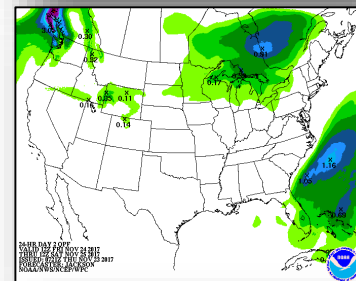
Precipitation Forecast



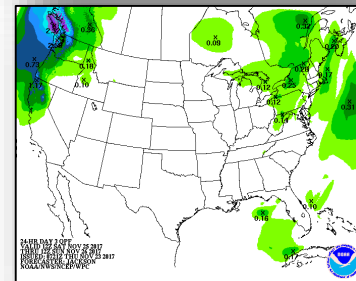

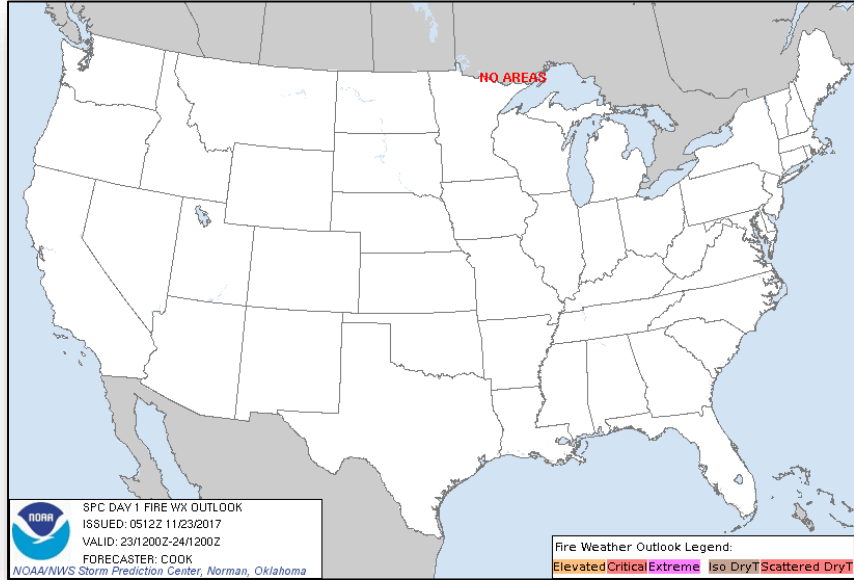

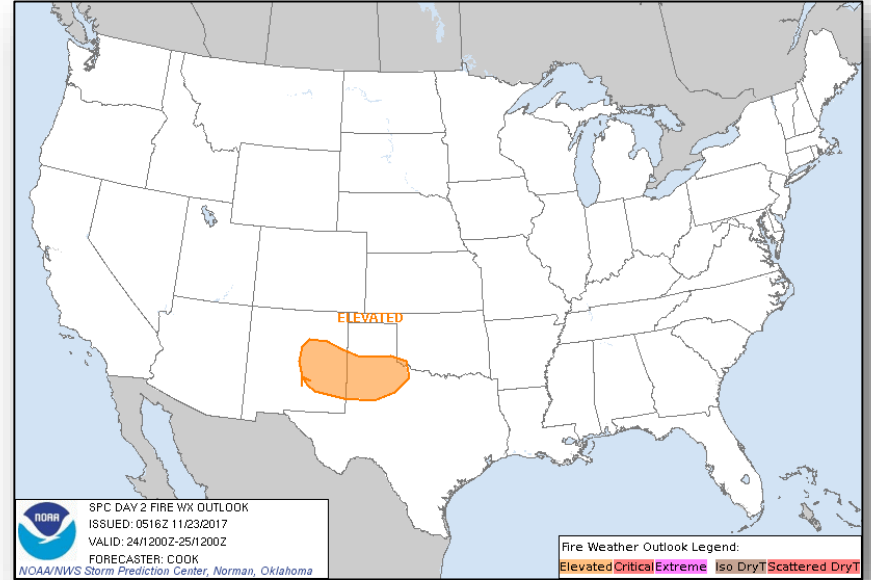
Fire Weather Outlook
