# Significant Activity: July 24-25



**Significant Events:** None

## **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance #1 – Low (near 0%)
- Central Pacific: Disturbance #1 – Low (10%); Disturbance #2 – Low (near 0%)
- Western Pacific: No activity threatening U.S. territories

## **Significant Weather:**

- Severe thunderstorms possible – Upper Midwest and Central Plains to Middle Mississippi Valley
- Flash flooding possible – areas of FL and the Middle Mississippi Valley
- Heat advisory/Excessive Heat – Lower Mississippi Valley to the Southeast
- Elevated Fire Weather Areas/Red Flag Warnings: MT
- Space Weather: Past 24 hours – none occurred; next 24 hours – none predicted

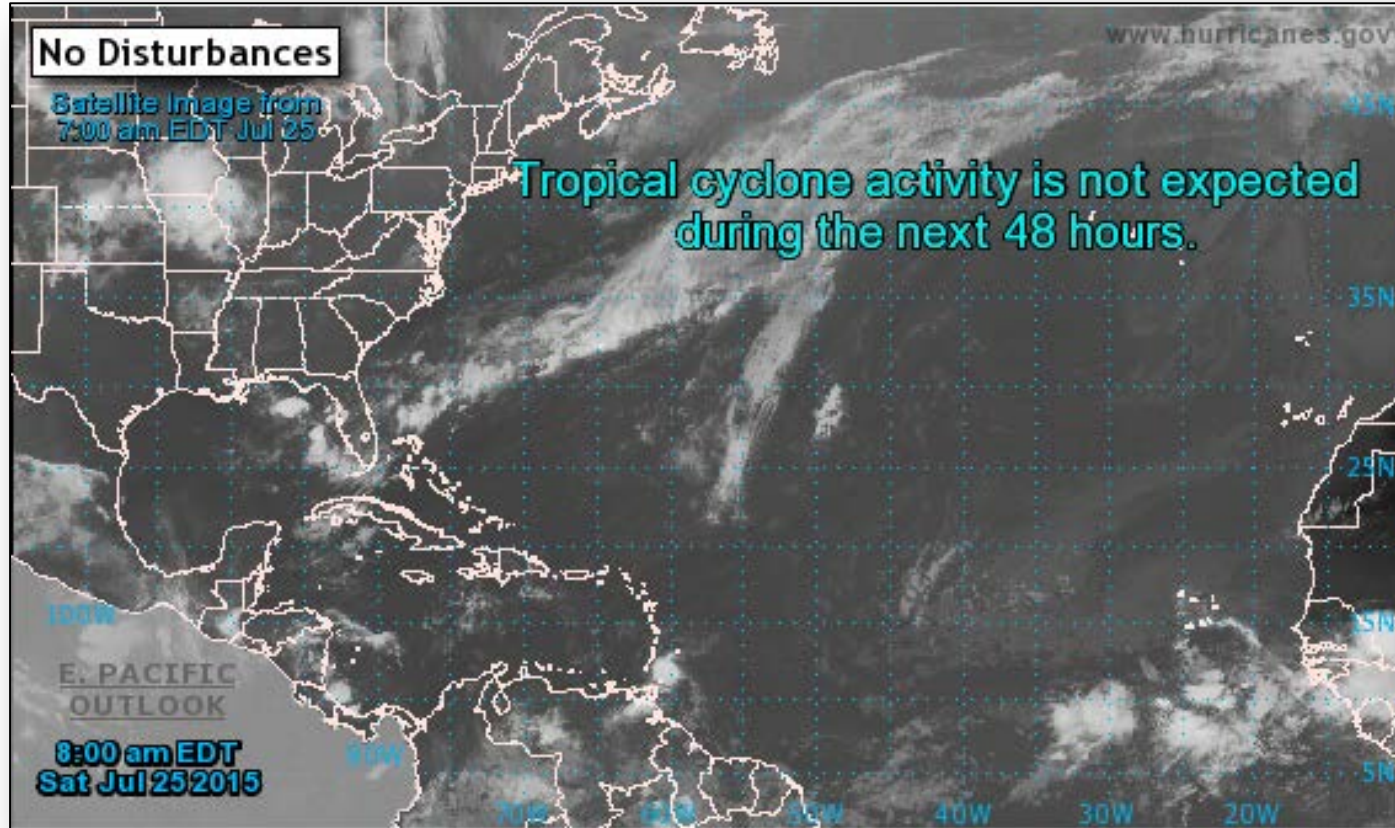

- Amendment #12 to FEMA-4222-DR-OK – Adds 12 counties for Individual Assistance

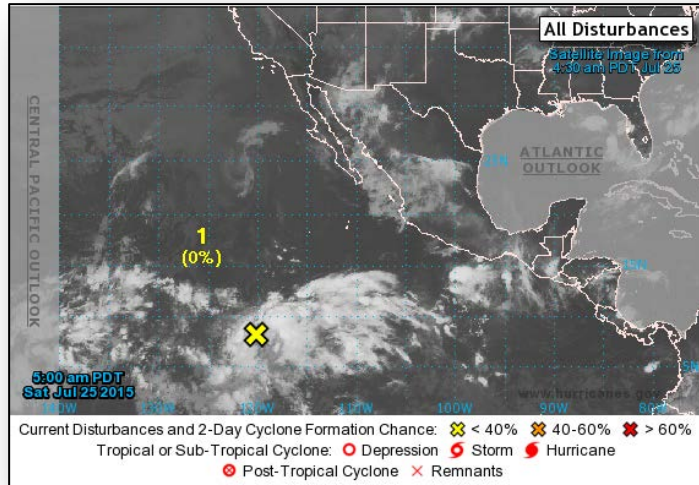
# 2-Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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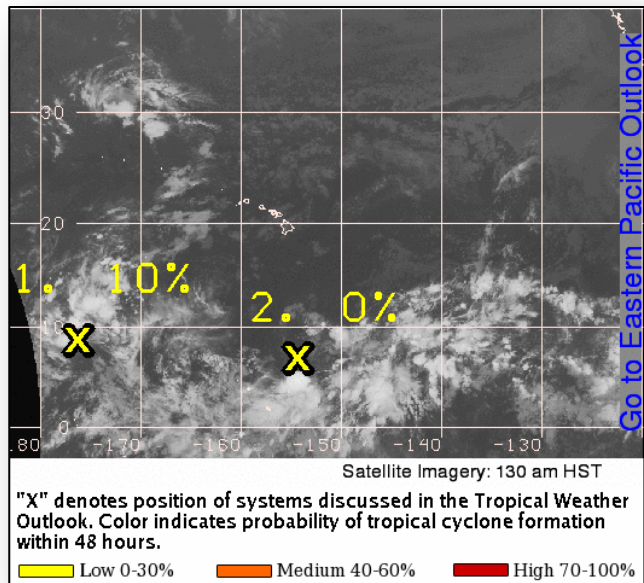
# 2-Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



## Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Area of low pressure associated with a tropical wave
- Located over 1,000 miles SSW of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving W to WNW at around 15 mph
- Gradual development expected by middle of next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)

# Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



## **Disturbance 1:** (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Broad area of showers & thunderstorms
- Associated with a weak surface low
- Located 1,300 miles southwest of Honolulu, HI
- Moving slowly west over next two days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)

## **Disturbance 2:** (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Weak area of low pressure centered 800 miles S of Hilo, HI
- Producing poorly organized thunderstorms
- Moving west at 10 mph
- Strong upper level winds will likely inhibit development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)

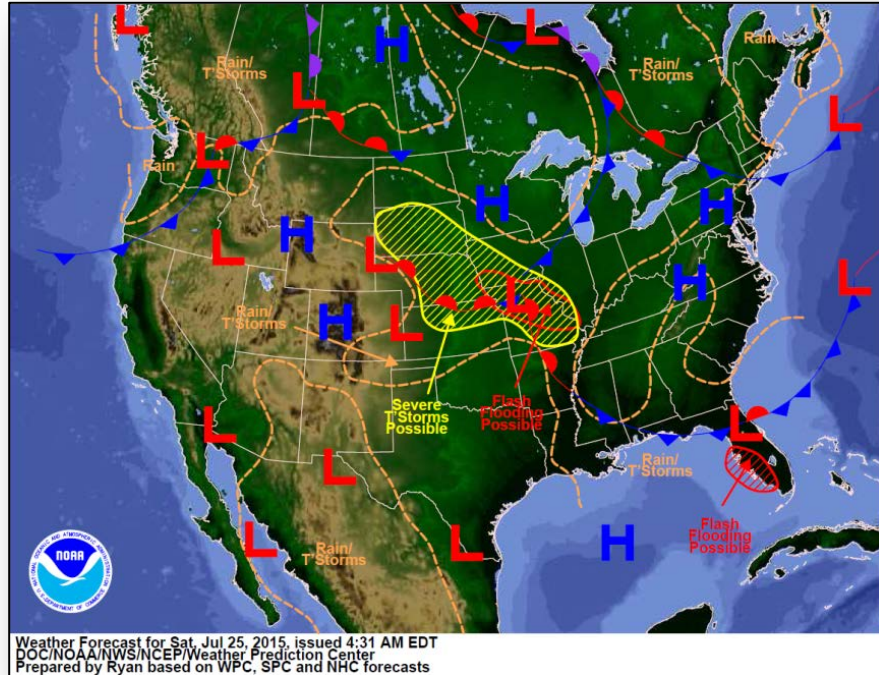

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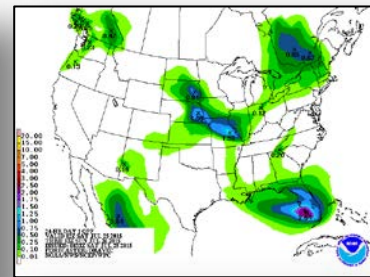
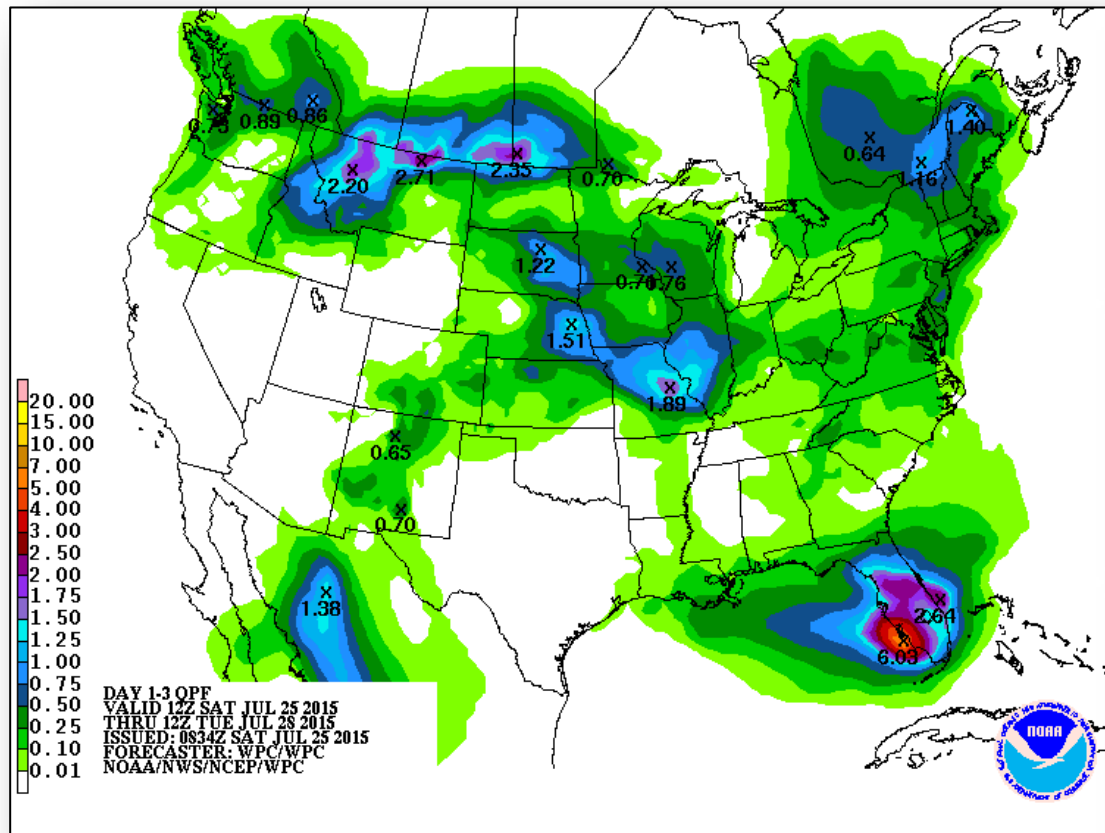




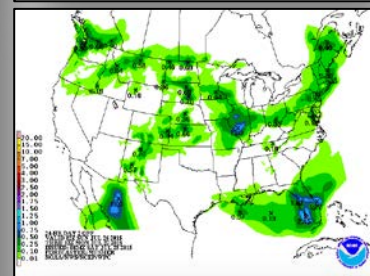
# Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



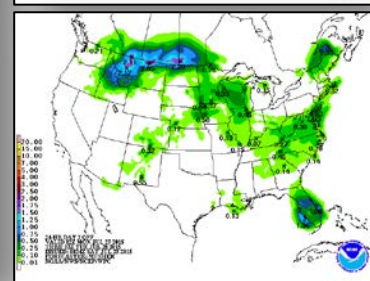
