Significant Activity – August 7-8



Significant Events: No significant activity

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Tropical Storm Franklin; Disturbance 1 – Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1 – Low (20%)
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected next 48 hours
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Flash flooding possible – Central/Southern High Plains, southeast TX to Lower Mississippi Valley; coastal Carolinas
- Red Flag Warnings – OR & CA
- Isolated dry thunderstorms – WA, OR, CA, NV, ID, UT & MT
- Space weather:
 - Past 24 hours: None observed
 - Next 24 hours: None predicted

Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

Declaration Activity: None

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic




Tropical Storm Franklin (Advisory #7a as of 7:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 85 miles NW of Chetumal, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 14 mph; maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Weakening expected; re-strengthening forecast tonight as it moves over Bay of Campeche
- Tropical storm force winds extend 140 miles
- Hurricane Watch and Tropical Storm Watches/Warnings in effect for coast of Mexico

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 800 miles E of Lesser Antilles
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Some development is possible this weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)



Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Area of low pressure may form a couple of hundred miles S of southern tip of Baja California peninsula late this week in association with remnants of Tropical Storm Franklin after it moves across southern Mexico
- Moving WNW or NW at 10 mph
- Conditions may be conducive for some re-development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific




48 Hour Outlook




5 Day Outlook




Precipitation Forecast














PA Highlights

- DR 4308-CA - Approximately \$14 million was obligated for Category A – Debris Removal.


Direct Housing




States with Currently Occupied Units
