
- Atlantic: Tropical Storm Kate




Atlantic – Tropical Storm Kate



Tropical Storm Kate (Update Statement 8:20 a.m. EST)


- Located 40 miles ESE of the Bahamas

- No coastal Watches or Warnings for the U.S.




2 Day Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




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2 Day Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day






Forecast River Flooding




- **12.5 feet:** Lower portions of Hideaway Lane begin to flood. Water covers the driveways in the Harts Bluff community
- **13 feet:** Some homes become flooded; most homes and cabins along the river between Canadys and Norman Landing are accessible only by boat


Severe Weather Outlook, Days 1-3

Temperature Probability





