- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. territories

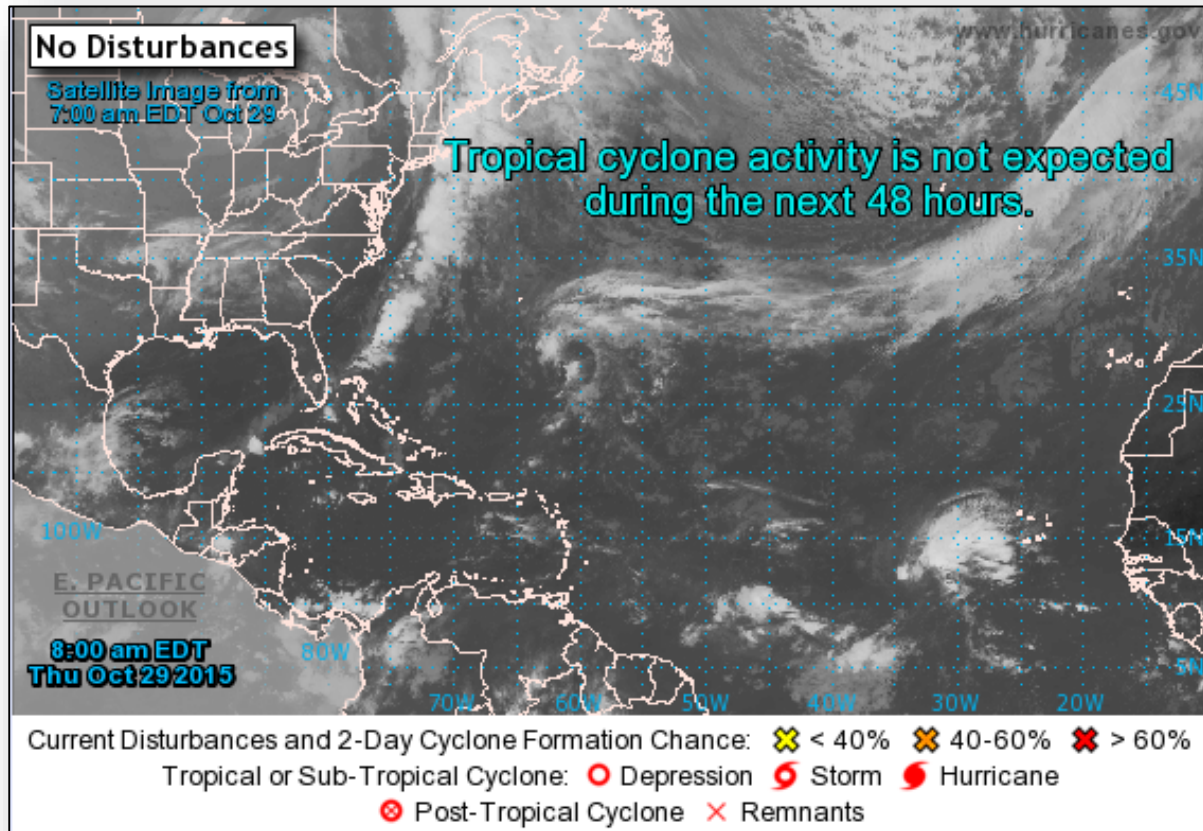

- Space weather: Past 24-hrs – Minor with S1; Next 24-hrs – Minor with S1

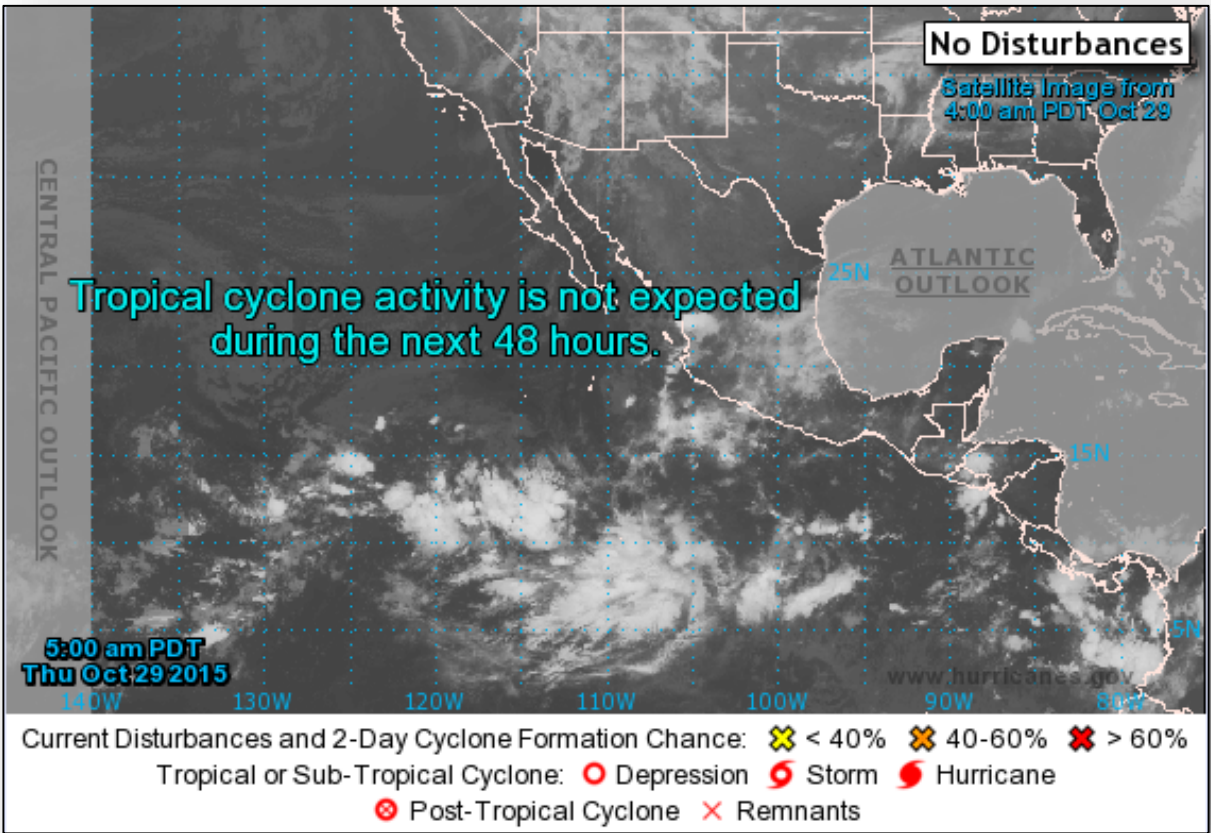

2 Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

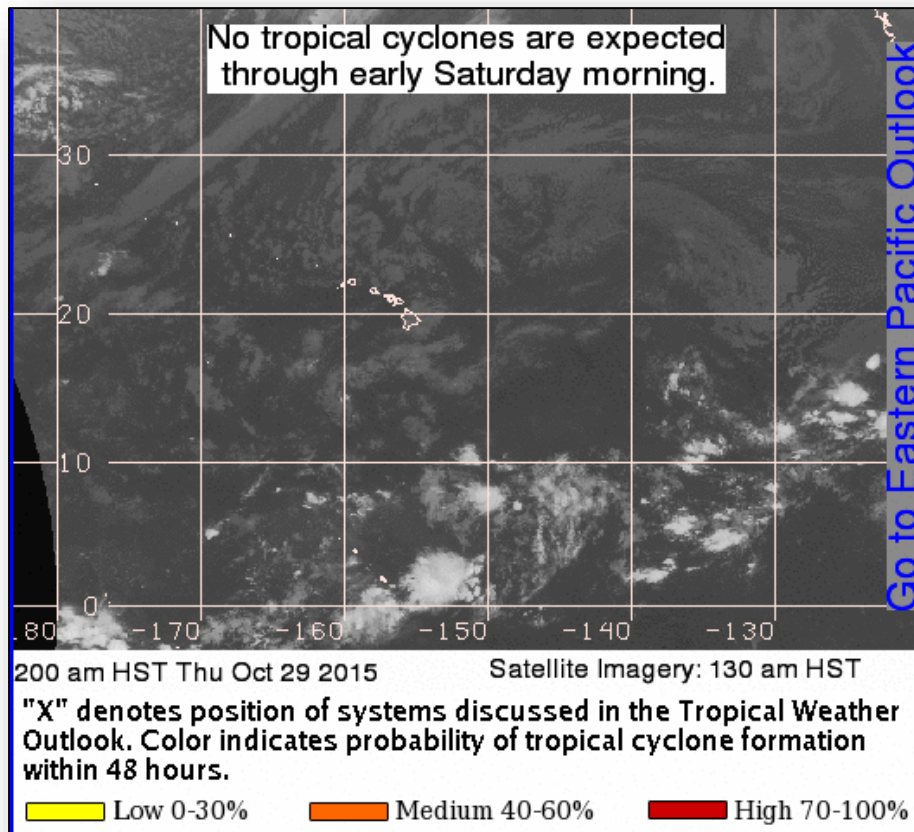




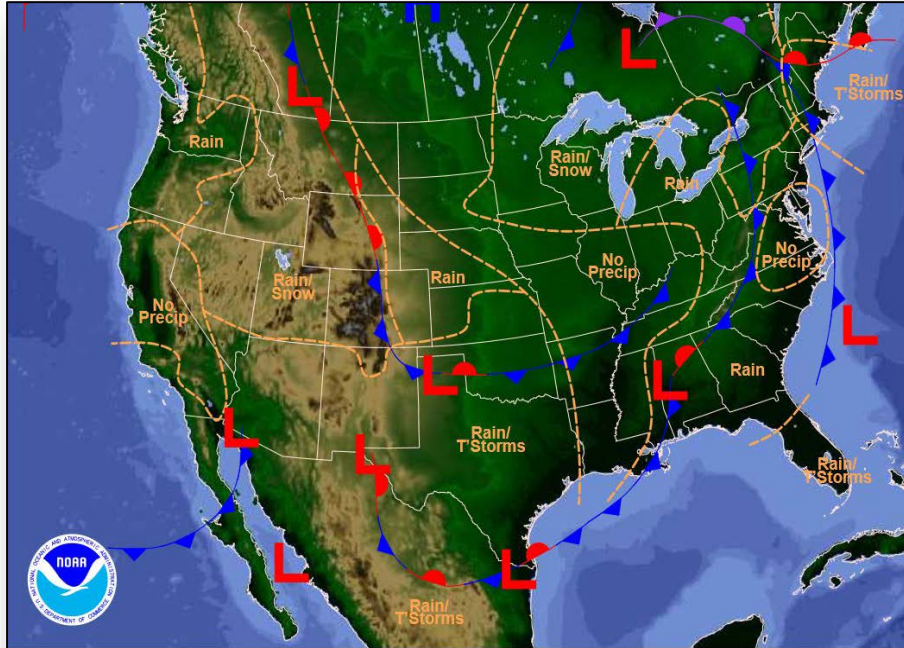
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



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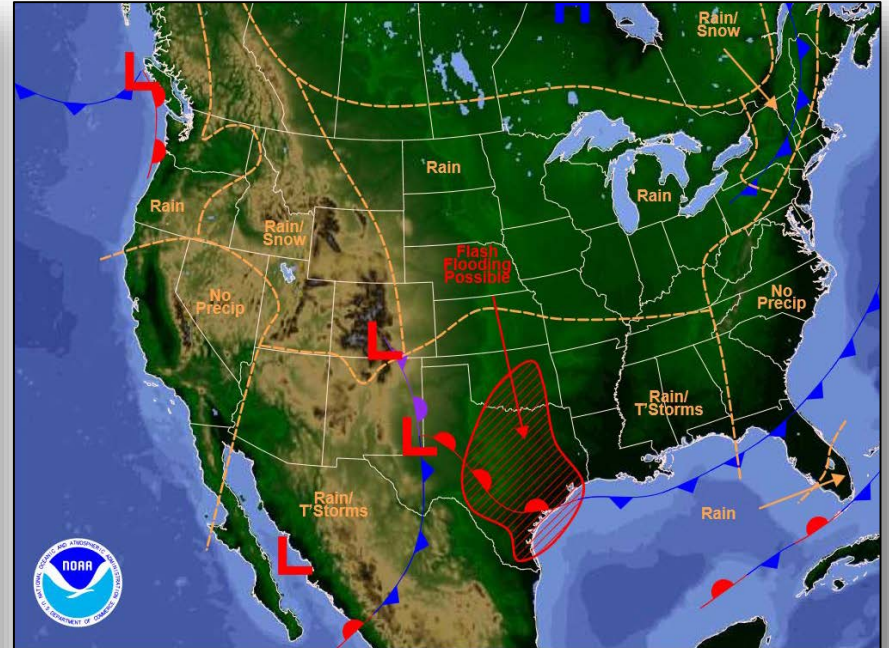

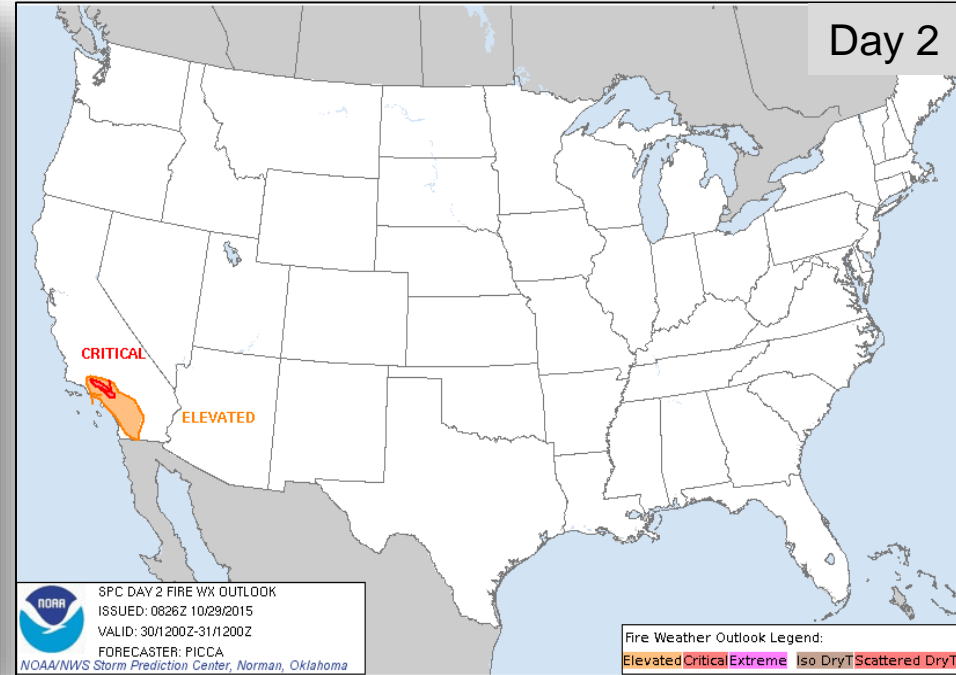
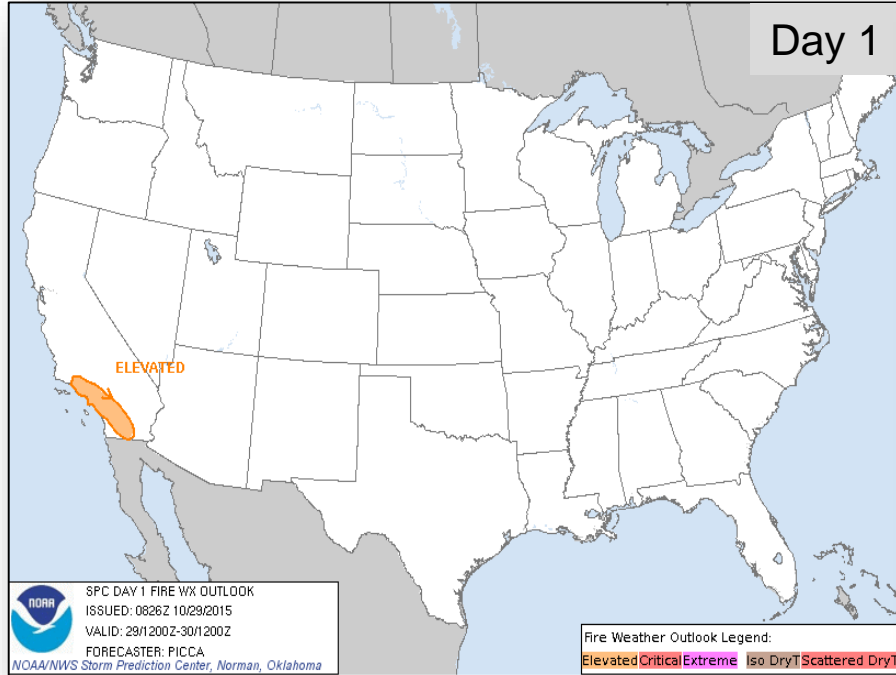
Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



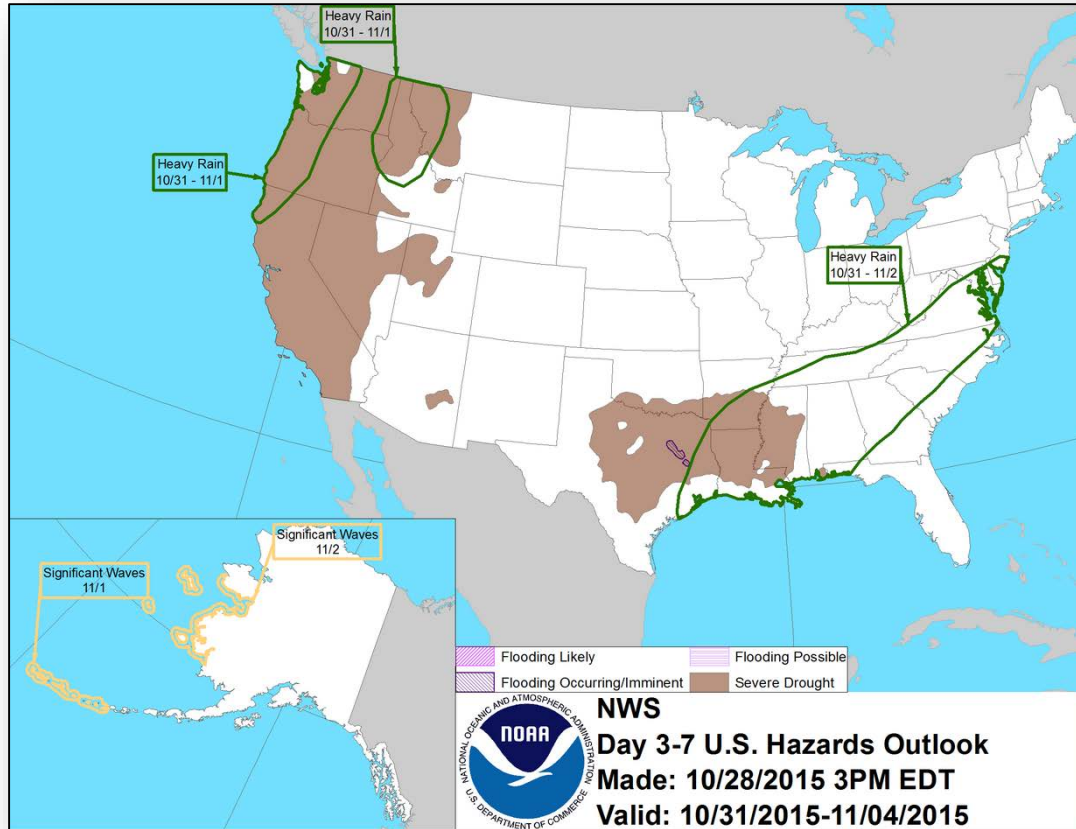
Flash Flood Potential

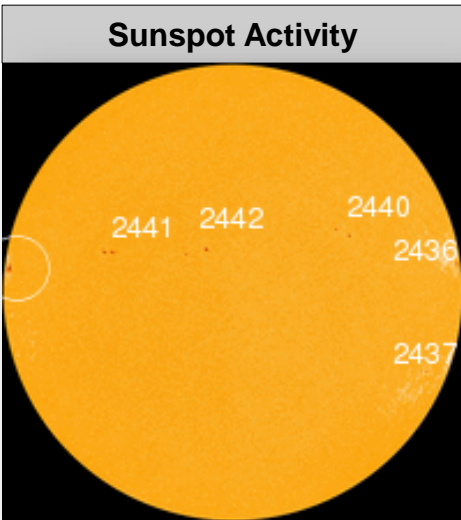
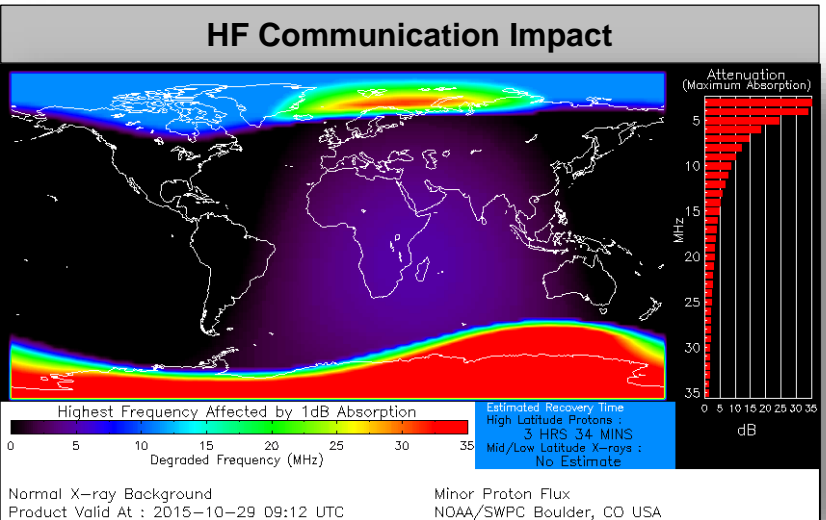

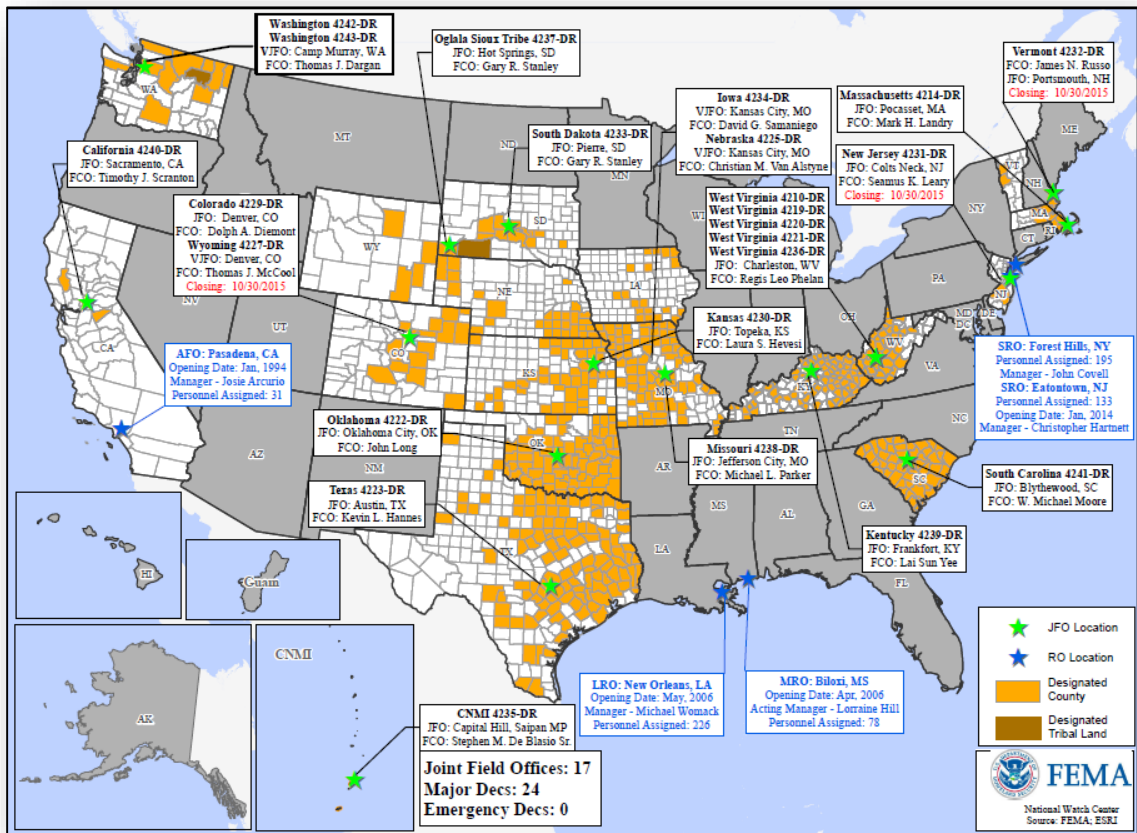
