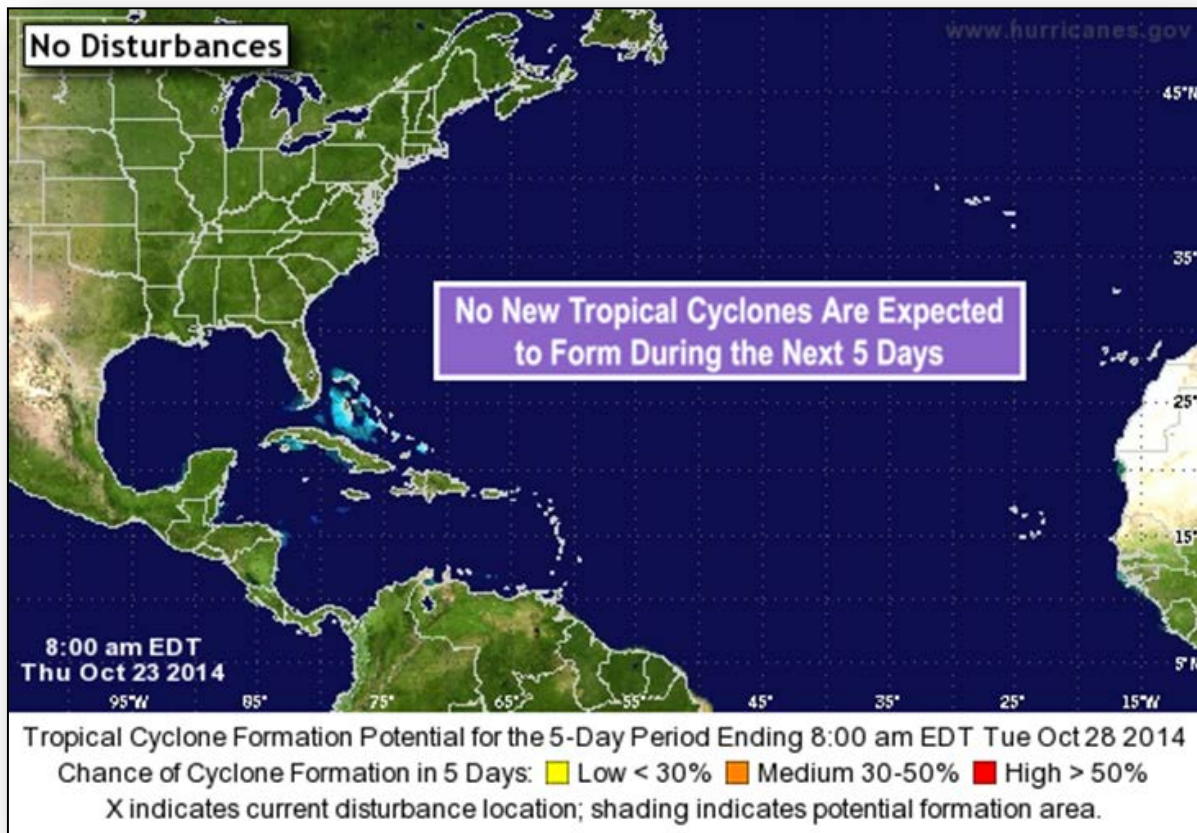

2 Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



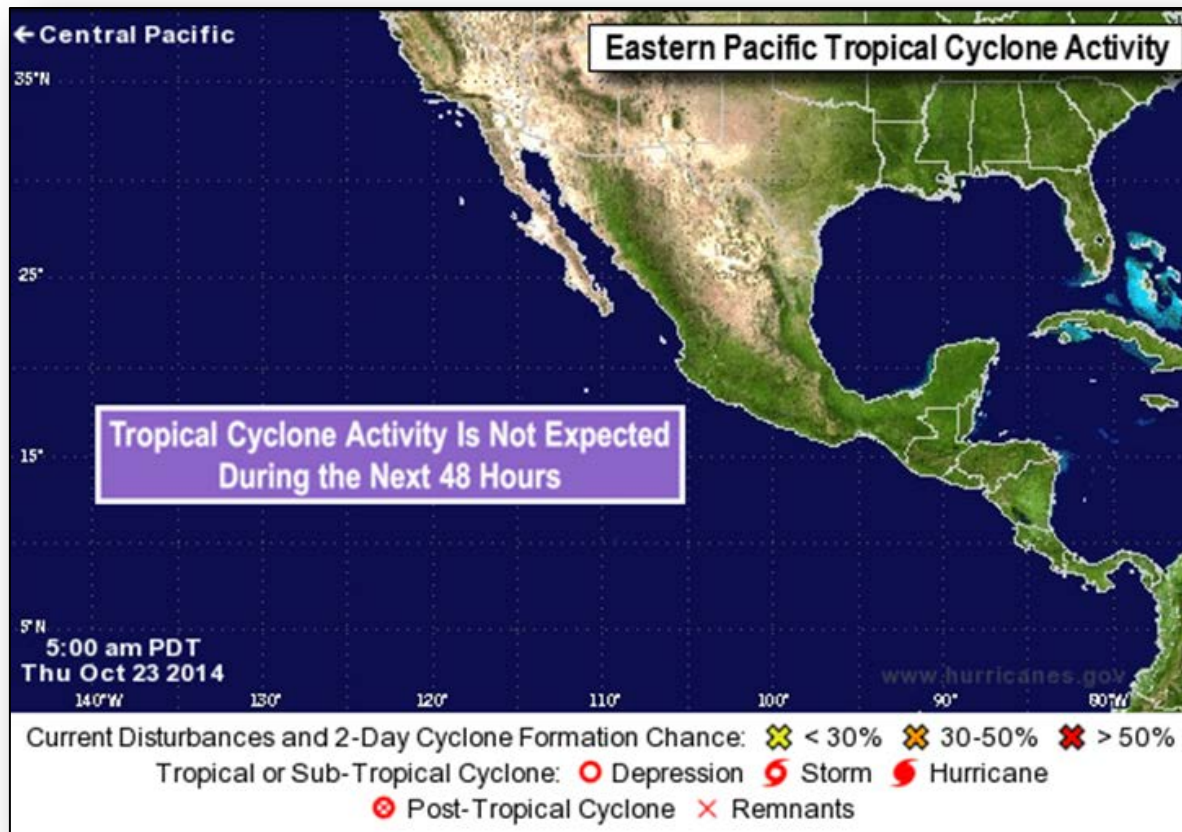

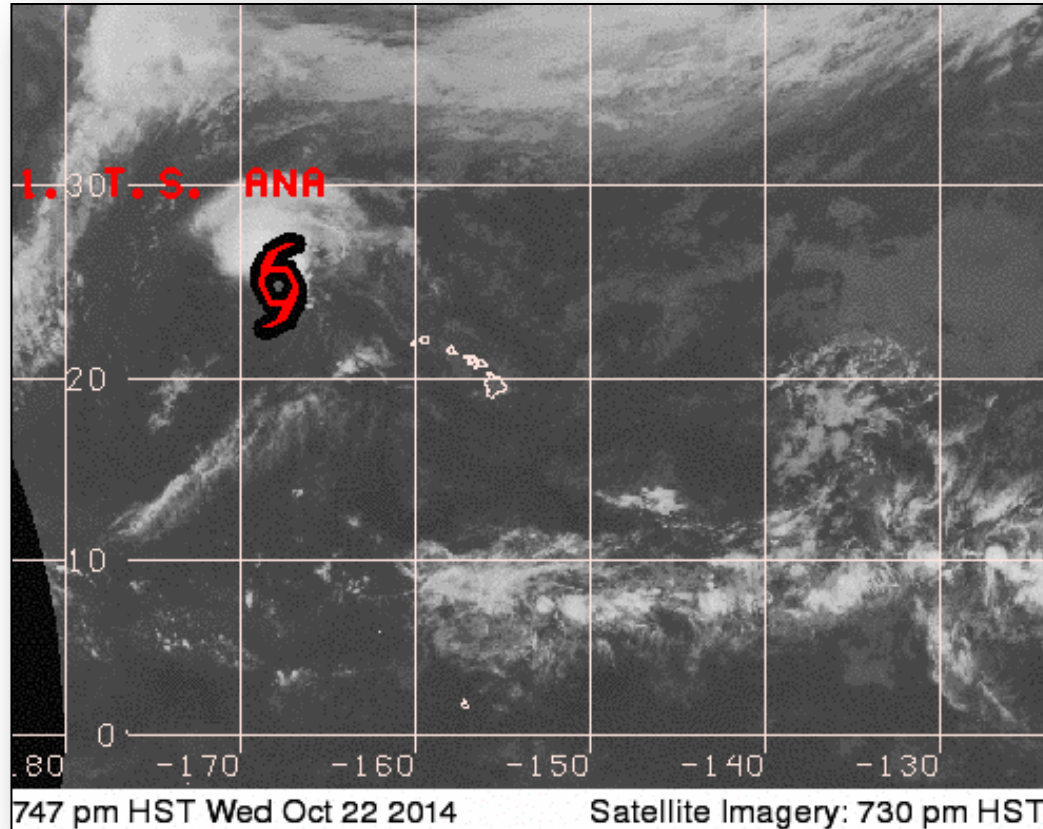
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

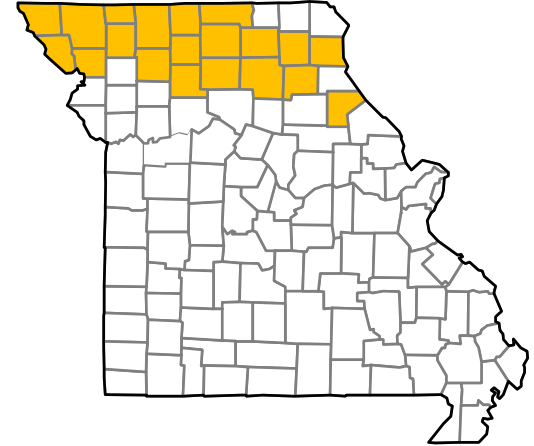

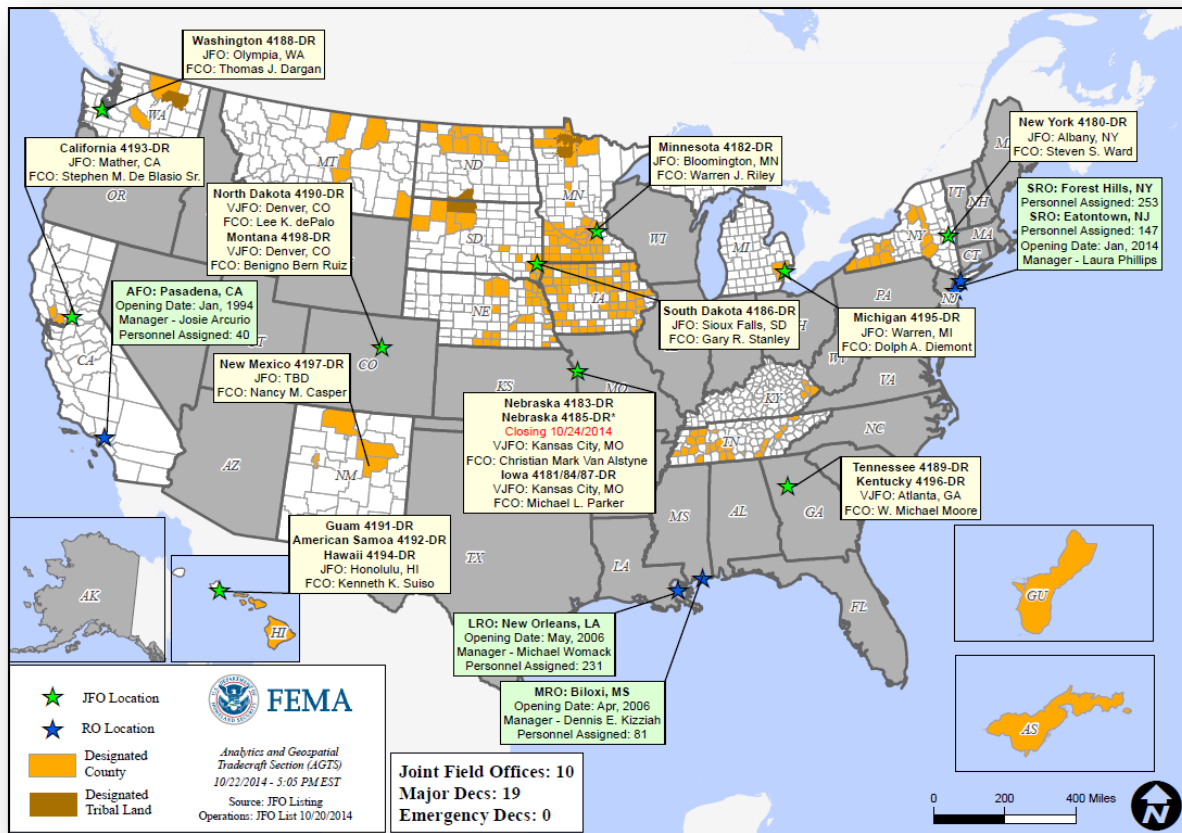
- Governor requested a Major Disaster Declaration

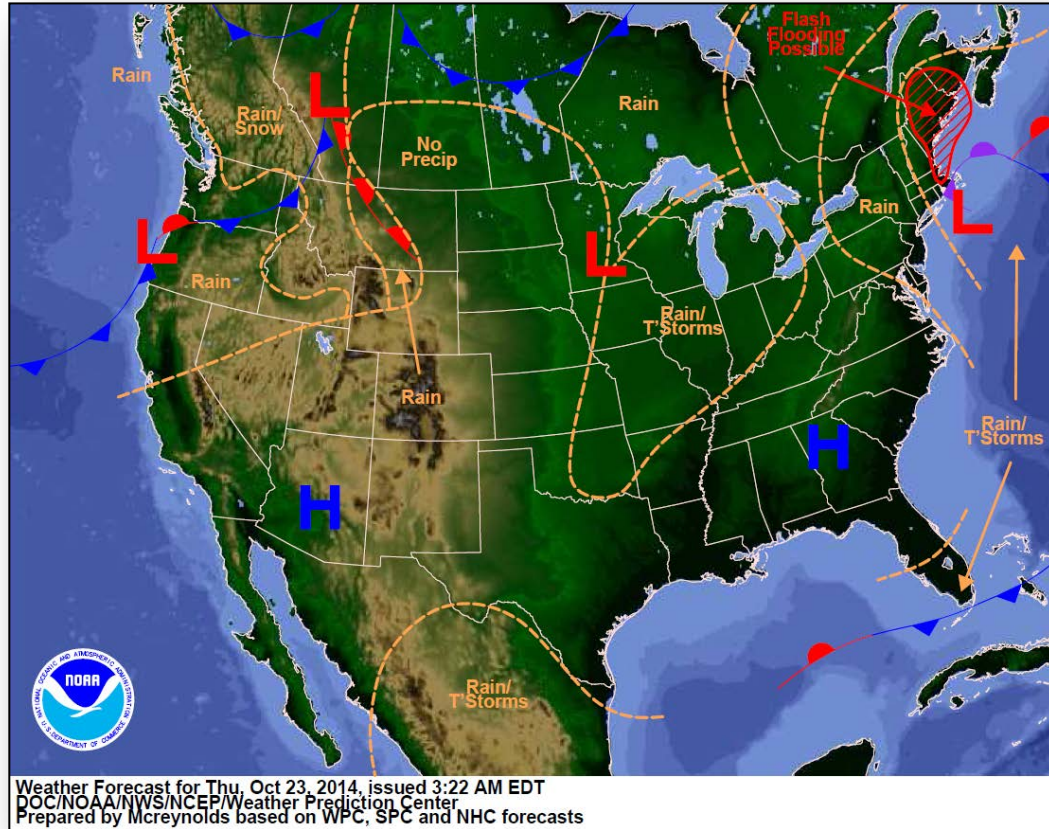
Open Field Offices as of October 23



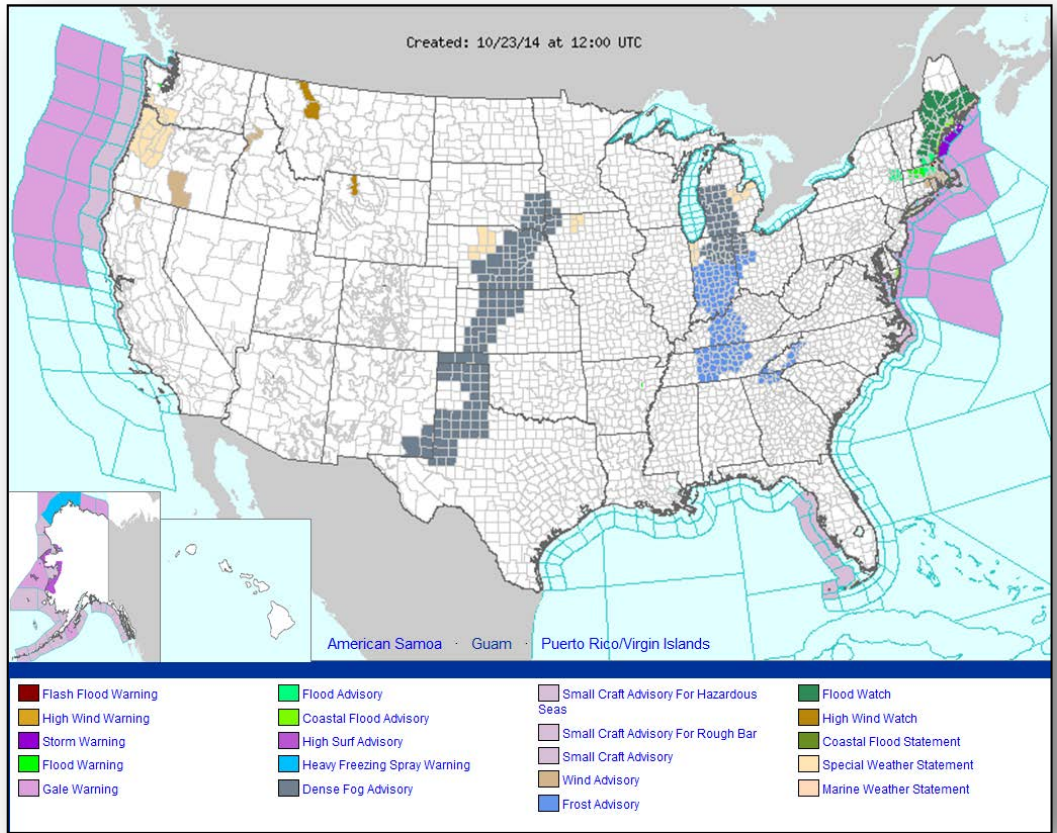

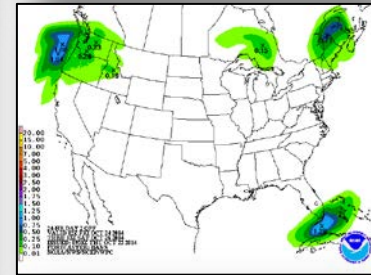
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day



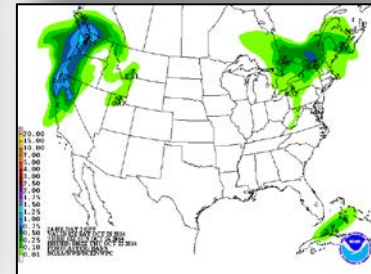

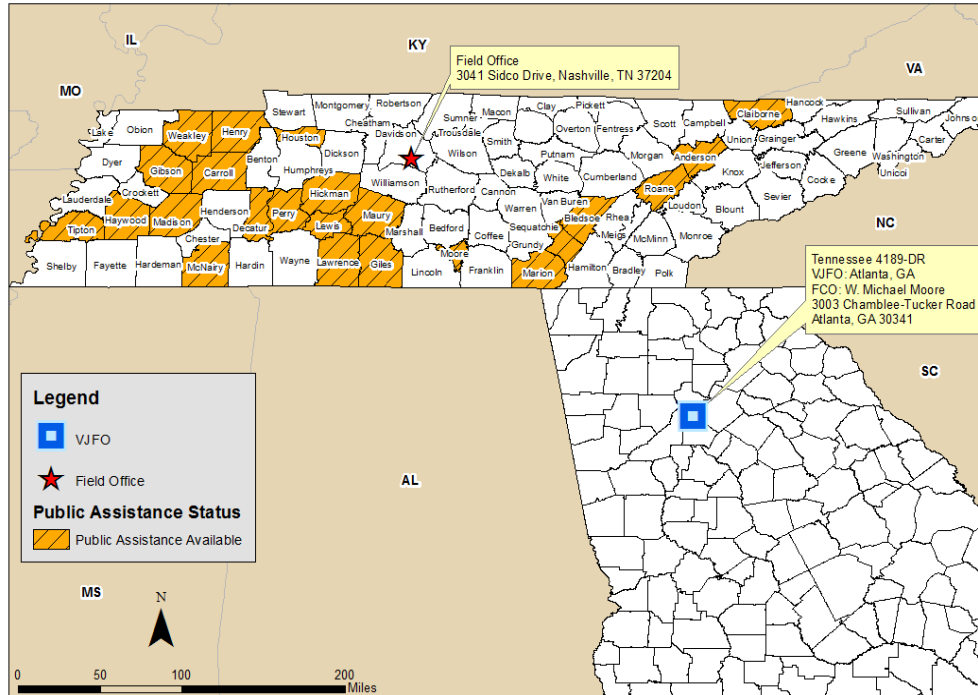

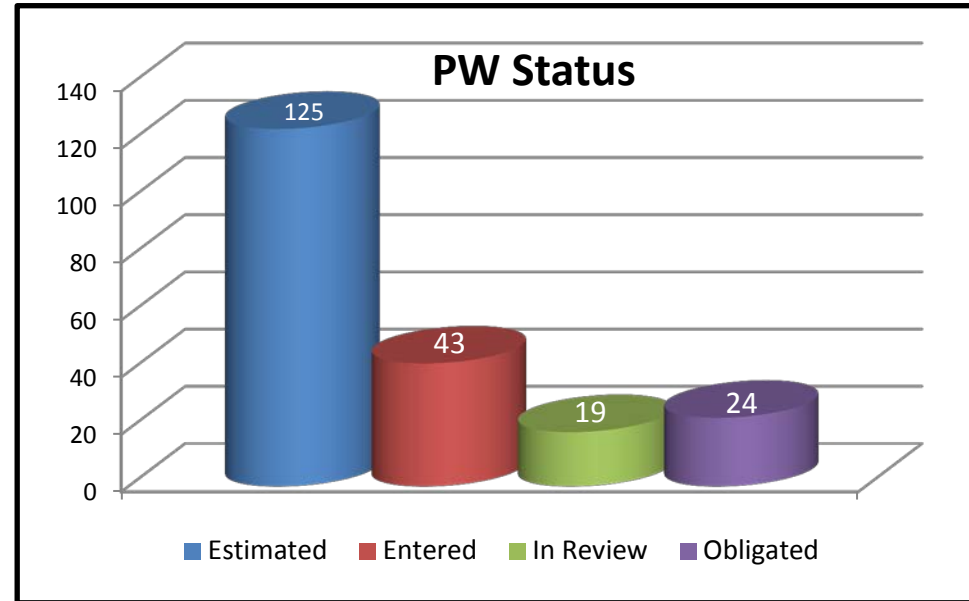

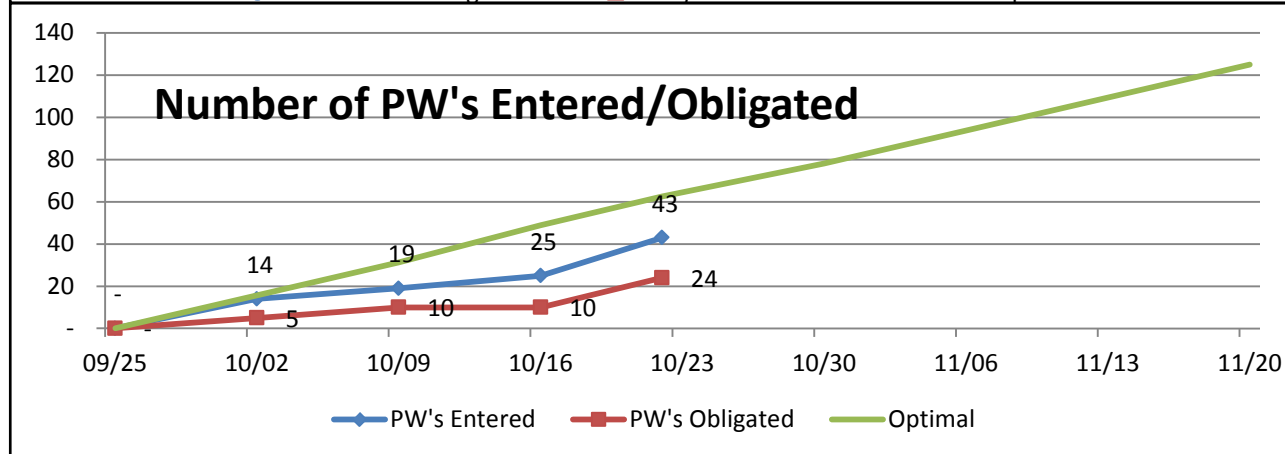

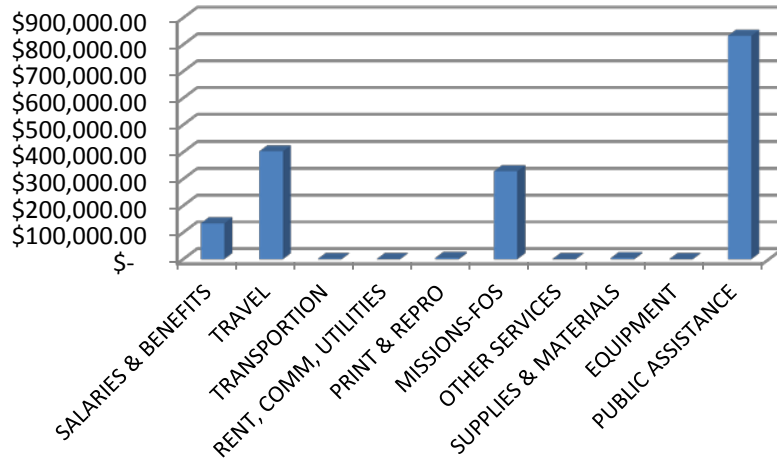

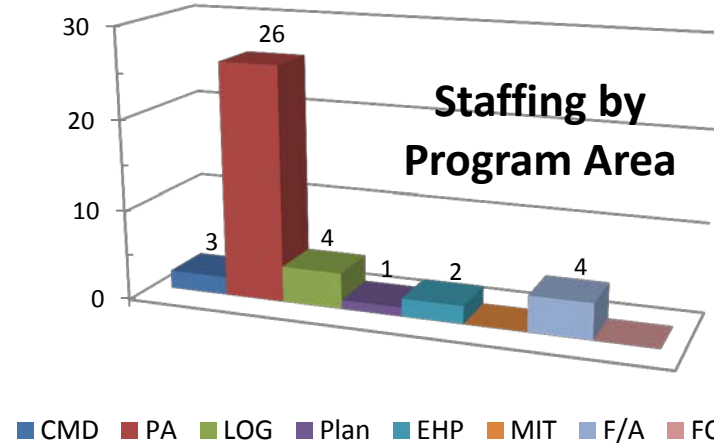

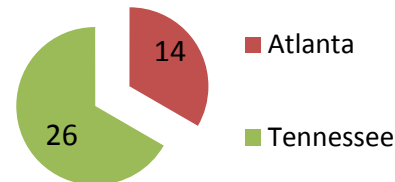

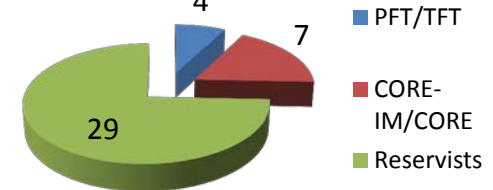
Staffing by Program Area
