**Significant Events:** No significant activity

## **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic – Tropical Cyclone Activity is not expected during the next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Simon
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected through Wednesday evening

## **Significant Weather:**

- Slight risk of severe thunderstorms – northern Mid-Atlantic to southern New England
- Isolated severe thunderstorms – eastern OK to the Ohio Valley
- TS Simon expected to bring heavy rain/flash flooding to portions of the Southwest today/Wednesday
- Blizzard conditions developing – northeast Alaska
- No Red Flag Warnings/Critical Fire Weather

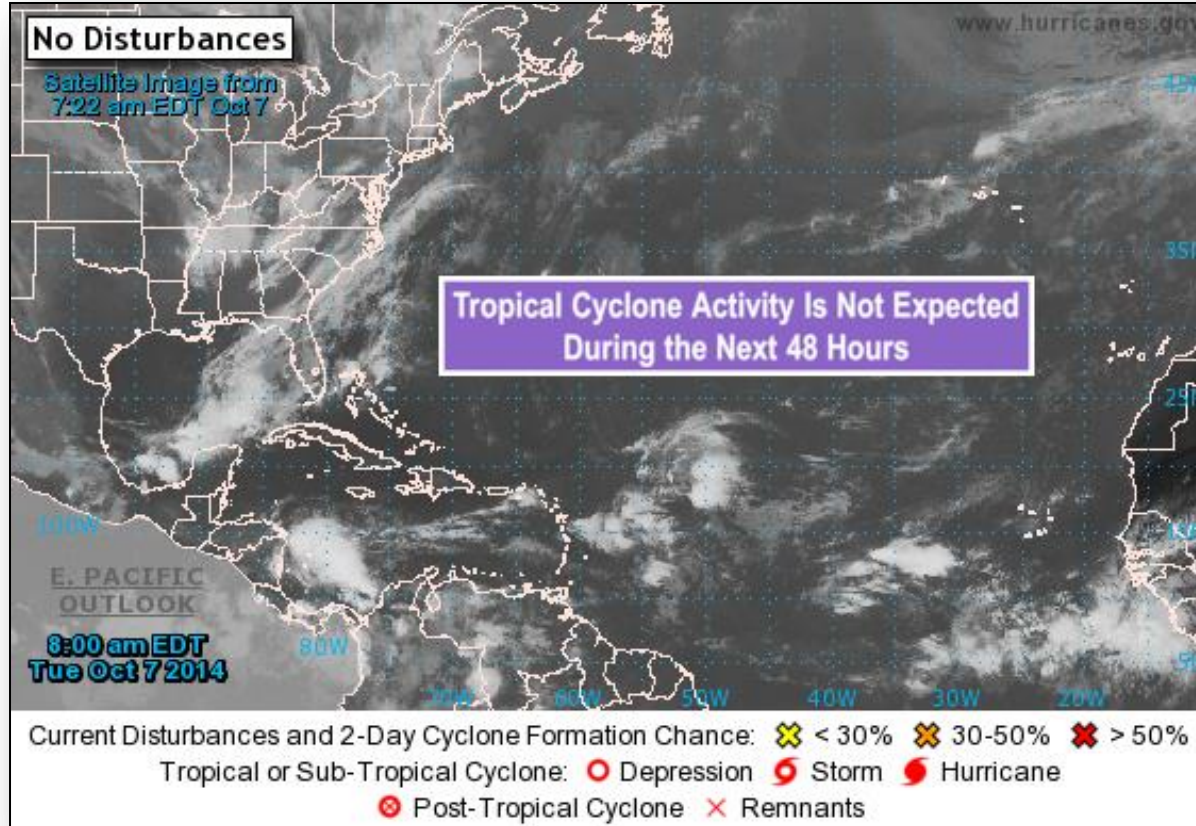

# 2-Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



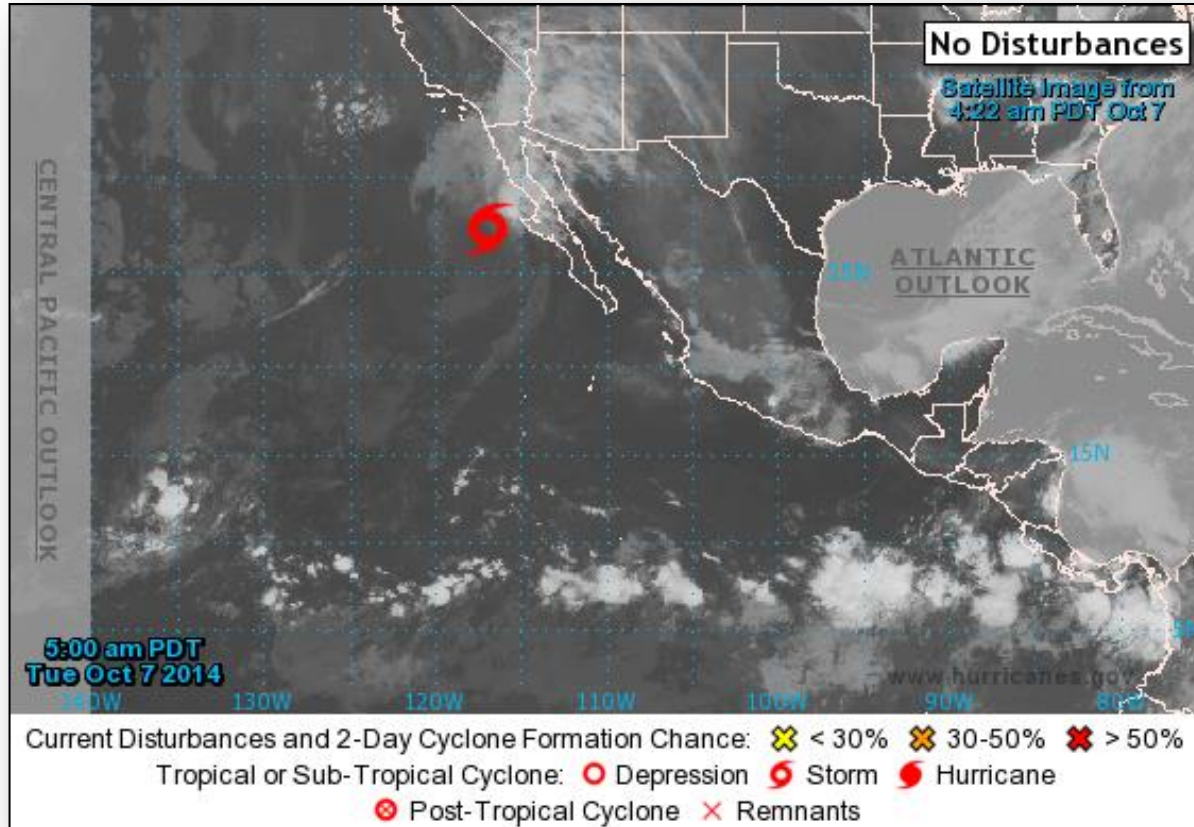

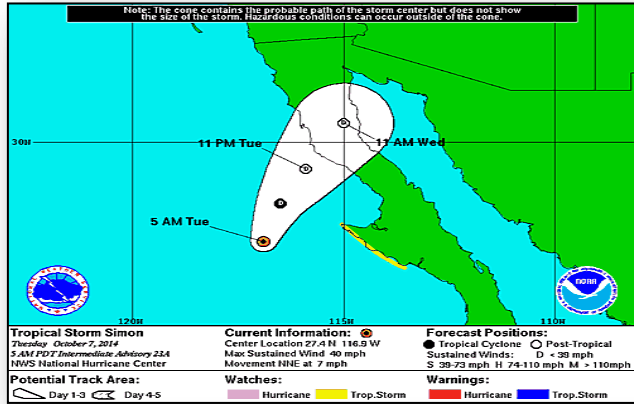
# 2-Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

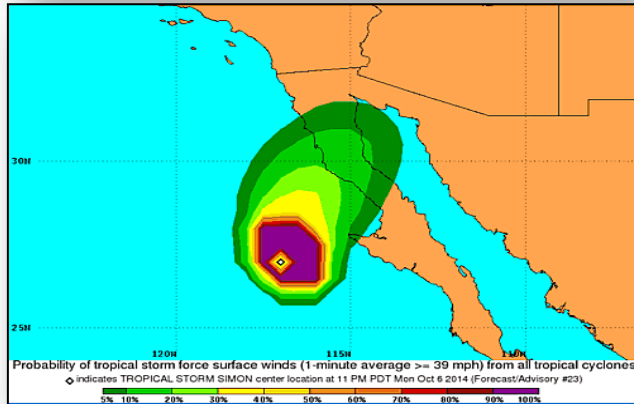

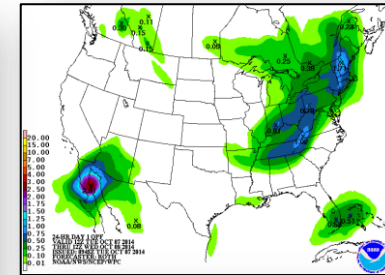
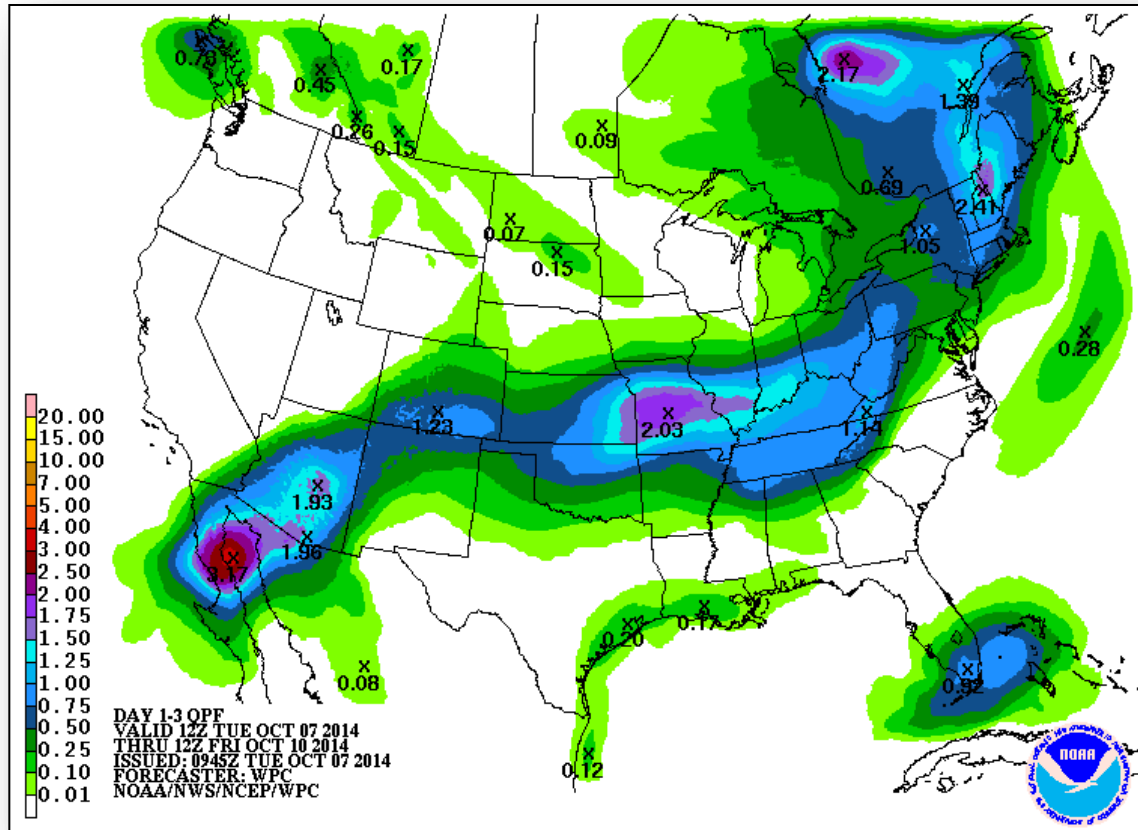


## Tropical Storm Simon (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

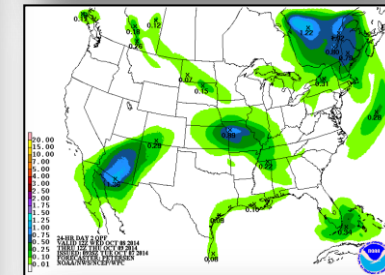
- Located 115 miles WSW of Punta Eugenia, Mexico
- Moving NNE near 7 mph
- Motion expected to continue during the next 24 to 36 hours
- Maximum sustained winds are near 40 mph
- Forecast to weaken to a remnant low today or Wednesday
- Tropical storm-force winds extend outward up to 90 miles
- Rainfall amounts of 1 to 2 inches with isolated amounts around 4 inches are expected across portions of Arizona
- Swells from Simon expected to impact portions of the Southern California coast today
- No watches and warnings in effect for the U.S.



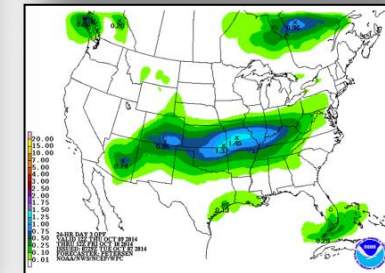
# Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day

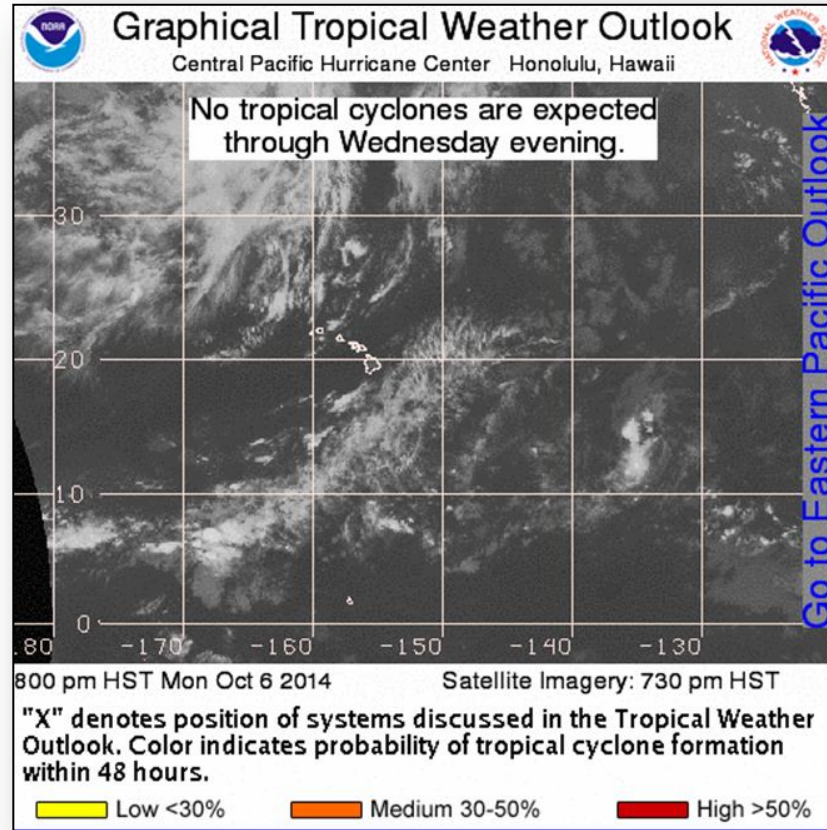

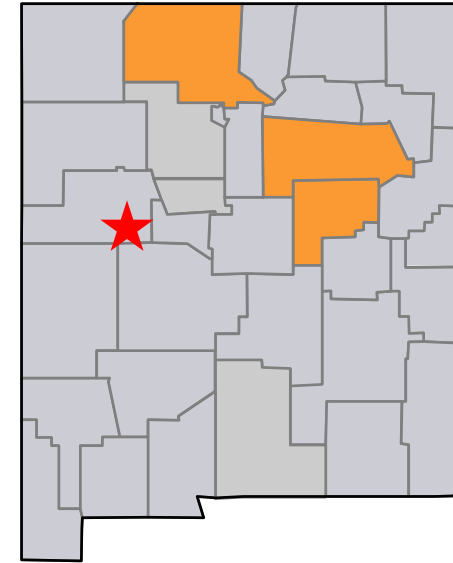
# Major Disaster Declaration – New Mexico

- FCO is Nancy M. Casper

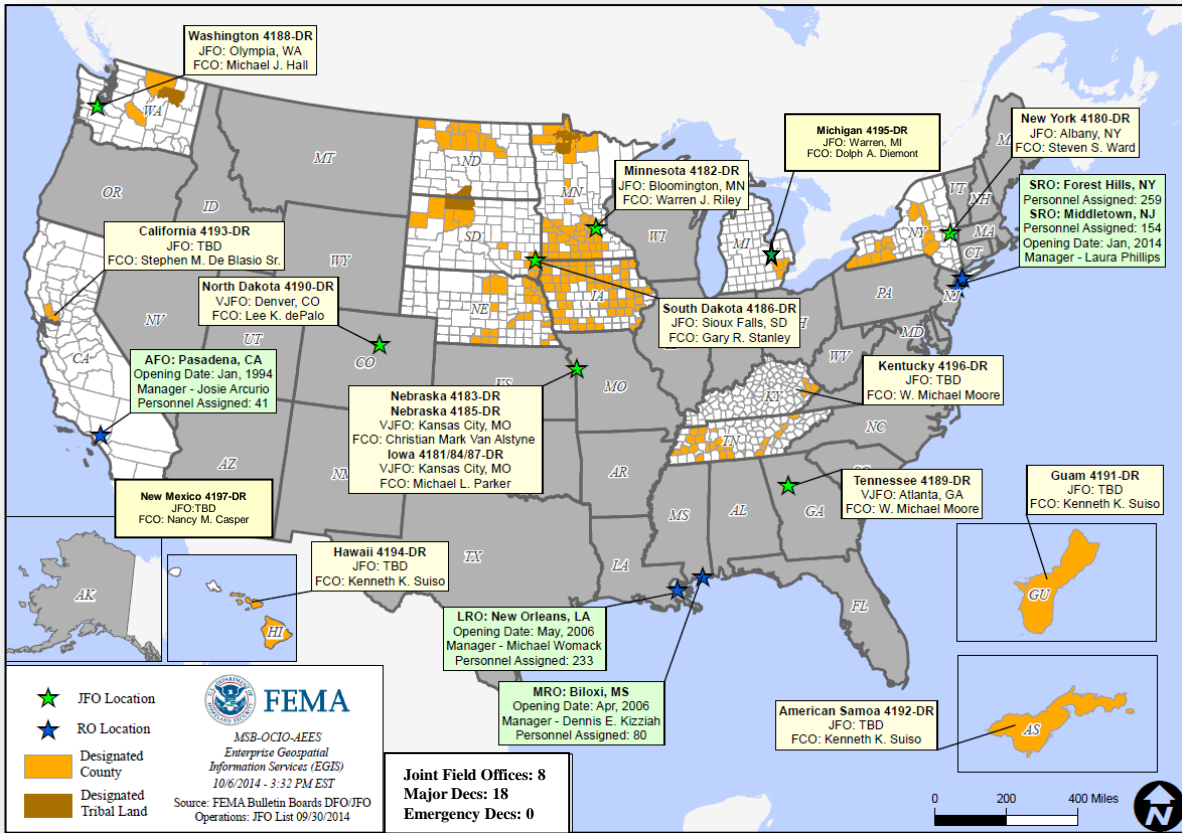

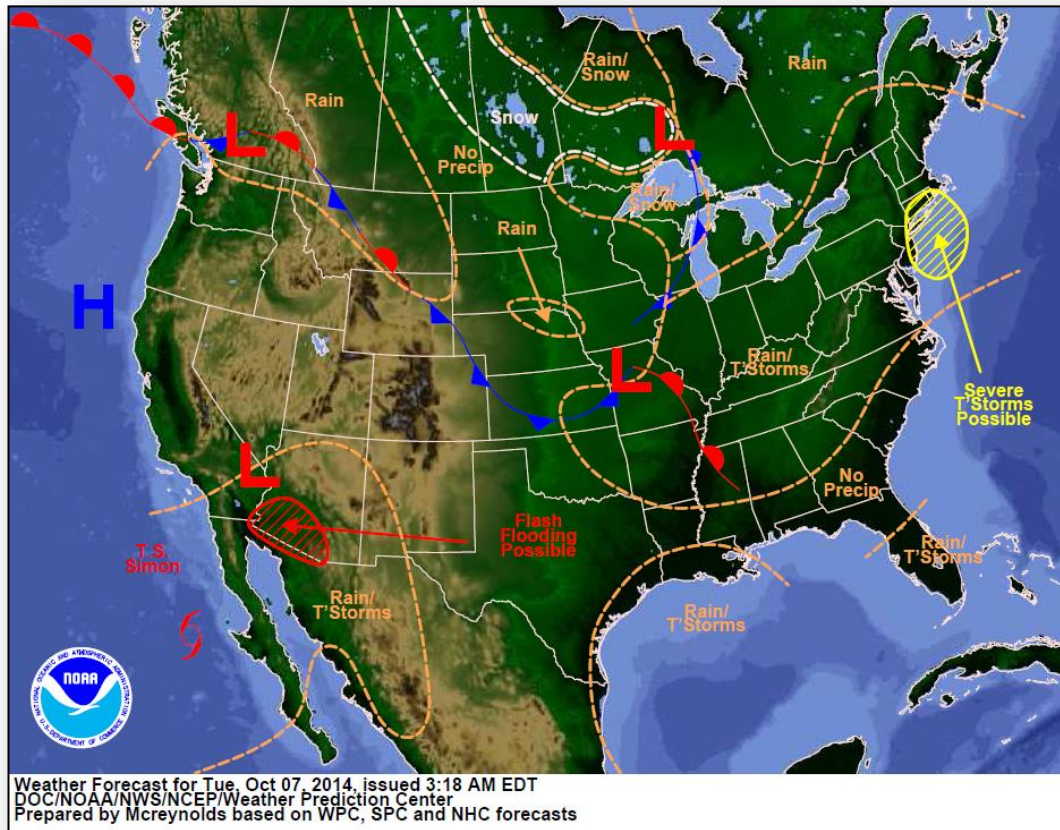

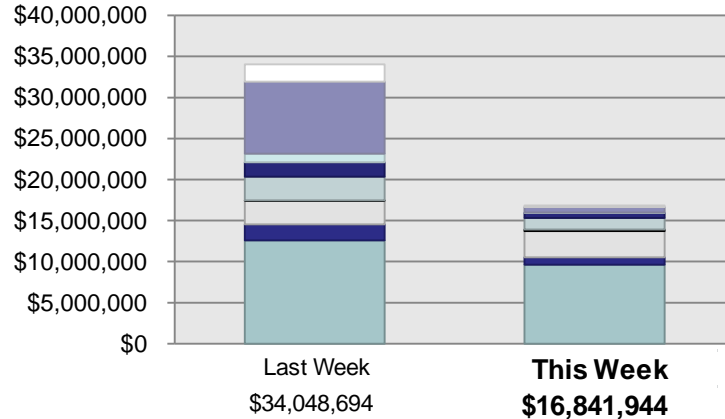

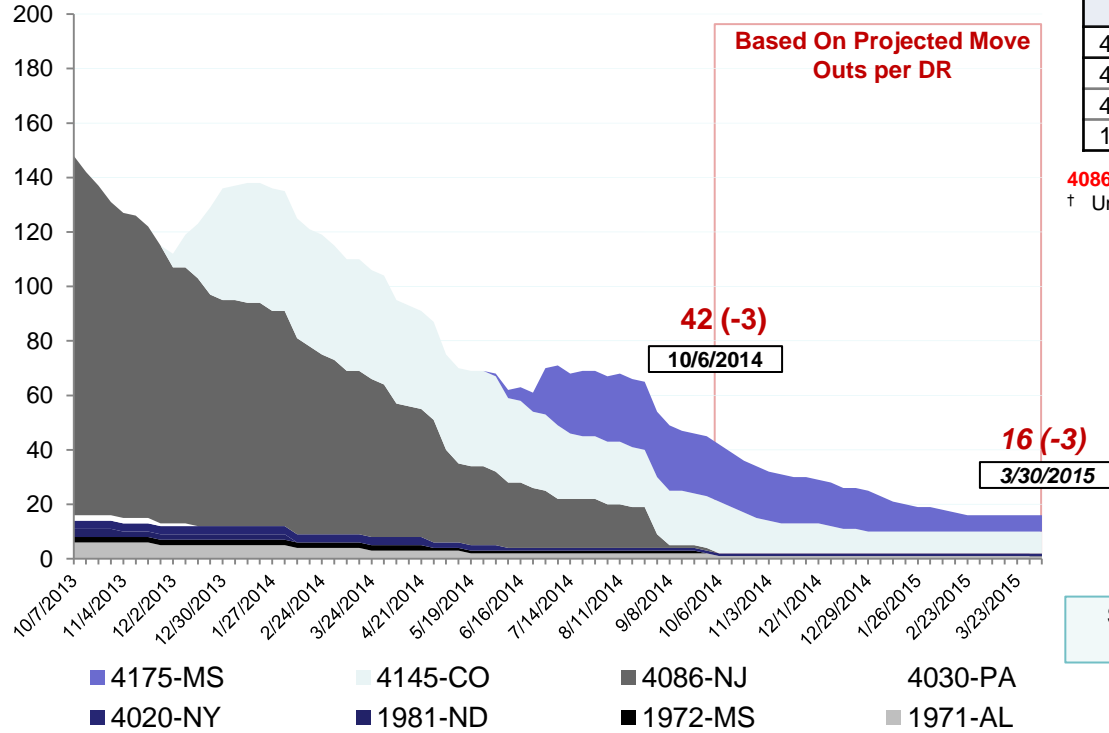
## PA Highlights

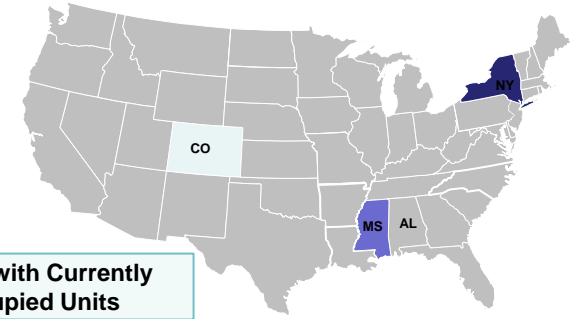


**Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State**

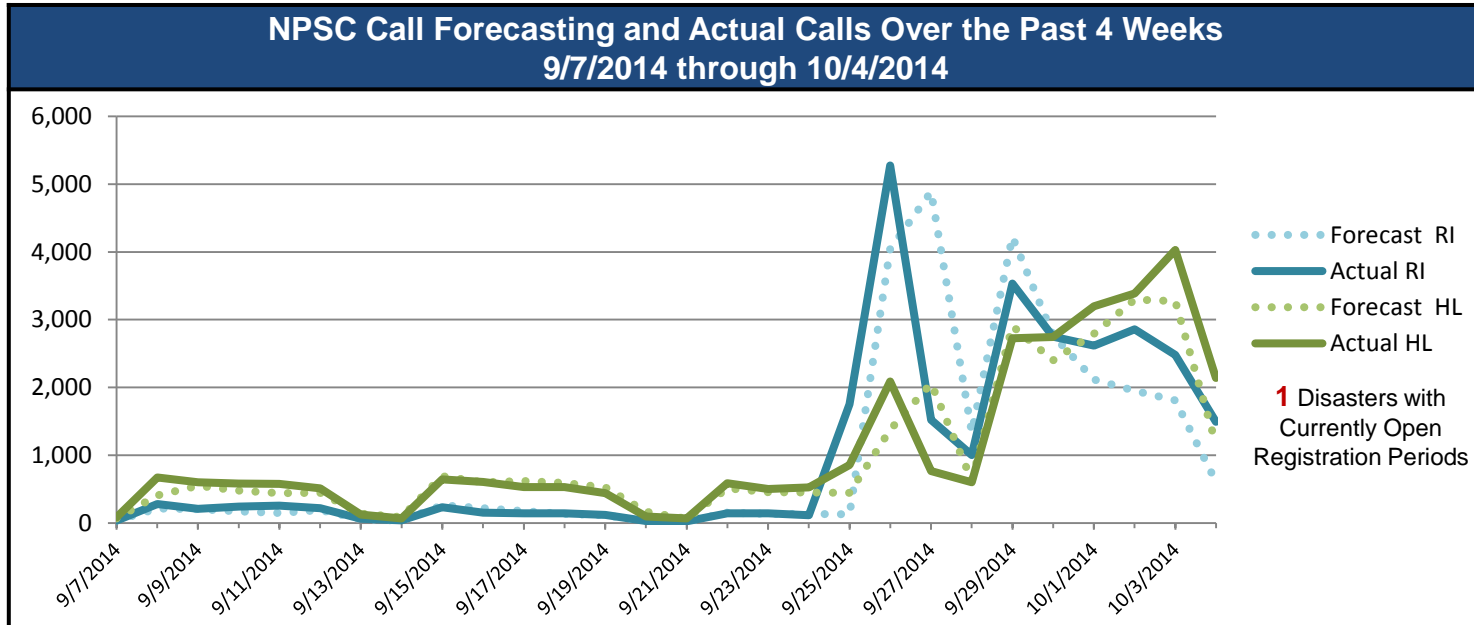

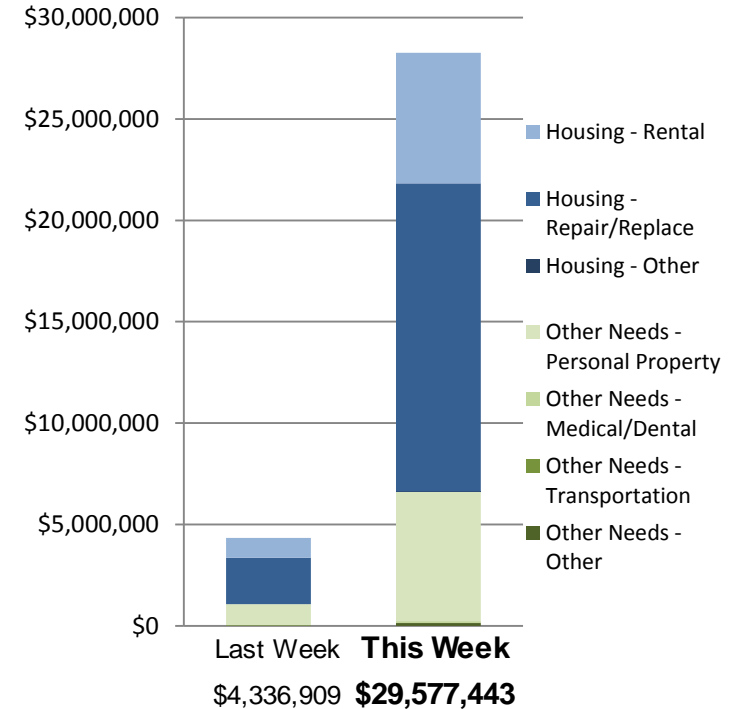
