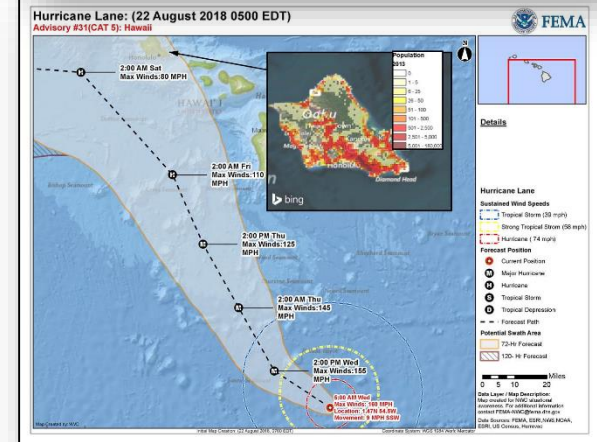
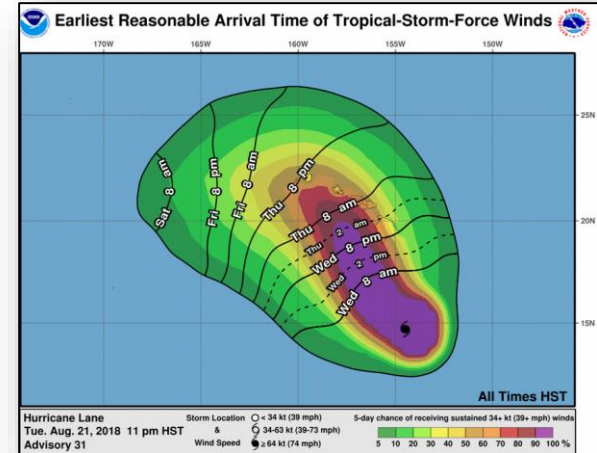

# Hurricane Lane – Central Pacific



## Hurricane Lane – CAT 5 (Advisory #31A as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 335 miles SEE of Kailua-Kona, Hawaii
- Moving WNW at 9 mph; turn toward the NW is expected today; center of Lane will move very close to / over Islands Thursday through Saturday
- Maximum sustained winds 160 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend out 40 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend out 140 miles
- Hurricane Watch in effect for Oahu and Maui County, including the islands of Maui, Lanai, Molokai and Kahoolawe; Hurricane Warning in effect for Hawaii County
- Hazards affecting land:
  - Expected to produce total rain accumulations of 10 to 15 inches with isolated amounts greater than 20 inches; flash flooding and landslides possible
  - Large swells, producing large and potentially damaging surf, will impact the Big Island and spread across the remainder of the island chain today

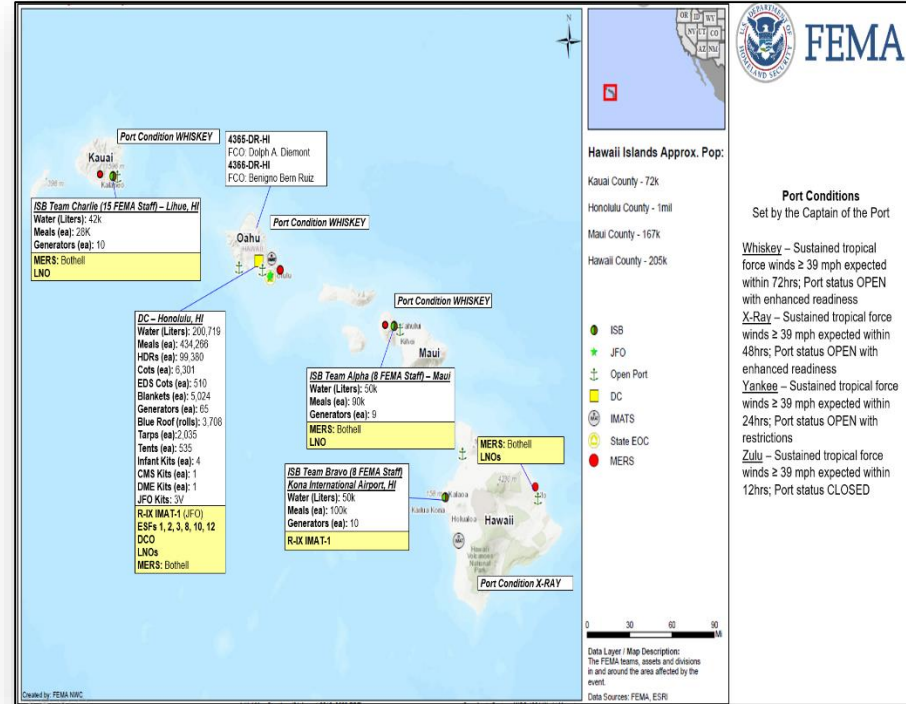
- HI EOC at Full Activation at 1000 PDT
  - Maui County EOC at Partial Activation
  - City and County of Honolulu (Oahu) at Partial Activation
  - Kauai at Partial Activation
- The Governor declared a State of Emergency on August 21
- All public and charter schools and Hawaii State Department of Education offices on Hawaii Island and Maui County will be closed UFN

### FEMA

- Region IX RWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
  - IMAT-1 already deployed to HI (for Kilauea lava flow)
  - ESFs 1, 2, 3, 8, 12, DCO and USCG LNO deployed to HI
- Region VII IMAT deployed to Region IX
- FEMA NWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
- FEMA NRCC will activate to level III today at 9:00 a.m. EDT
- Bothell MERS deployed to Hilo, Honolulu, Maui, and Kauai
- DEC working with Statewide Interoperability Coordinator (SWIC)
- ISB Teams deployed to Maui, Kona, and Kauai
- Reservist from HLT supporting / monitoring

- X-RAY – Maui, Oahu, and Kauai
- YANKEE – Hawaii County (Big Island) (port is closed for entry)

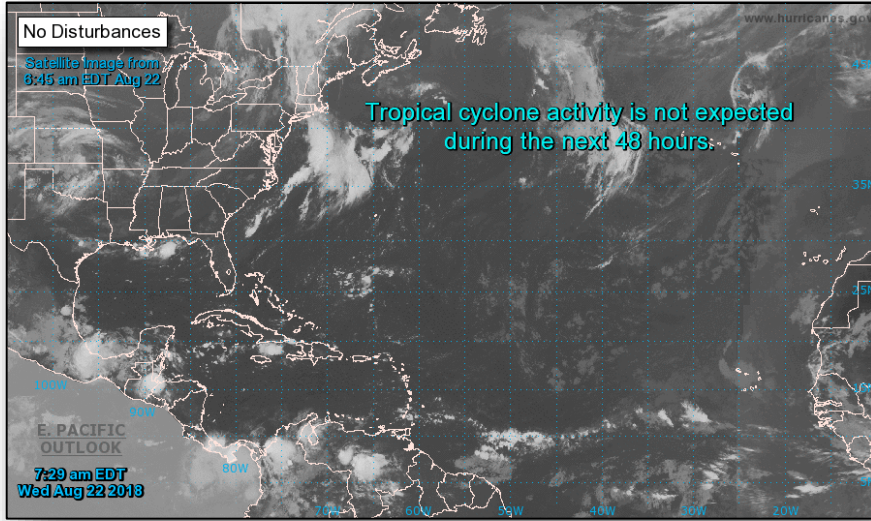
**Whiskey** – Sustained tropical force winds  $\geq$  39 mph expected within 72hrs; Port status OPEN with enhanced readiness

**Yankee** – Sustained tropical force winds  $\geq$  39 mph expected within 24hrs; Port status OPEN with restrictions

**Zulu** – Sustained tropical force winds  $\geq$  39 mph expected within 12hrs; Port status CLOSED

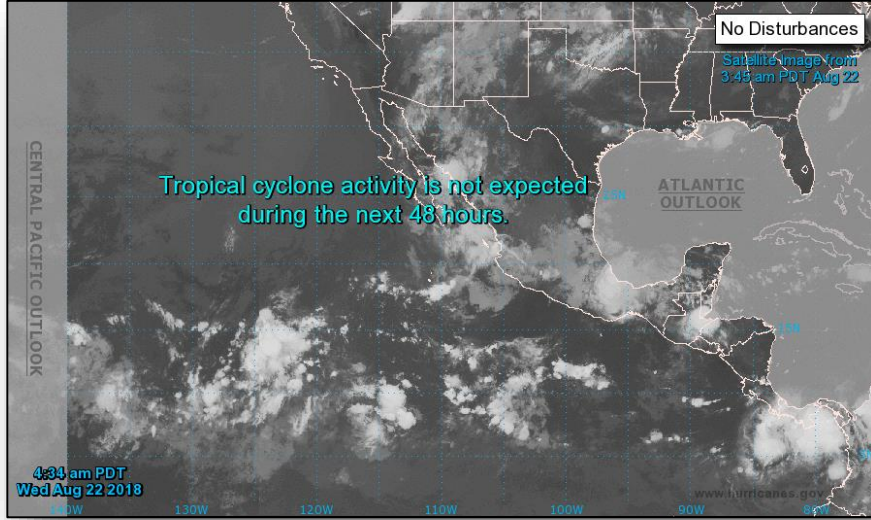


**48 Hour Outlook**
