Significant Weather:

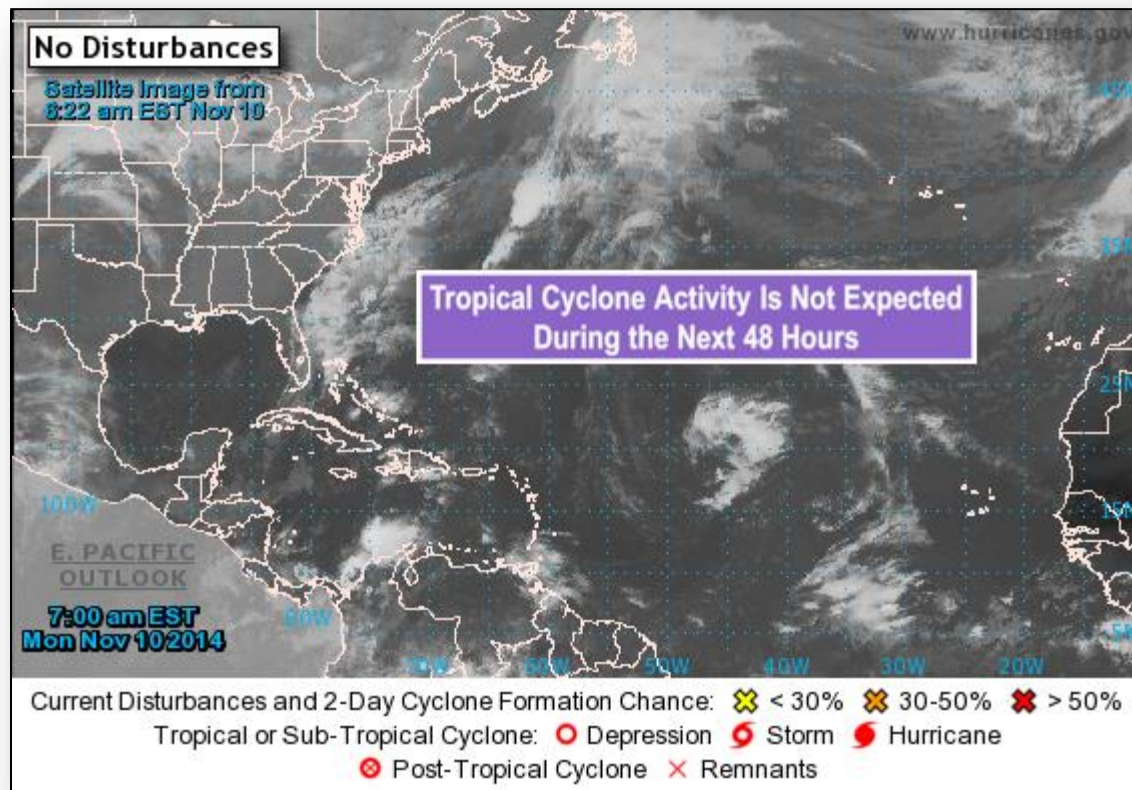
- Heavy snow possible – Northern Rockies to Great Lakes

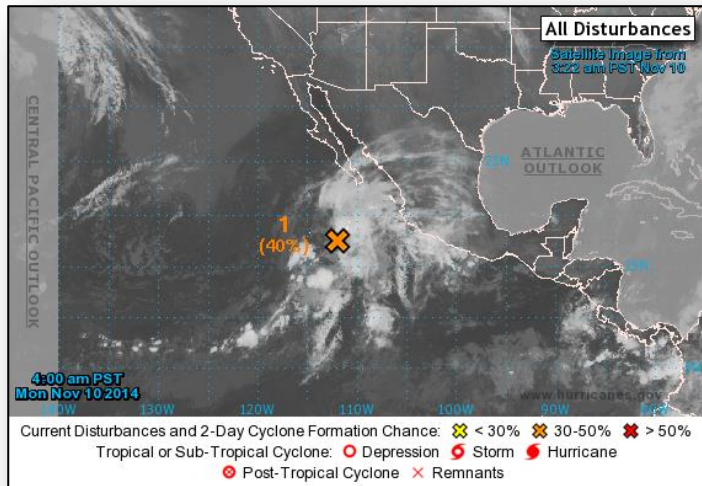
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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Disturbance 1 – Eastern Pacific



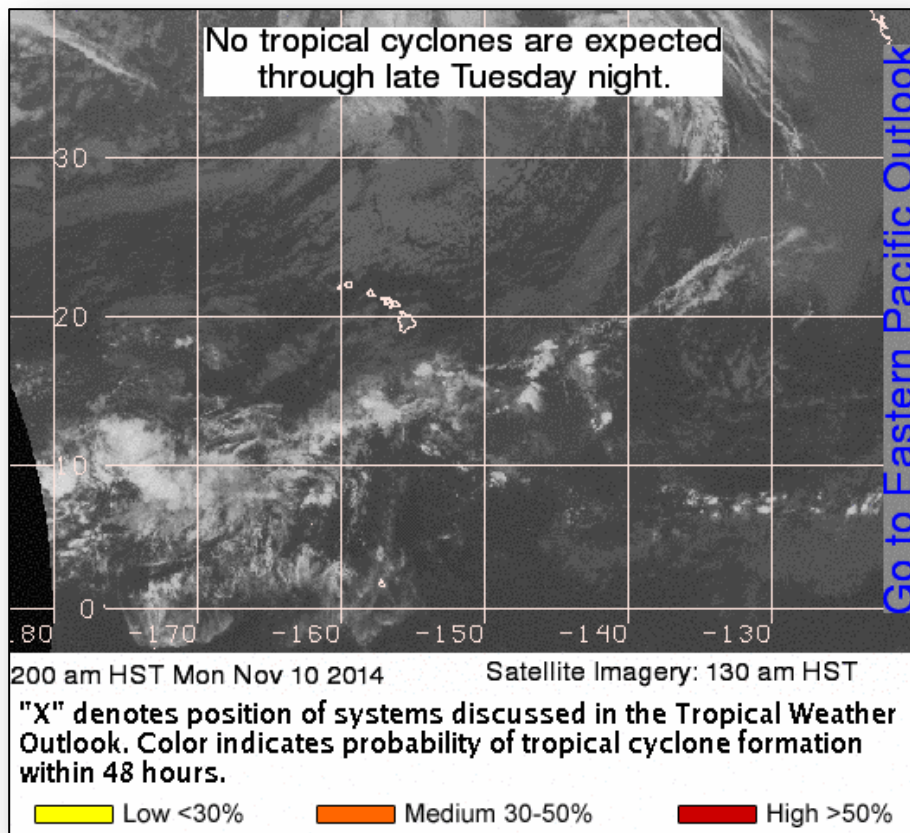
Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. EST)

- Formation chance:
 - Next 48 hours – Medium, 40%
 - Next 5 days – Medium, 40%

2 Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



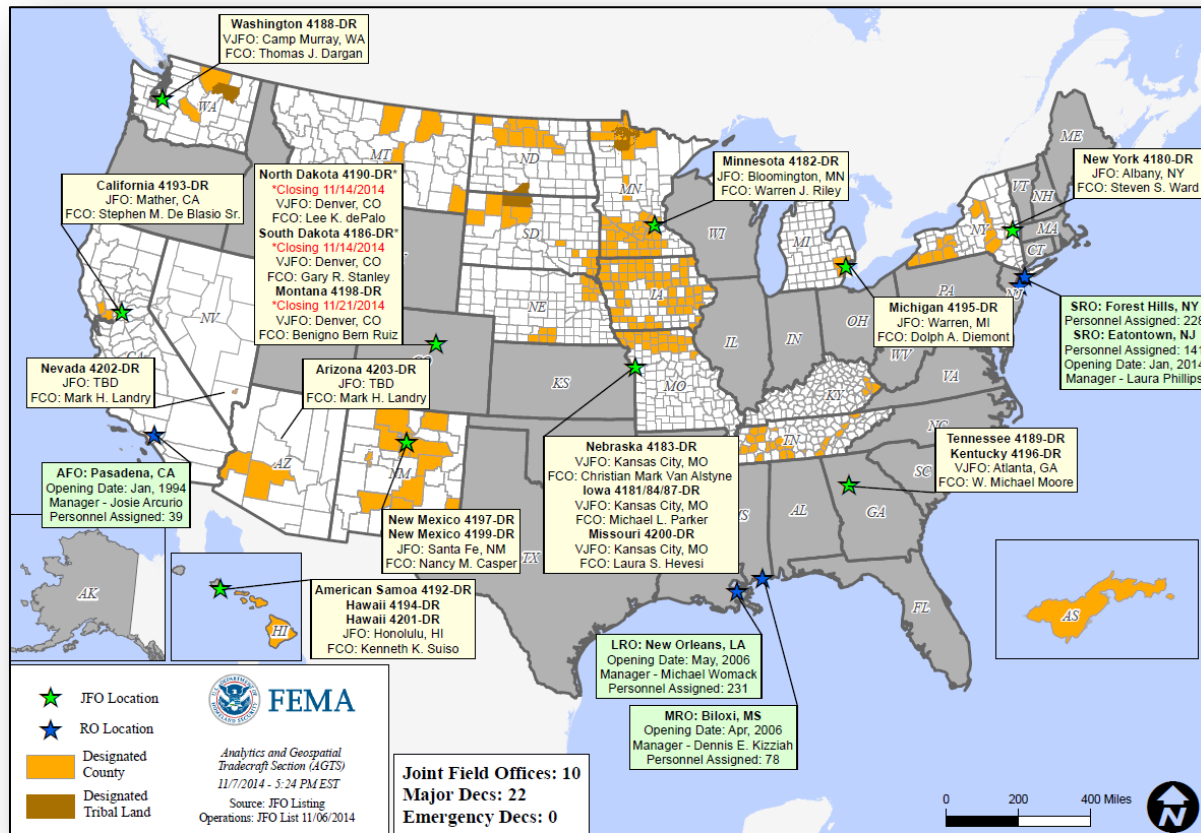
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Open Field Offices as of November 10



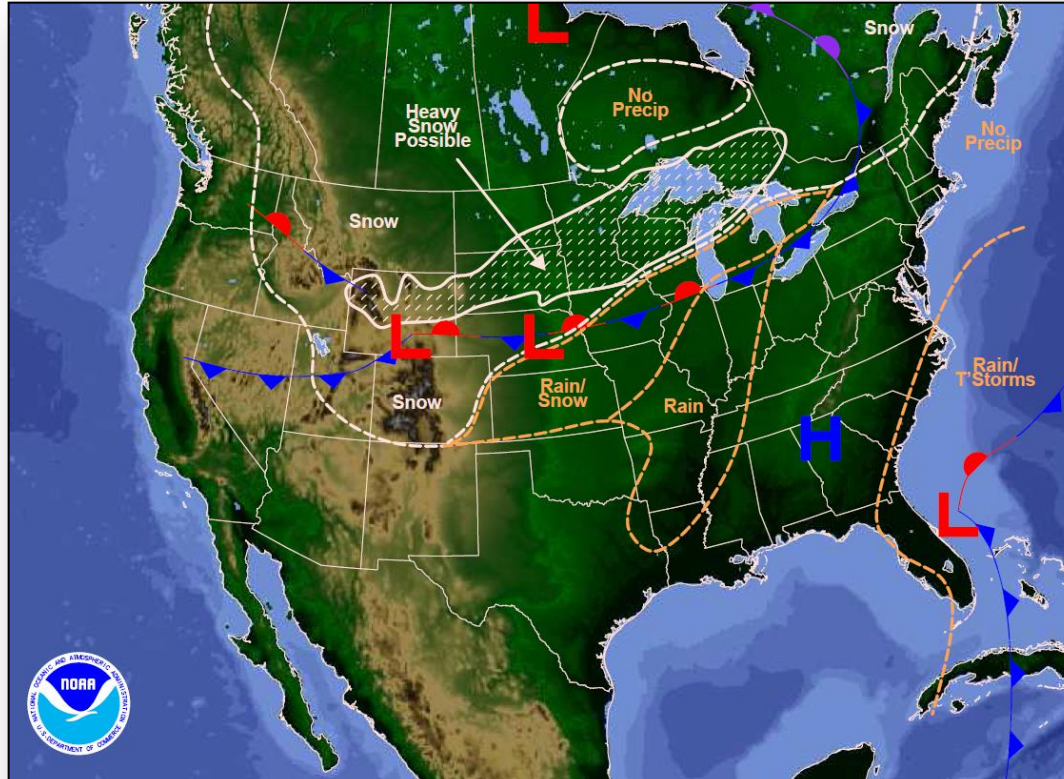

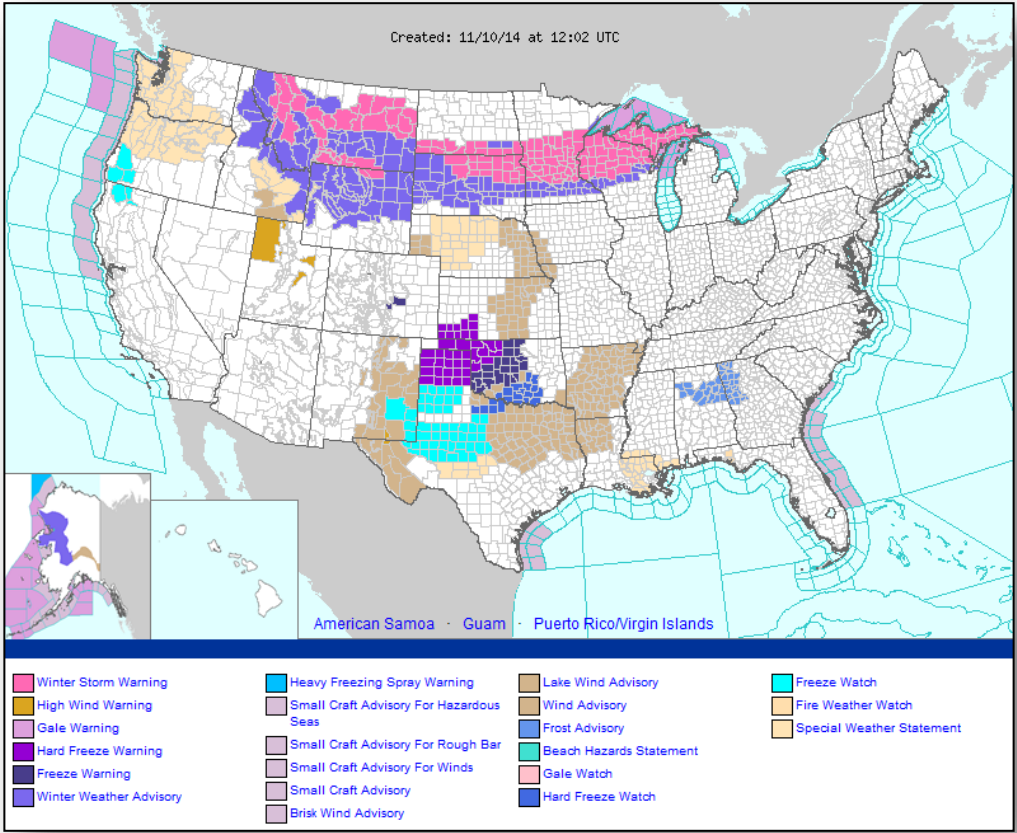

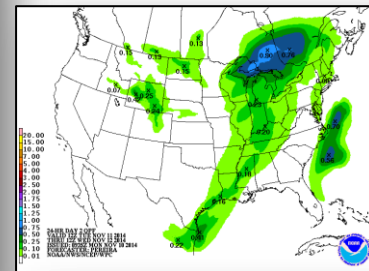
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day



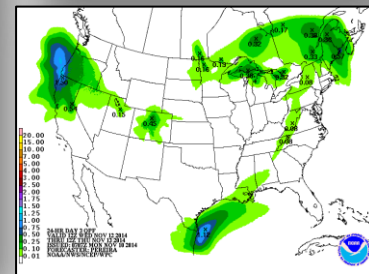

Snowfall Forecast

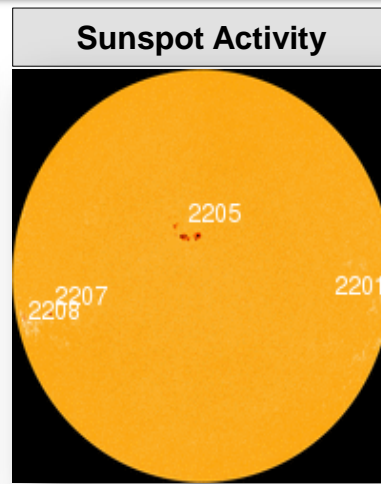
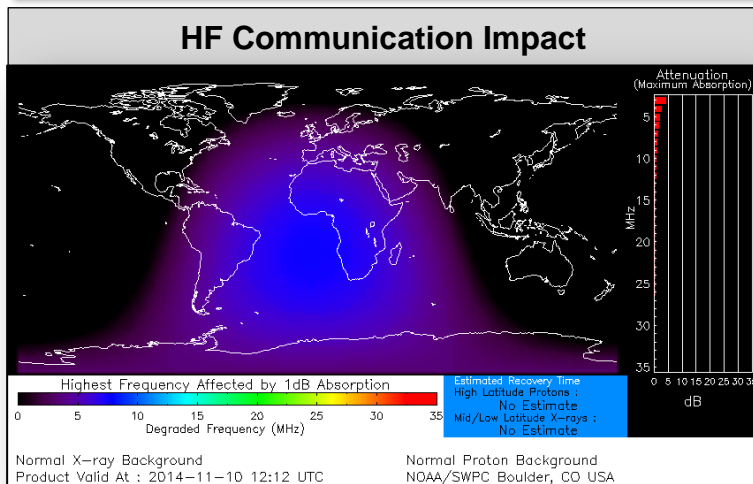
