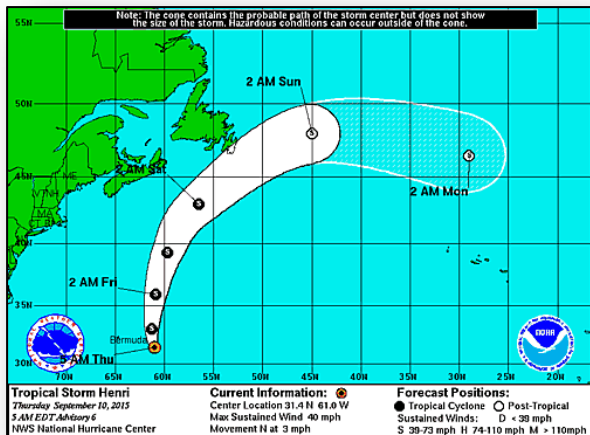
- Atlantic: Tropical Storm Henri; Disturbance 1 (Low-0%)
- Eastern Pacific: Tropical Storm Linda; Disturbance 1 (Low-10%)

- Western Pacific: No significant activity affecting U.S. territories

- Rain/thunderstorms – So. California, Southwest, Central & Southern Plains across to eastern half of U.S.
- Red Flag Warnings – WY

- Space weather: Past 24 hours – Moderate w/G2 Level occurred; next 24 hours – Moderate w/G2 Level expected

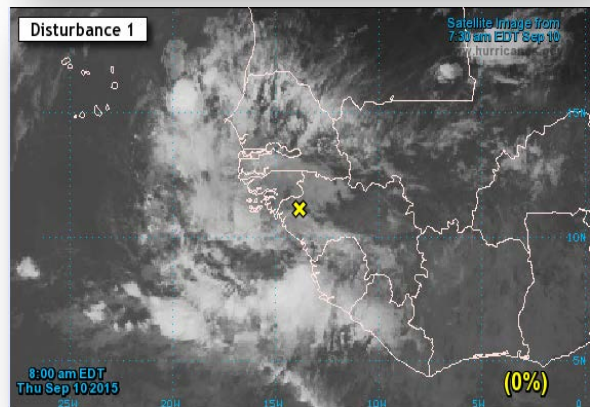

2-Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Tropical Storm Henri (Advisory #6): (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located about 230 miles ESE of Bermuda
- Moving N at 3 mph; general motion expected to continue
- Maximum sustained winds are 40 mph
- Some strengthening is forecast during the next day or so
- Tropical storm-force winds extend up to 125 mph
- No coastal watches and warnings are in effect



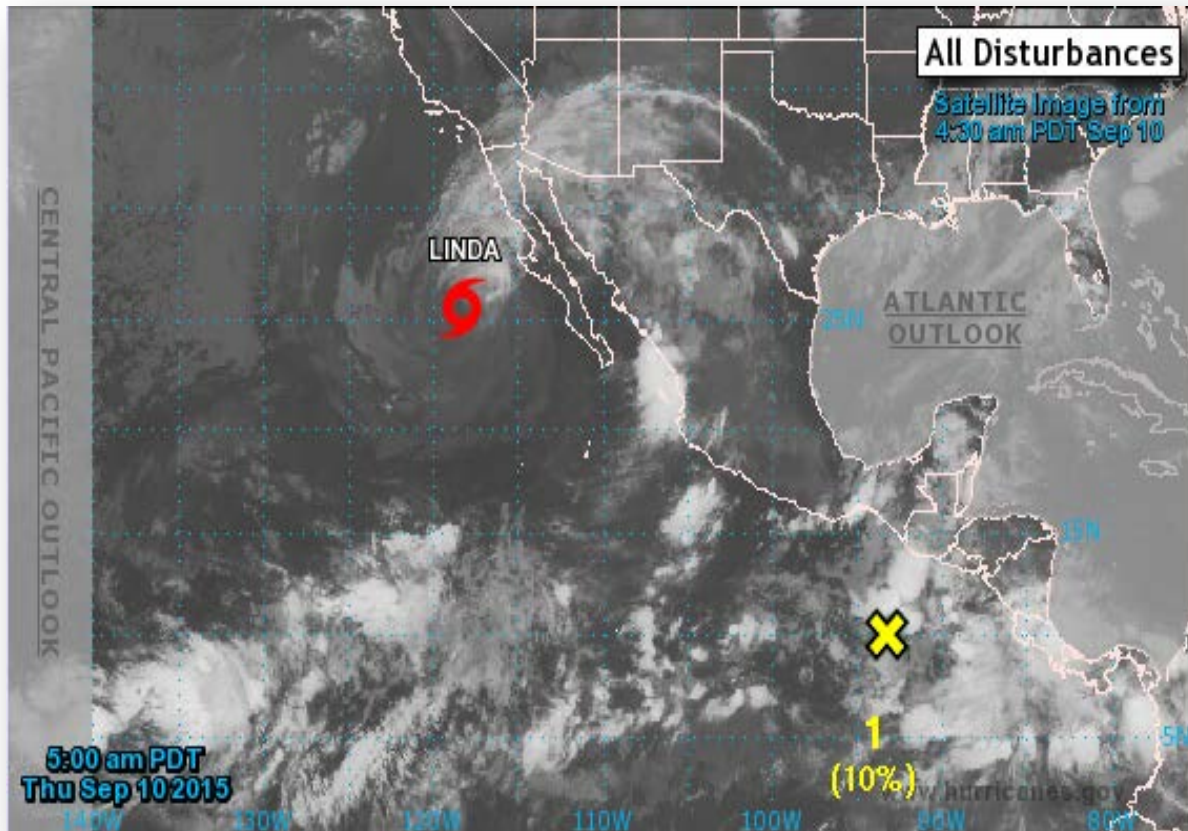
Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located off the west coast of Africa
- Moving W at 15 mph
- Slow development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

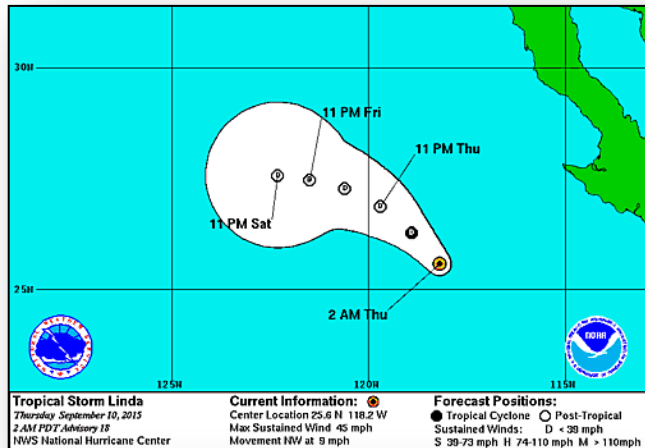
2 – Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



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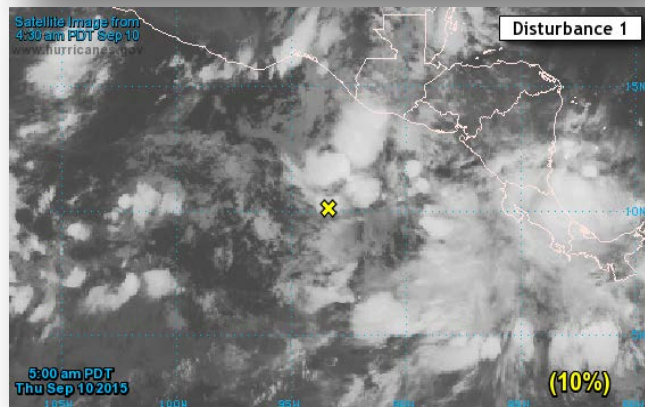


2-Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Linda (Advisory #18) (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

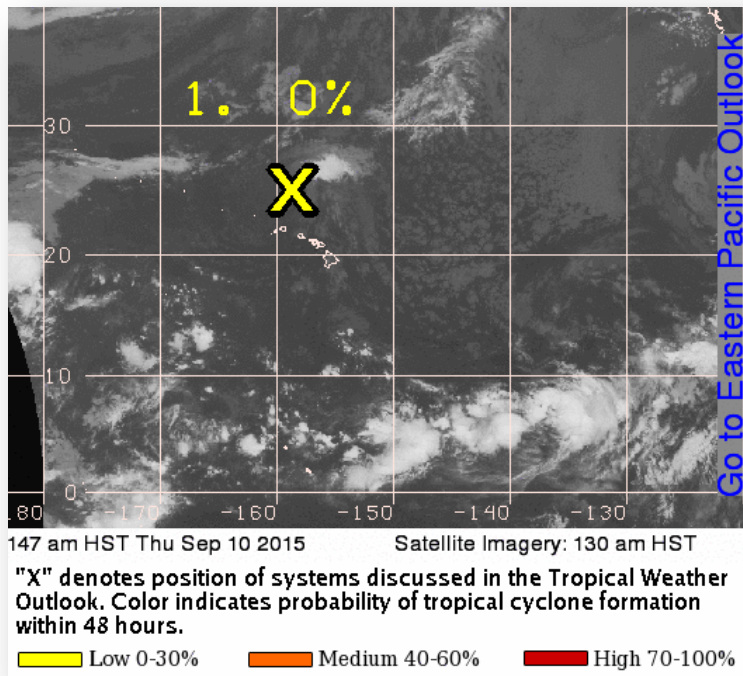
- Located 245 miles SW of Punta Eugenia, Mexico
- Moving NW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds near 45 mph
- Tropical storm-force winds extend 70 miles
- Forecast to become a remnant low by tonight



Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Few hundred miles SSW of the coast of Guatemala
- Moving WNW at 10 mph
- Environmental conditions are forecast to be somewhat conducive for gradual development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)

2 – Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Remnant Low (Post-TD Jimena): (as of 11:00 p.m. EDT) **FINAL**

- Located 225 miles N of Lihue, HI
- Moving WSW near 10 mph
- Environmental conditions may inhibit development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)

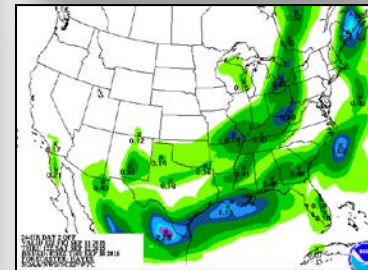
Severe Weather Outlook, Days 1 – 3



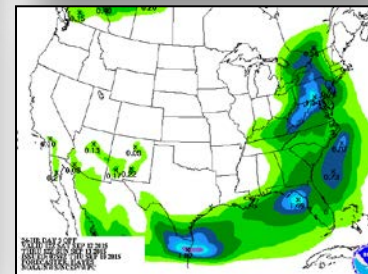
Precipitation Forecast, 1 – 3 Day

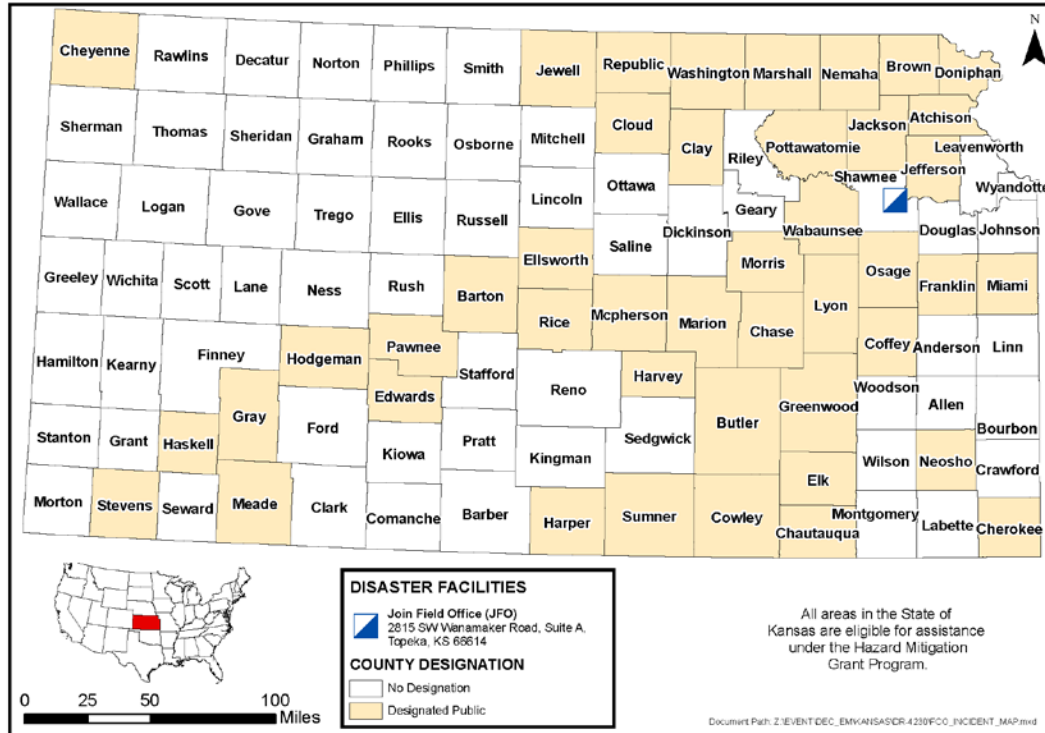
