Significant Weather:

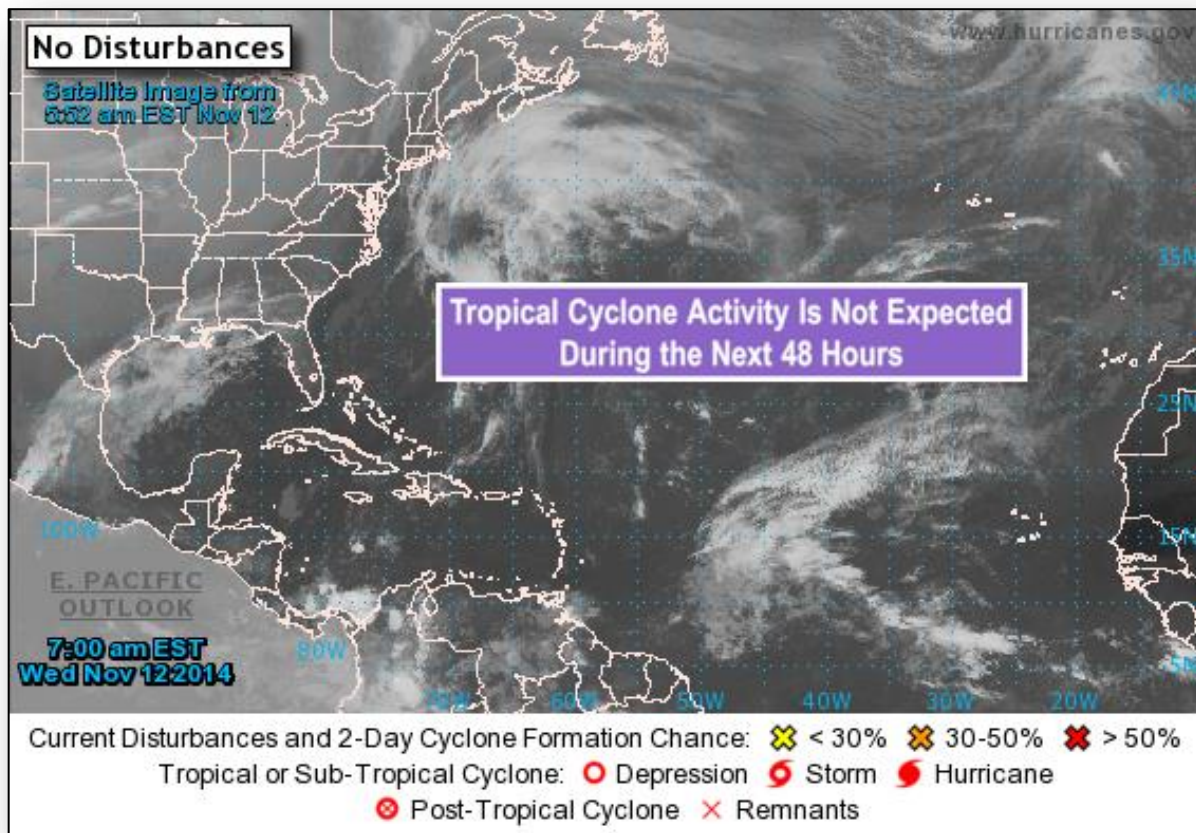
- Freezing rain – Pacific Northwest/Northern Intermountain

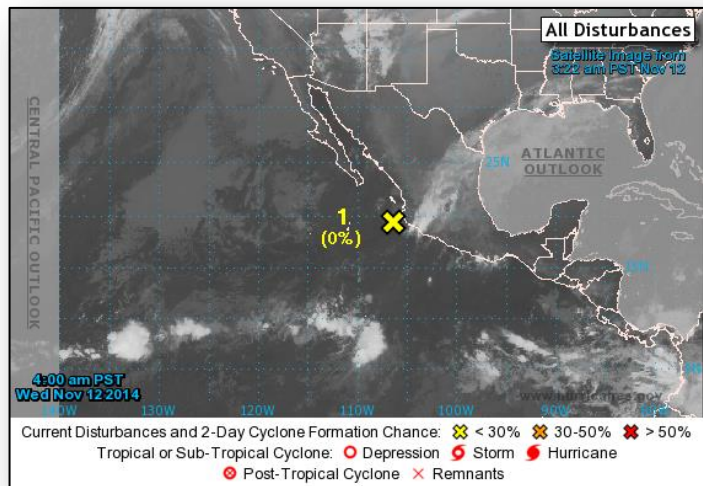
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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Disturbance 1 – Eastern Pacific



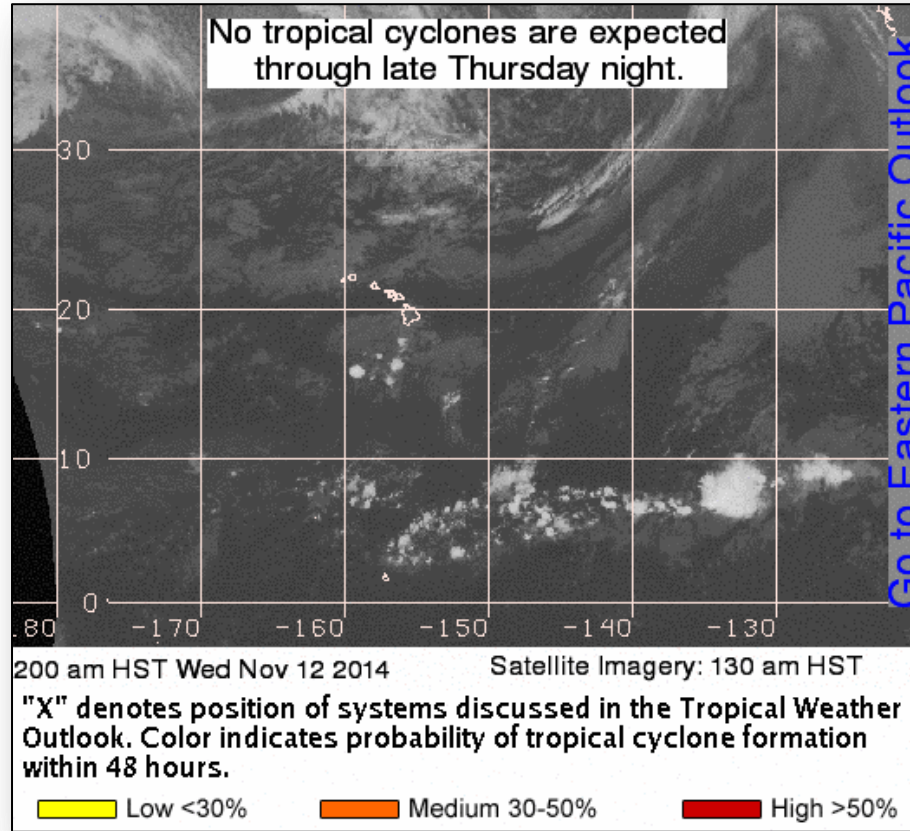

2 Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



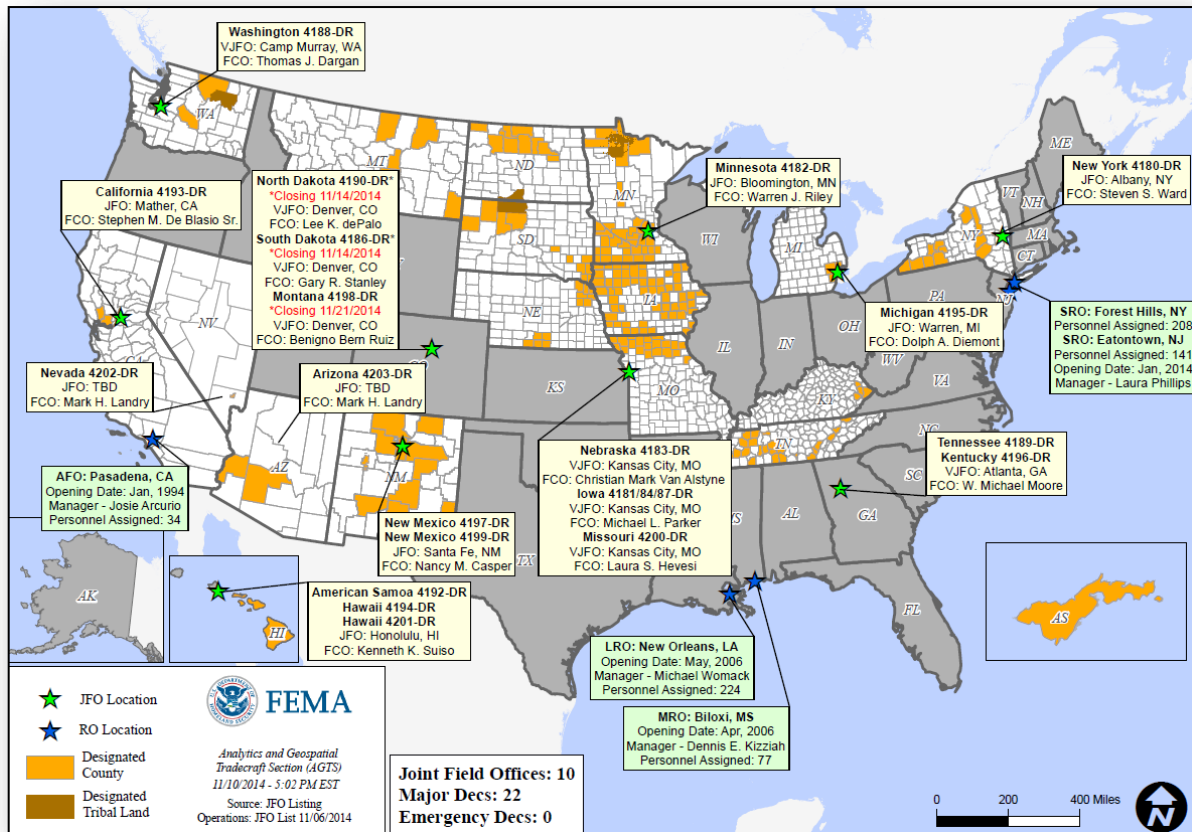
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Open Field Offices as of November 12



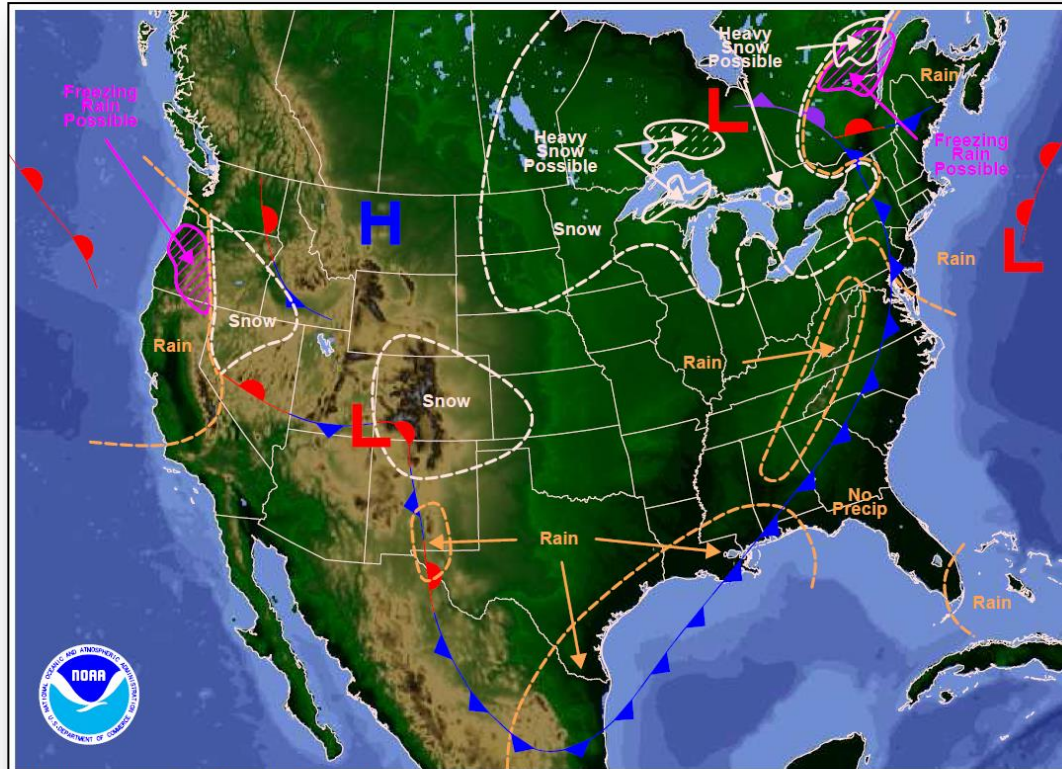

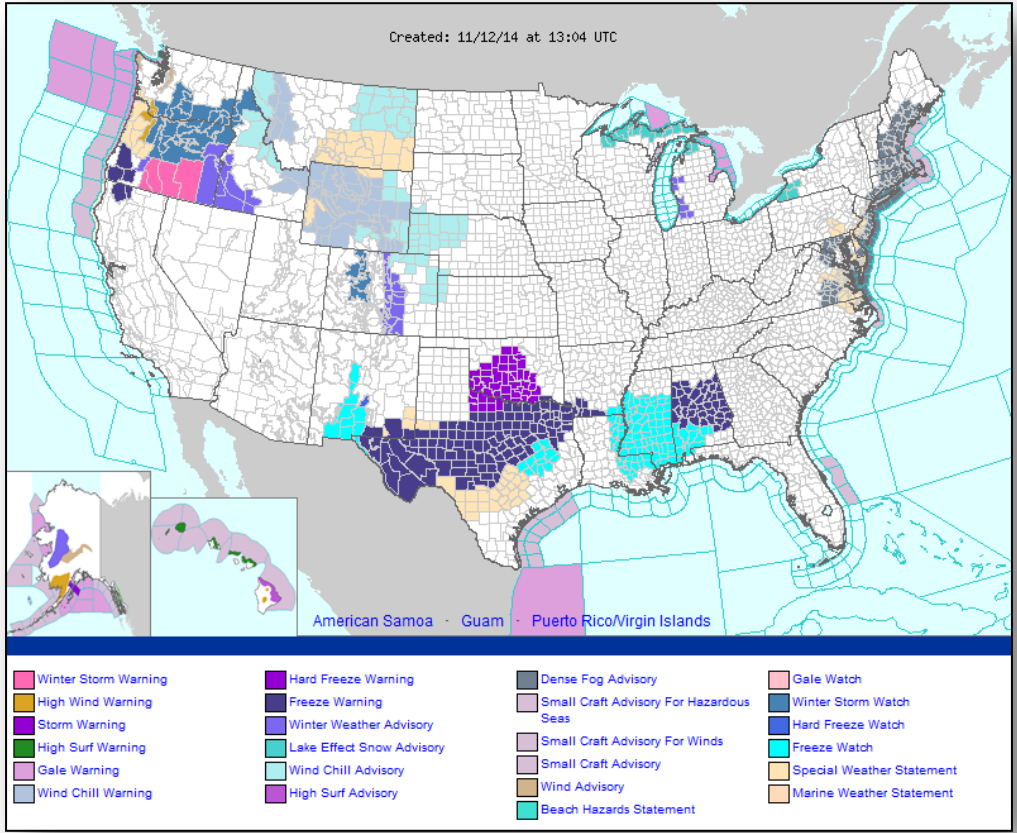

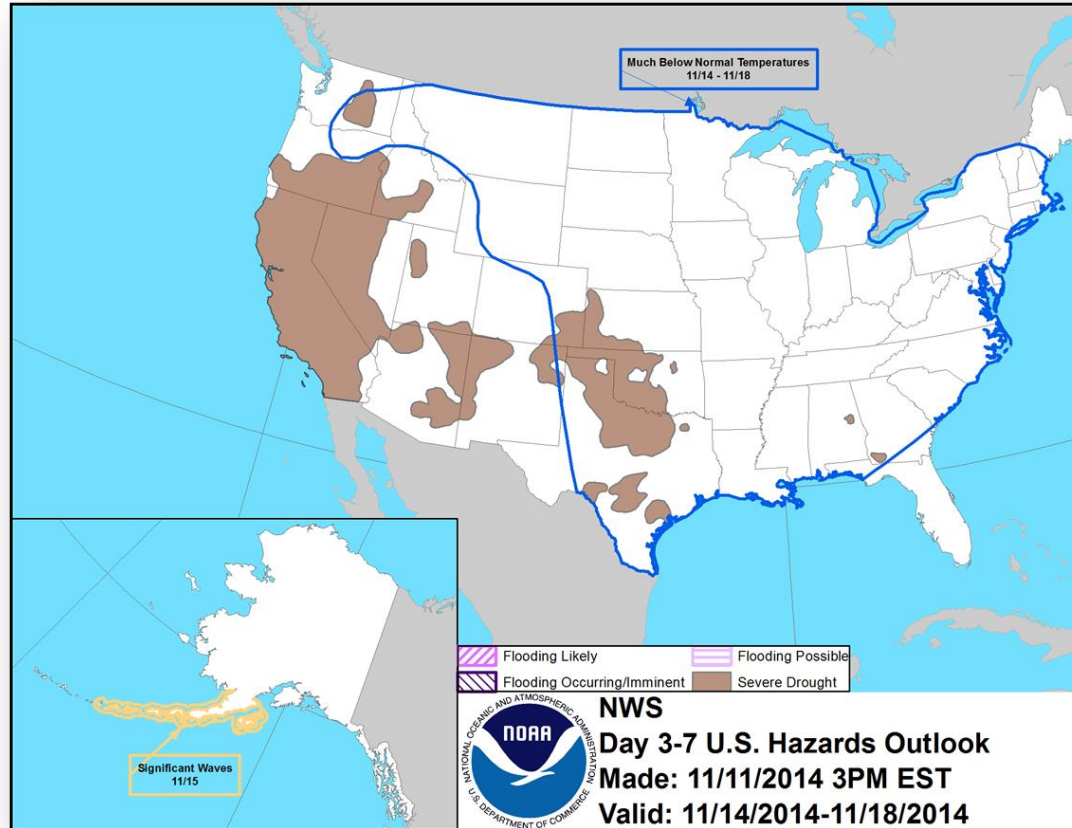

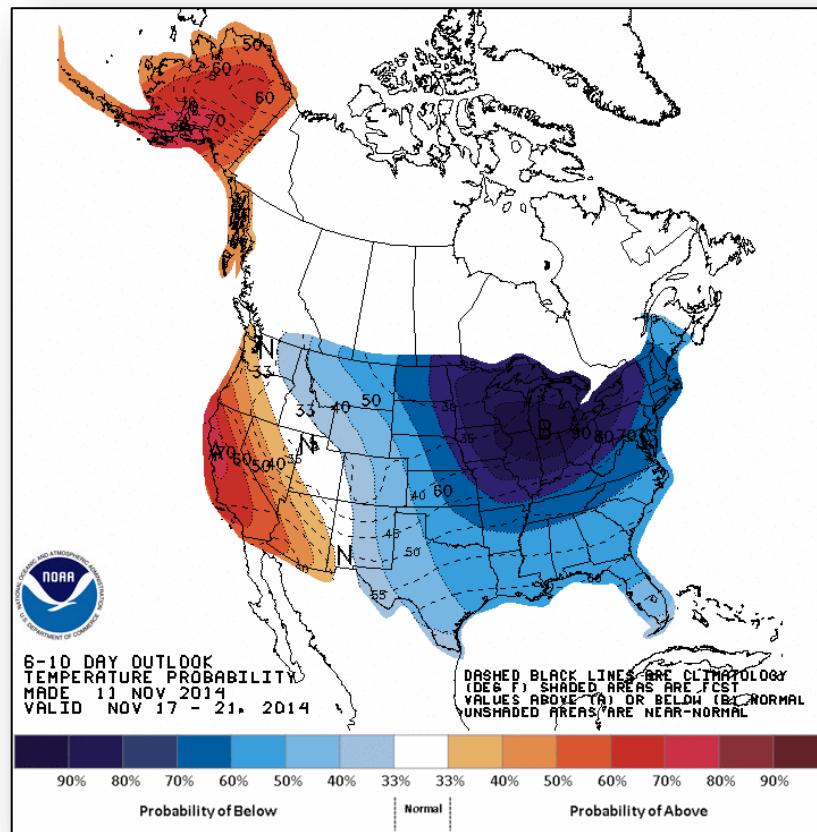
Snowfall Forecast



Hazard Outlook: Nov 14-18



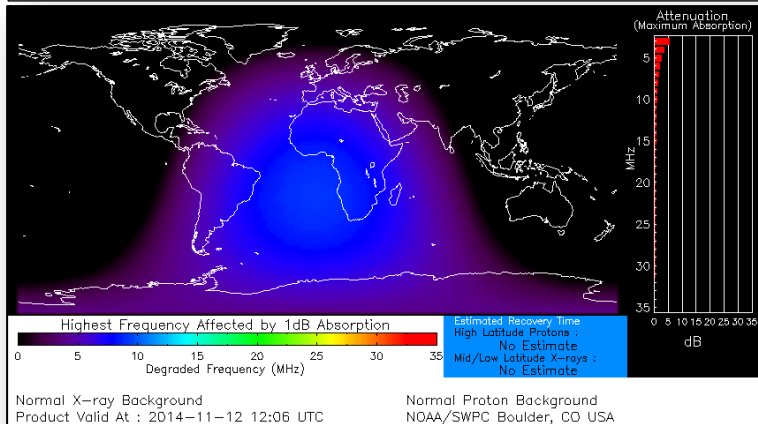
6-10 Day Temperature Outlook



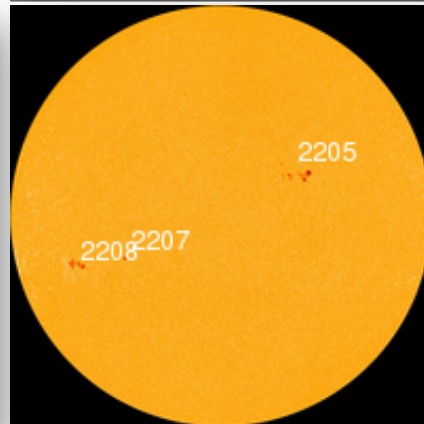

Sunspot Activity



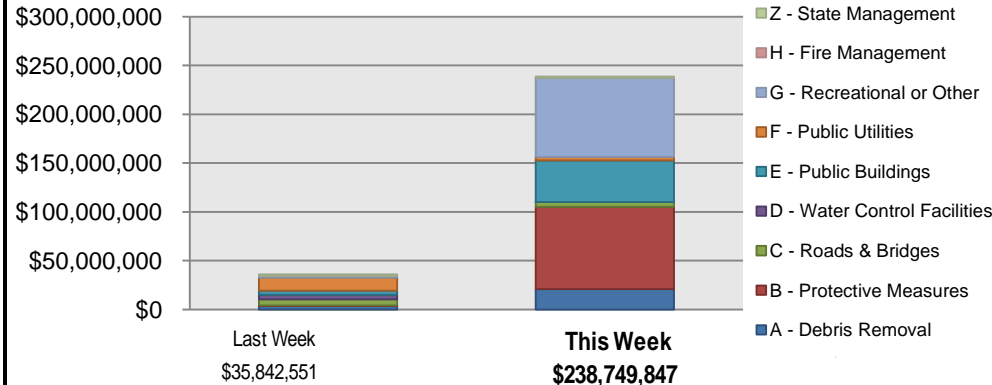

PA Highlights

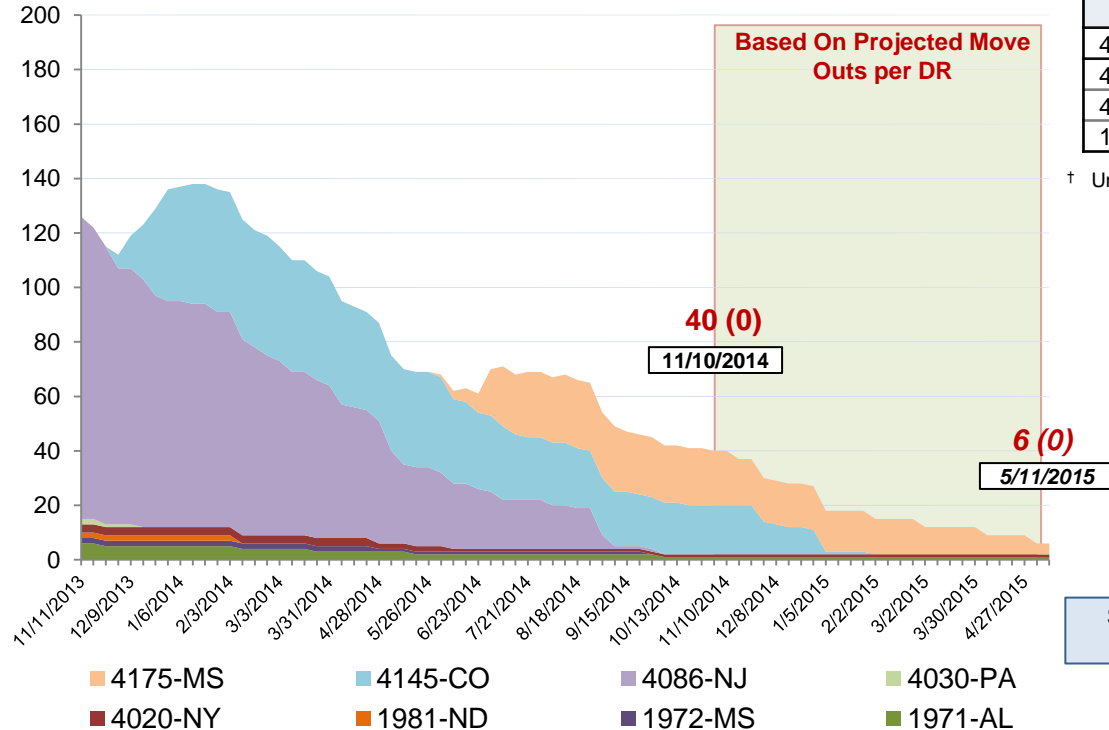

Direct Housing



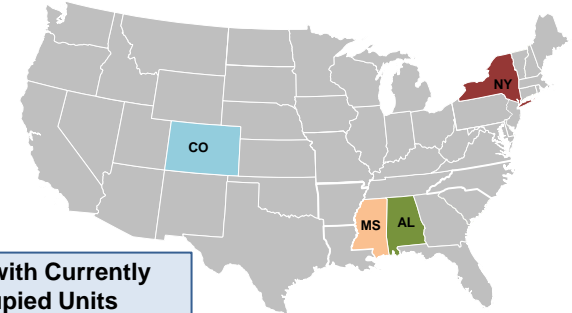
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Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State

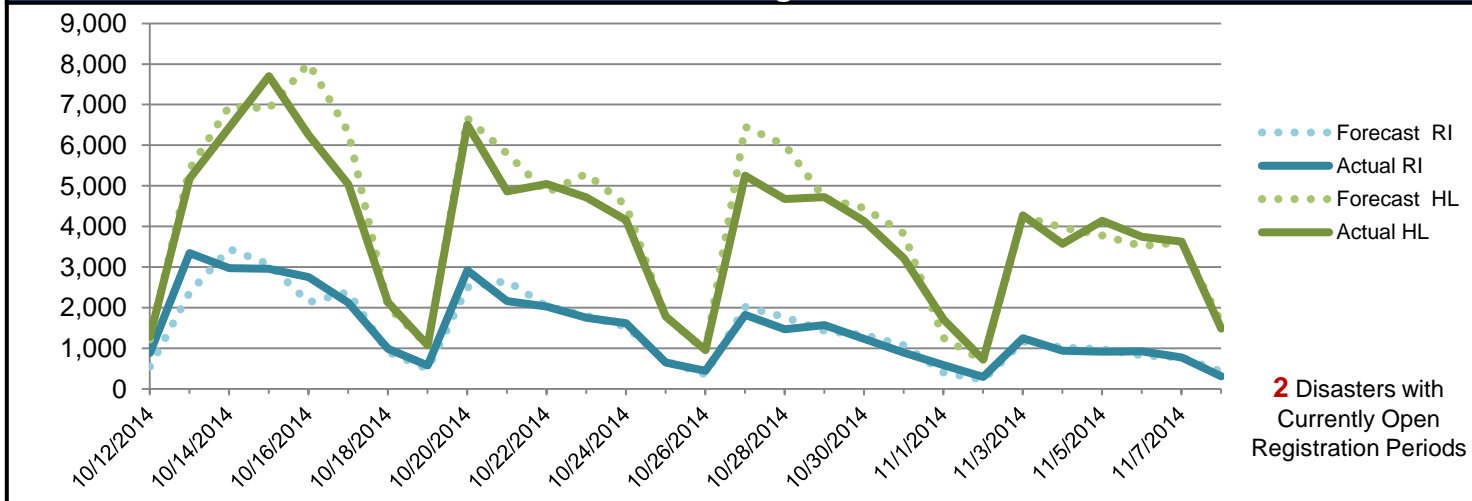

NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 10/12/2014 through 11/8/2014



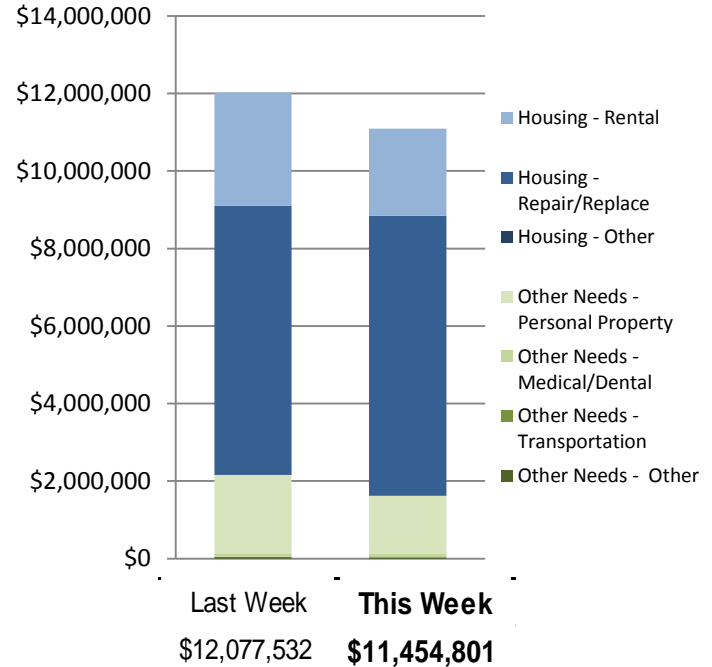
