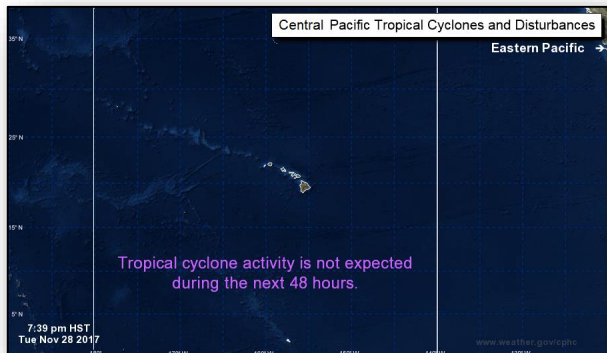

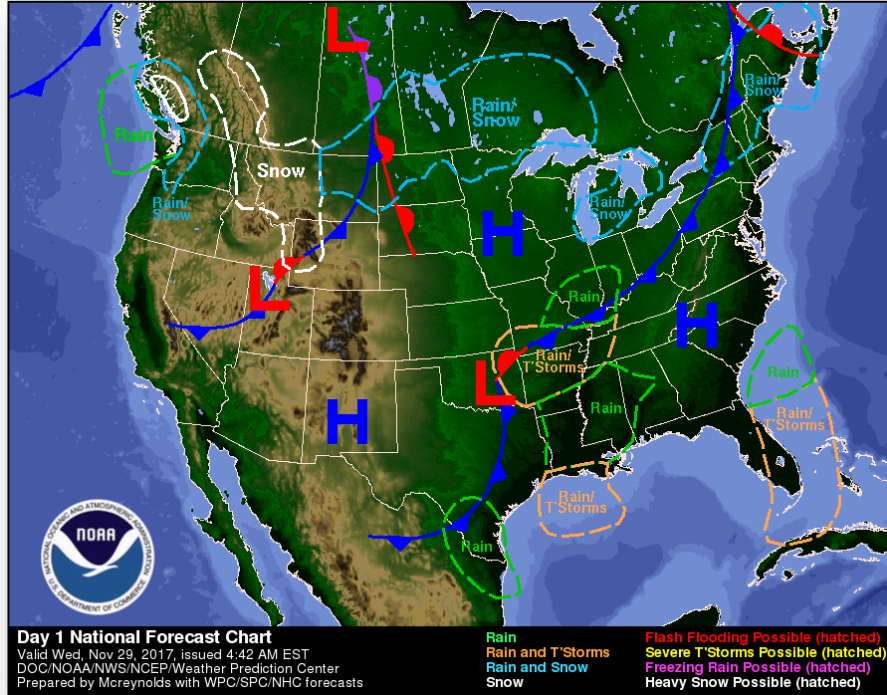

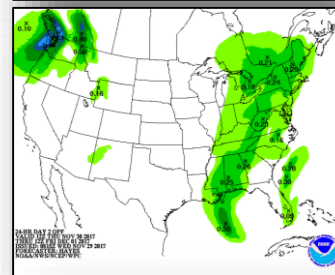
Precipitation Forecast



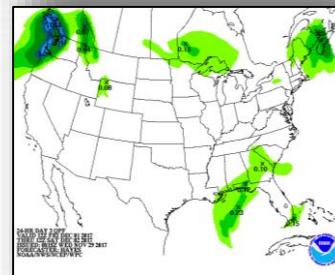

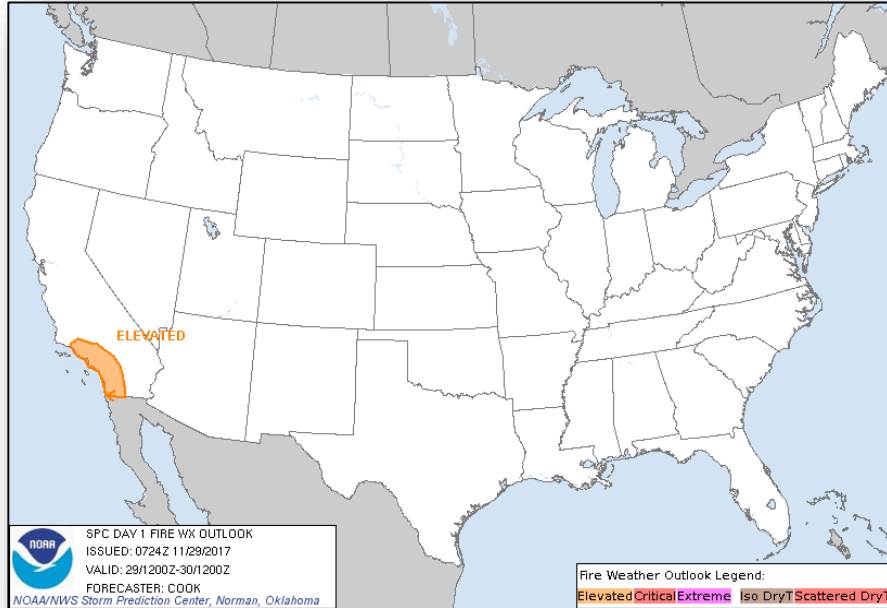

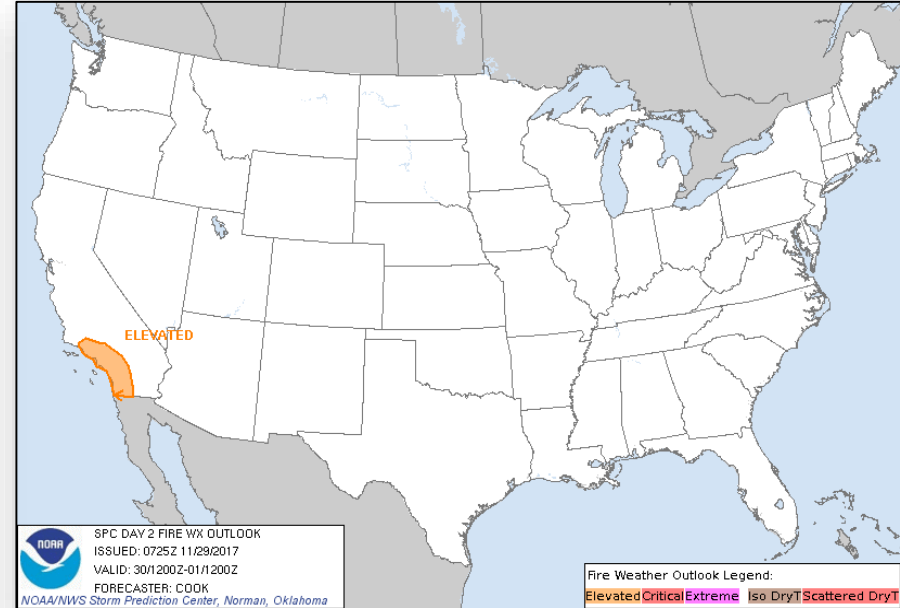
Fire Weather Outlook

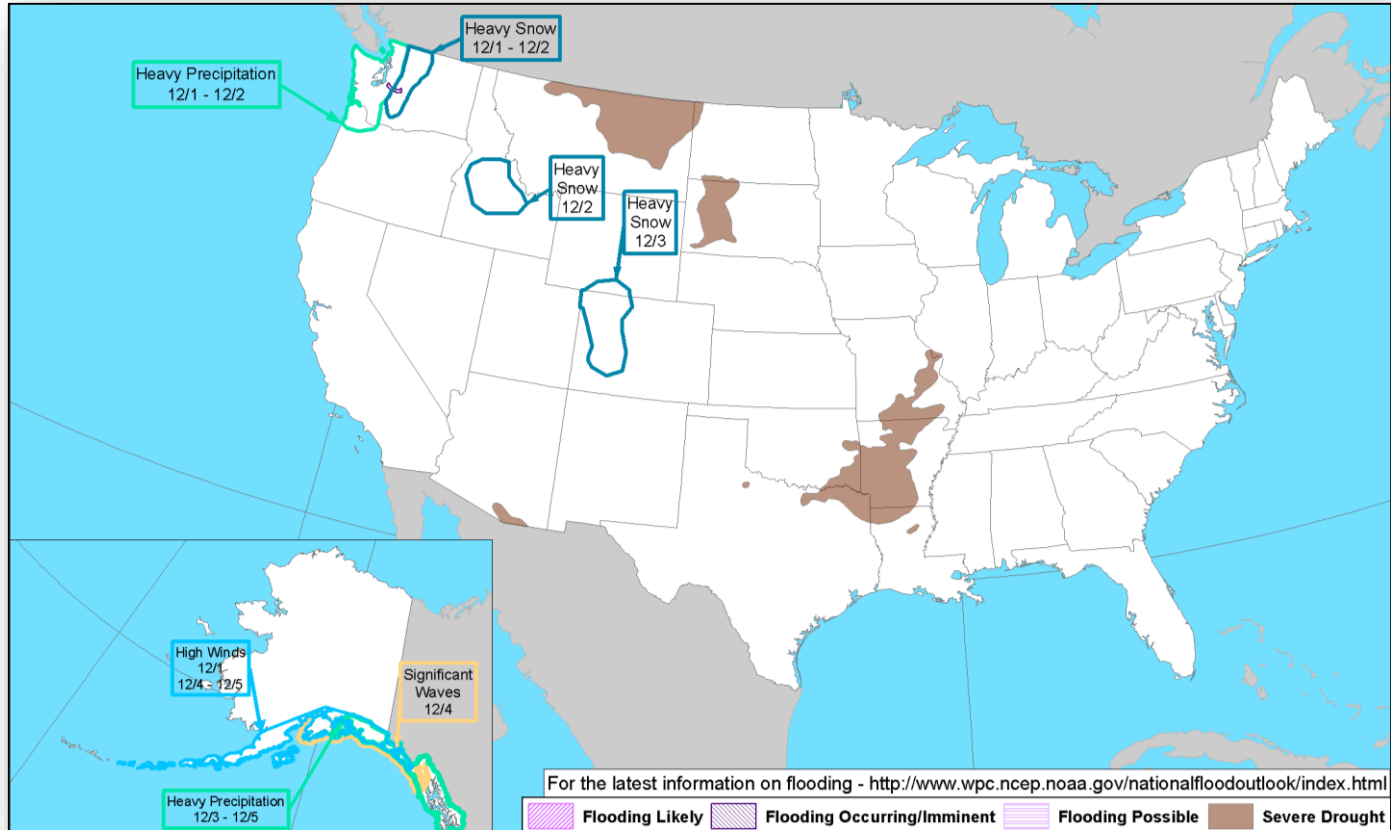

 - Hazard Mitigation statewide



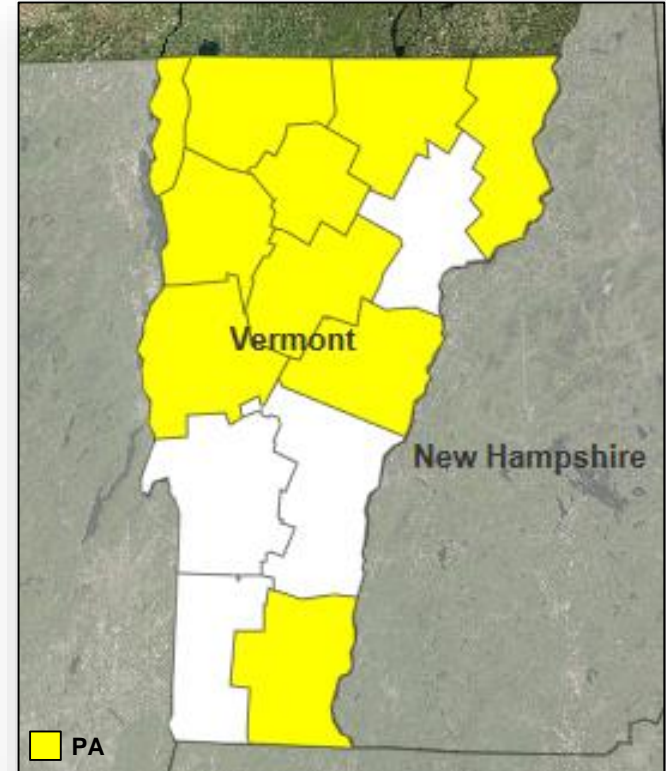


