Significant Weather:

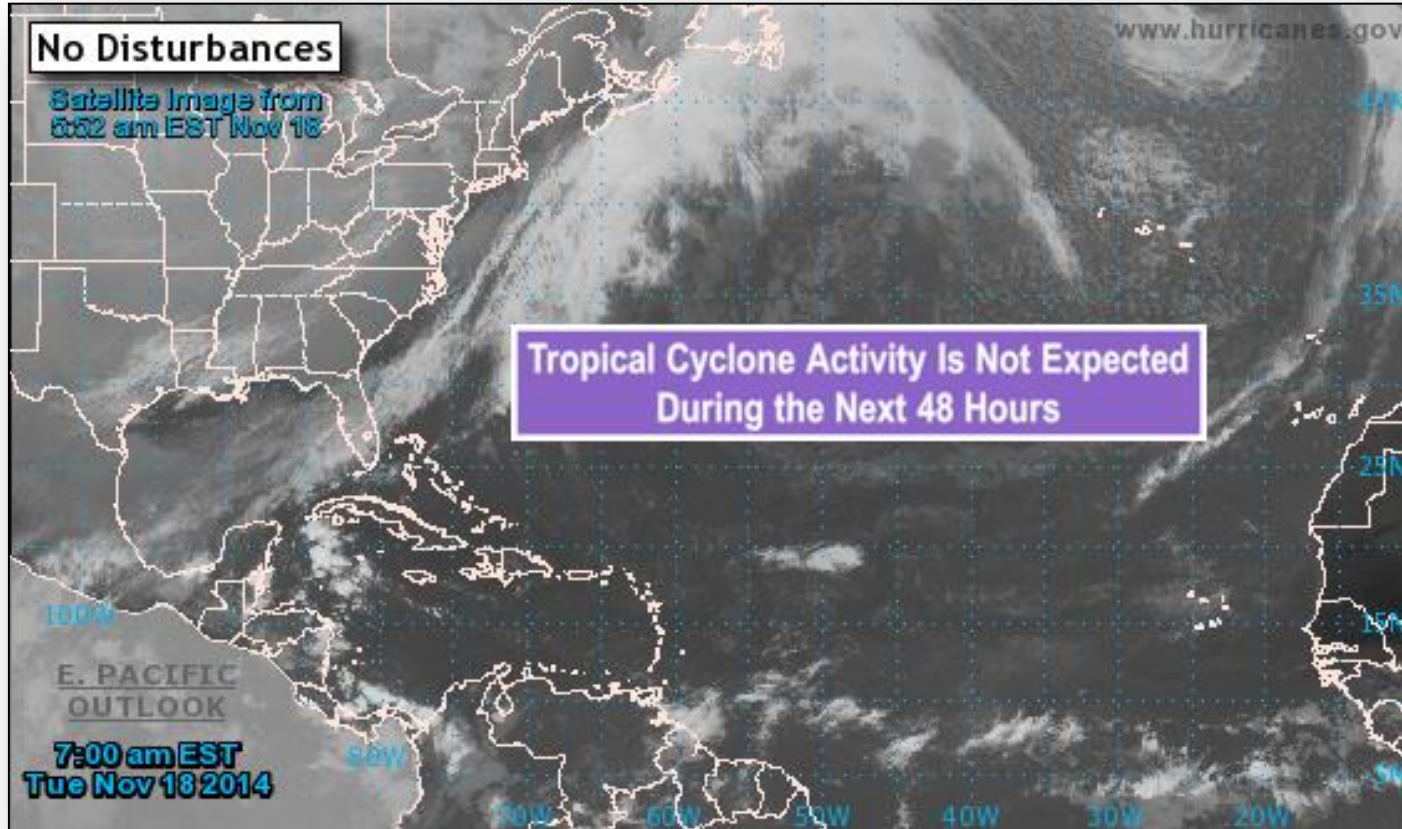
- Heavy Lake effect snow

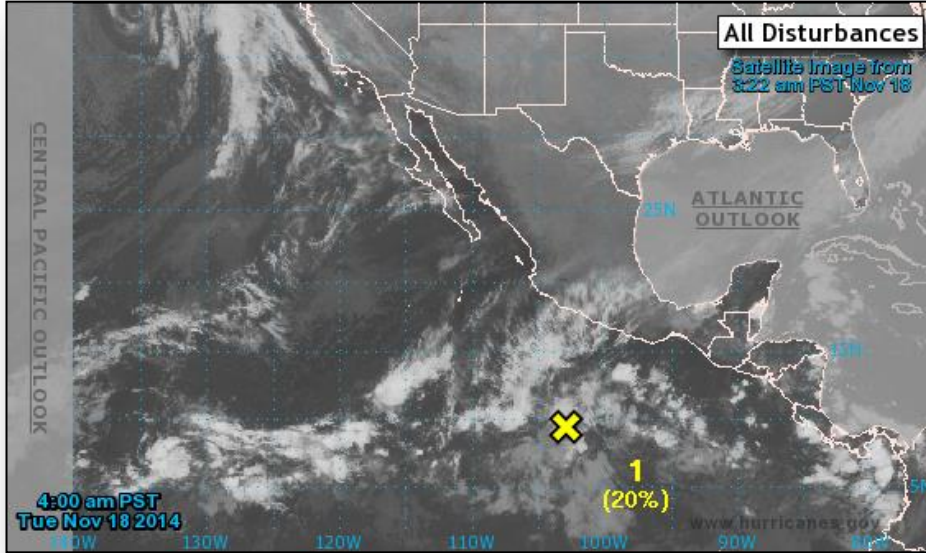
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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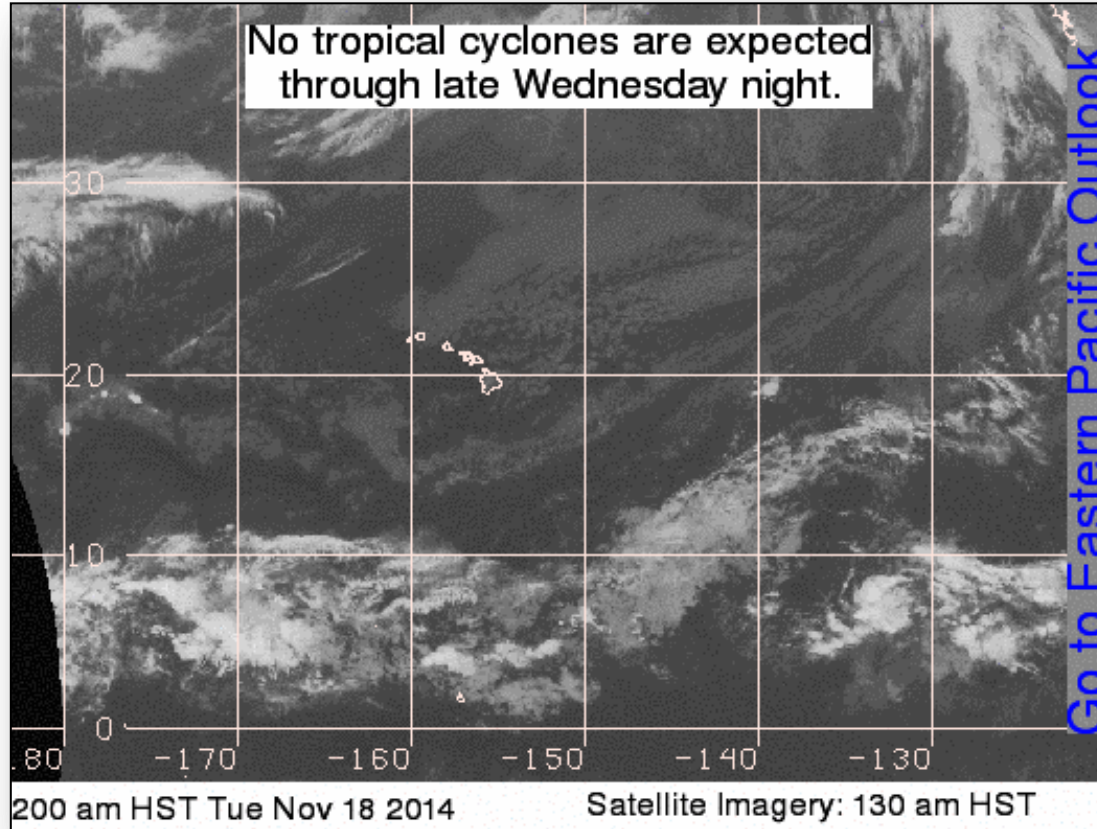
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

 - Next 5 days – Medium, 40%

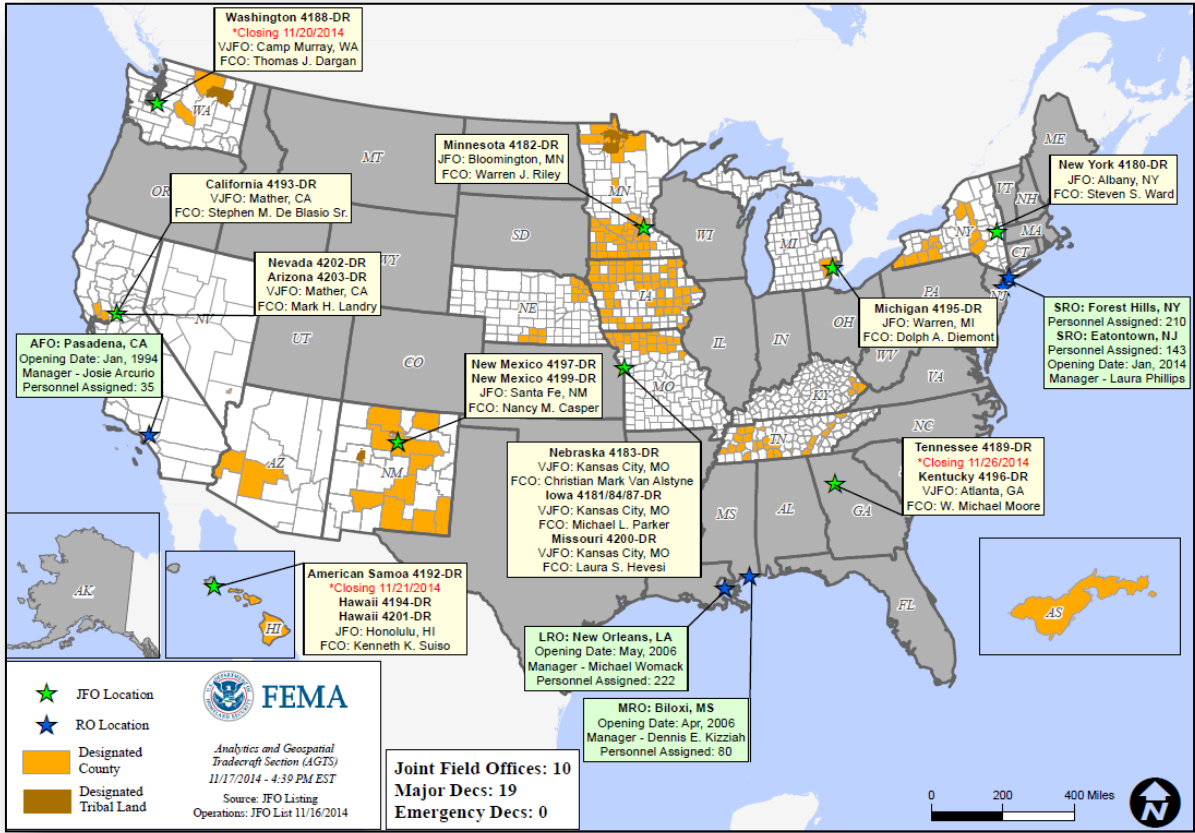
2 Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Open Field Offices as of November 18



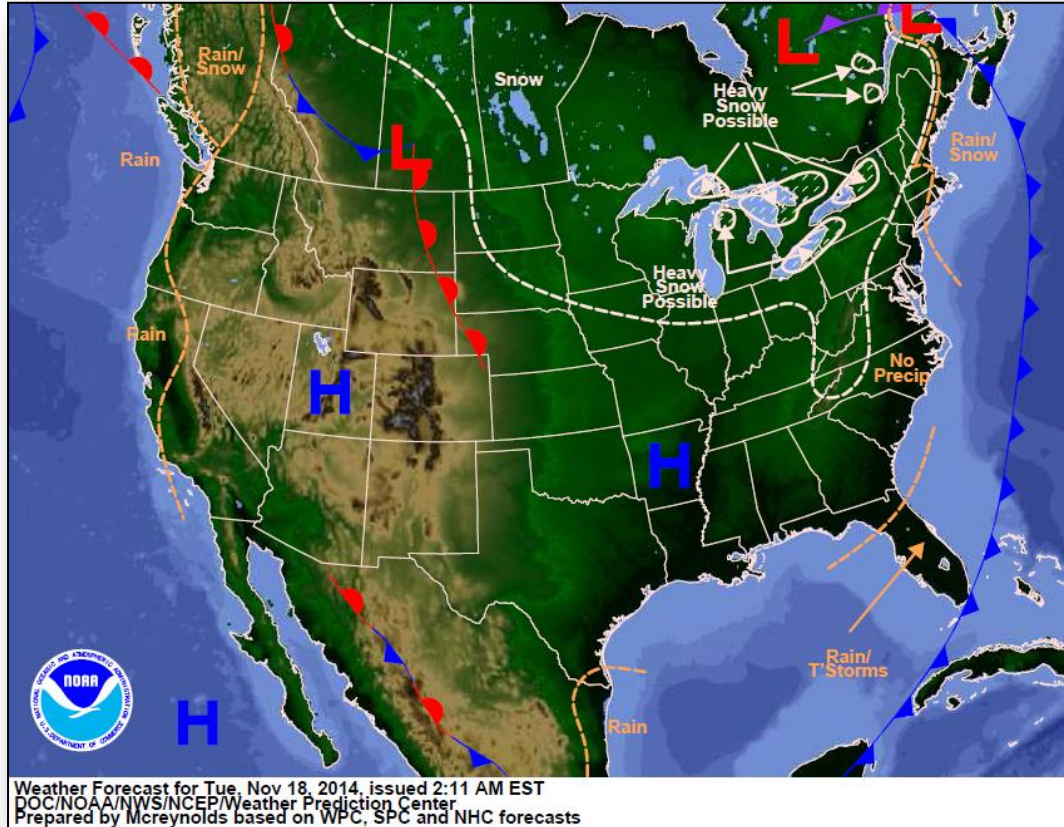
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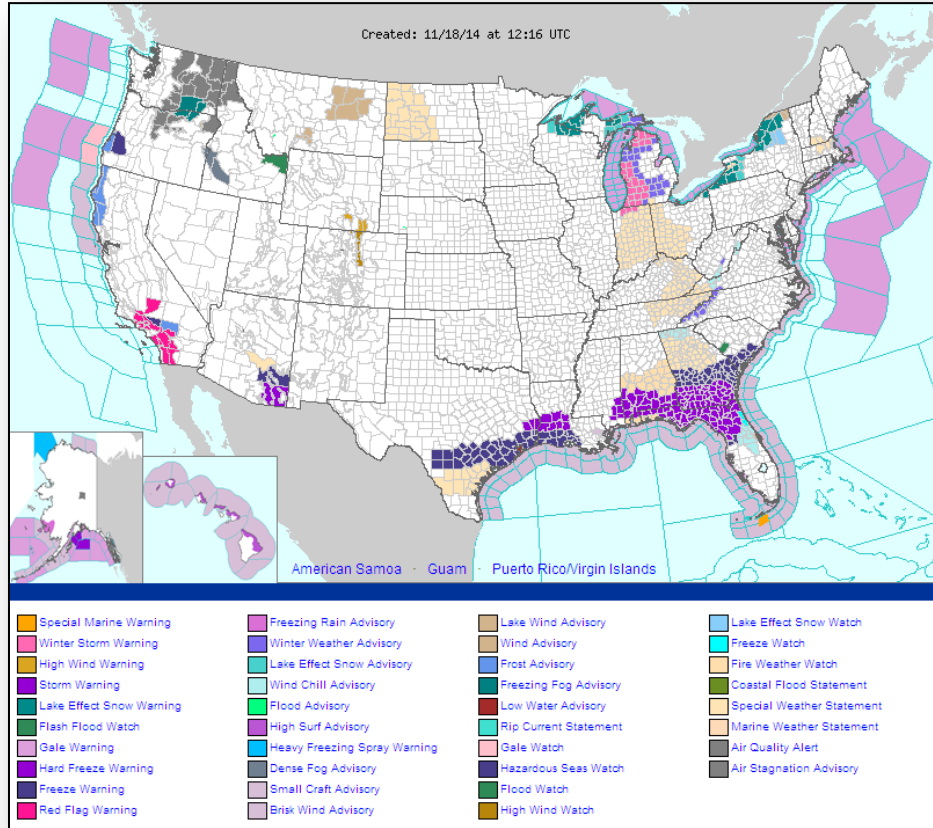

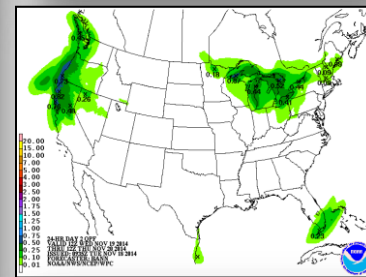
Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day



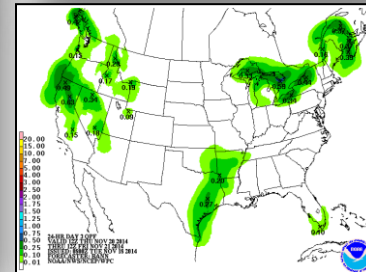

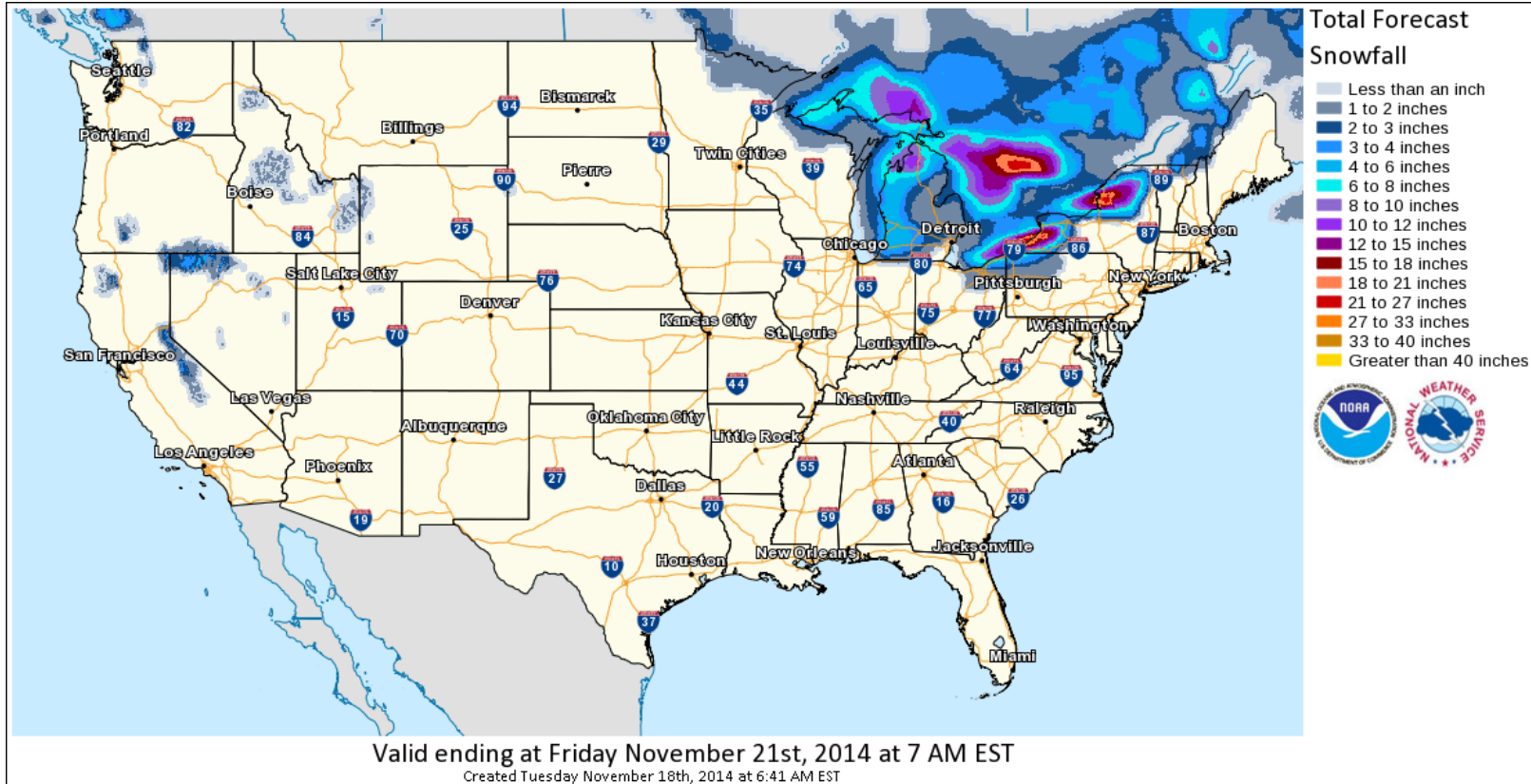

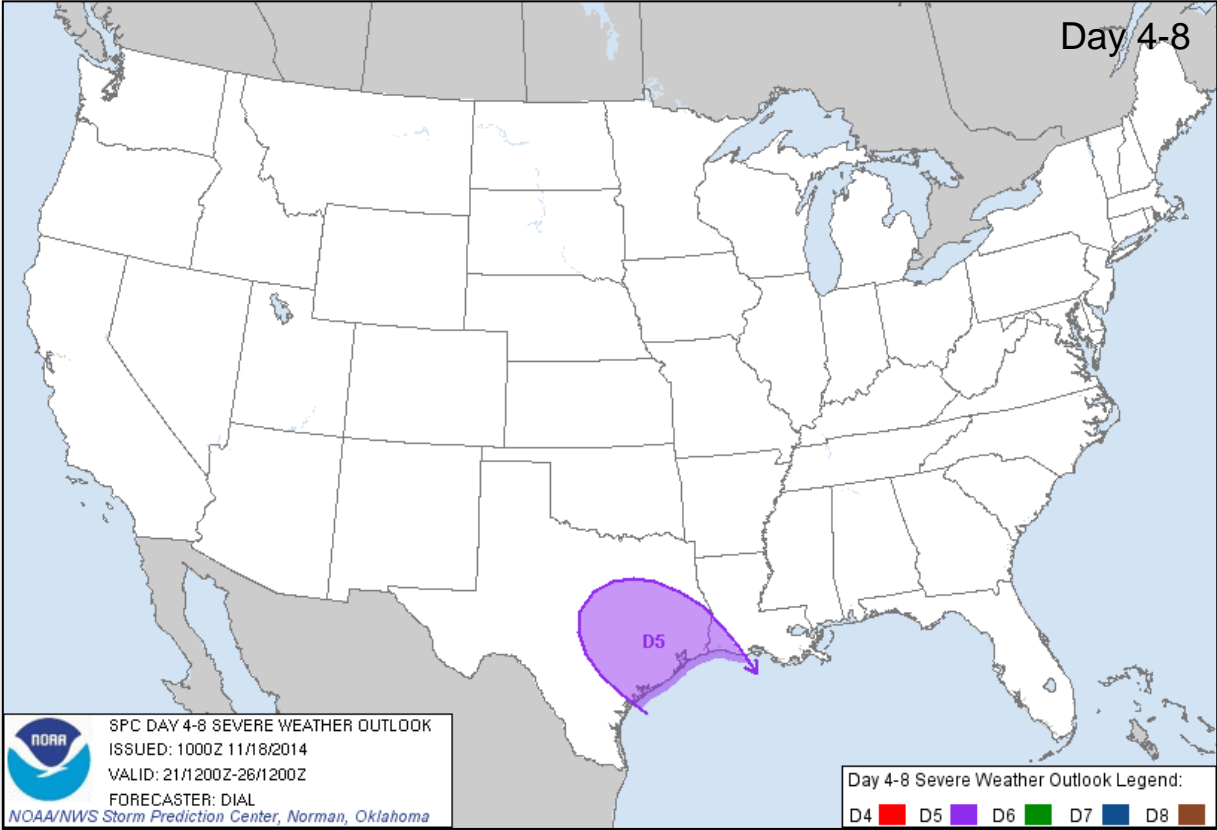
Total Forecast Snowfall



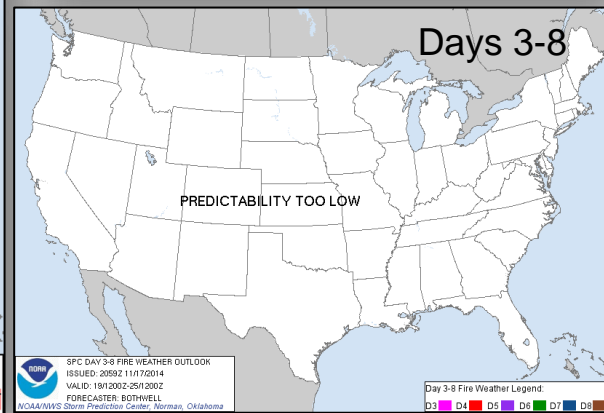
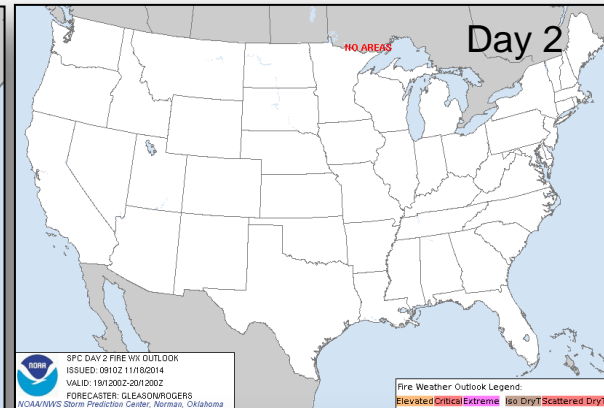
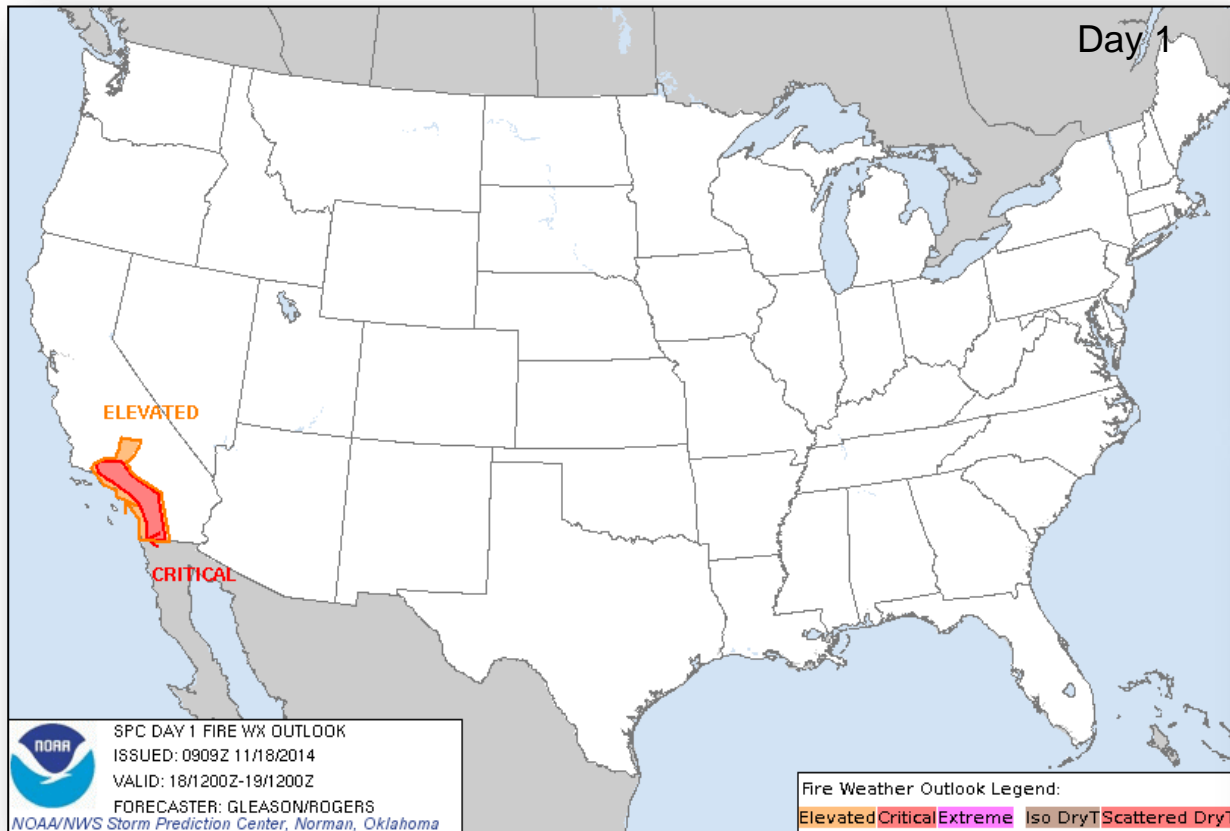
Convective Outlook, Days 4 – 8



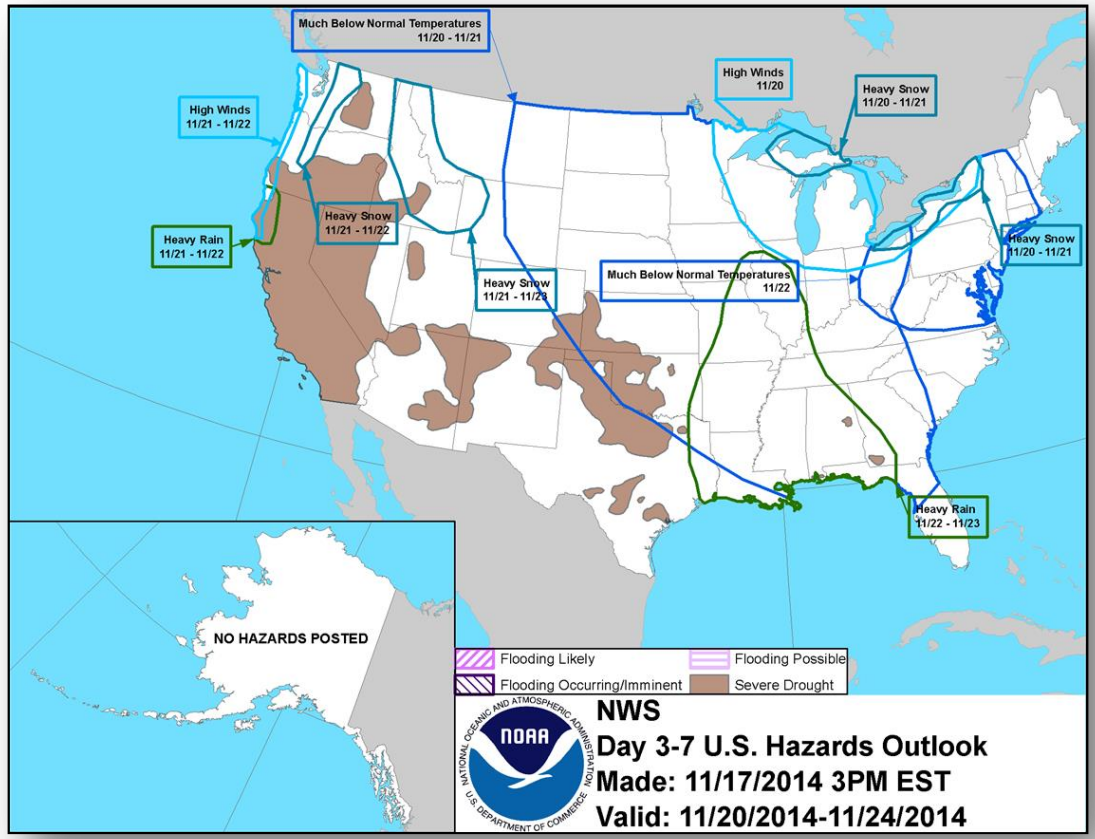
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Fire Weather Outlook, Days 1 – 8



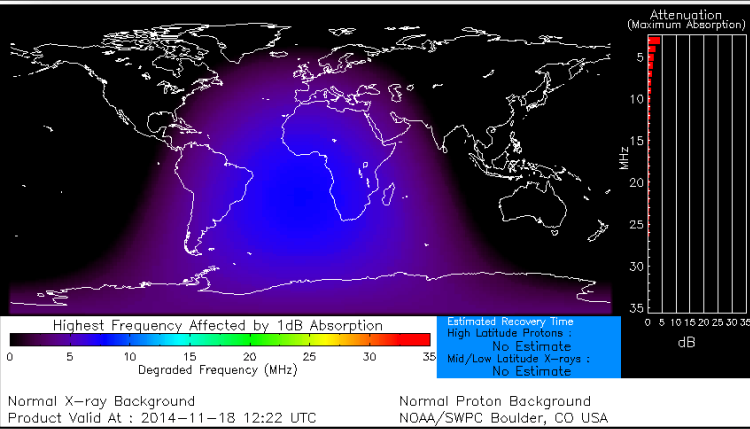

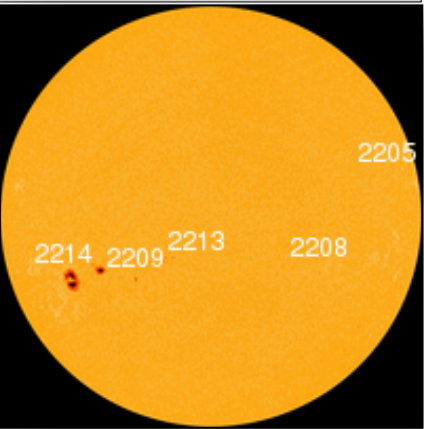

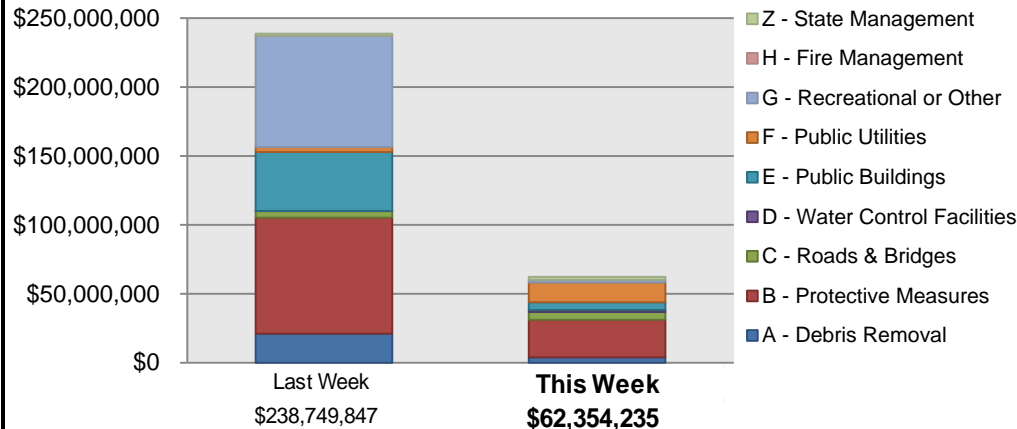

Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 11/4/2014 through 11/17/2014



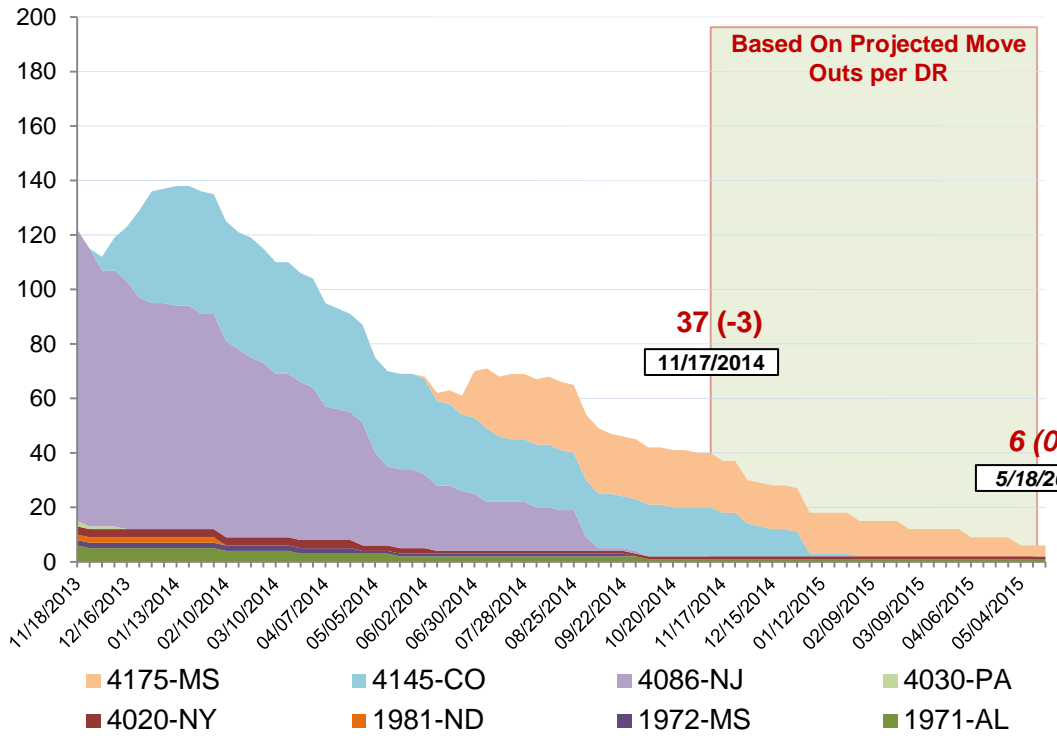
PA Highlights

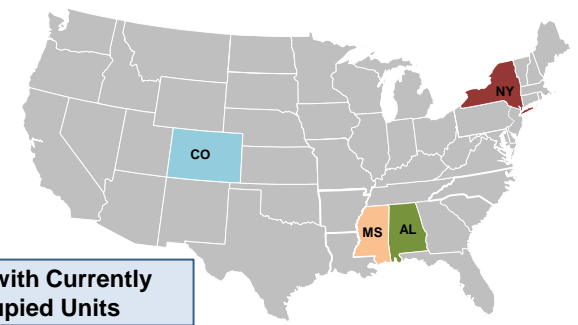
Direct Housing (Data as of 10/10)

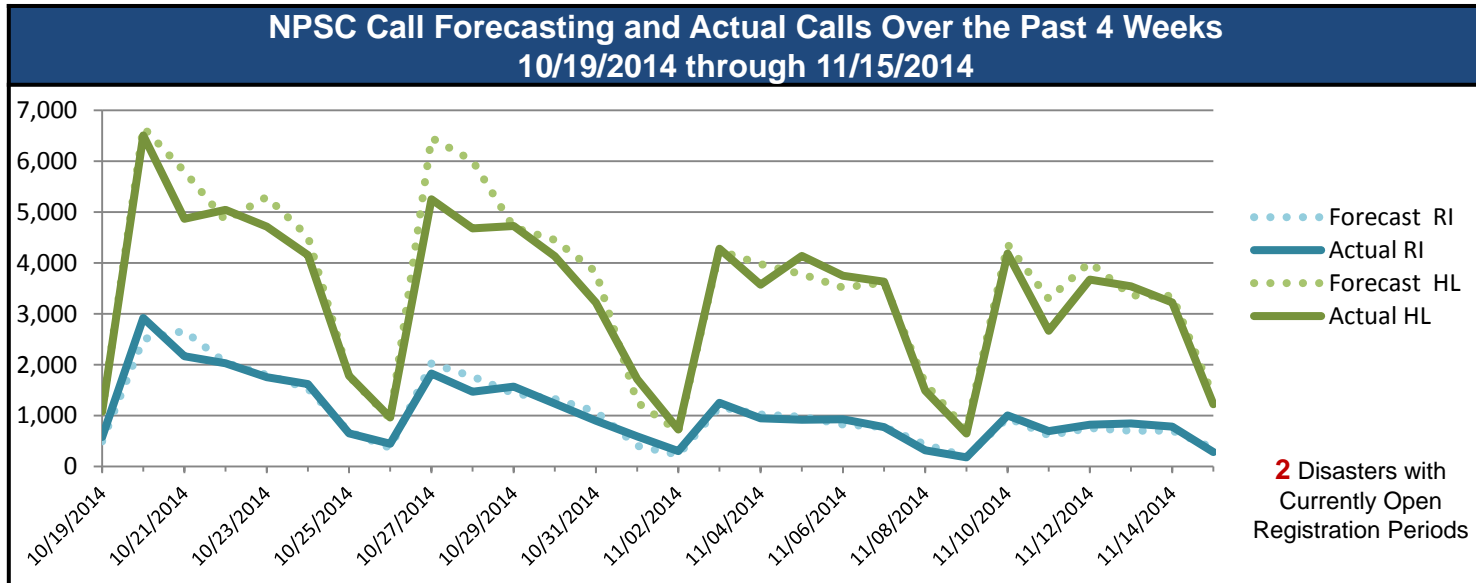

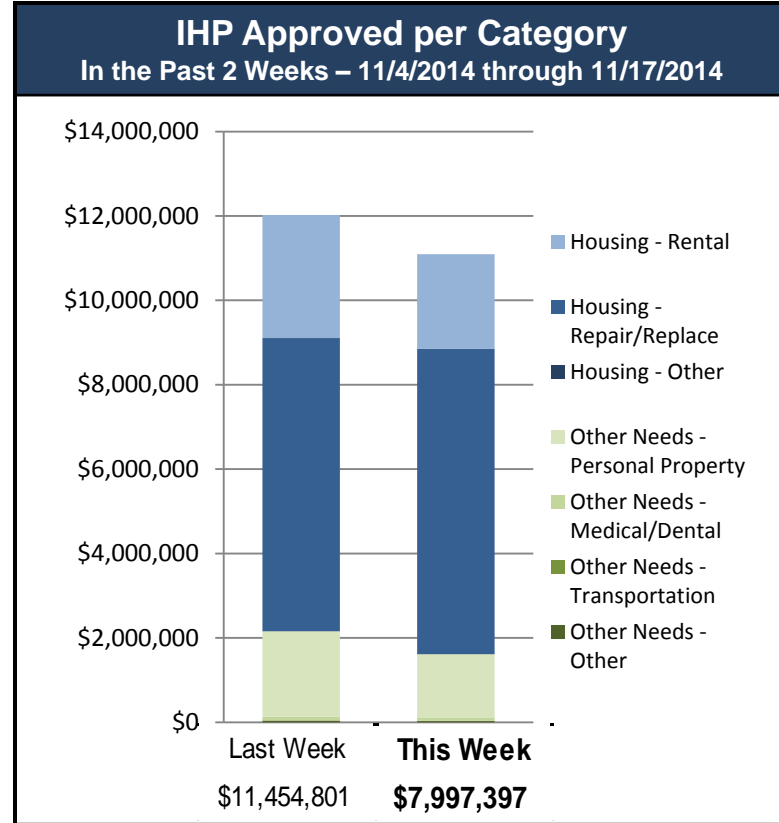
