- Atlantic –Disturbance 1 (Low 0%)
- Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Javier
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected through early Wednesday morning
- Western Pacific – No activity threatening U.S. territories

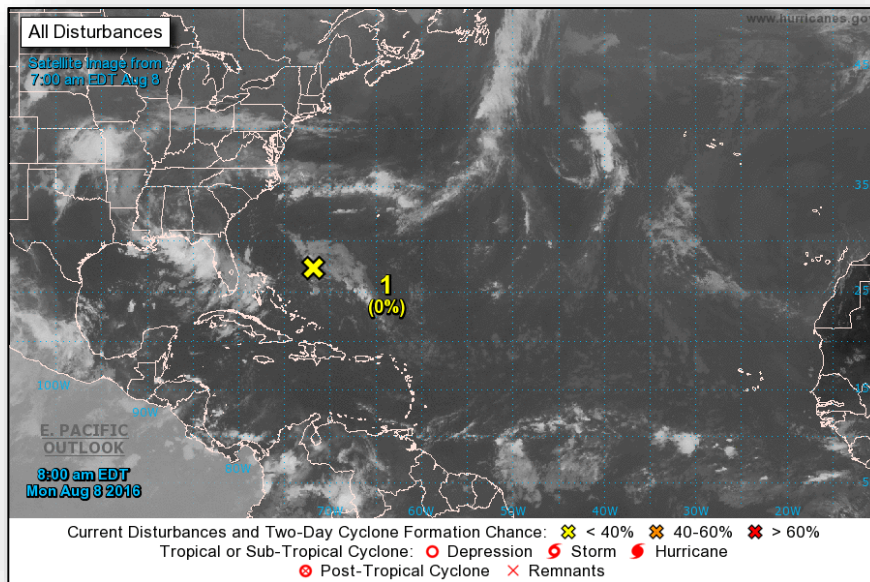
Significant Weather:

- Heavy Rainfall/Flash Flooding – Middle Mississippi Valley; Southeast to Central Appalachians; Florida Big Bend
- Elevated Fire Weather areas – ID, UT, NV, WY, & MT
- Red Flag Warnings –WY
- Space Weather – Past 24 hours, Minor with Radio Blackouts reaching R1; Next 24 hours, Minor with Geomagnetic storms reaching the G1 level are likely

Tropical Outlook - Atlantic



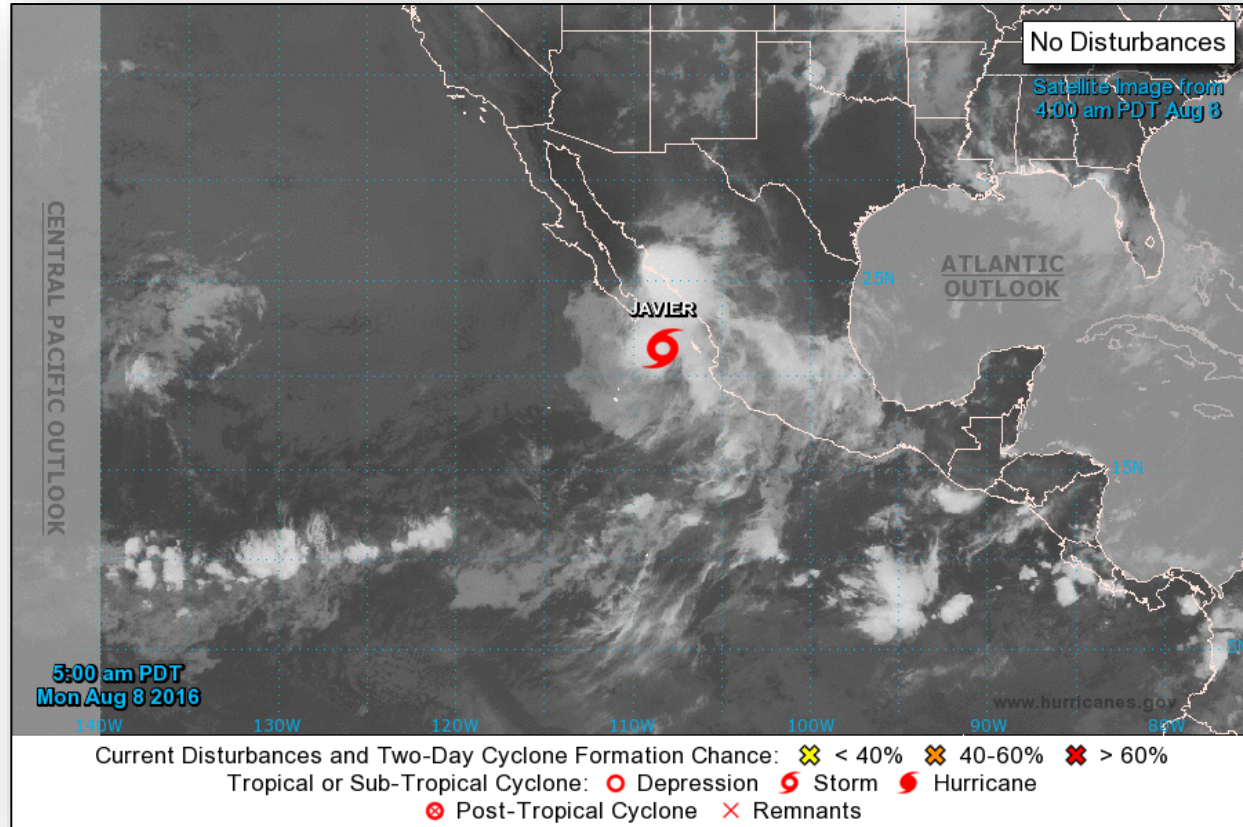
Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (Near 0%)

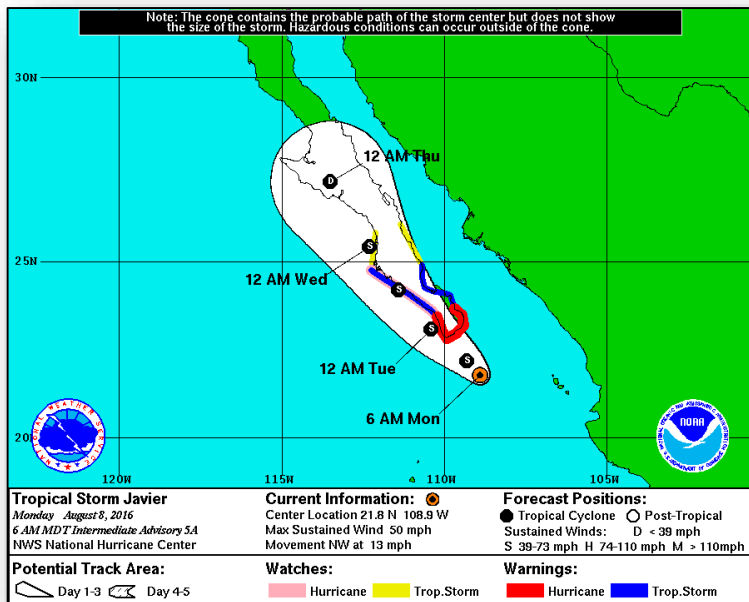
Tropical Outlook - Eastern Pacific



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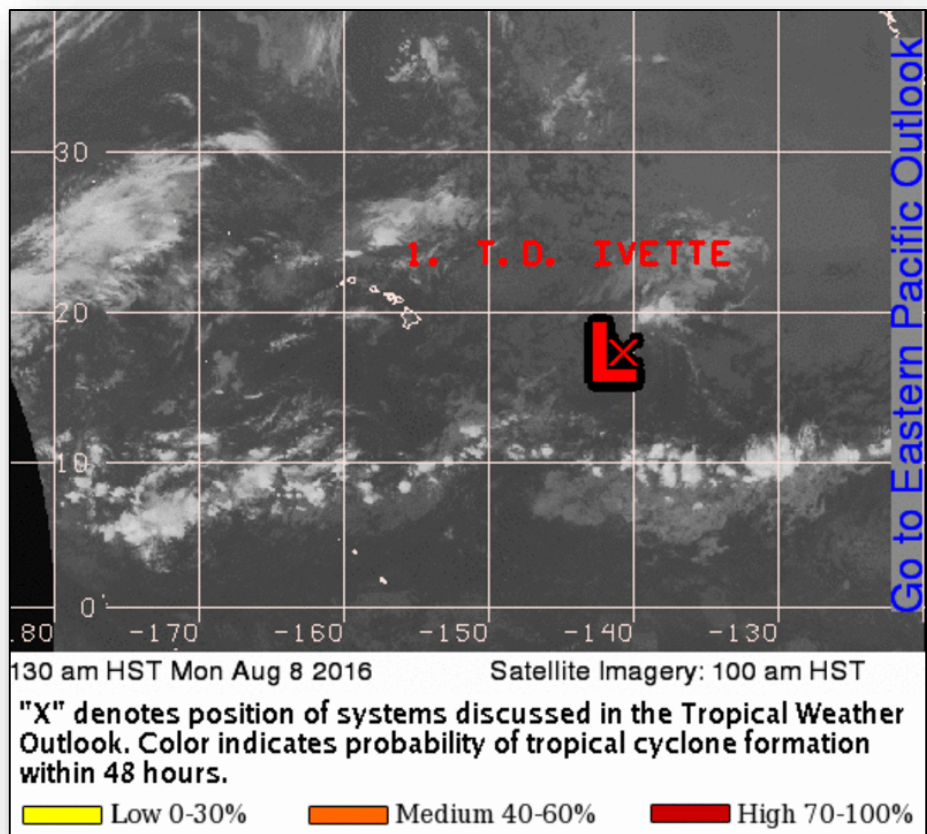

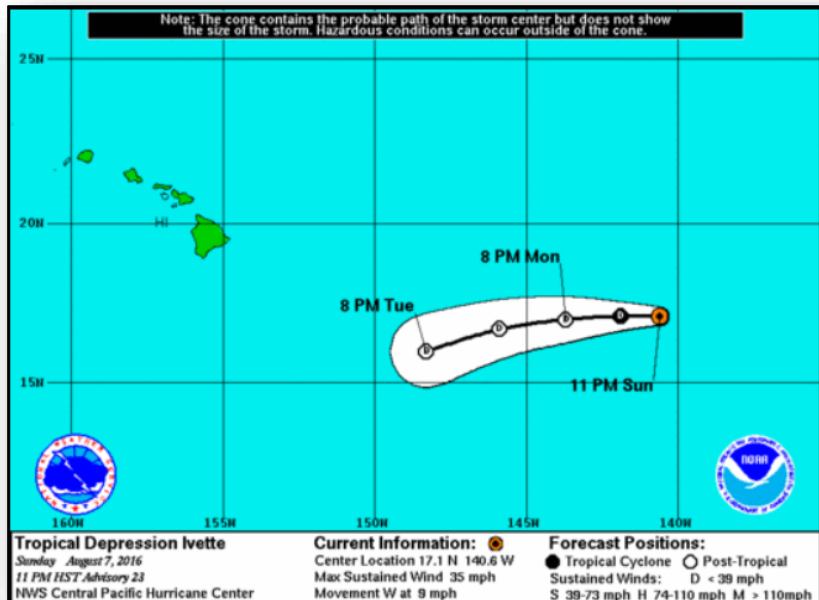
Tropical Storm Javier (Advisory #5a as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located about 100 miles SW of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico
- Moving NW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- A decrease in forward speed expected Tuesday
- Strengthening expected within next 24 – 48 hours
- Could become a hurricane as it passes Baja California, Mexico
- Tropical-storm force winds extend 60 miles

Tropical Outlook - Central Pacific



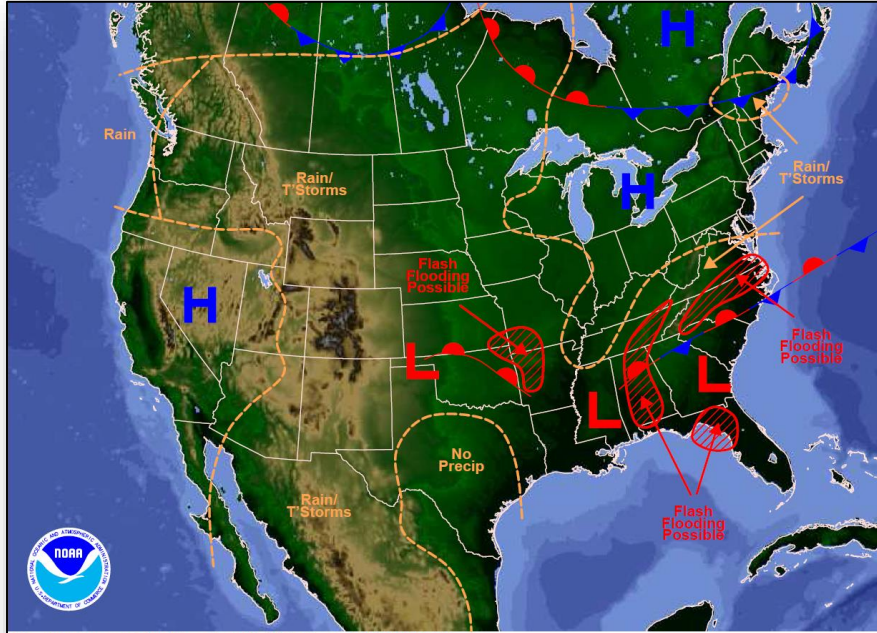
Tropical Outlook - Central Pacific



Tropical Depression Ivette (Advisory #23 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

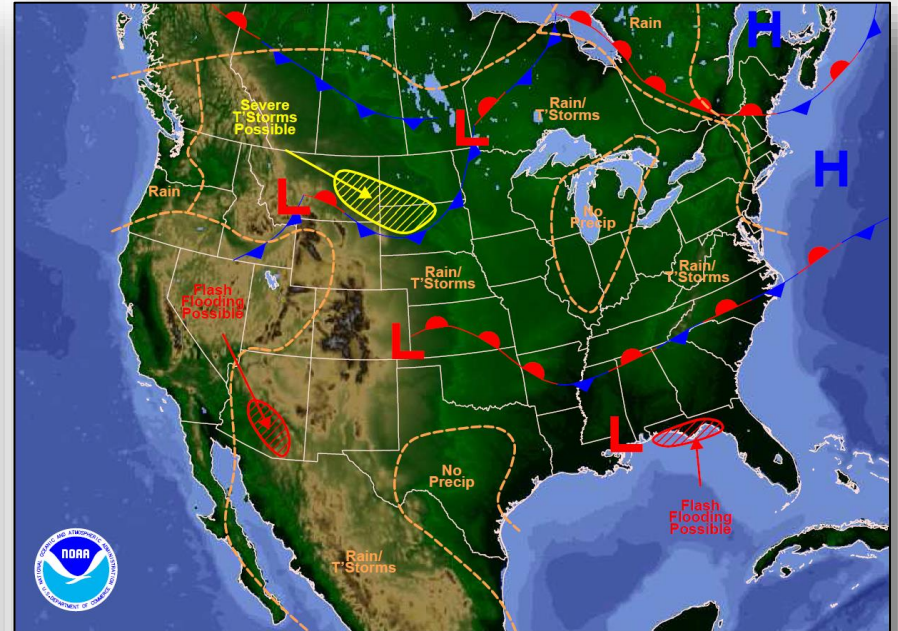
- Located about 965 miles East of Hilo, HI

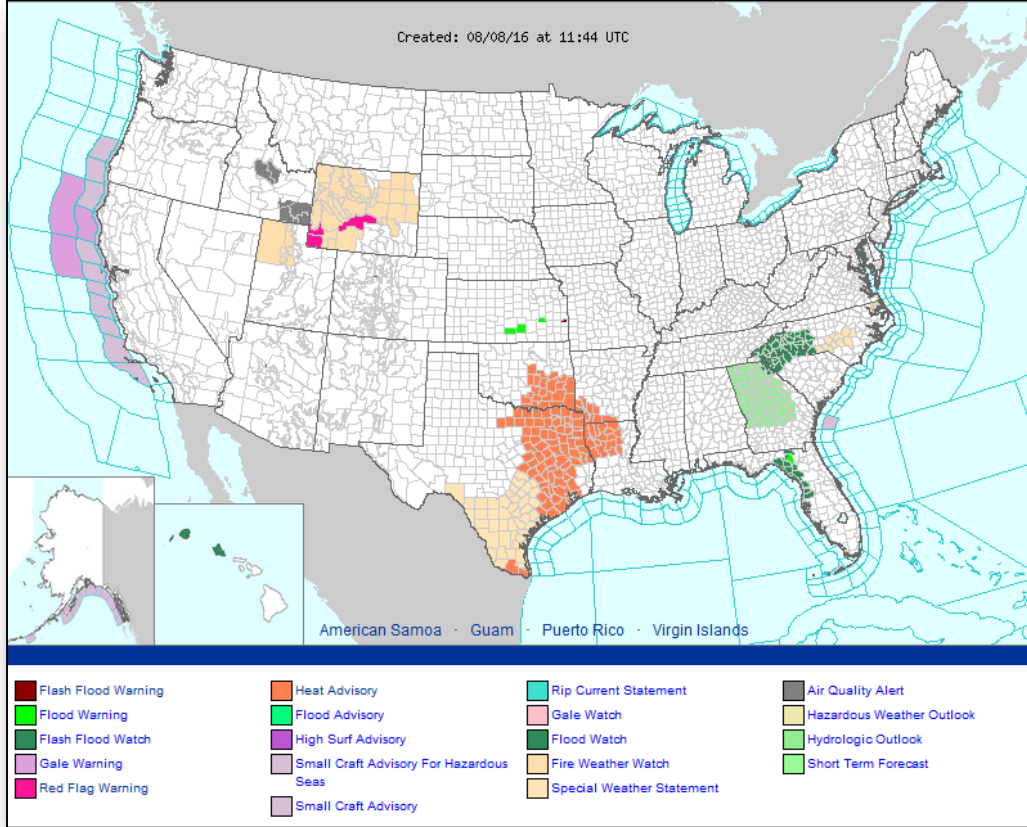

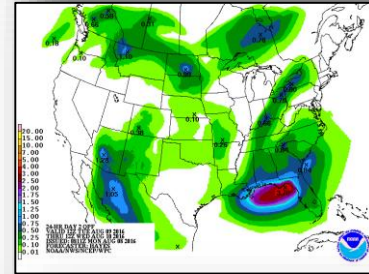
Precipitation Forecast - Days 1-3



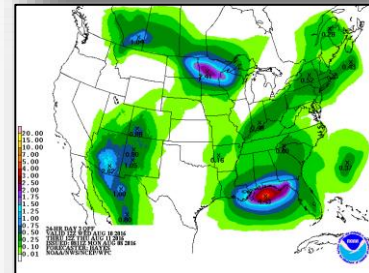

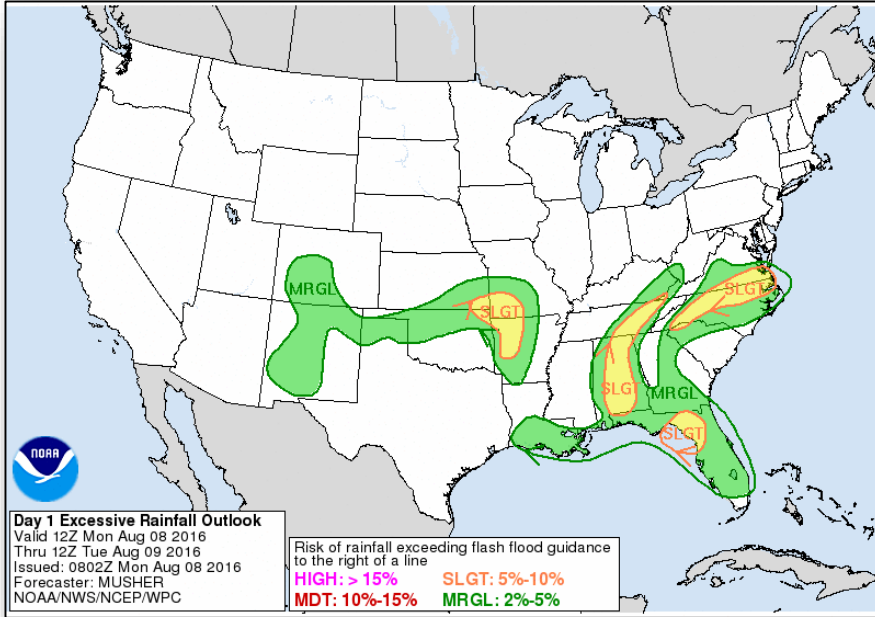
Precipitation Forecast - Days 4 - 5



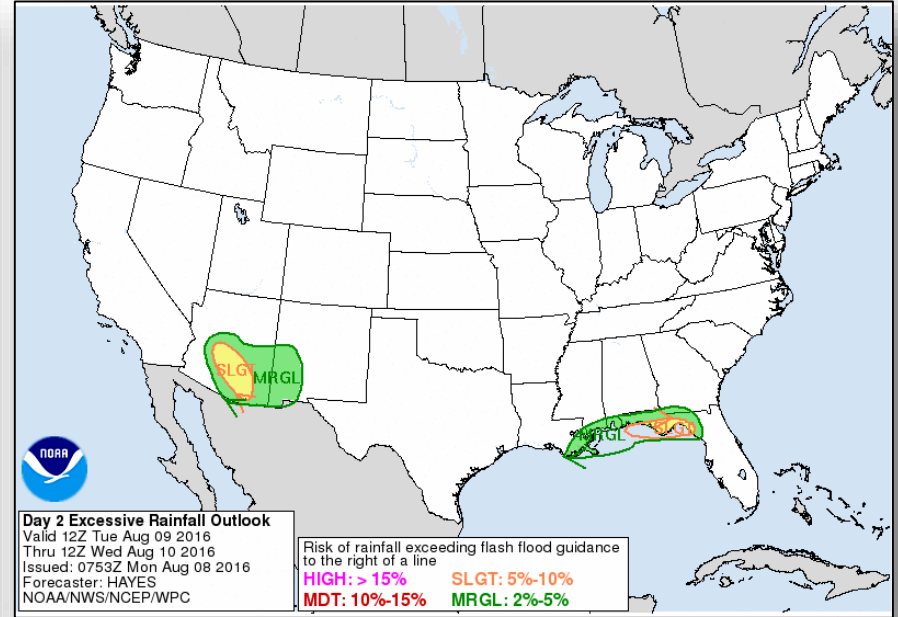
Severe Weather Outlook - Days 1-3



Flash Flood Potential

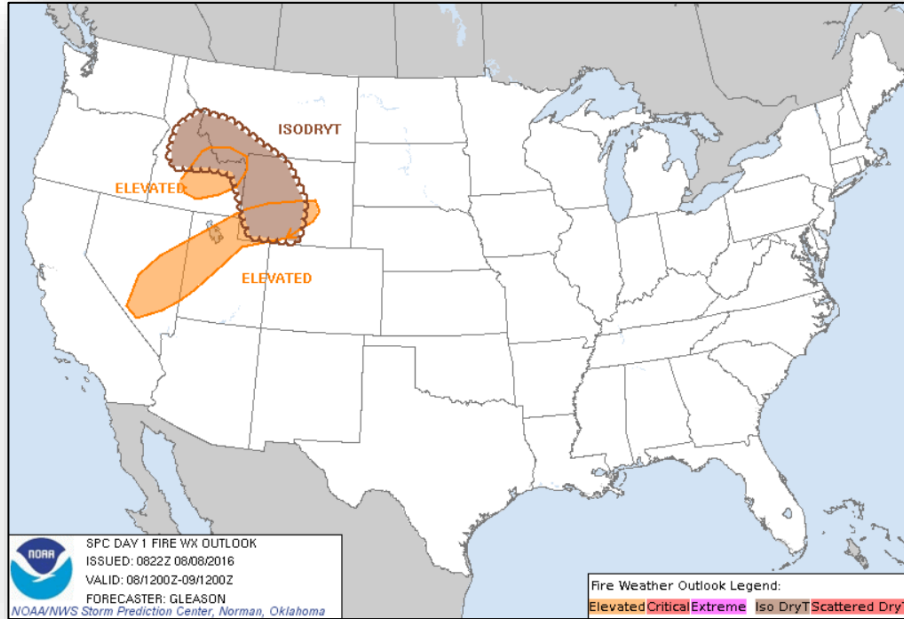

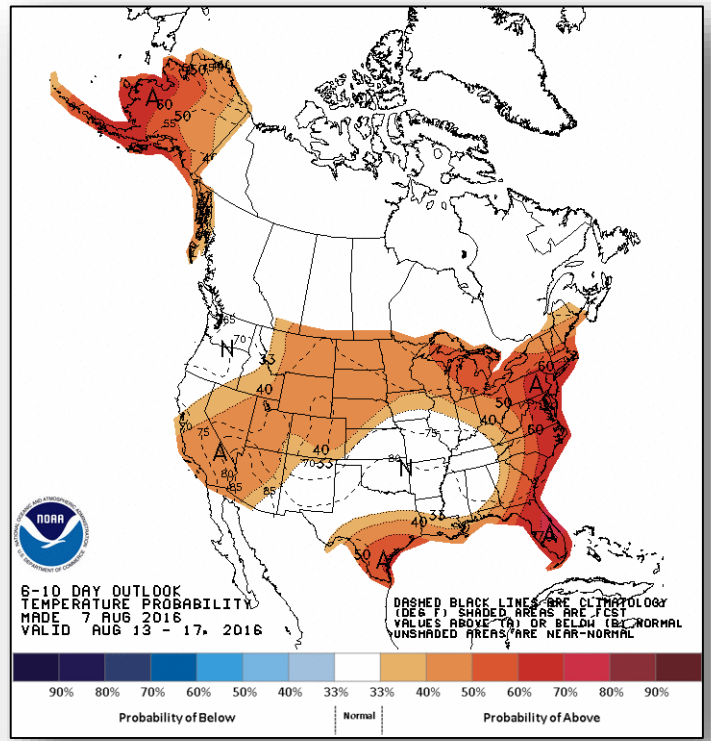

6 - 10 Day Temperature Probability

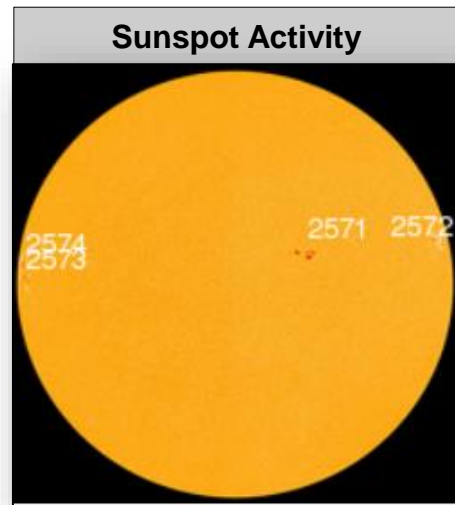
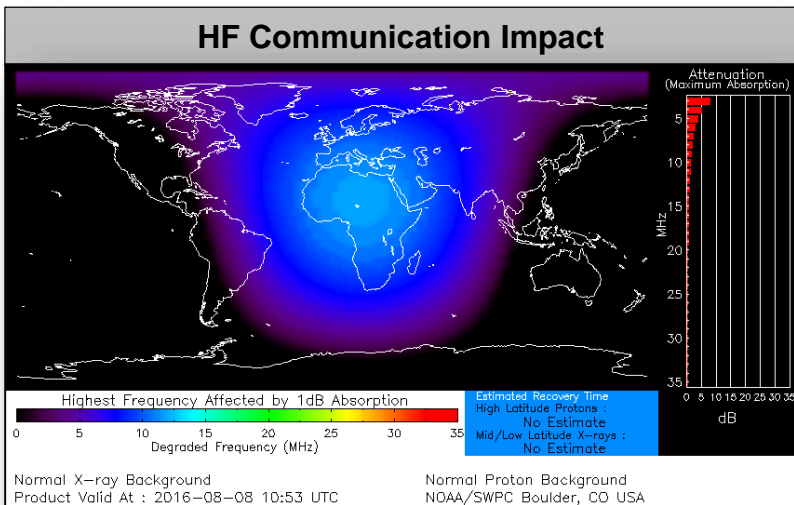


6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

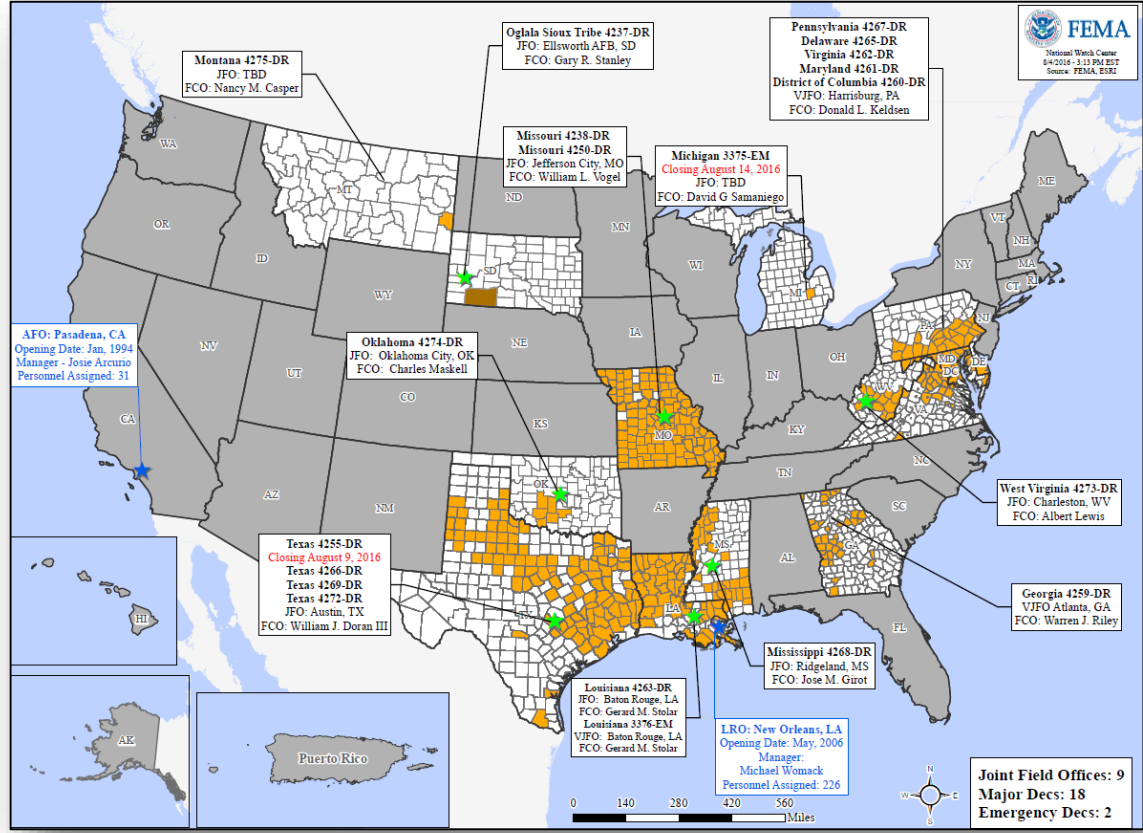
