- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1 (10%)
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected through Saturday evening

- Slight risk of Severe Thunderstorms – parts of the Southern Plains
- Heavy rain possible – Lower Mississippi/Tennessee Valley
- No Red Flag Warnings/Critical Fire Weather

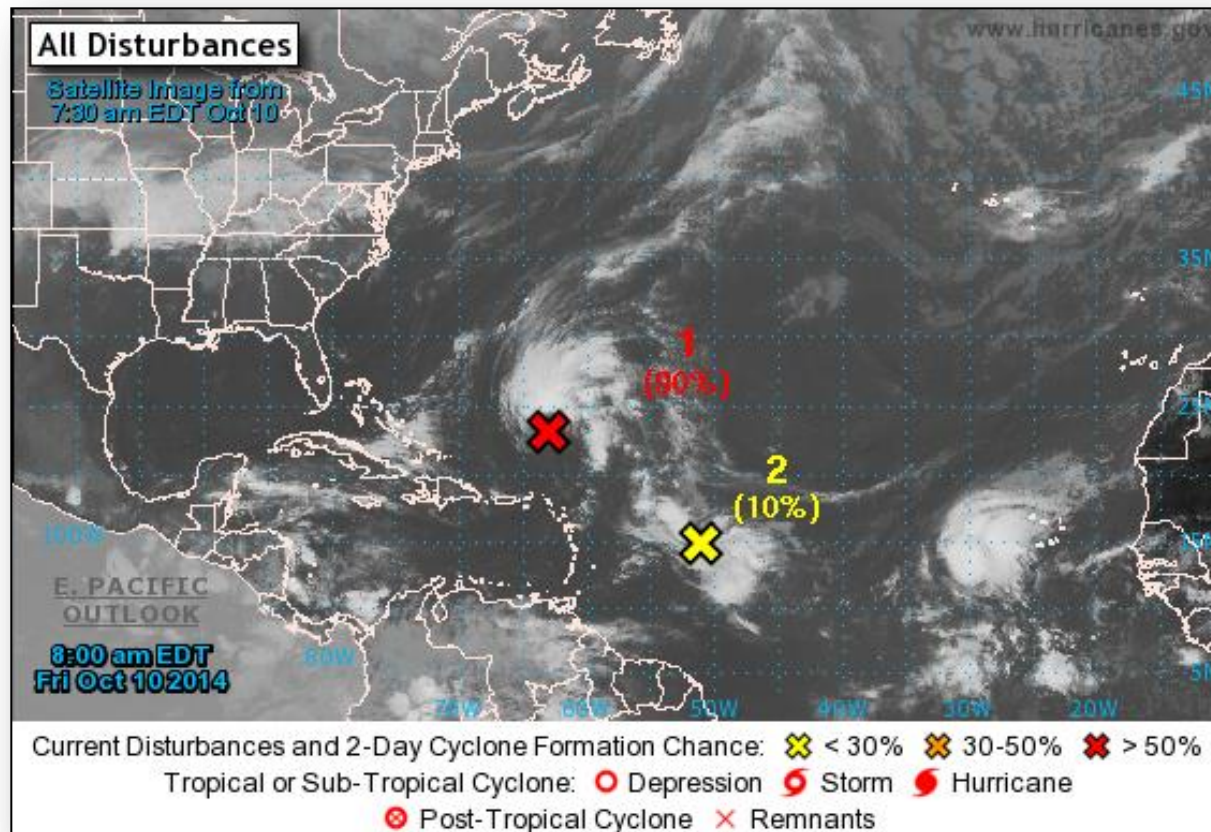

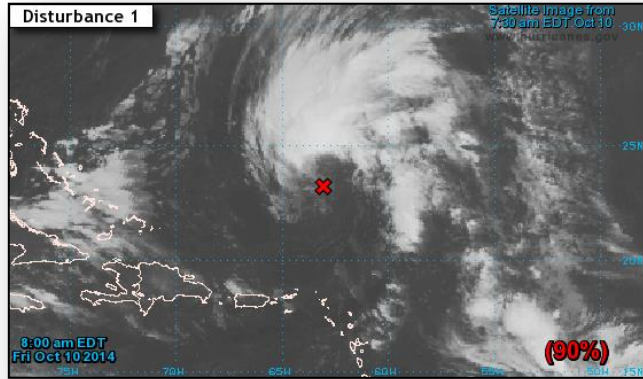
2 Day Tropical Outlook - Atlantic



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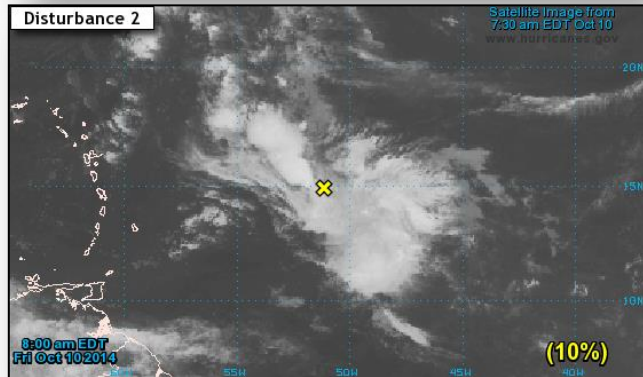

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

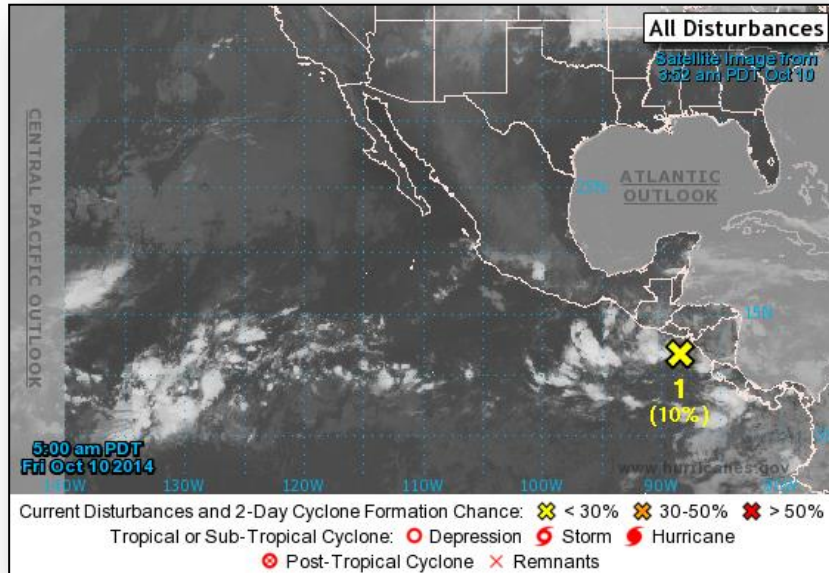
- Showers and thunderstorms associated with a Low pressure system located about 625 miles S of the Bermuda
- Forecast to move NW and then N at 10-15 mph the next couple days
- Becoming better organized; a subtropical depression or storm could form
- An Air Force Hurricane Hunter is scheduled to investigate this afternoon
- Probability of formation:
 - Next 48 hours: High (90%)
 - Next 5 days: High (90%)



Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Shower and thunderstorm activity has become more concentrated 700 miles E of the Lesser Antilles
- Conditions appear conducive for gradual development and the system moves WNW at 10 mph
- Probability of formation:
 - Next 48 hours: Low (10%)
 - Next 5 days: Low (20%)

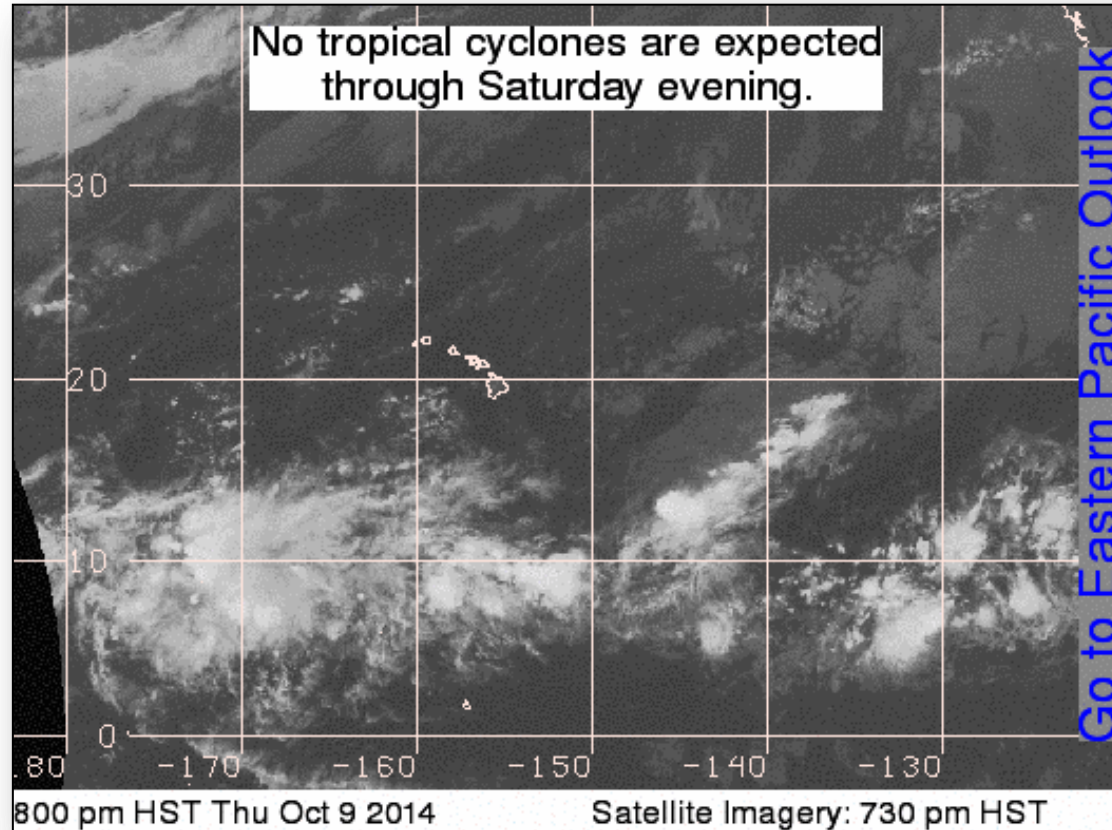
2-Day Tropical Outlook - Eastern Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Disorganized cloudiness and showers and continue in association with an area of low pressure centered south of the coast of El Salvador
- Drifting WNW
- Slow development possible during the next several days
- Will produce locally heavy rain over portions of Central America the next couple days
- Probability of formation:
 - Next 48 hours: Low (10%)
 - Next 5 days: Medium (50%)

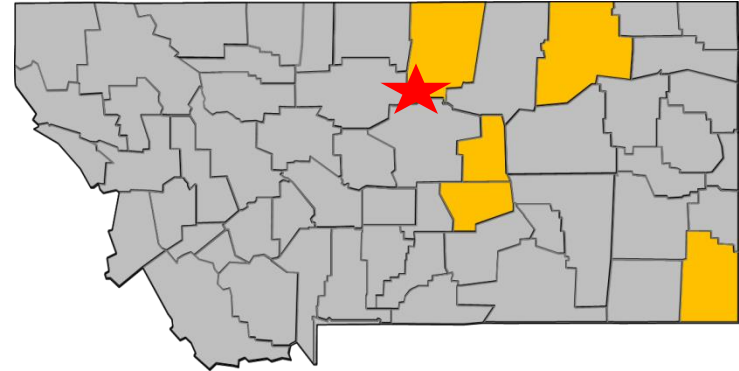
Major Disaster Declaration - Montana



FEMA-4198-DR-MT

- For Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds and Flooding that occurred August 21-25, 2014
- Provides:
 - Public Assistance for 5 counties and 1 reservation (Carter, Blaine, Musselshell, Petroleum & Valley counties & the Fort Belknap Reservation in Blain County)
 - Hazard Mitigation statewide
- FCO is Benigno Bern Ruiz

★ = Fort Belknap Reservation

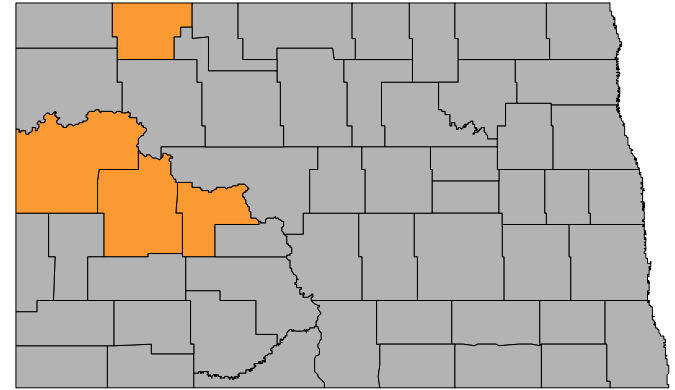
Major Disaster Declaration Request - North Dakota

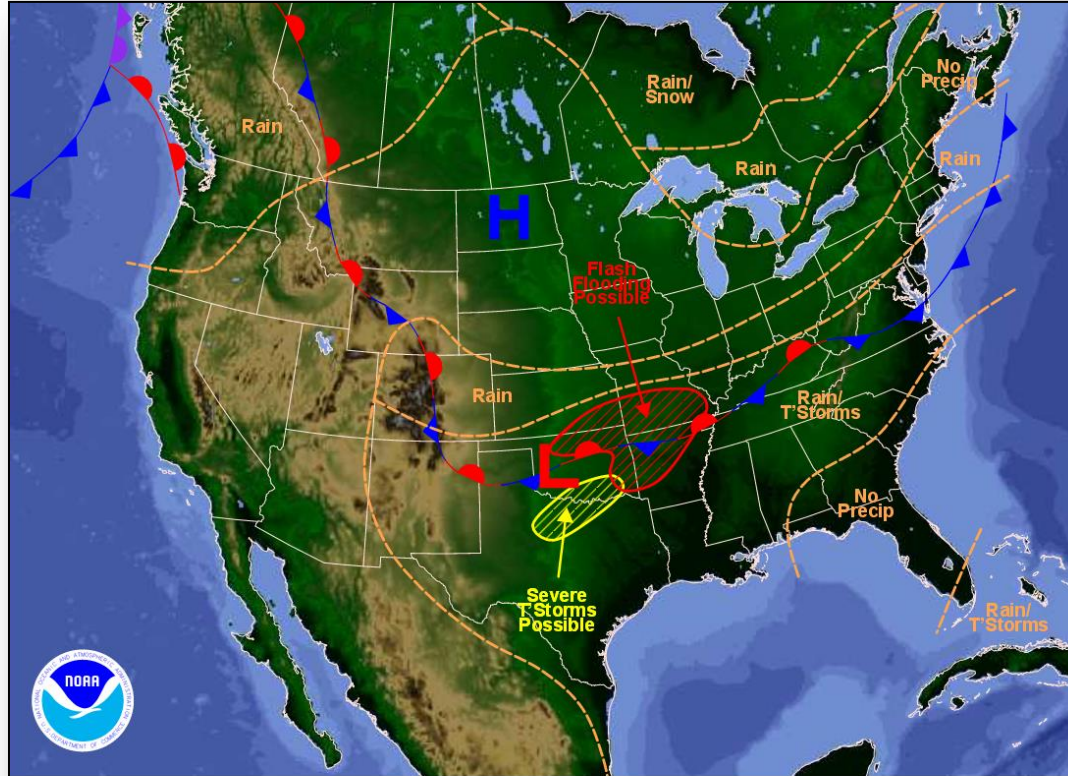

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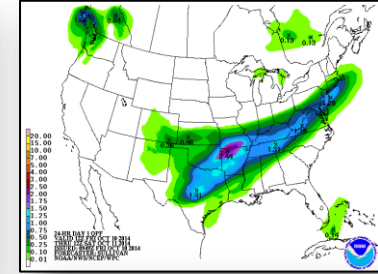

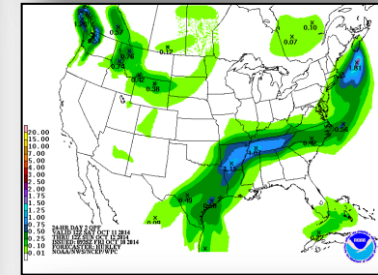
Precipitation Forecast - 3 Day



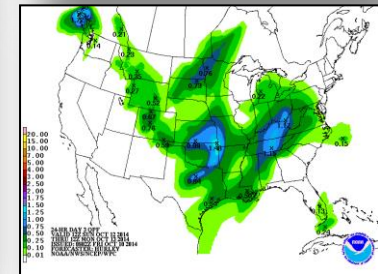

River Forecast



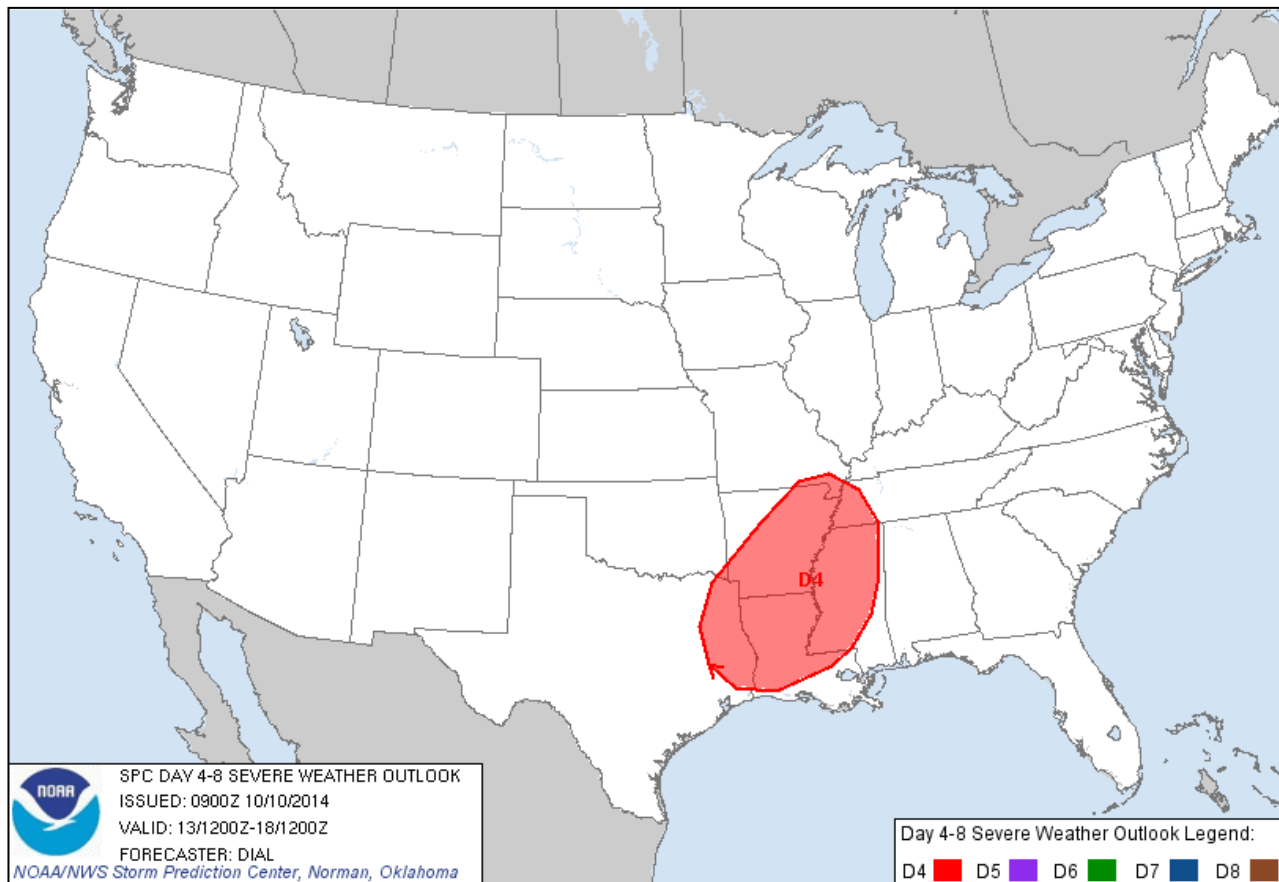
Convective Outlook, Days 1 - 3



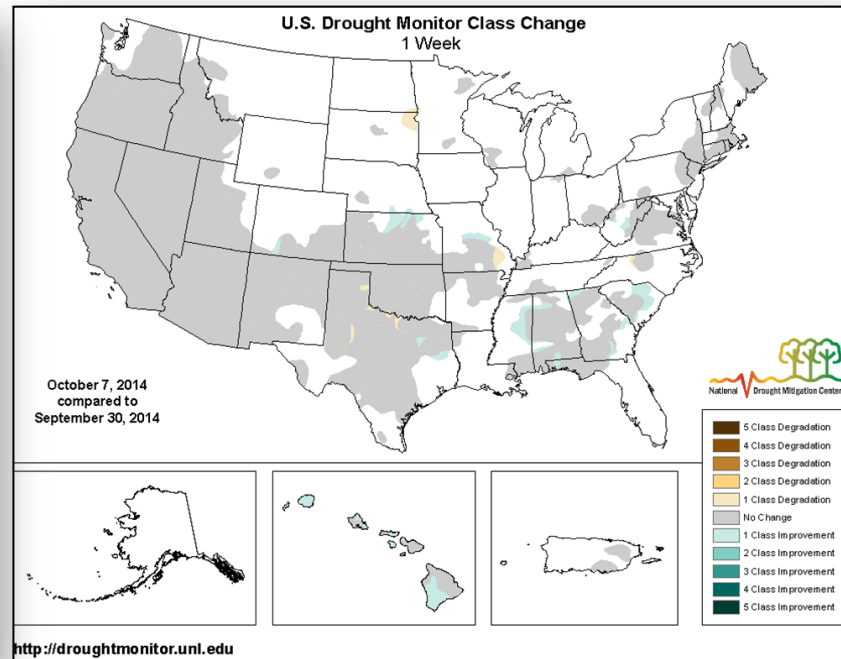
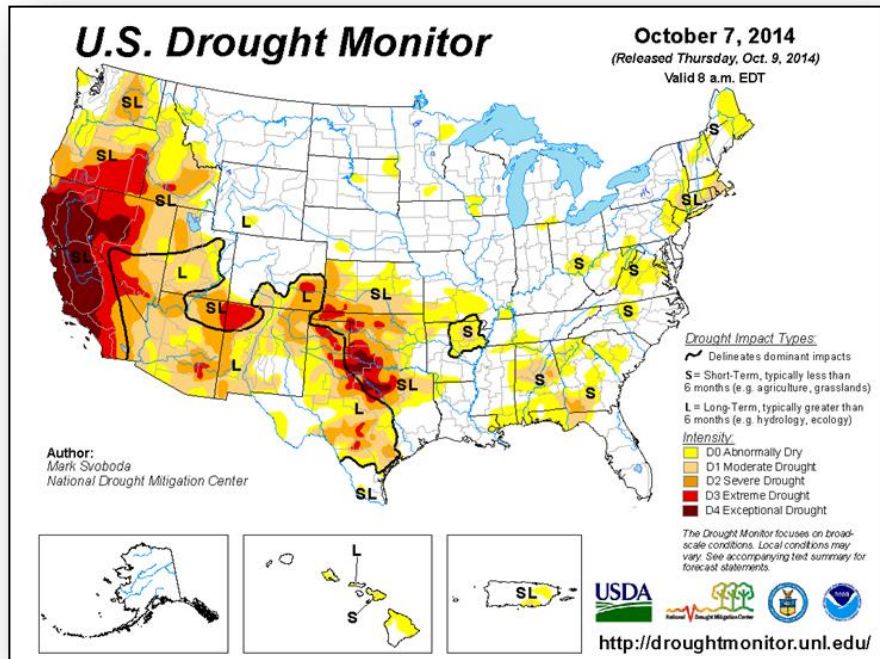
Convective Outlook, Day 4



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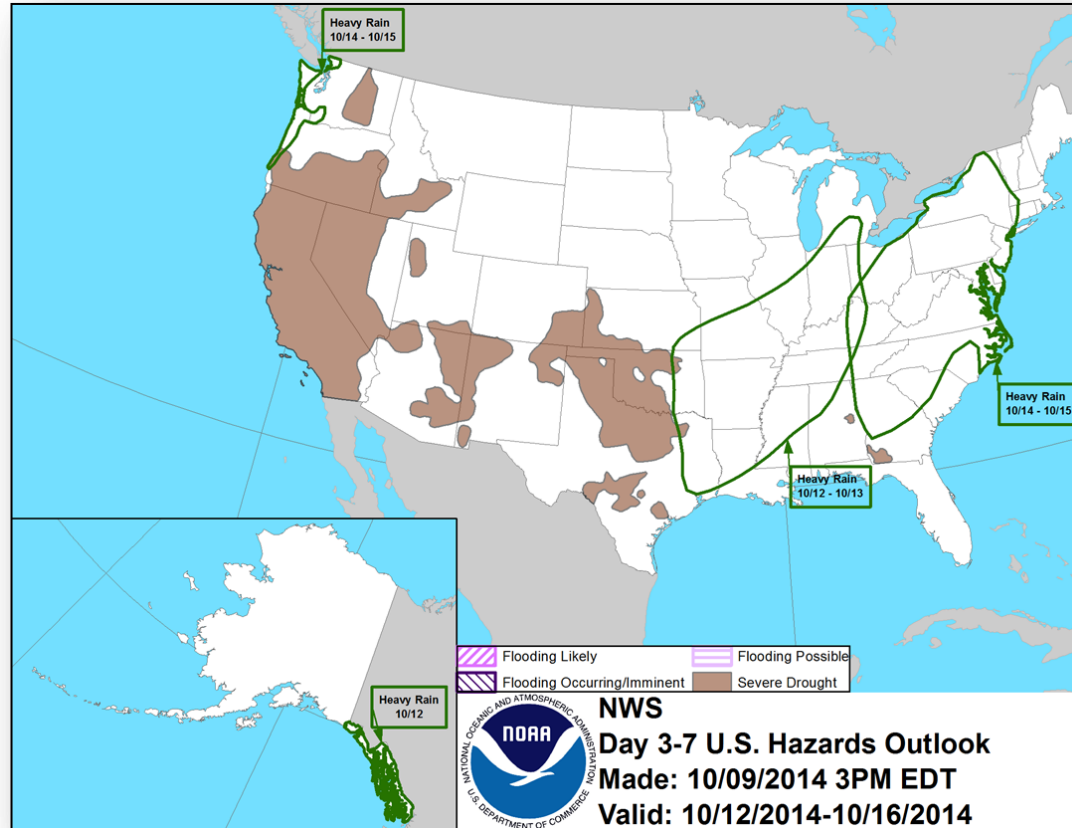
U.S. Drought Monitor

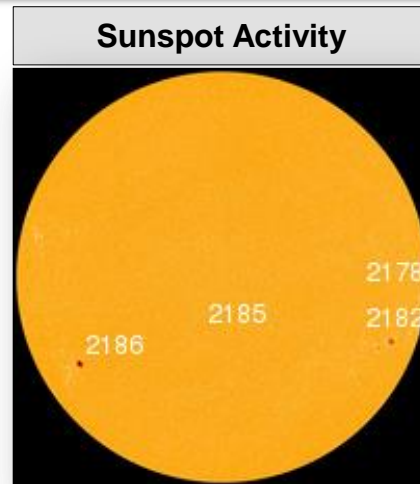
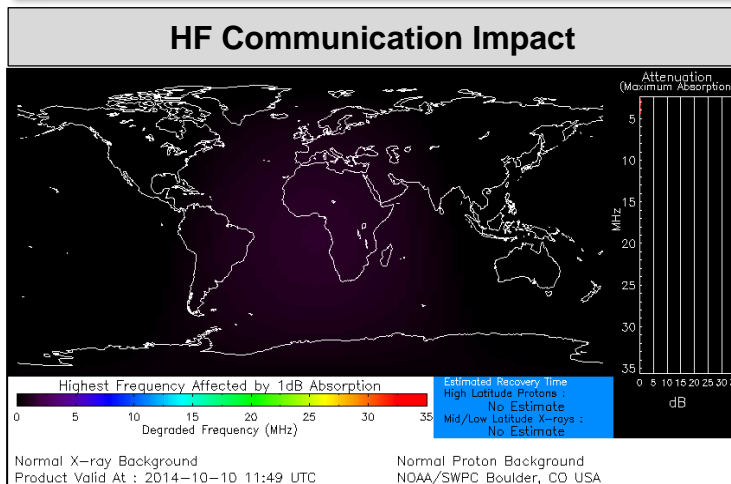
