**Tropical Activity Western Pacific:** No activity affecting U.S. interests

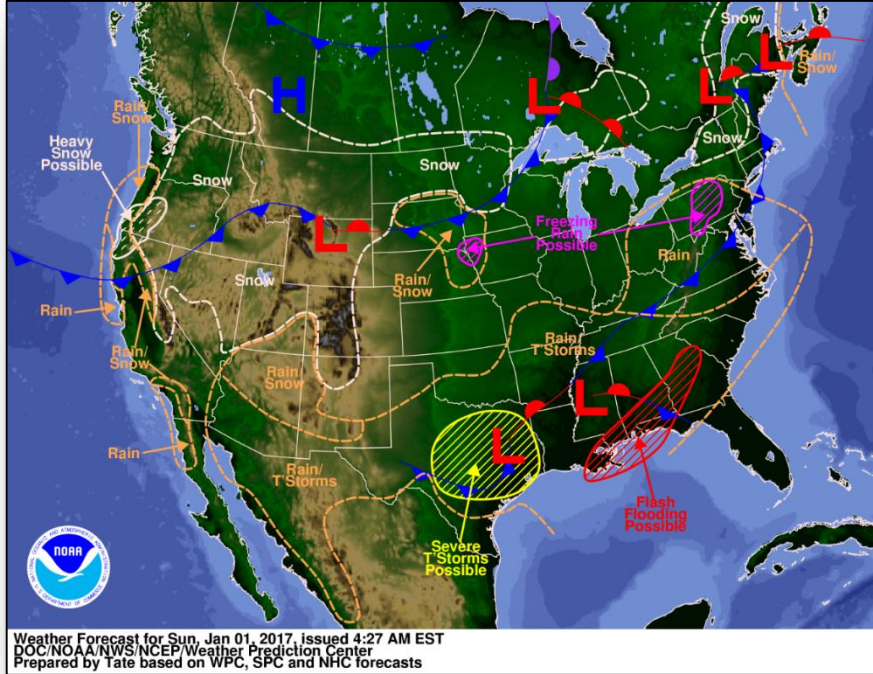

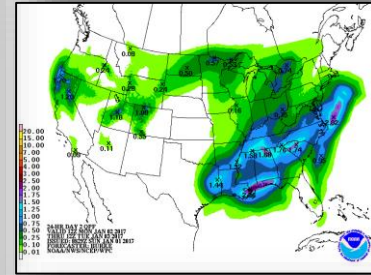
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



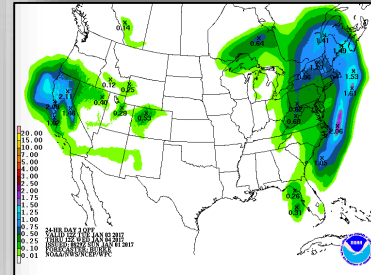

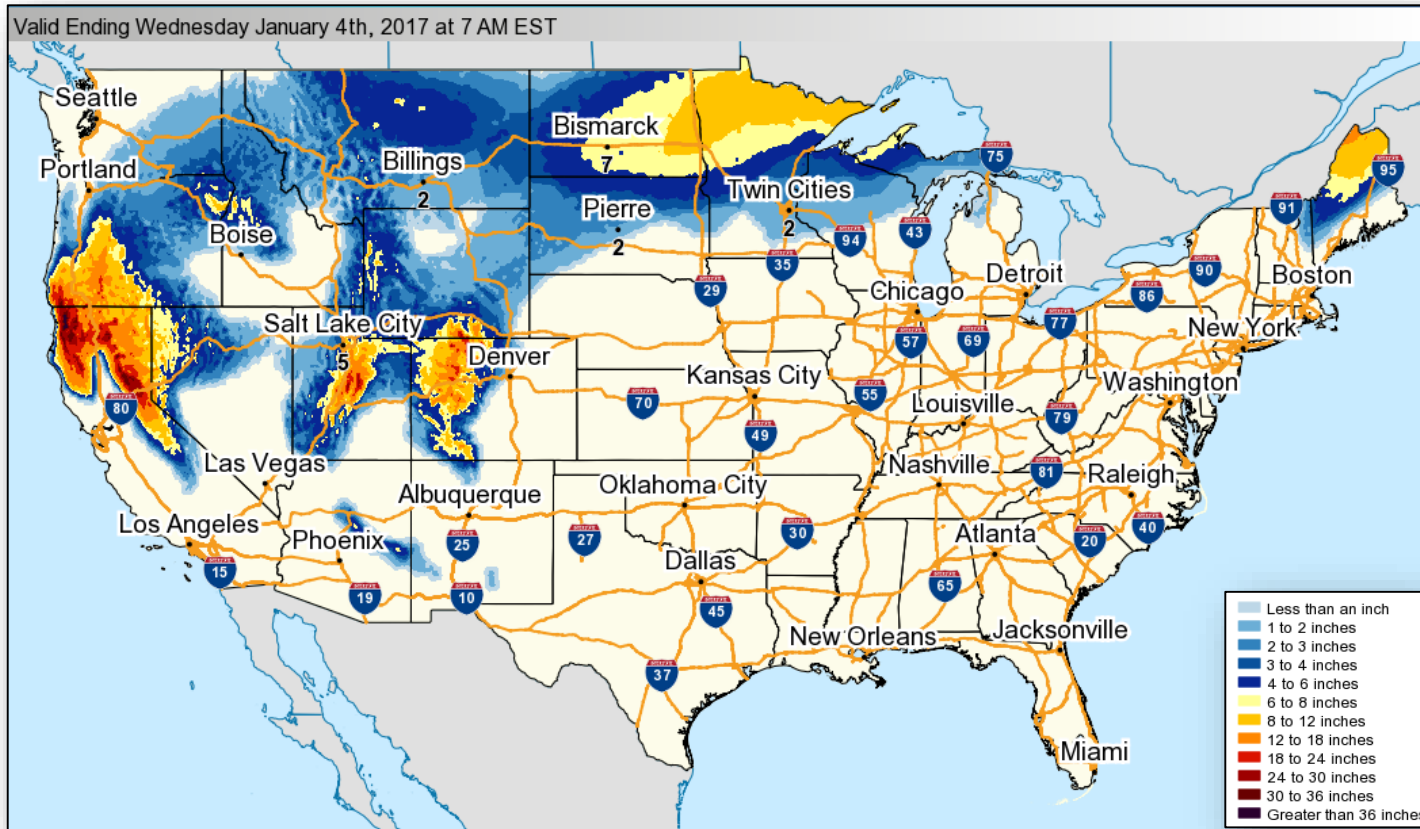

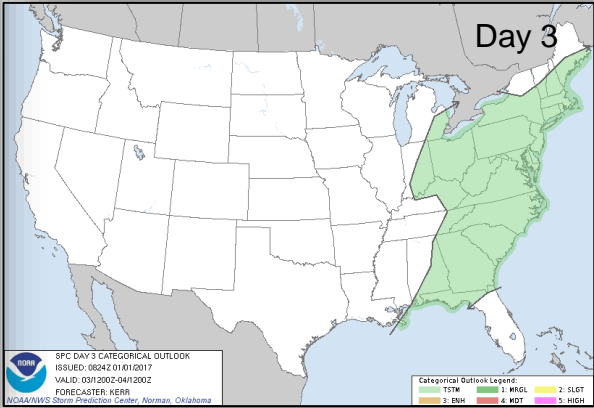
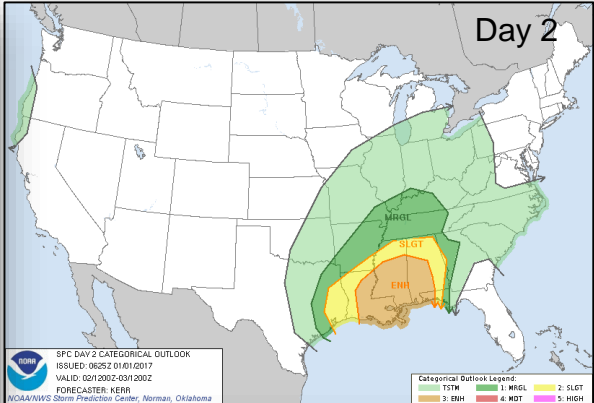
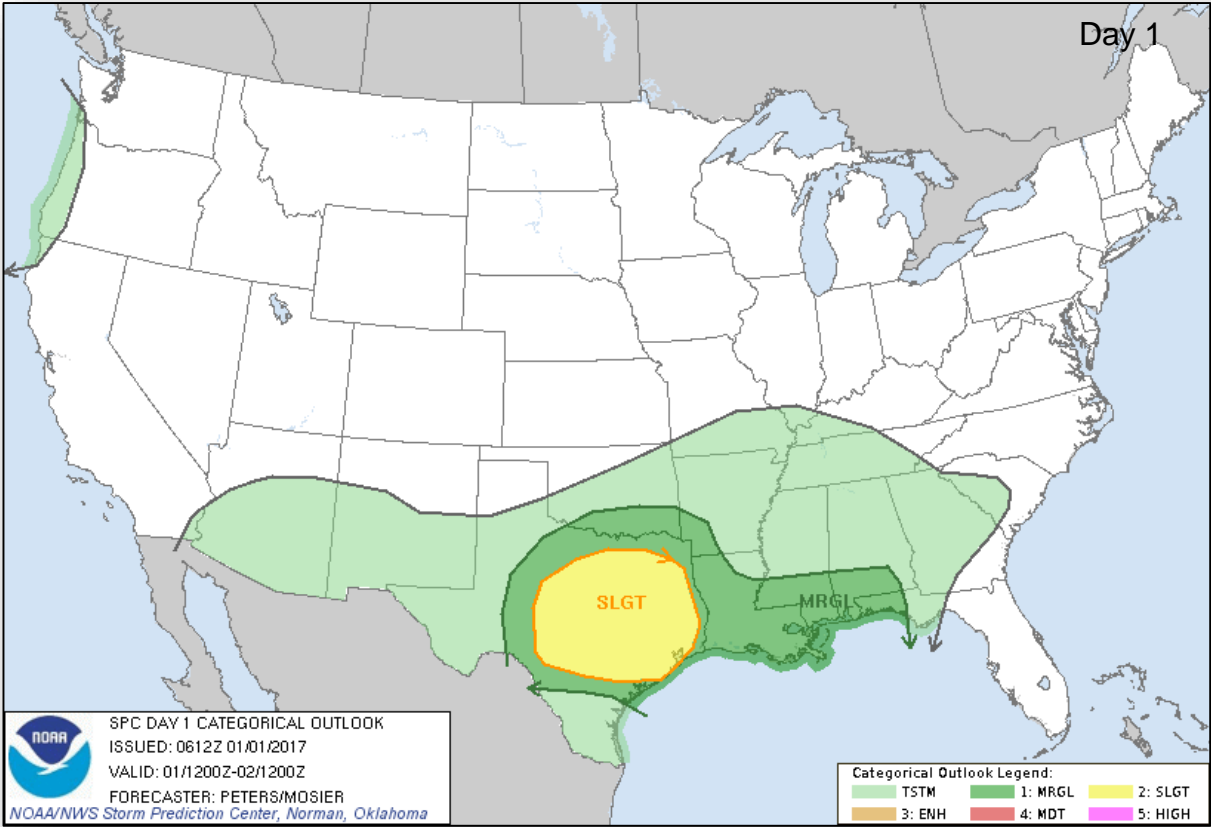
# Forecast Snowfall – Days 1-3

# Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3

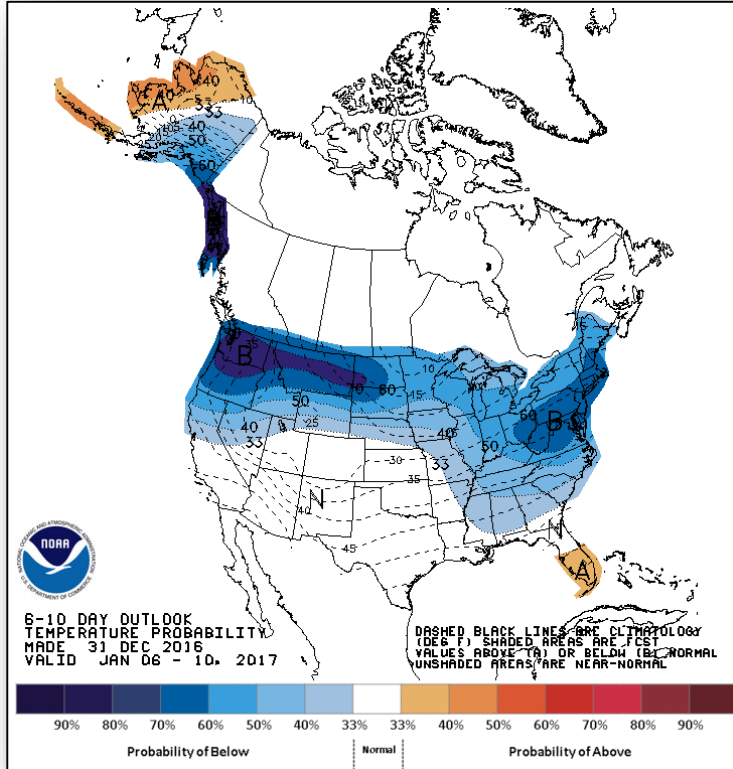




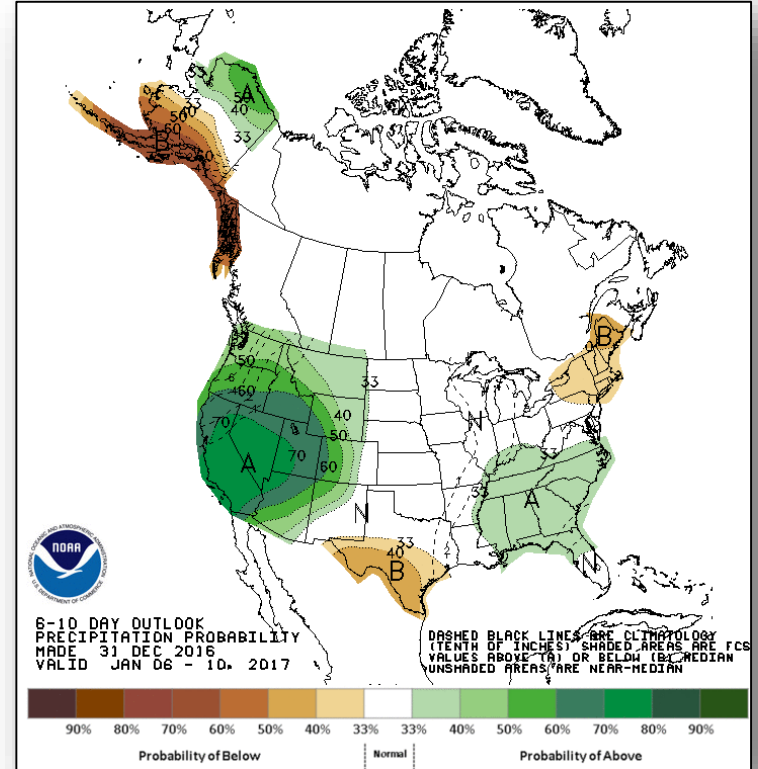
# 6-10 Day Outlooks

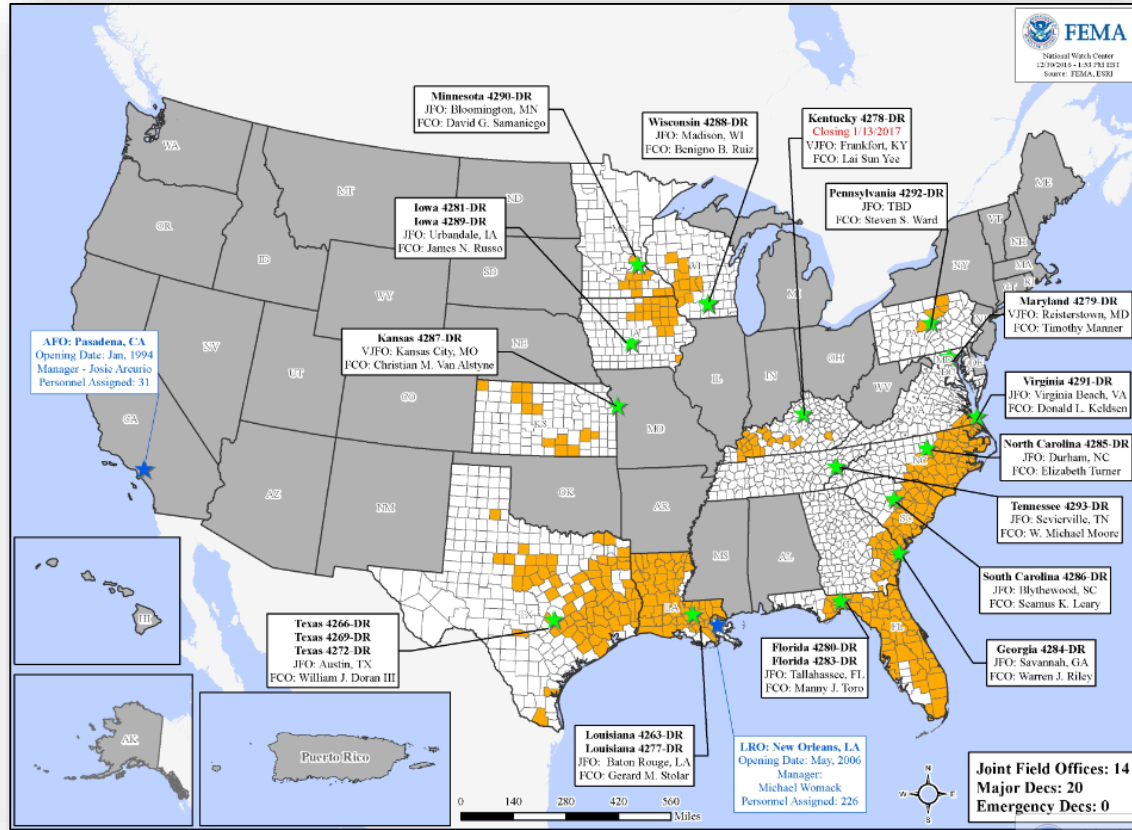
