Significant Activity: July 25 – 26



Significant Events: Democratic National Convention

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Tropical cyclone activity not expected next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific – Hurricane Georgette; Tropical Storm Frank
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected through early Thursday morning; Post-Tropical Cyclone Darby (FINAL)
- Western Pacific – No activity threatening U.S. territories

Significant Weather:

- Severe thunderstorms and flash flooding possible – Northern and Central Plains
- Rain and thunderstorms – Northern Intermountain to Great Lakes, Southwest, Southeast, Central Great Basin to Mid-Atlantic; Northeast
- Red Flag Warnings – ID
- Isolated dry thunderstorms – ID, MT, WY, UT & CO
- Space Weather – None observed past 24 hours; none predicted next 24 hours

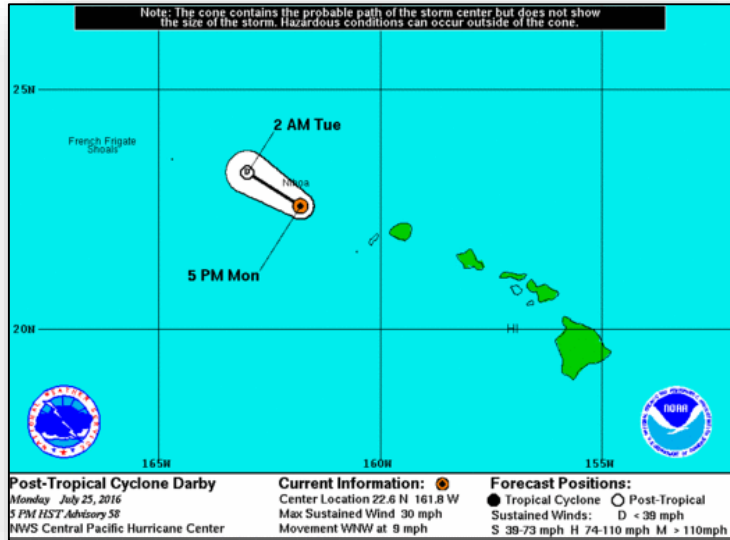

Post-Tropical Cyclone Darby (FINAL)



Post-Tropical Cyclone Darby: (Advisory #58 as of 11:00 p.m. EDT) **FINAL**

- Located 265 miles WNW of Honolulu, HI
- Moving WNW at 9 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- Expected to continue weakening and will dissipate later today

Impacts:

- No injuries or fatalities reported
- All seaports or airports open
- All shelters have closed

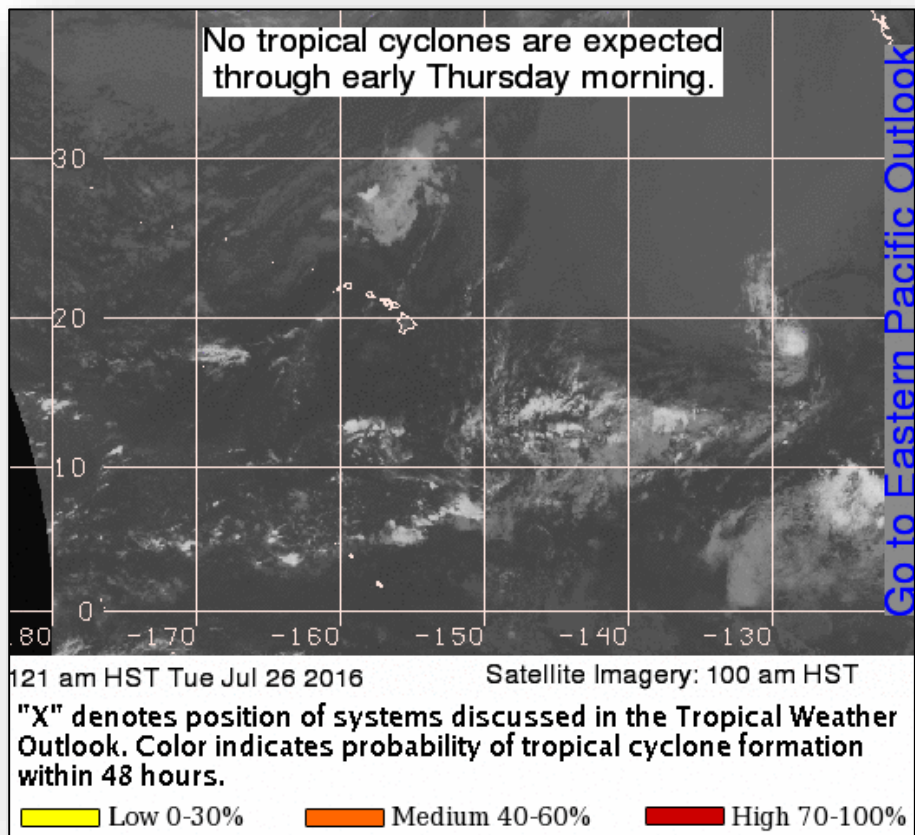
State/Federal Response:

Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



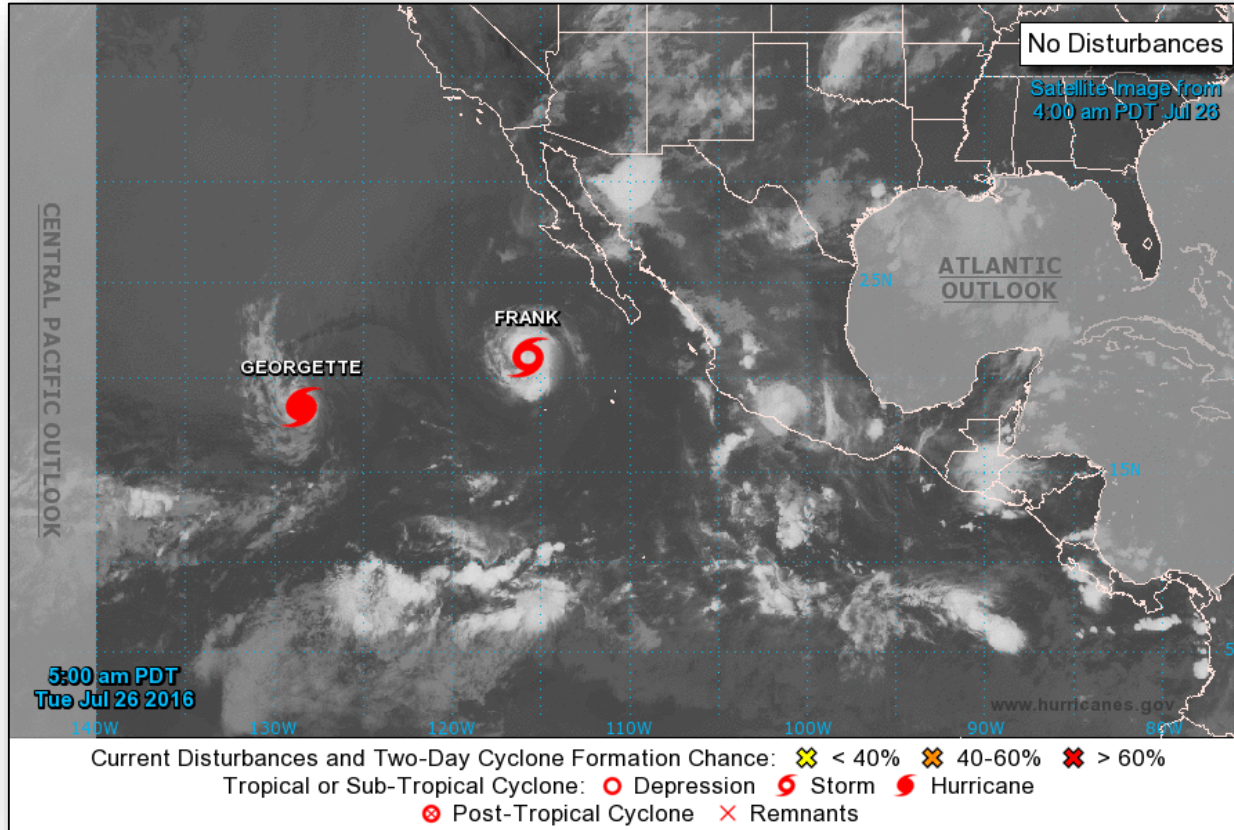

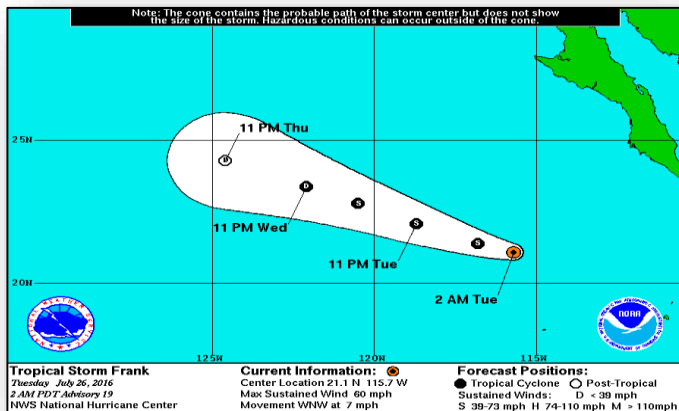
Tropical Outlook - Eastern Pacific



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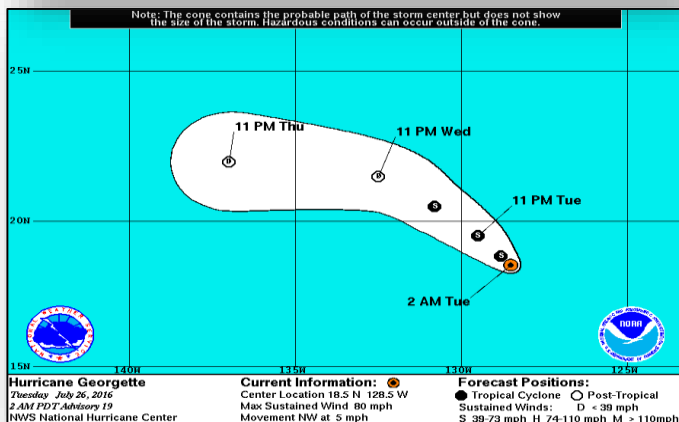

Tropical Storm Frank: (Advisory #19 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

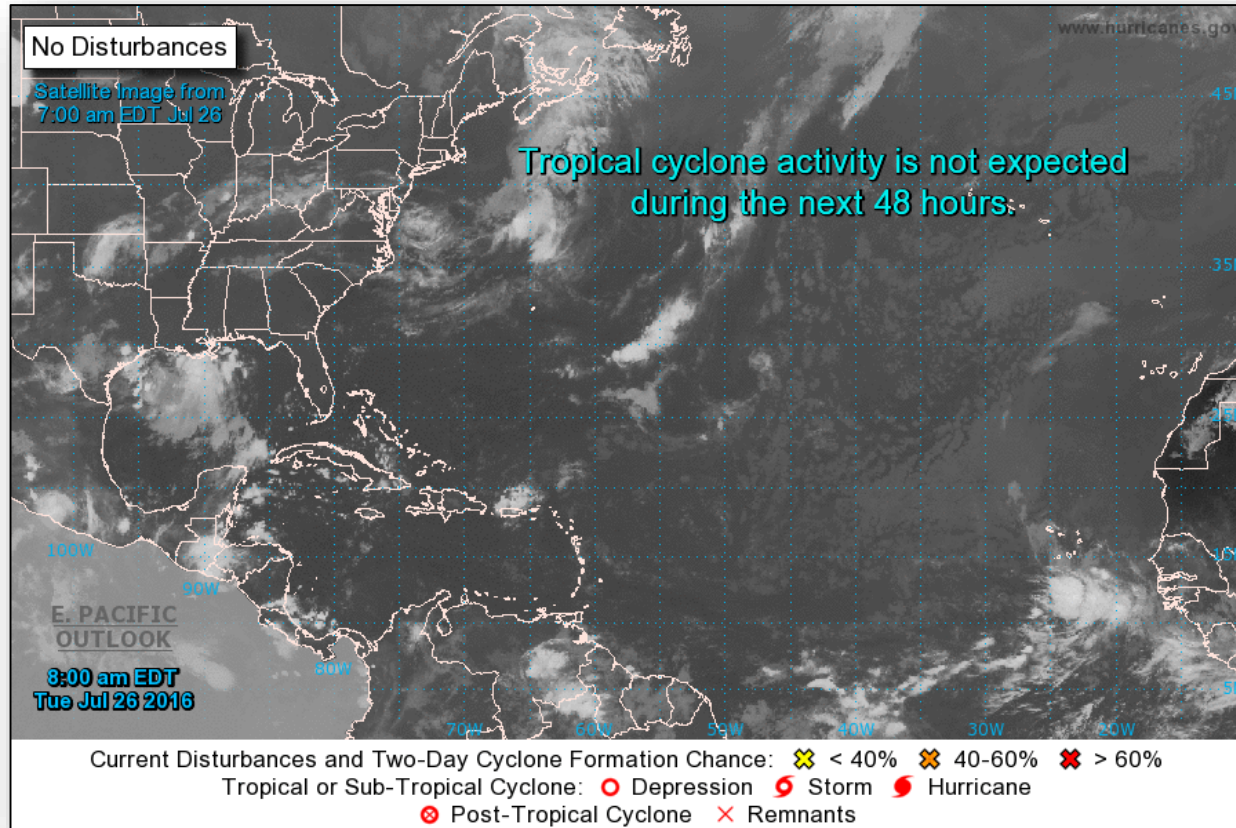
- Located 390 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 7 mph
- This general motion expected to continue next 48 hours
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Weakening is forecast
- Should become a tropical depression next 48 hours
- Tropical storm force winds extend 70 miles
- No coastal watches or warnings in effect



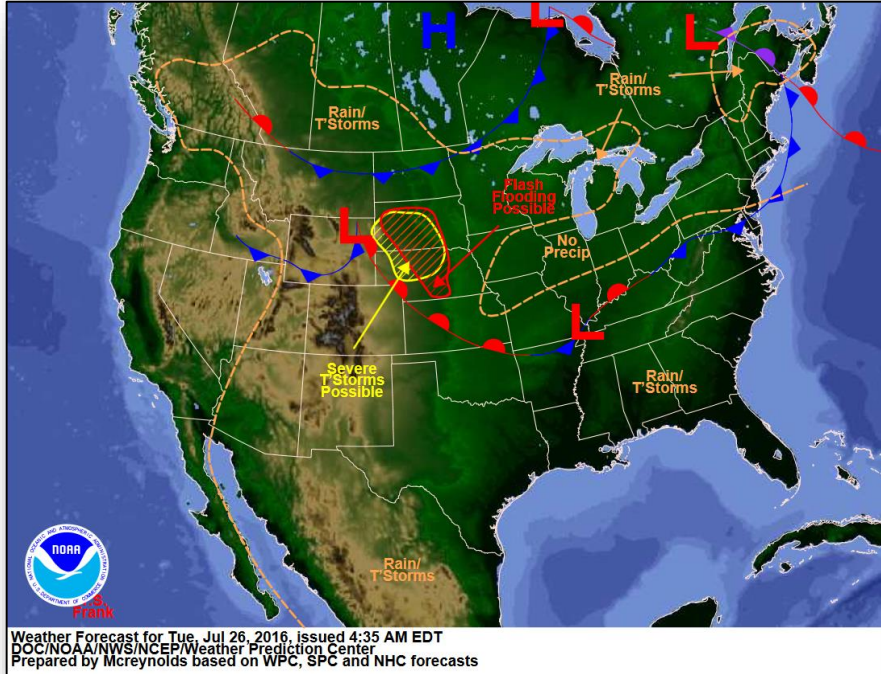
Hurricane Georgette: (Advisory #19 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 1,240 miles W of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NW at 5 mph
- A turn WNW with some increase in forward speed expected next 48 hours
- Maximum sustained winds 80 mph (Category 1 hurricane)
- Continued rapid weakening forecast next 48 hours
- Expected to become a tropical storm later today
- Hurricane force winds extend 10 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend 45 miles
- No coastal watches or warnings in effect

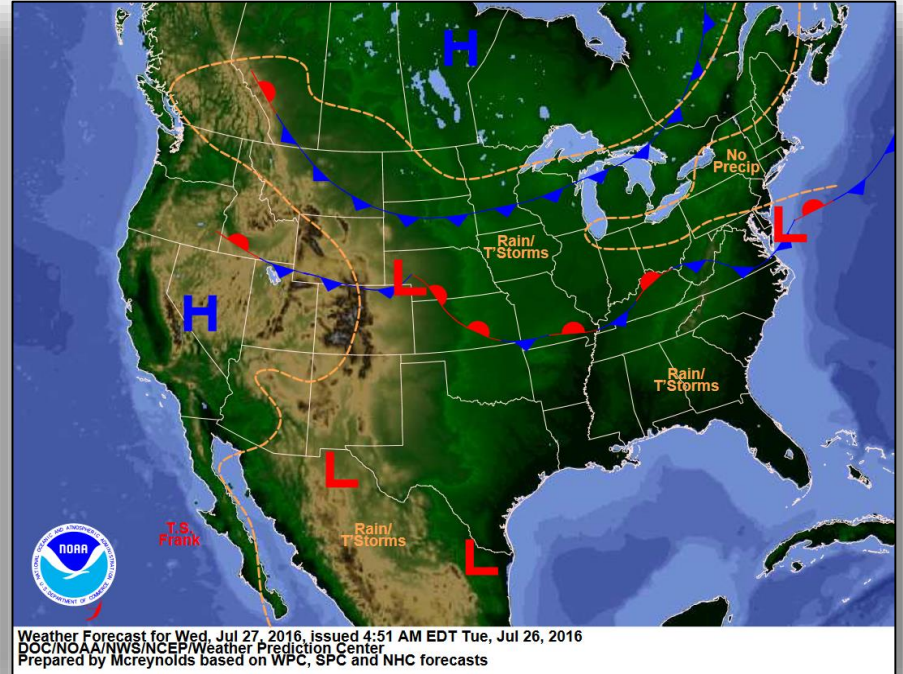
Tropical Outlook - Atlantic

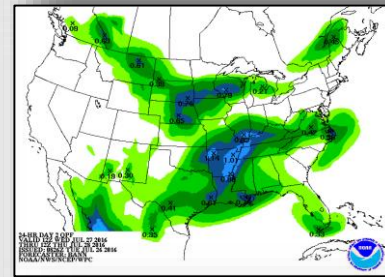
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



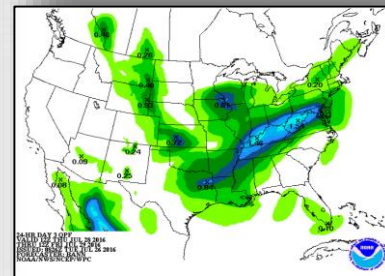

Current Situation

- Fire began on July 11, 2016, on federal land 20 miles NE of Dubois (Fremont County - pop 41k) and moving onto private land
- Threatening communities of Union Pass, Porcupine, Warm Springs, and Hat Butte
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 789 residents

- Region VIII RWC remains at Watch/Steady State

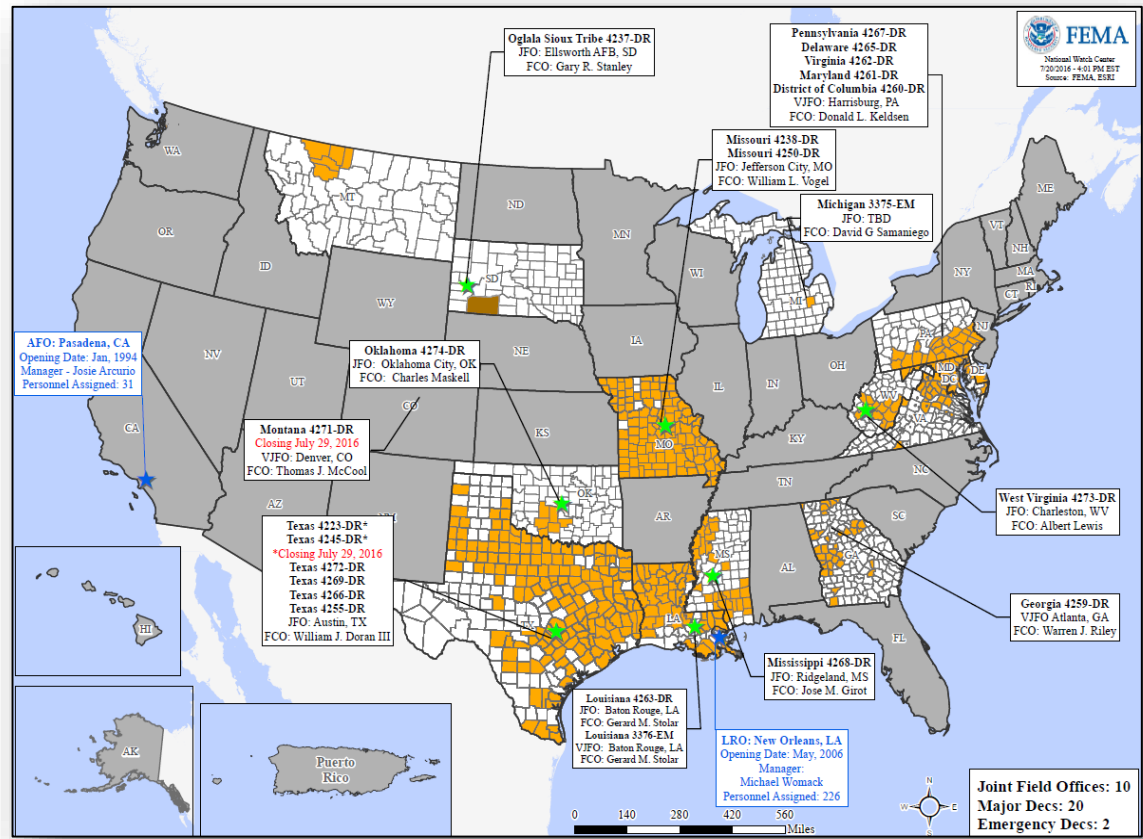

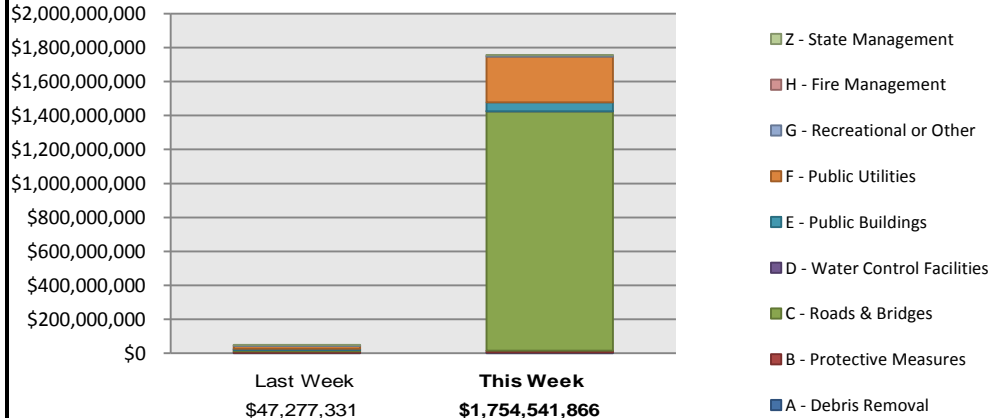

Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 07/11/2016 through 07/25/2016



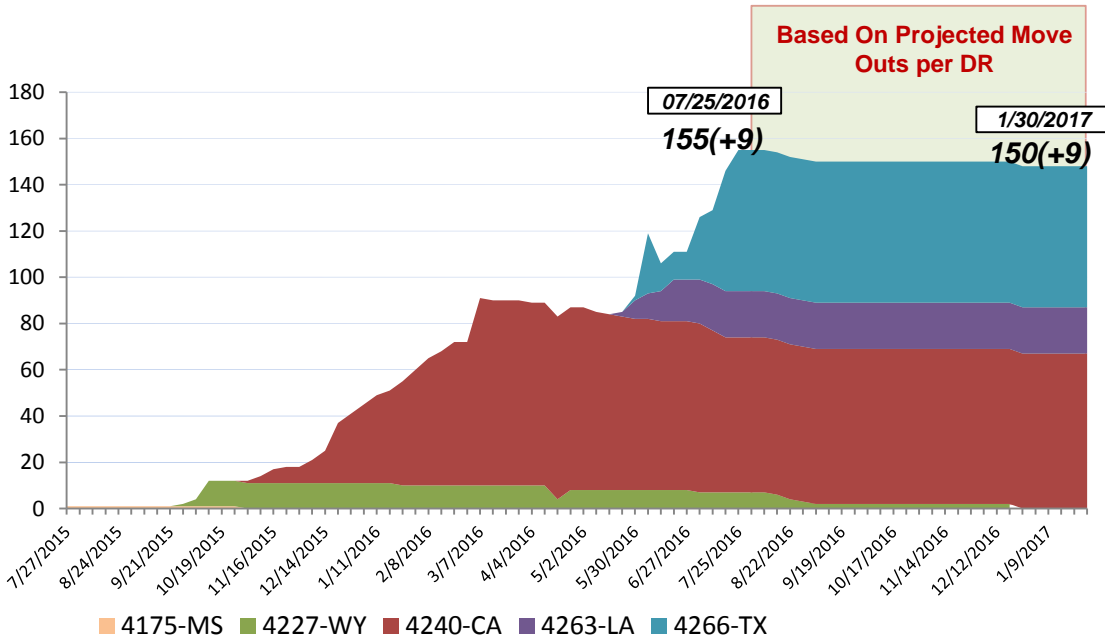

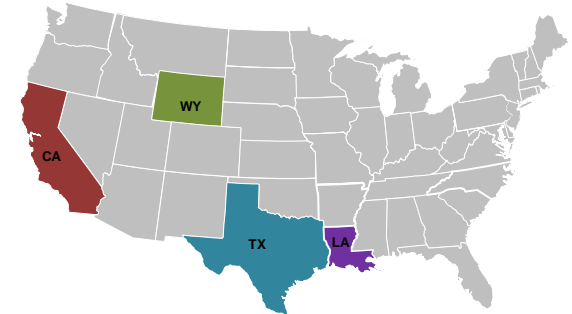

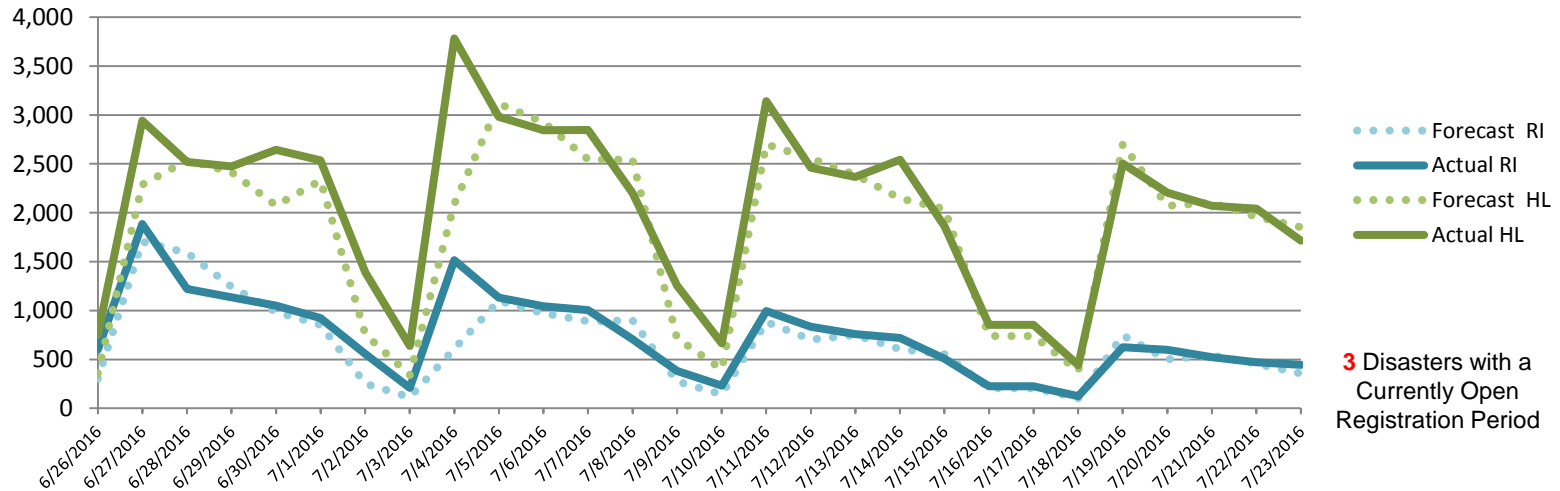

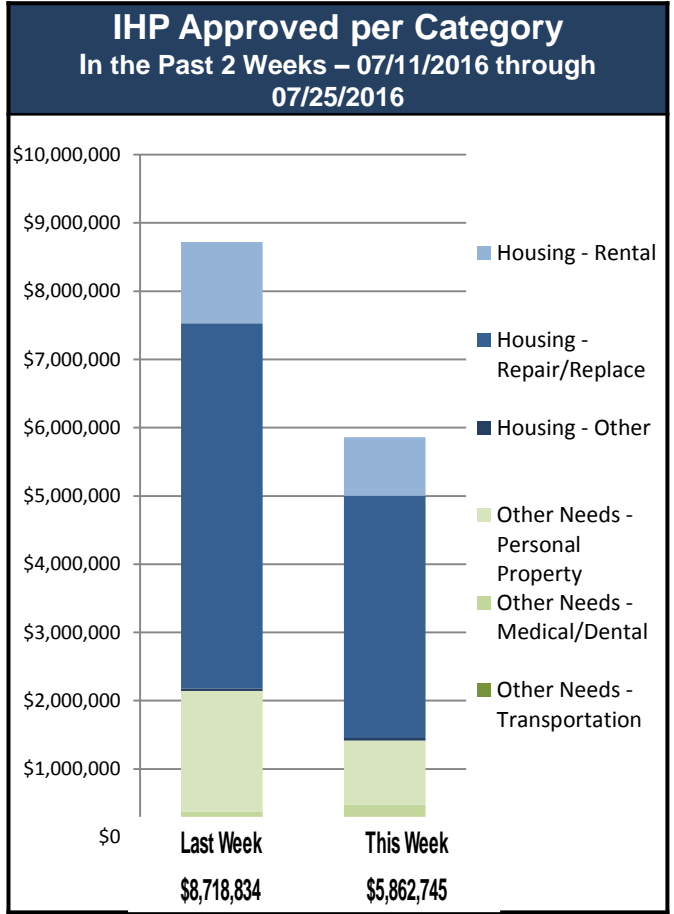
NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 06/26/2016 through 07/23/2016
