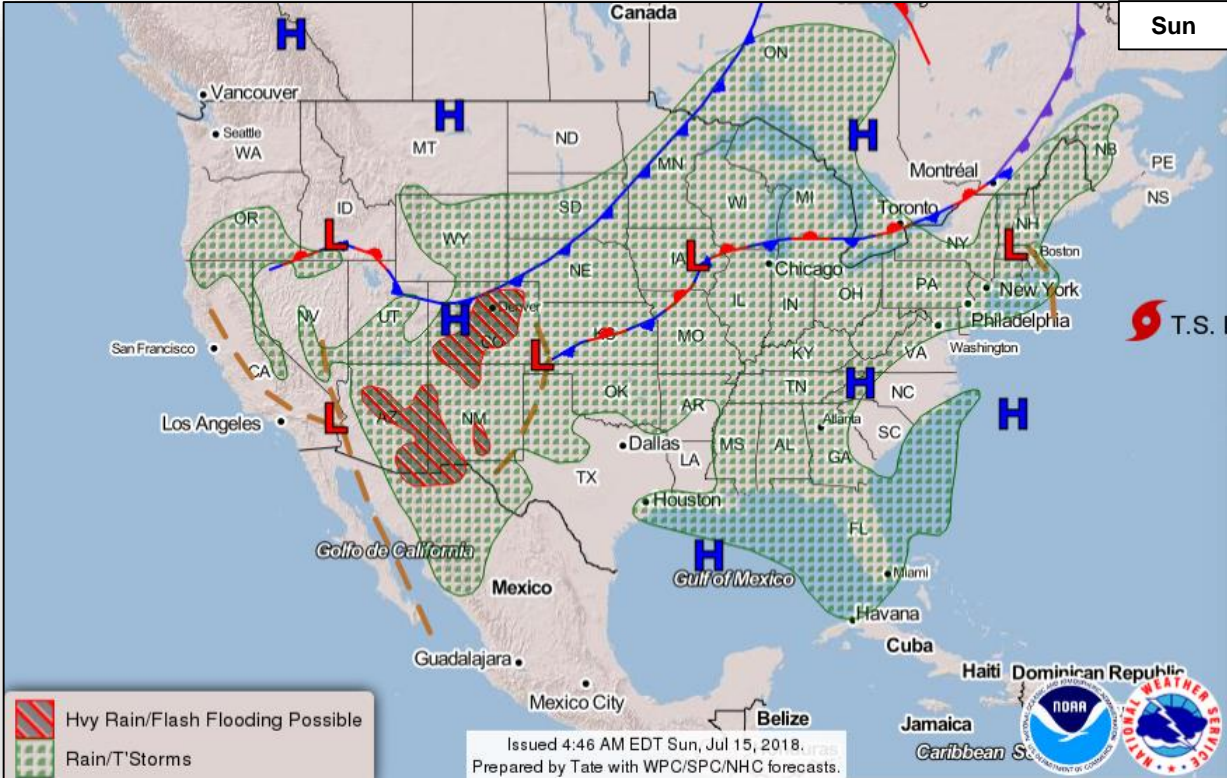


**5 Day Outlook**

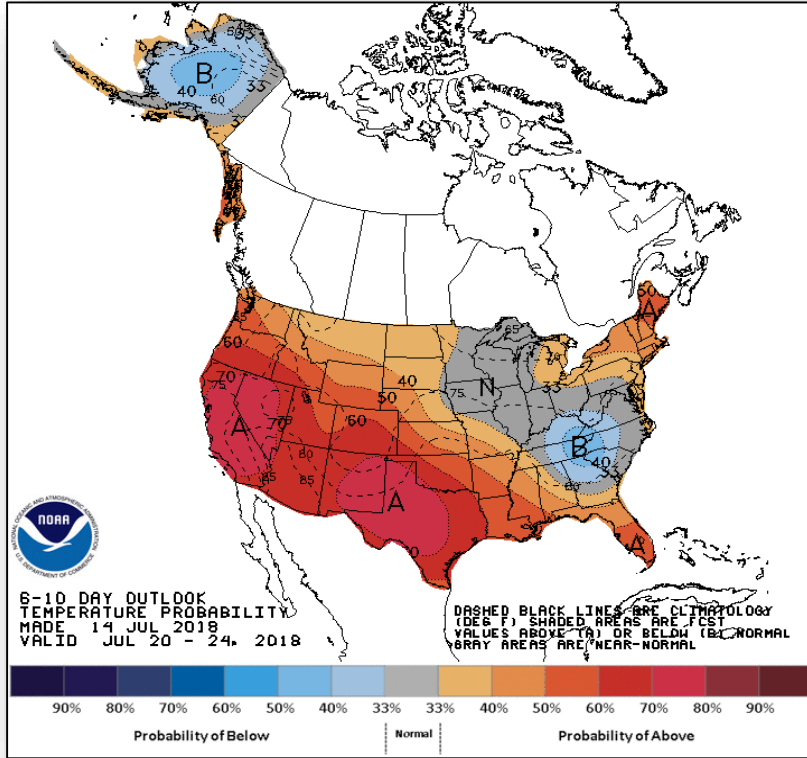

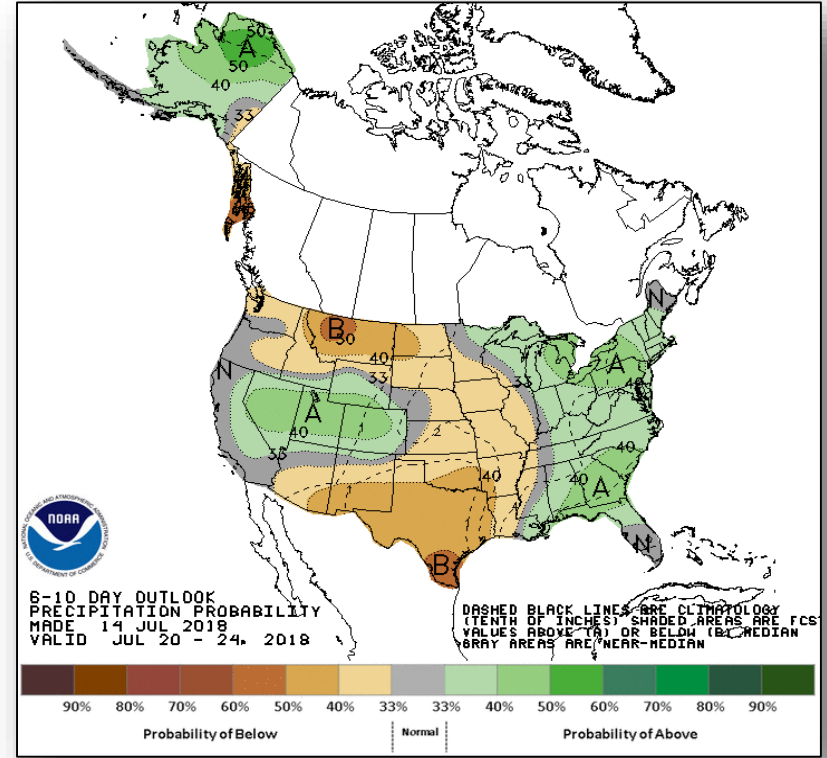
# Long Range Outlooks – July 20-24

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

