  - Next 24 hours – None

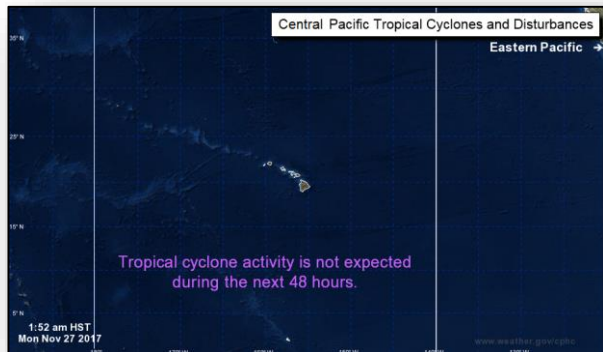

***Eastern Pacific***

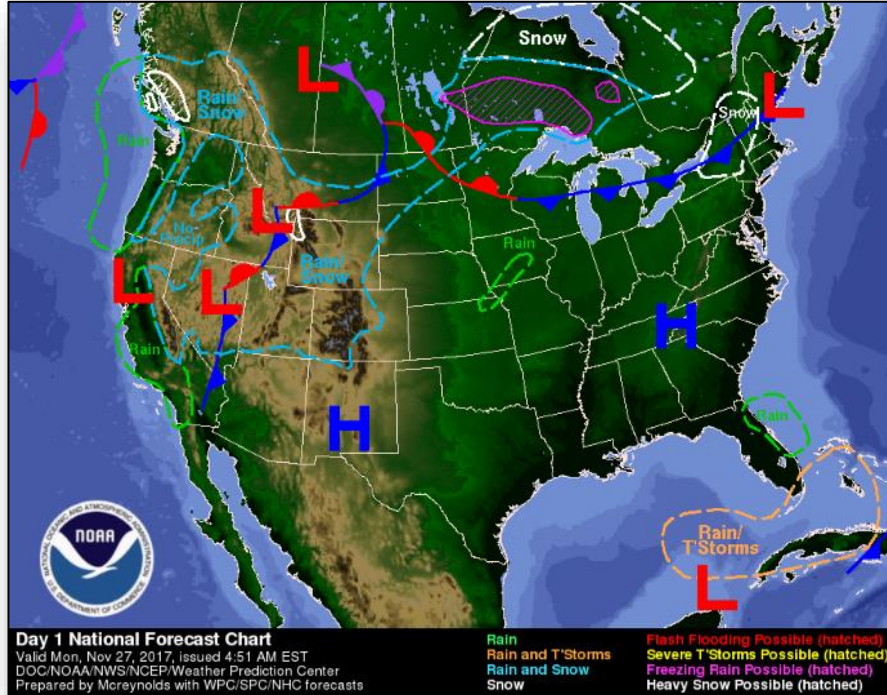

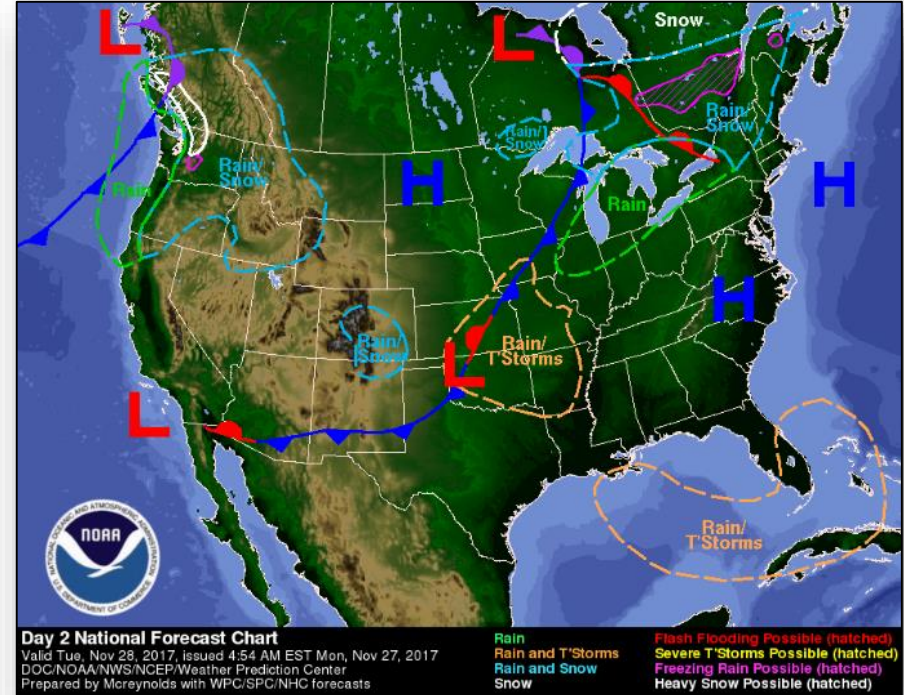

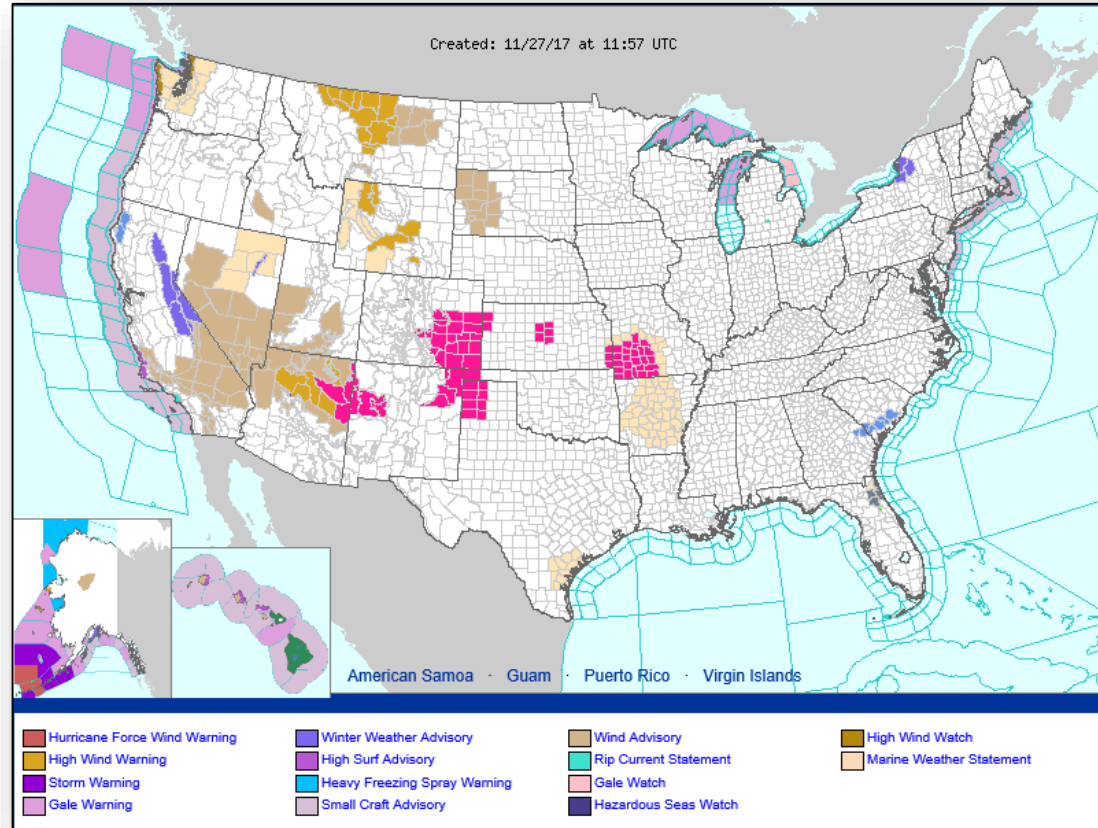

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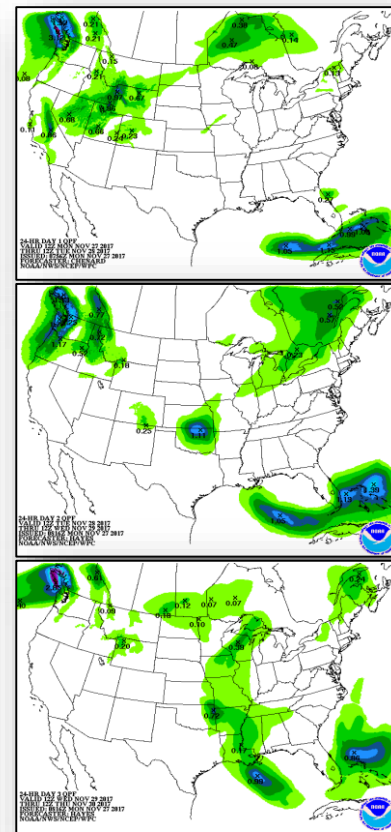
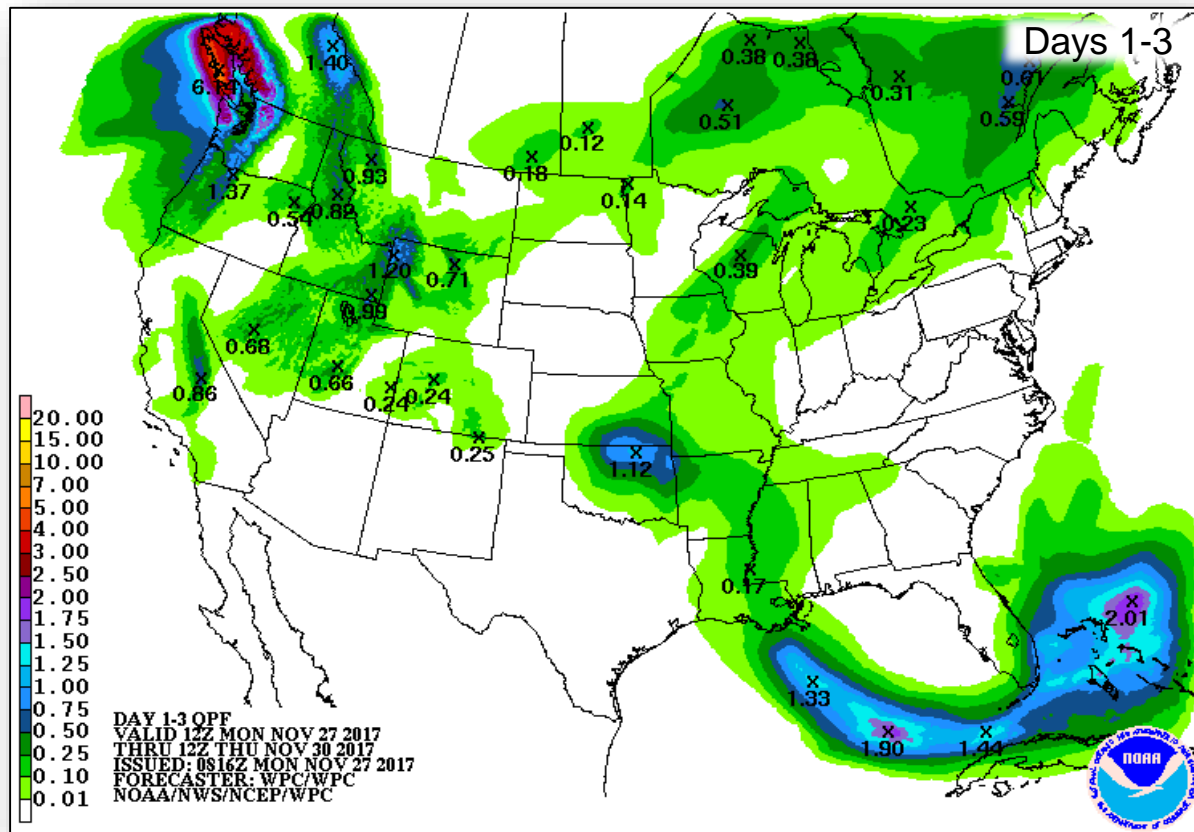




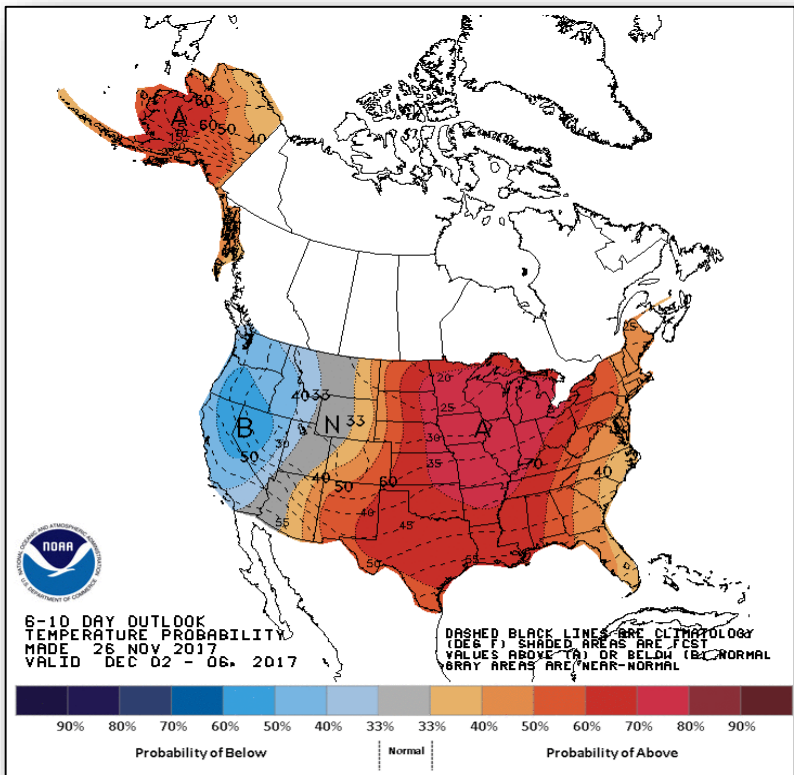
# Precipitation Forecast



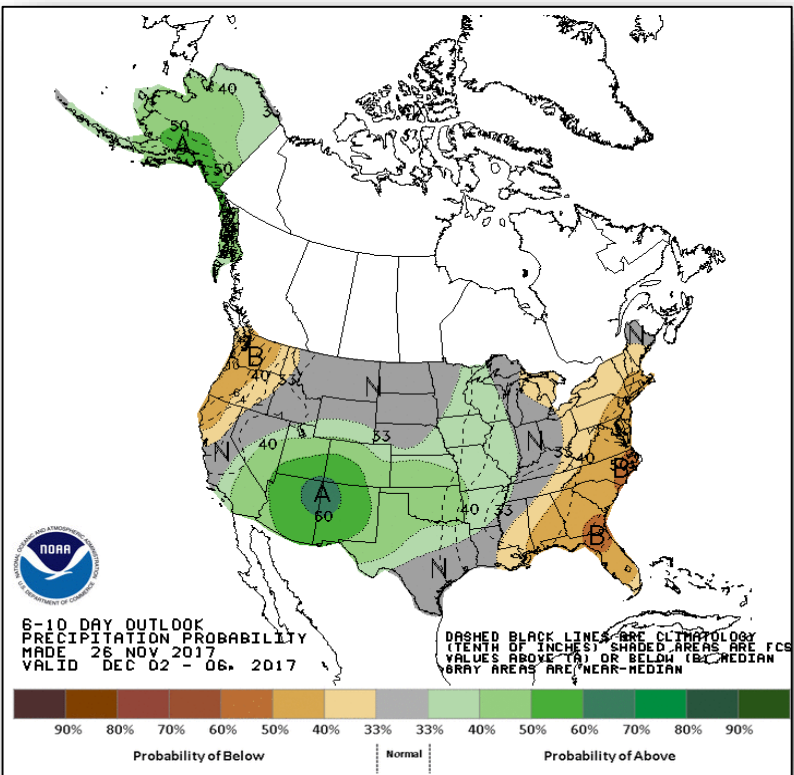
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# 6-10 Day Outlooks


